SUBSIDY FOR "EXPORT / OFF LOAD OF WHEAT STOCKS" Subject:

Economic Coordination Committee (ECC) of the Cabinet in case No. ECC-19/3/2015 dated 09-02-2015 titled "Export / Offload of Wheat Stocks" has allowed export of wheat from the Province of Sindh (400,000 metric tons) and Punjab (800,000 metric tons) with export rebate of US\$ 45 per metric ton and US\$55 metric ton respectively as notified by Ministry of National Food Security and Research on 12th February, 2015.
