OFFICE MEMORANDUM

SUBJECT: DECISION OF THE MEETING OF ECC OF THE CABINET HELD ON 20.09.2024 REGARDING EXPORT OF 40,000MT OF SUGAR TO TAJIKISTAN

The undersigned is directed to refer to the subject cited above and to state that the Economic Coordination Committee (ECC) of the Cabinet in its Case No. ECC-178/21/2024 dated 20th September, 2024 (copy enclosed) has approved para 3 of the Summary moved with the modification that Ministry of Industries and Production will play a lead role, through Pakistan Sugar Mills Association (PSMA), in the negotiations with the Government of Tajikistan and Trading Corporation of Pakistan (TCP) would facilitate the Ministry. The decision has been ratified by the Federal Cabinet vide its decision in case No. 479-Rule-19/2024/812 dated 25.09.2024 para 3 of this relevant summary is reproduced as under:

"It is proposed that export of 40,000 MT sugar to Tajikistan as agreed between the two governments on bilateral trade arrangements may be allowed on Business (PSMA) to Government (agency nominated by Tajikistan) basis."

2. It may kindly be note as informed by Ministry of Foreign Affairs vide their U.O No. Tak-6/2024 dated 27.08.2024 (copy enclosed) Tajikistan Government has nominated "Agency of State Material Reserves of Tajikistan". TCP to coordinate with PSMA and with the Tajik Government (and to communicate names of the sugar mills designated to export sugar to Tajikistan on B to G arrangement to this Ministry).
3. All concerned are requested to implement the decision of the ECC/Federal Cabinet in letter and spirit and to facilitate the export of sugar as per the directions of ECC/Federal Cabinet.
