State Bank refutes rumours of mixing of gold in Rs. 1/- & Rs.2/- coins

The State Bank of Pakistan (SBP) has categorically denied the reports/rumours appearing in a section of the regional press/media regarding the mixing of gold in aluminum/copper coins of Rs. 1/- & Rs.2/-.

The Chief Spokesman of SBP, Syed Wasimuddin described the reports/rumours as baseless, highly misleading and mischievous.

In a clarification issued today, the SBP Chief Spokesman said the exchange value of Rs. 1/- & Rs. 2/- coins will remain the same as per their face value. He advised the members of the general public that they should not buy or sell these coins on any price which is above their face value.
