

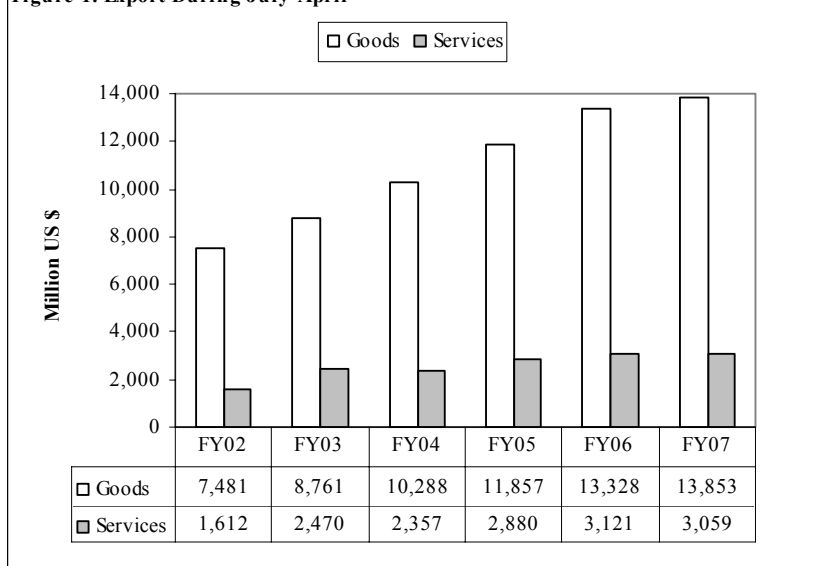

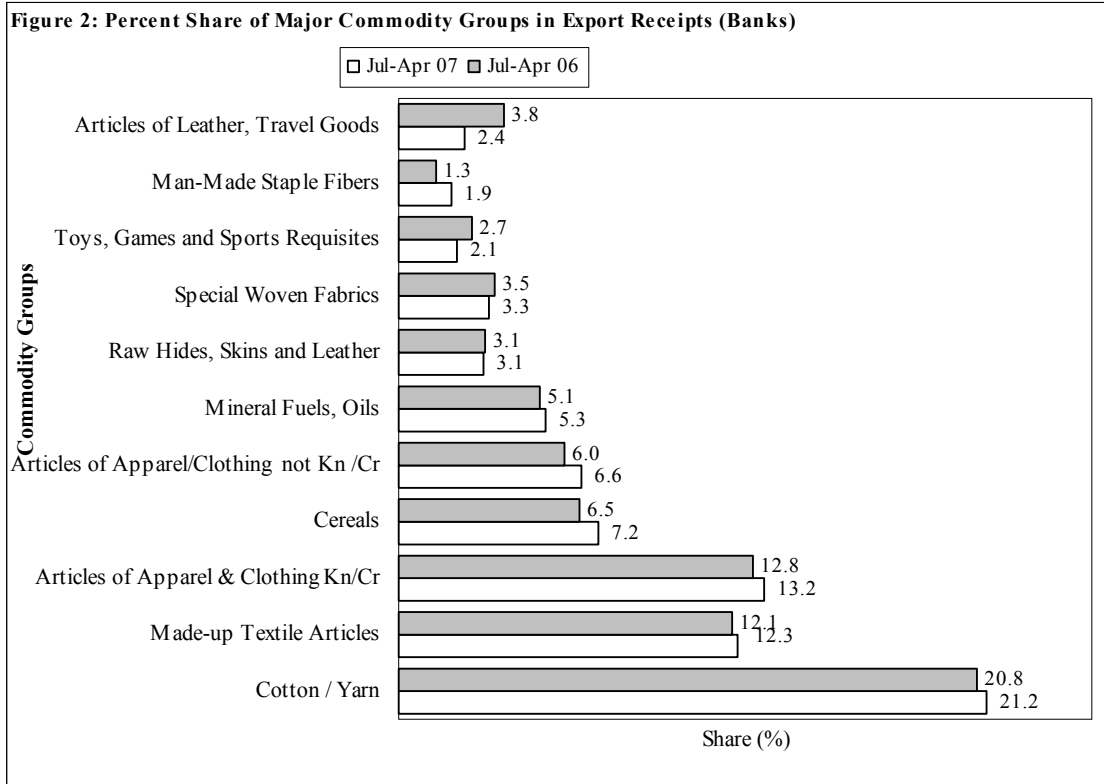

**Figure 1. Export During July-April**

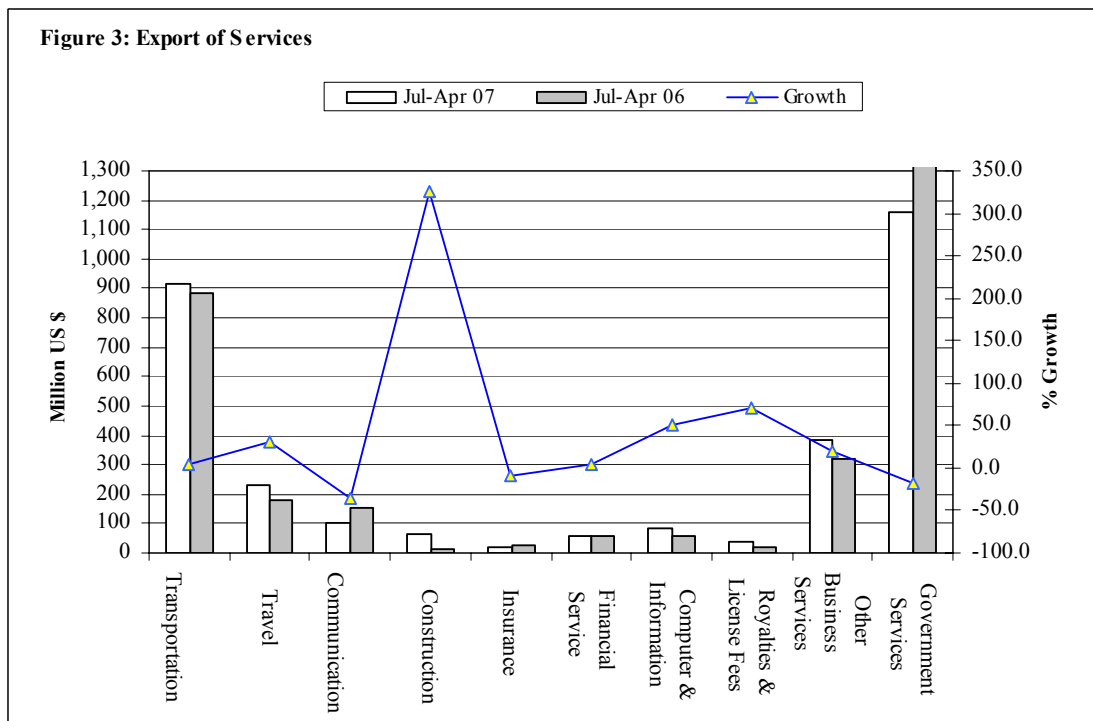

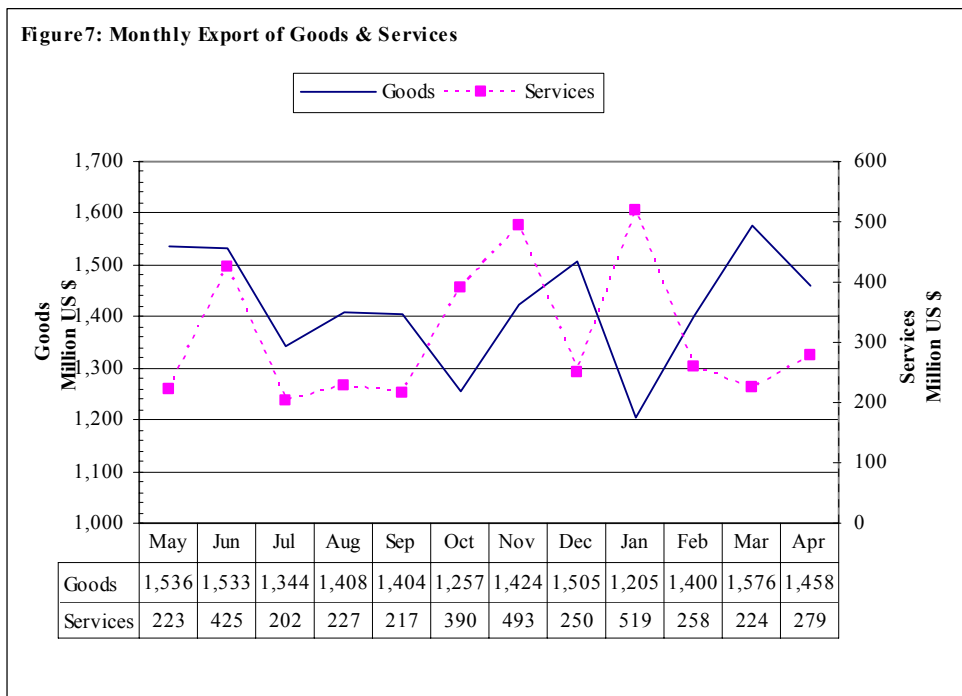
