Figure 1. Export During July-February

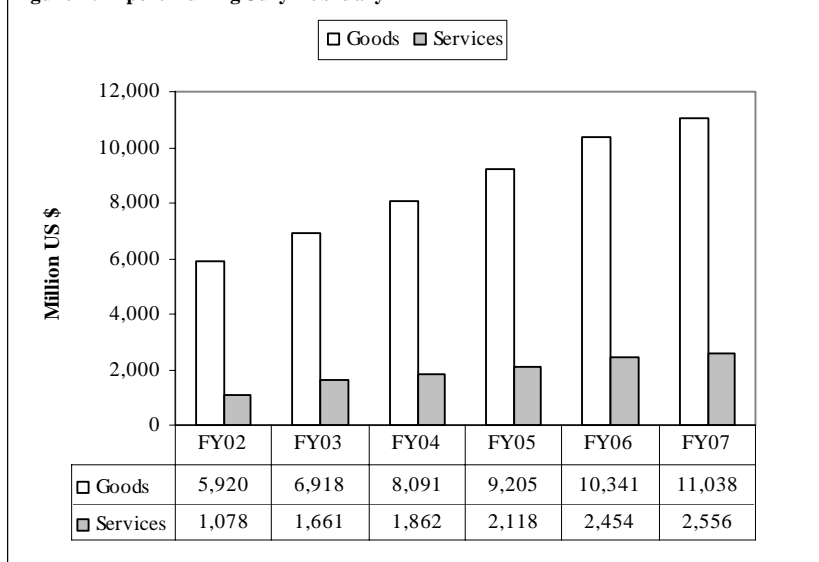
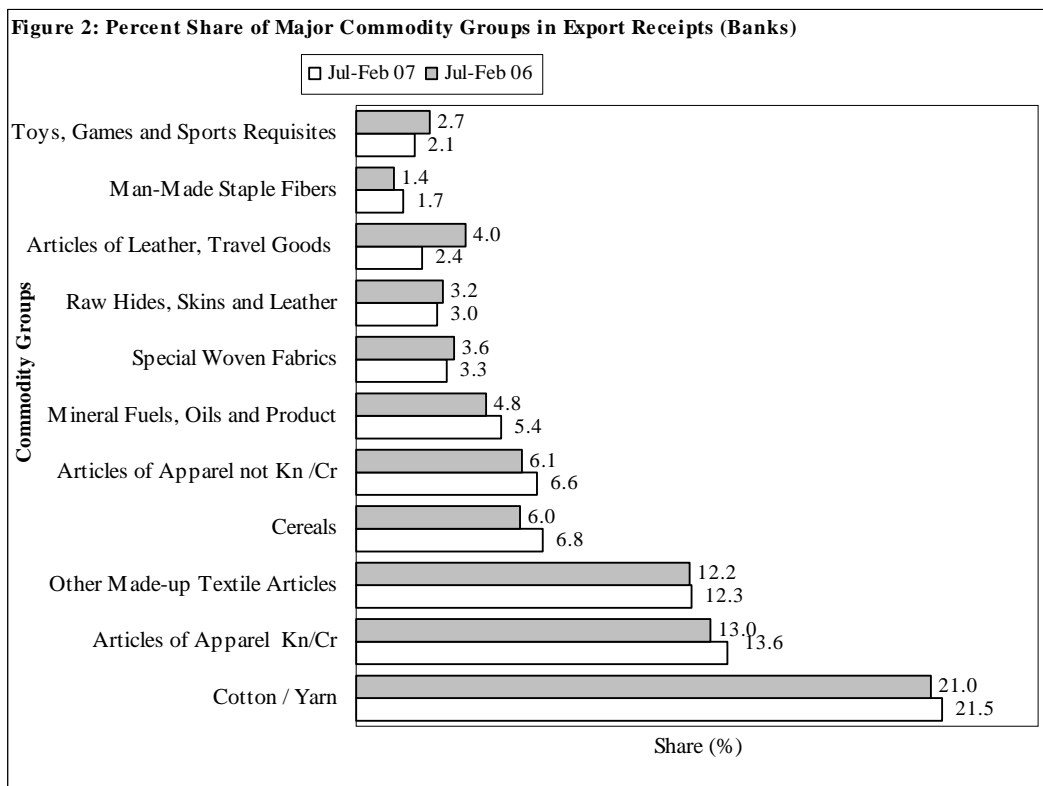

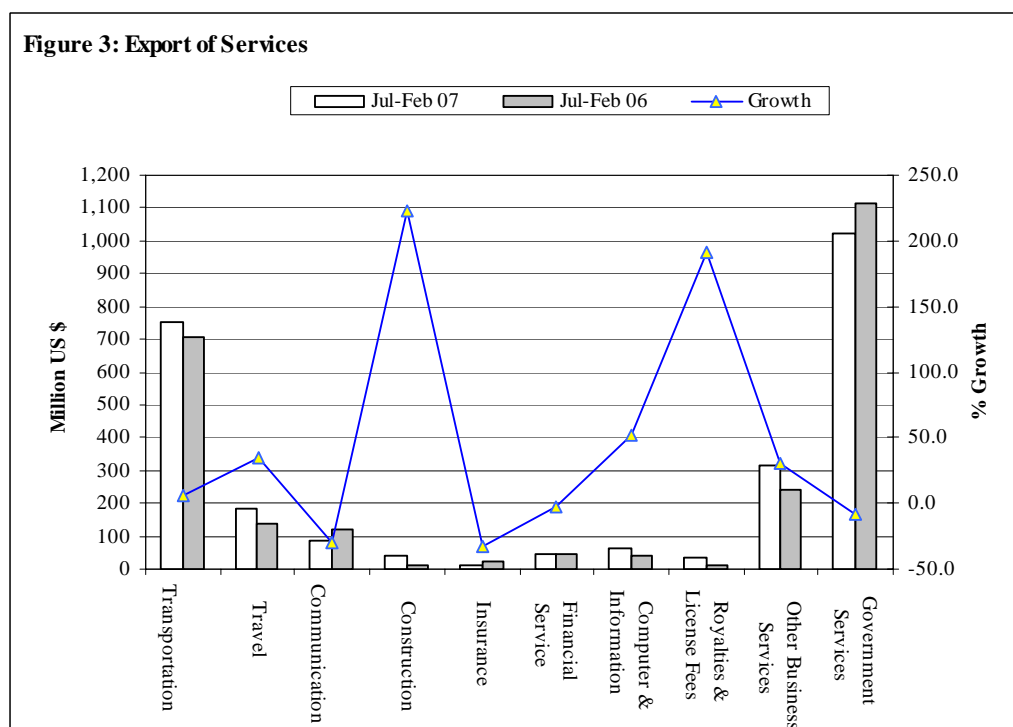
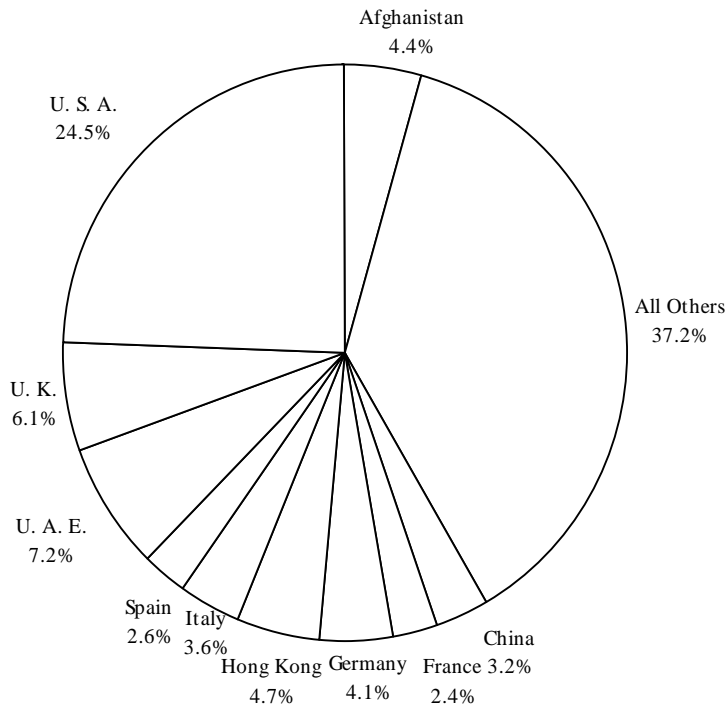

Figure 5: % Share of Major Countries in Export of Services During Jul-Feb 2007

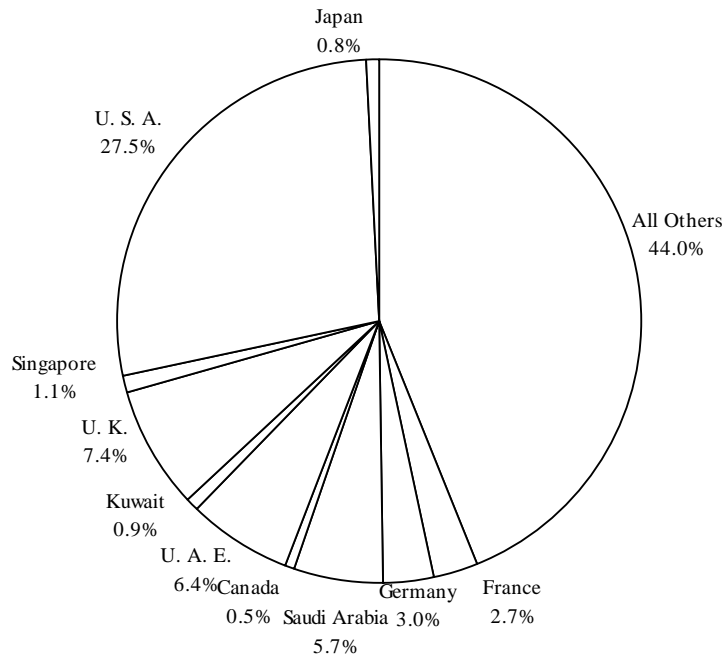
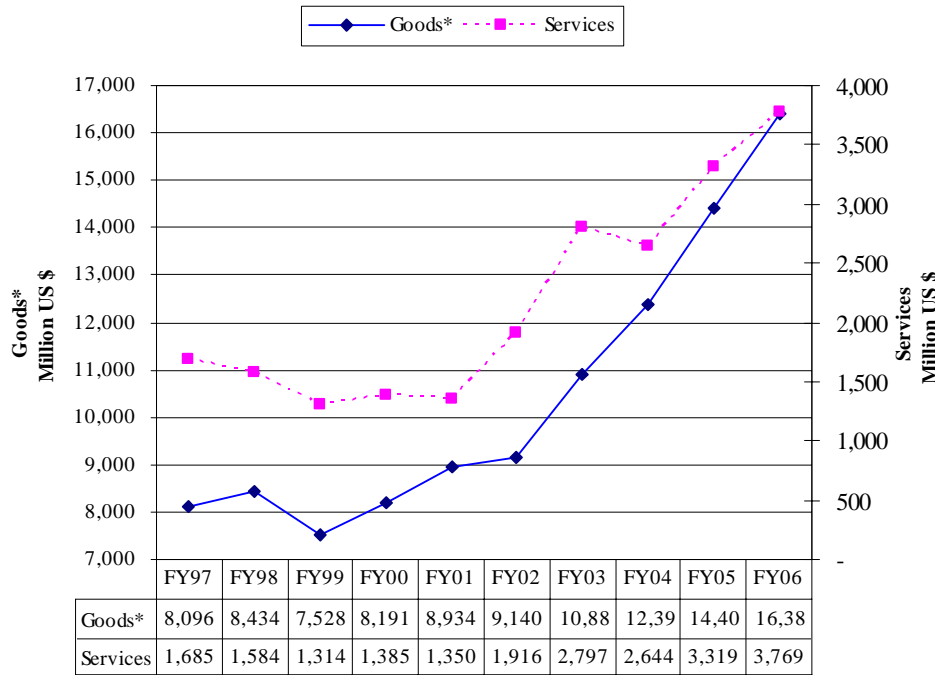


Figure 6: Annual Export of Goods & Services from FY97 to FY06

Figure7: Monthly Export of Goods & Services

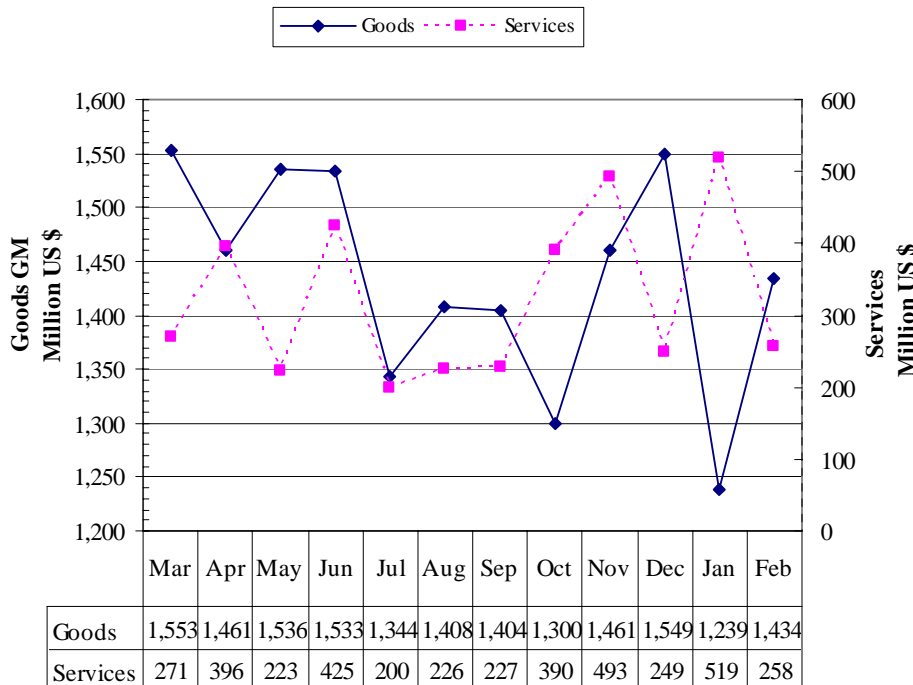
