Figure 1. Export During July 07

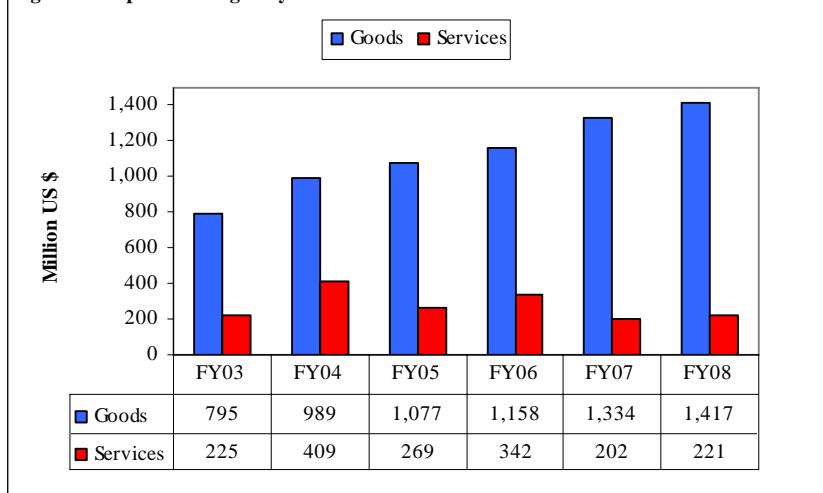
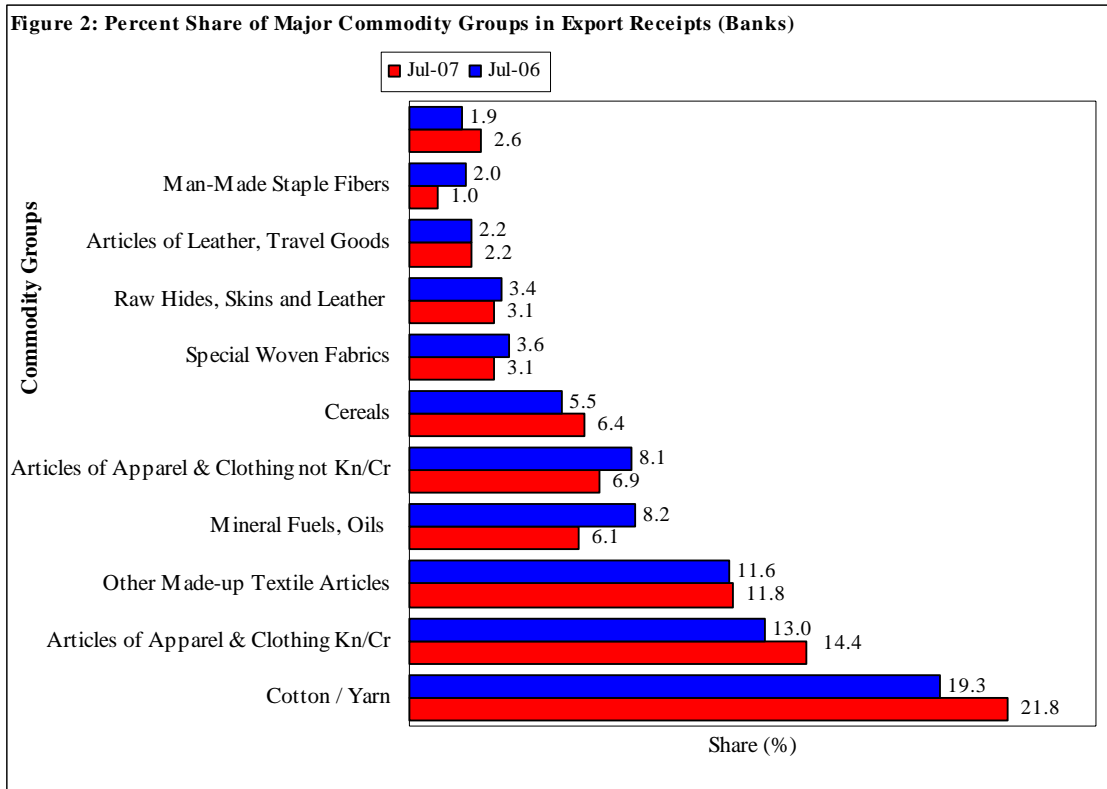

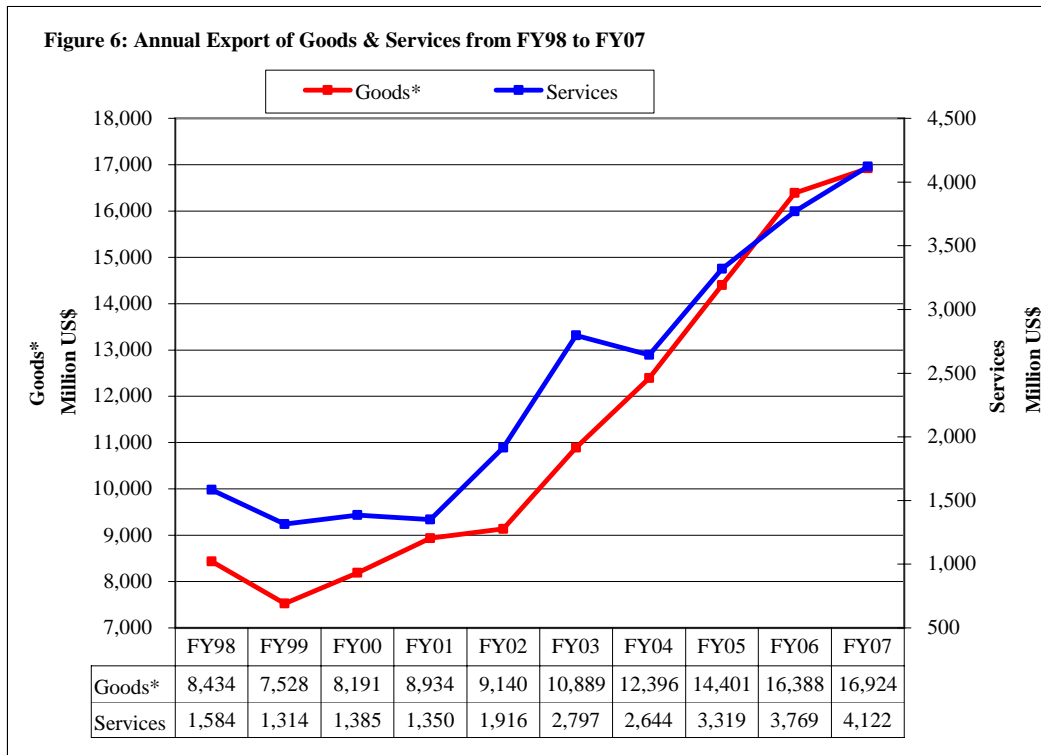
Figure 4: % Share of Major Countries in Export Receipts (Banks) During Jul 2007

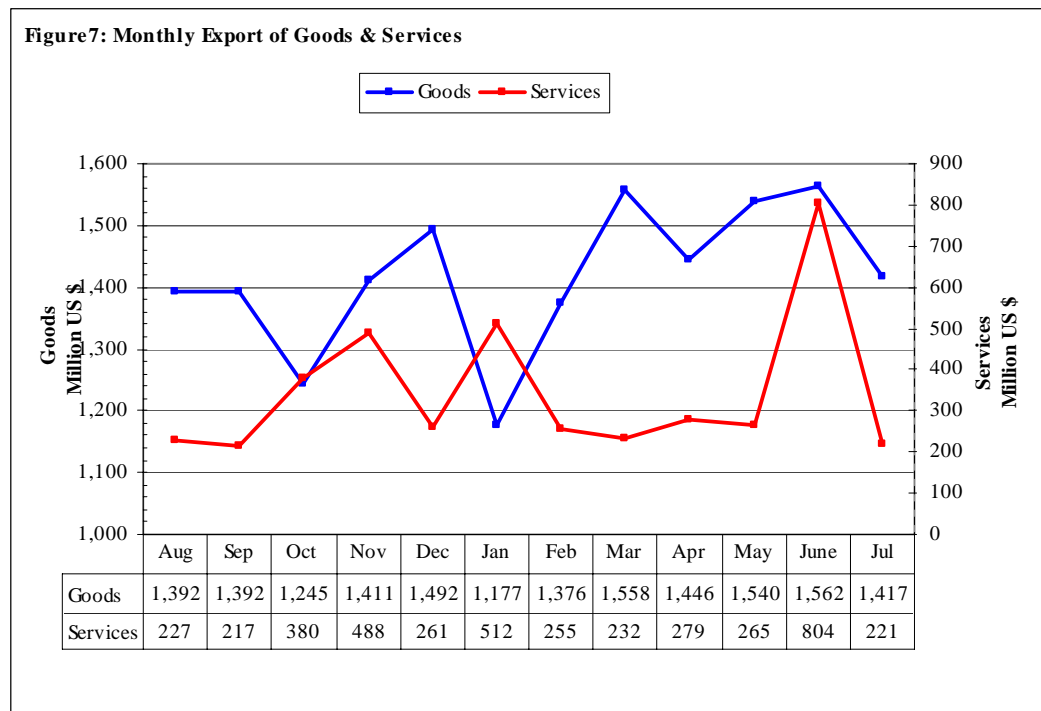
