Figure 1. Export During July-March

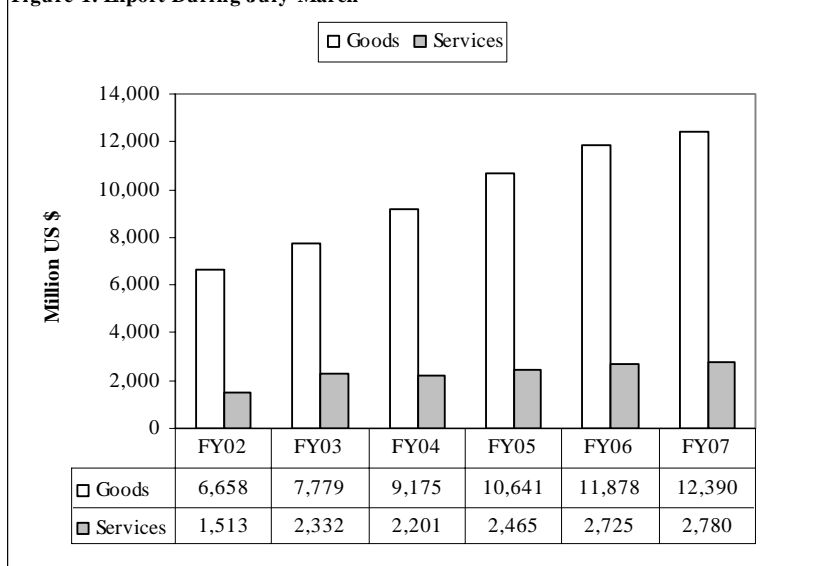
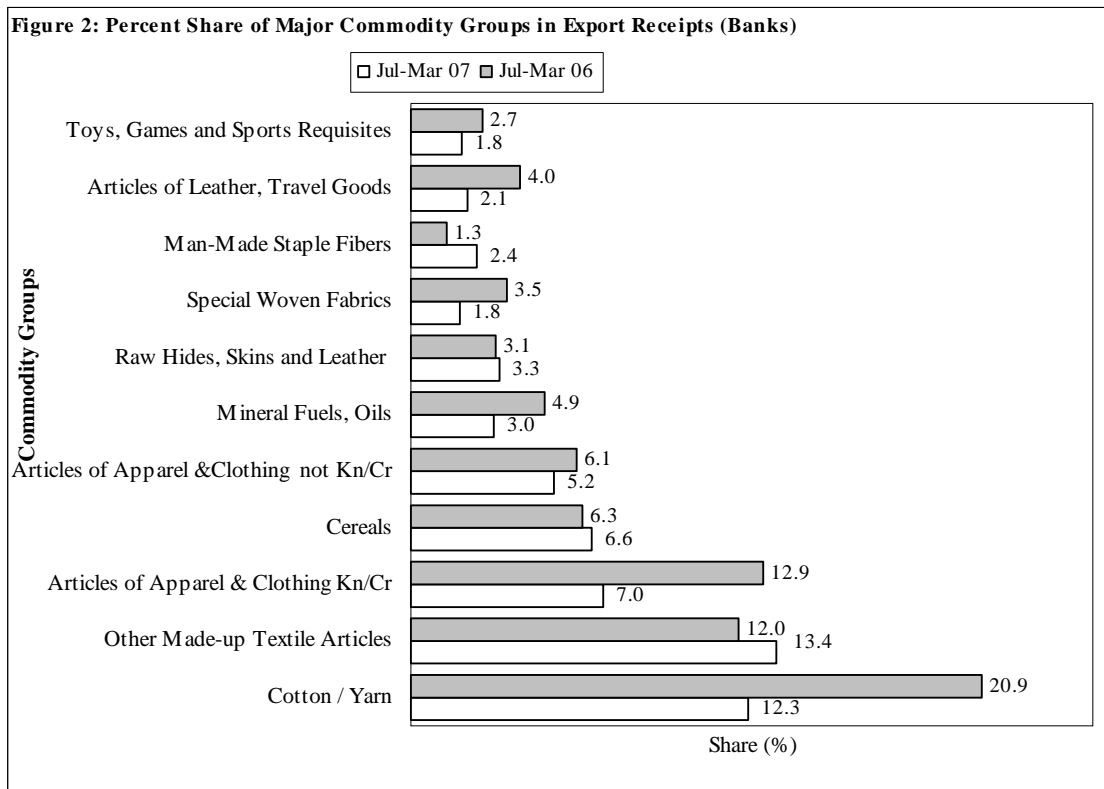

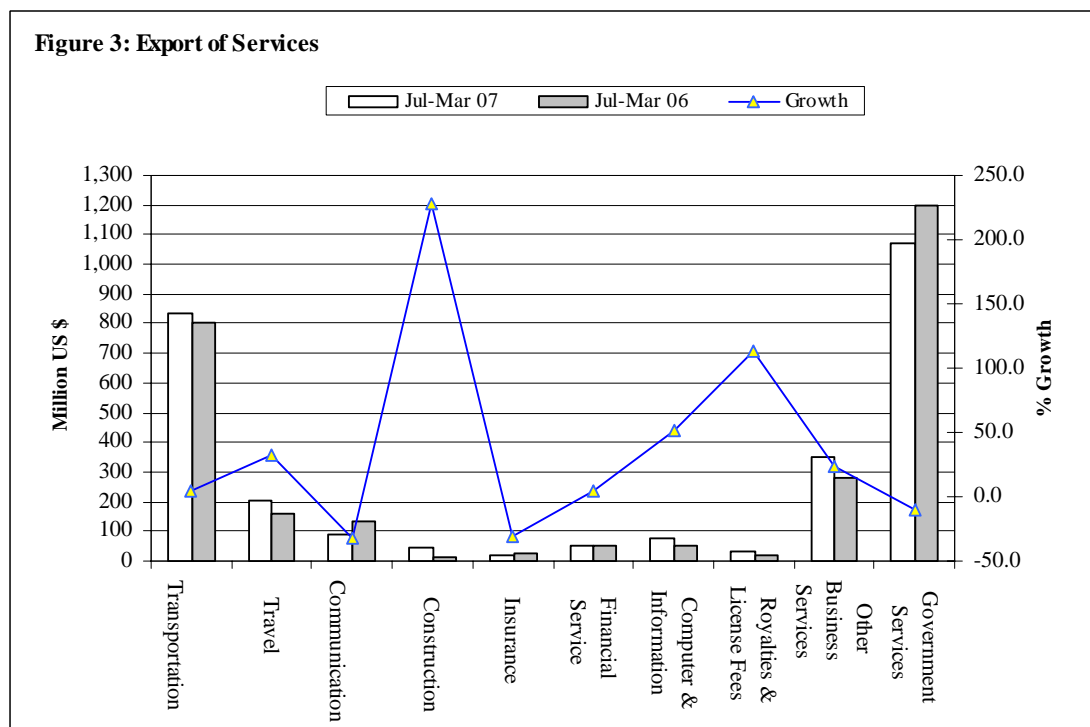
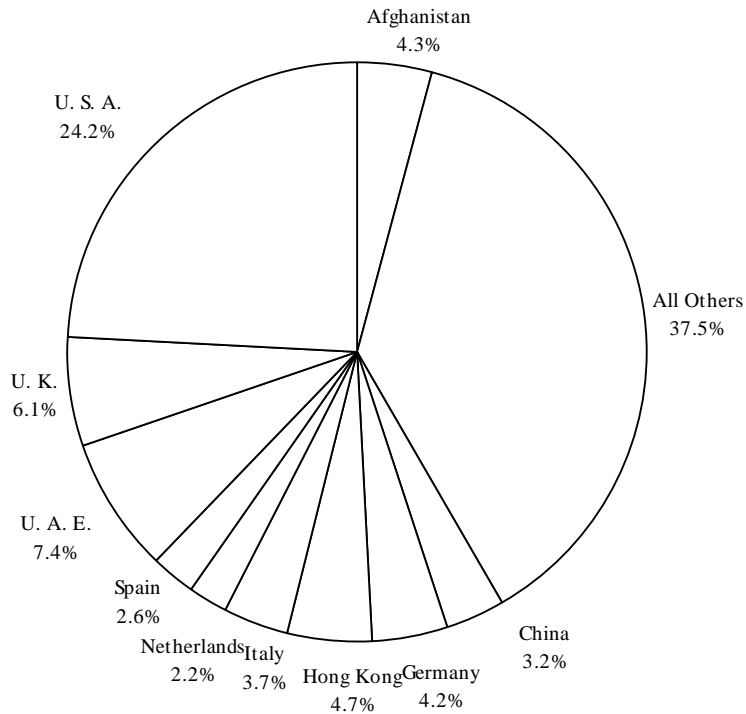


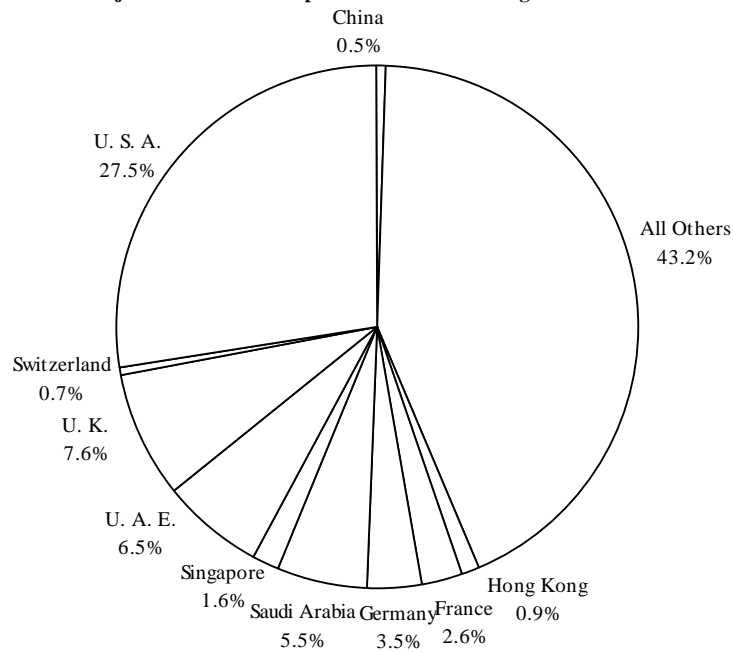

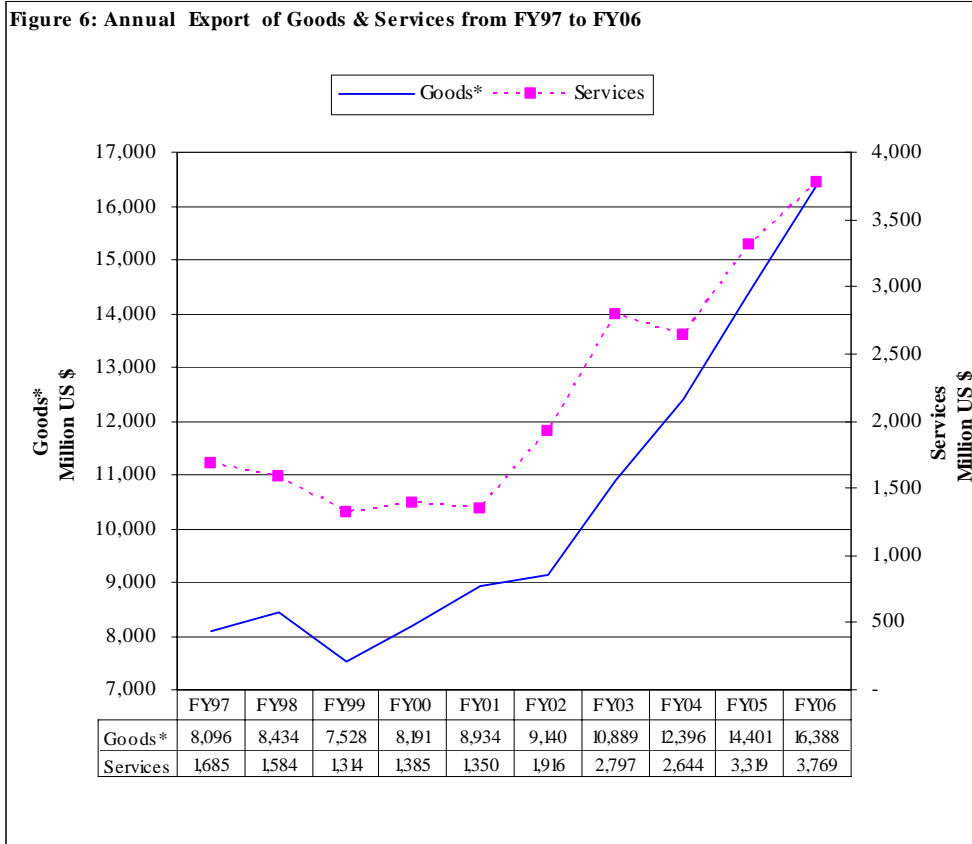
Figure 4: % Share of Major Countries in Export Receipts (Banks) During Jul-Mar 2007

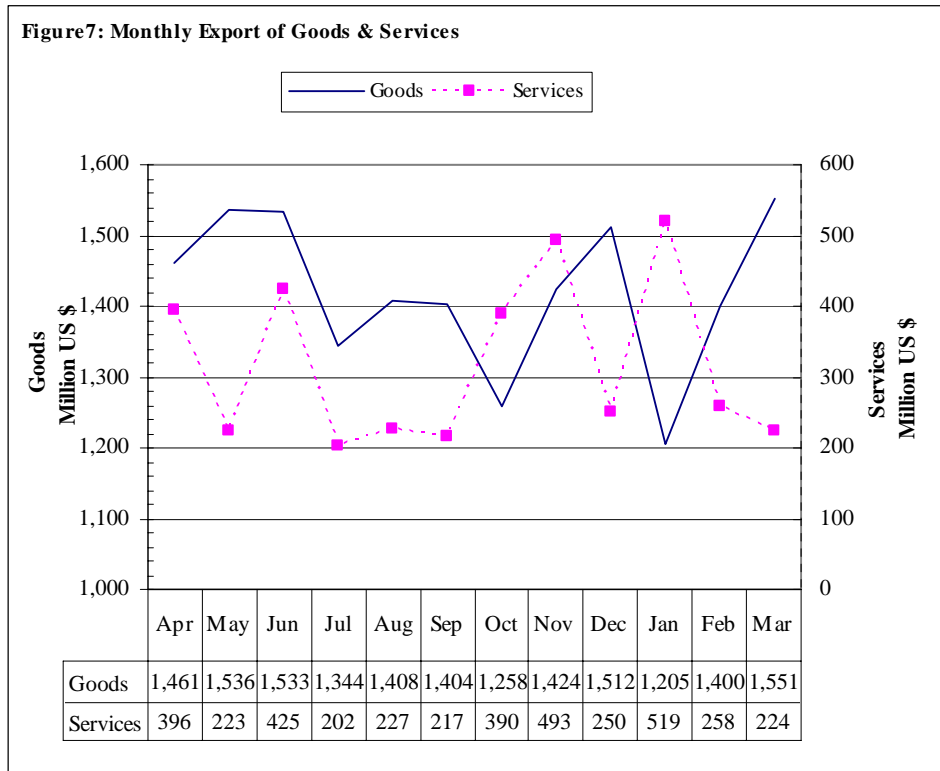
