Figure 1. Export During July-May

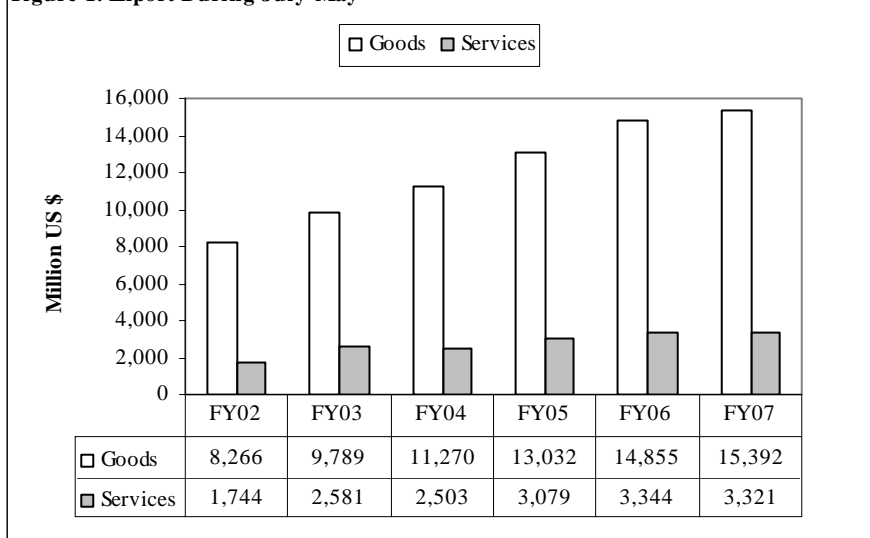
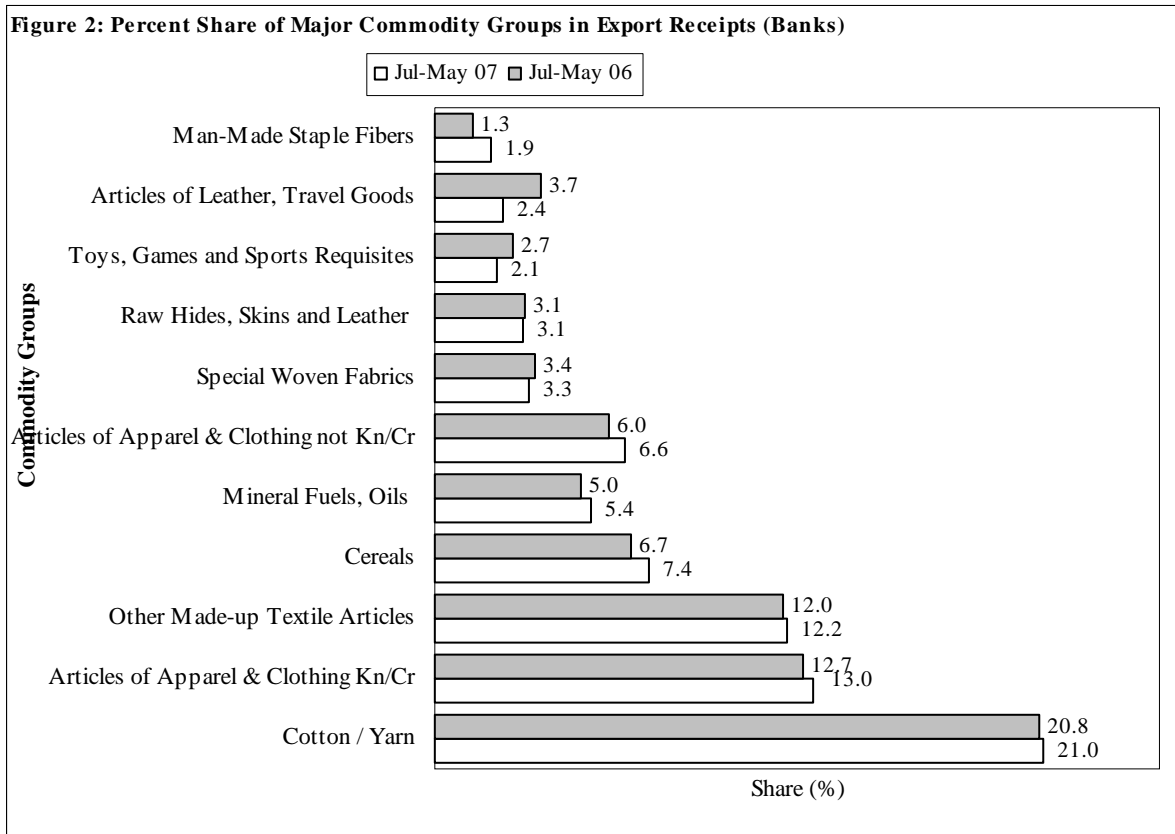

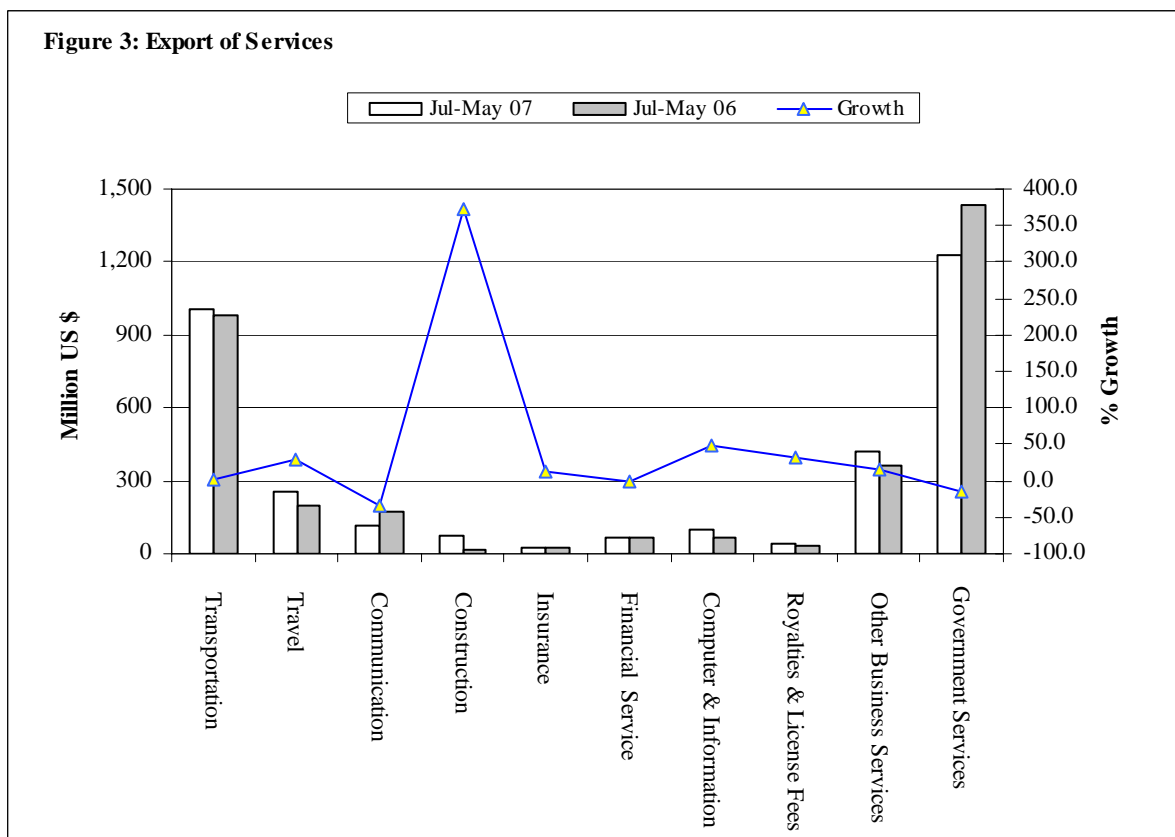
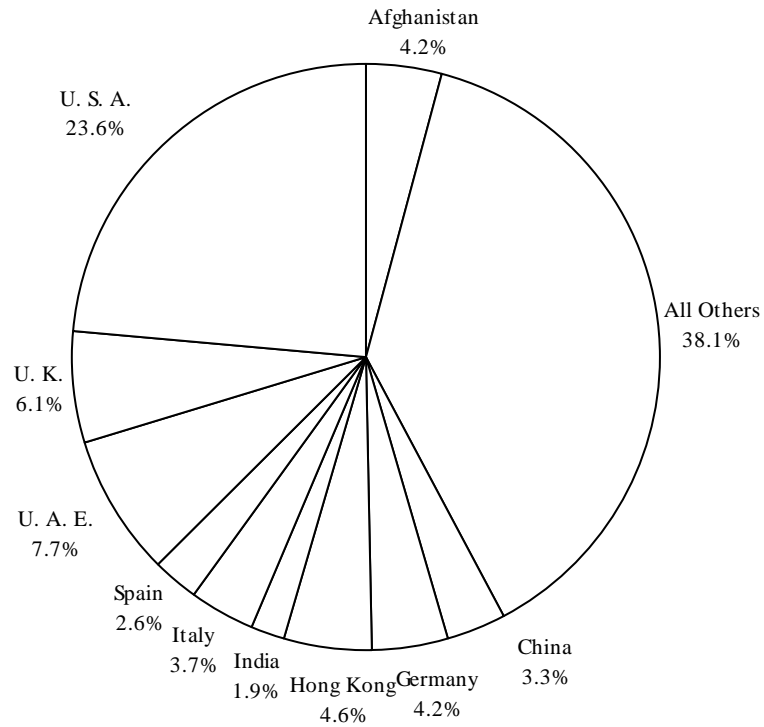


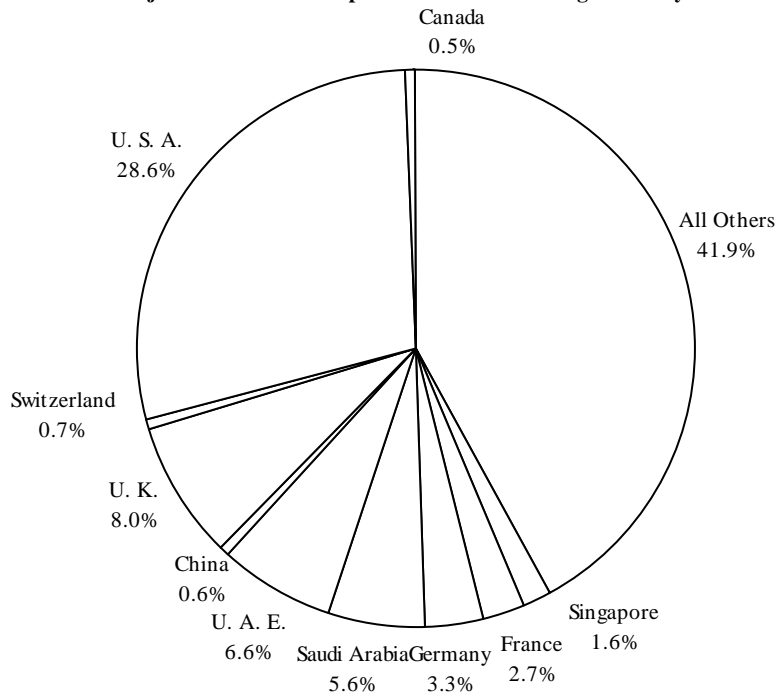

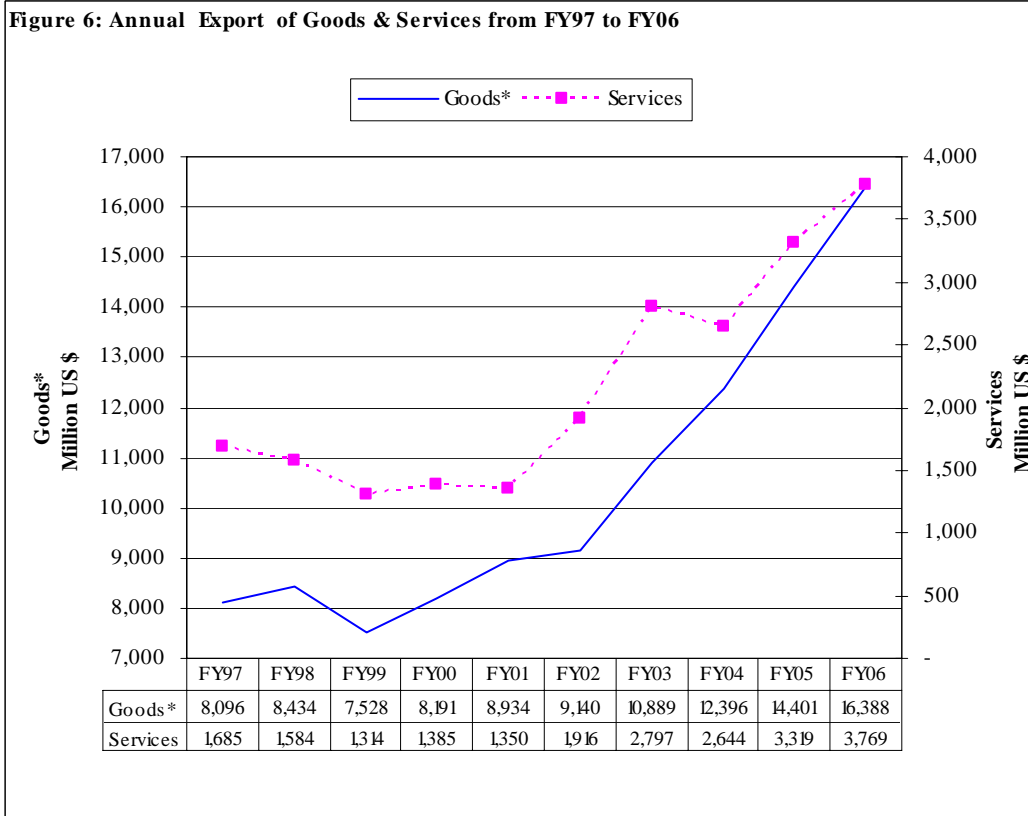
Figure 4: % Share of Major Countries in Export Receipts (Banks) During Jul-May 2007

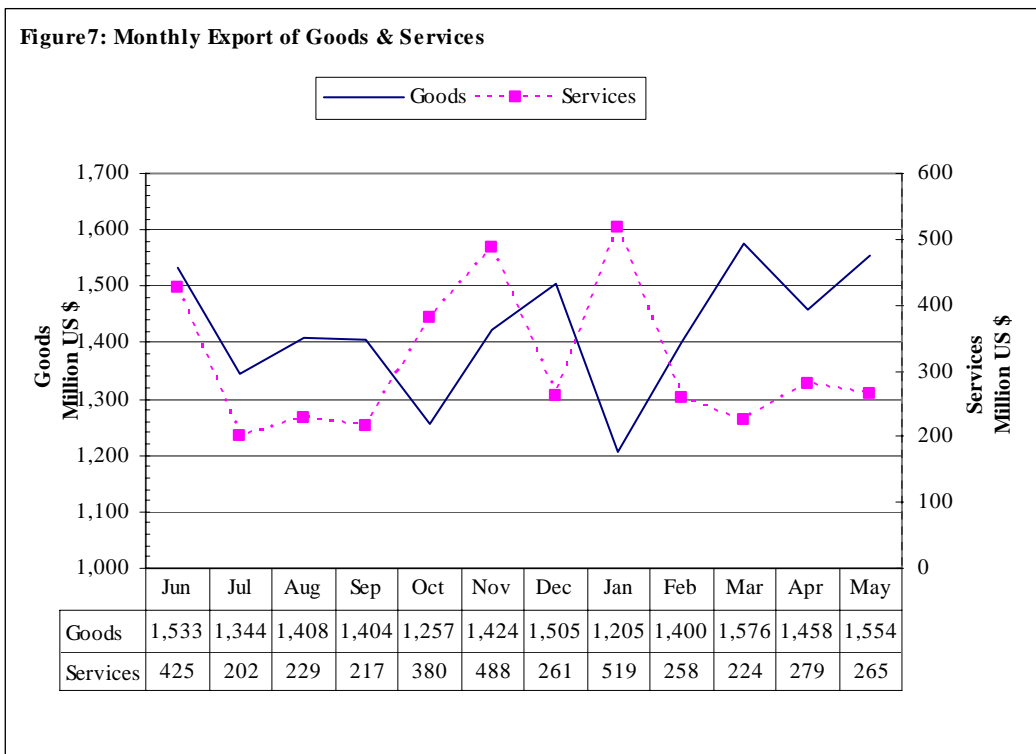
