Figure 1. Export During Jul-Nov 07

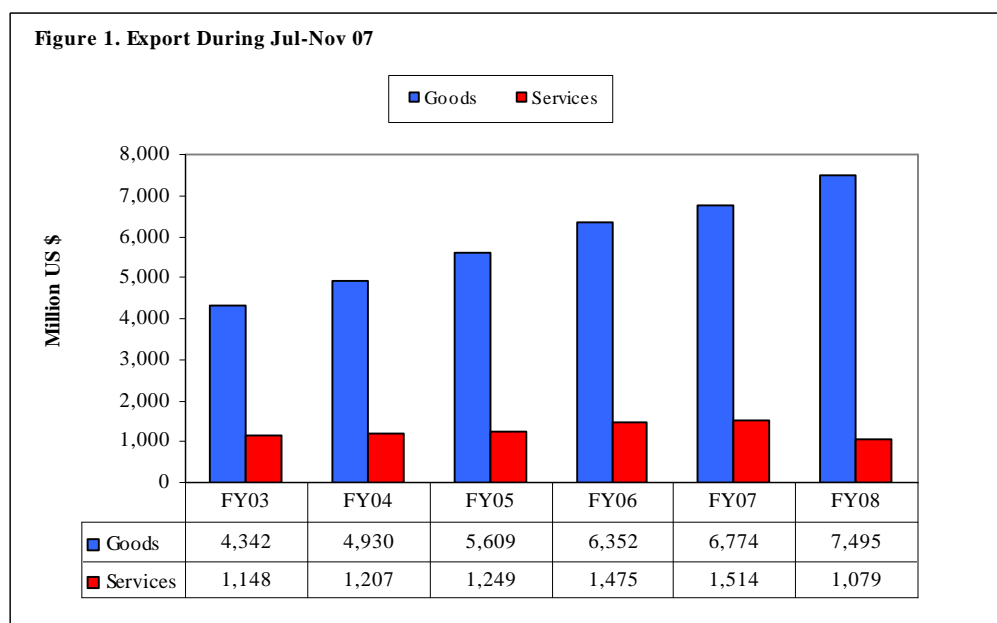
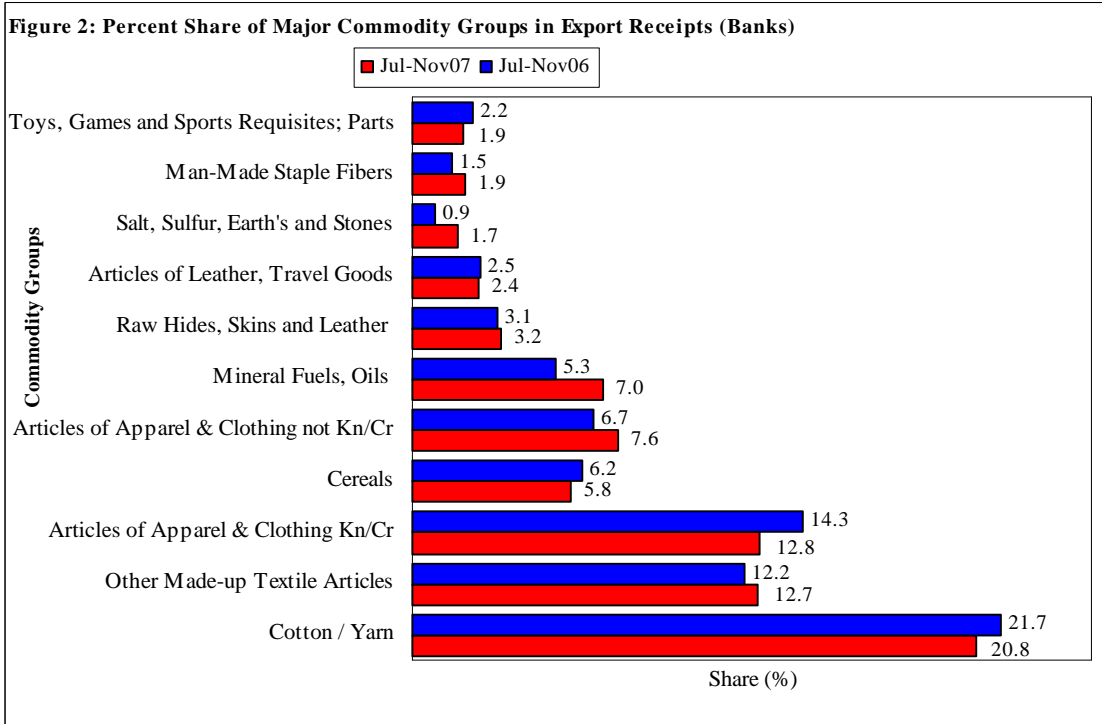

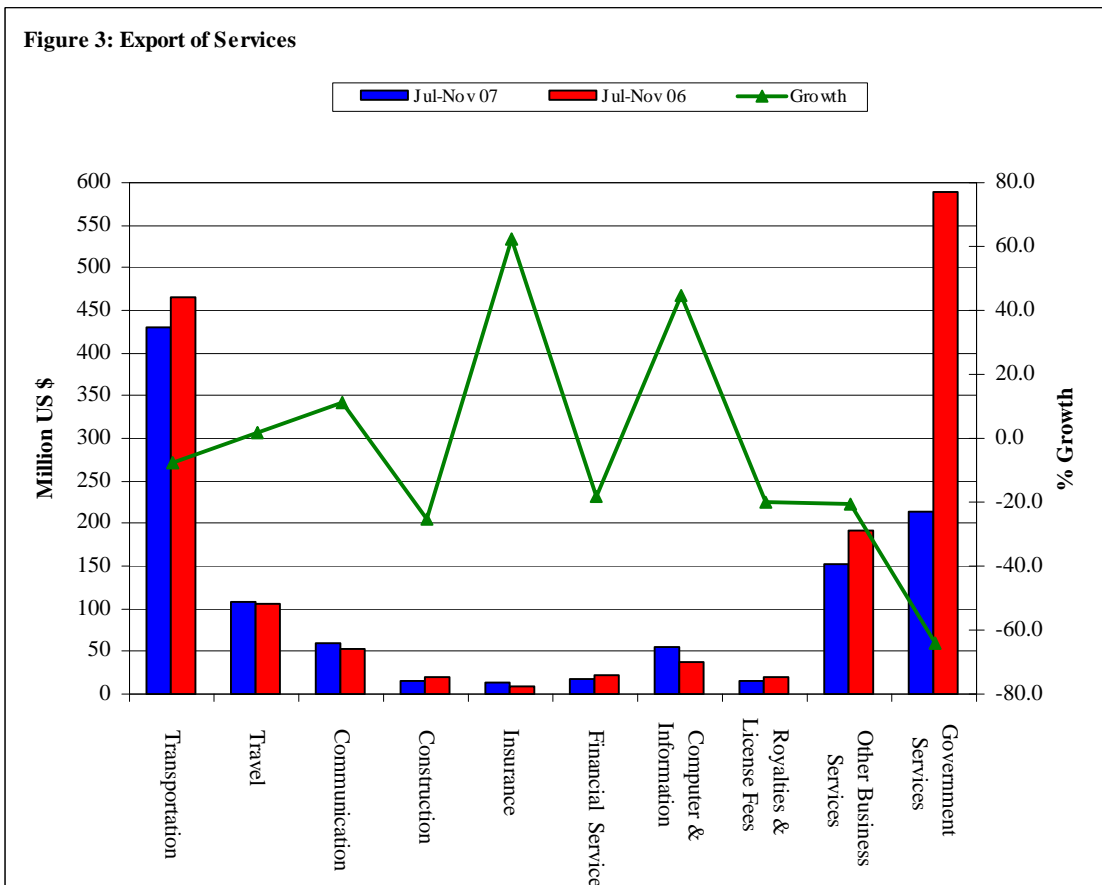
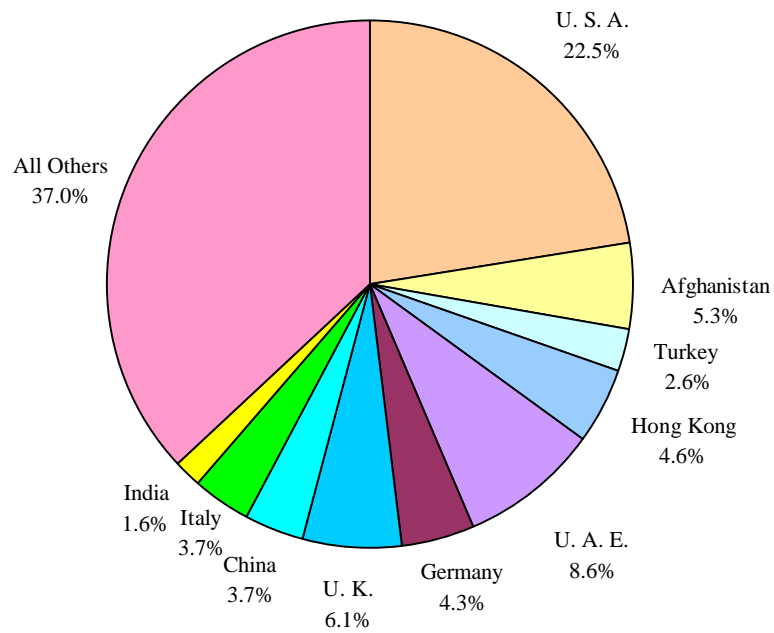


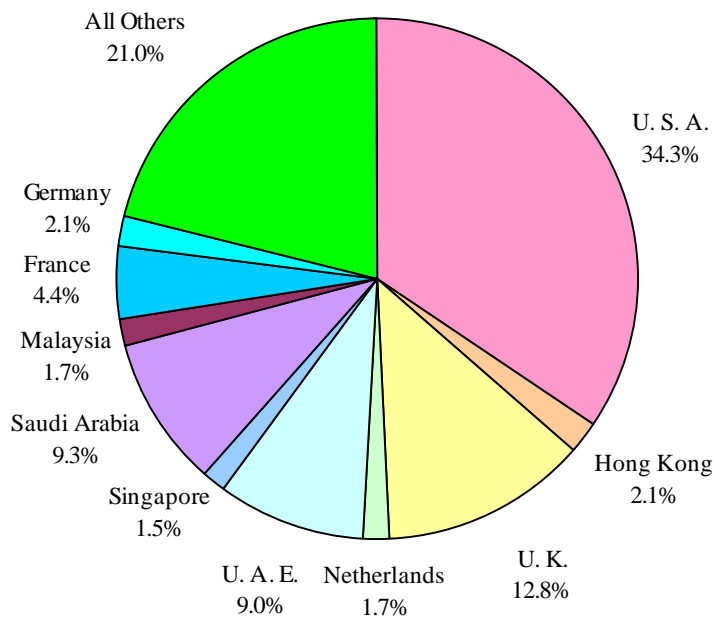

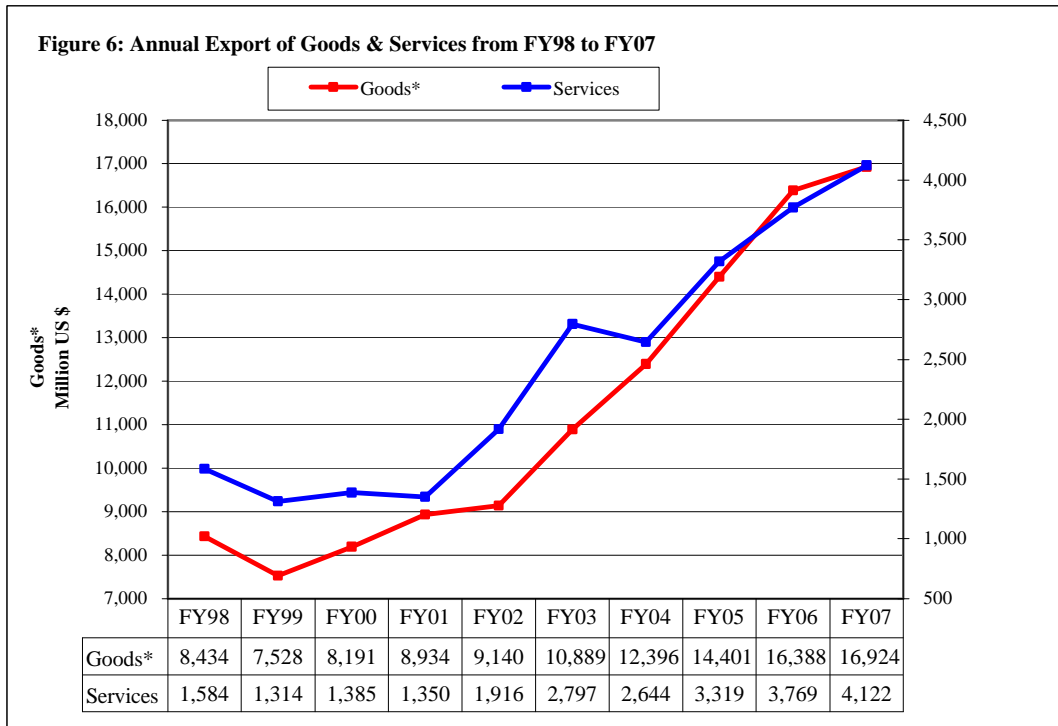
Figure 4: % Share of Major Countries in Export Receipts (Banks) During Jul-Nov 2007

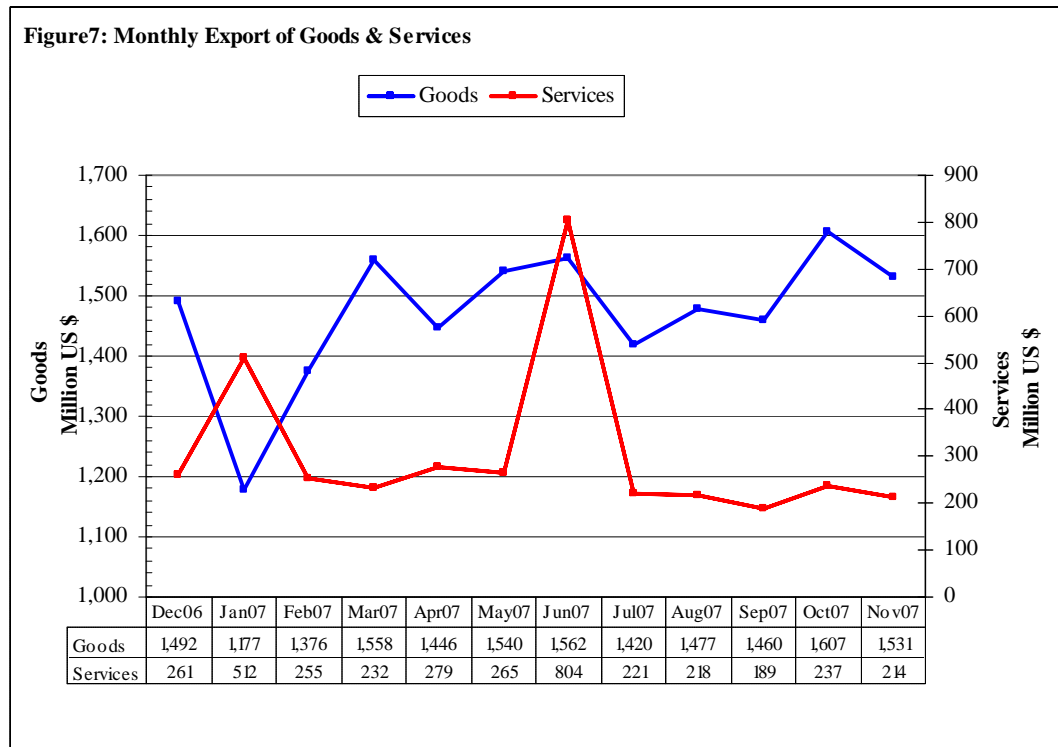
