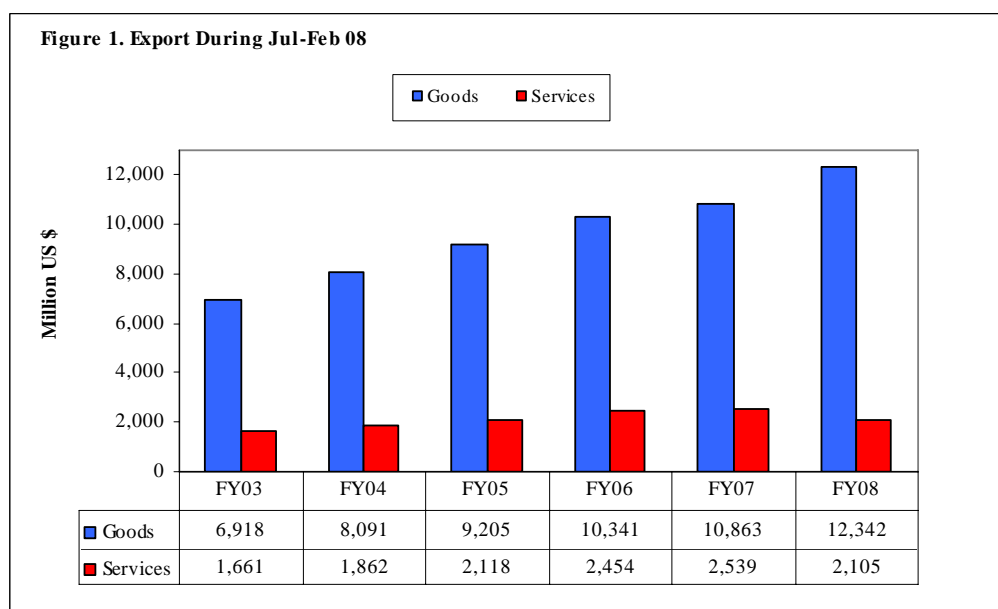
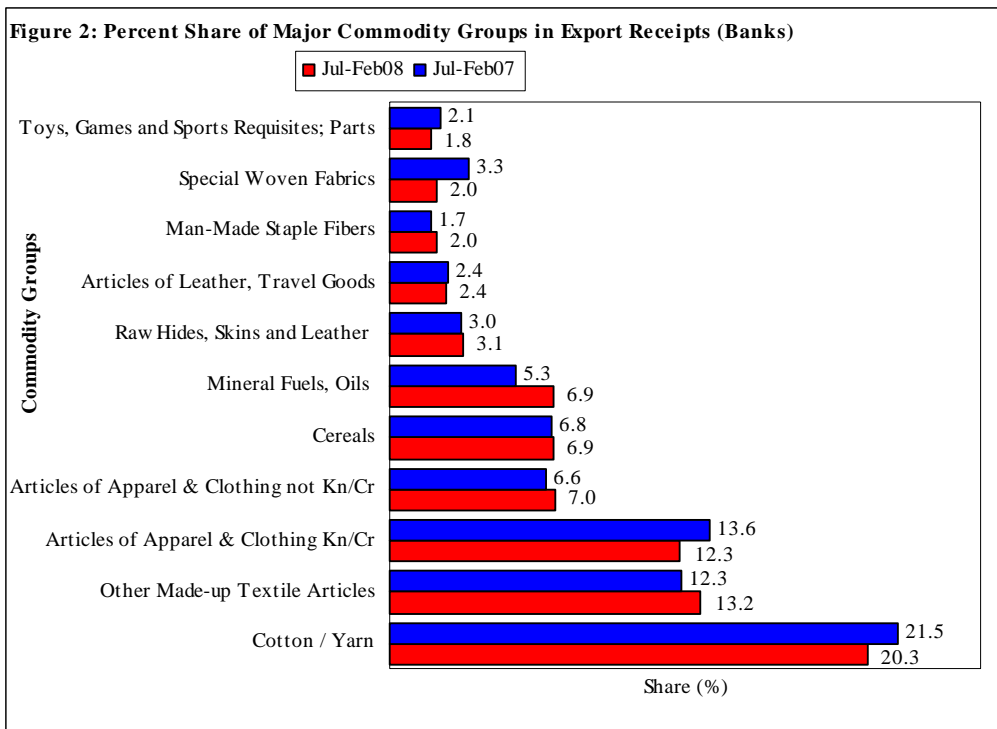

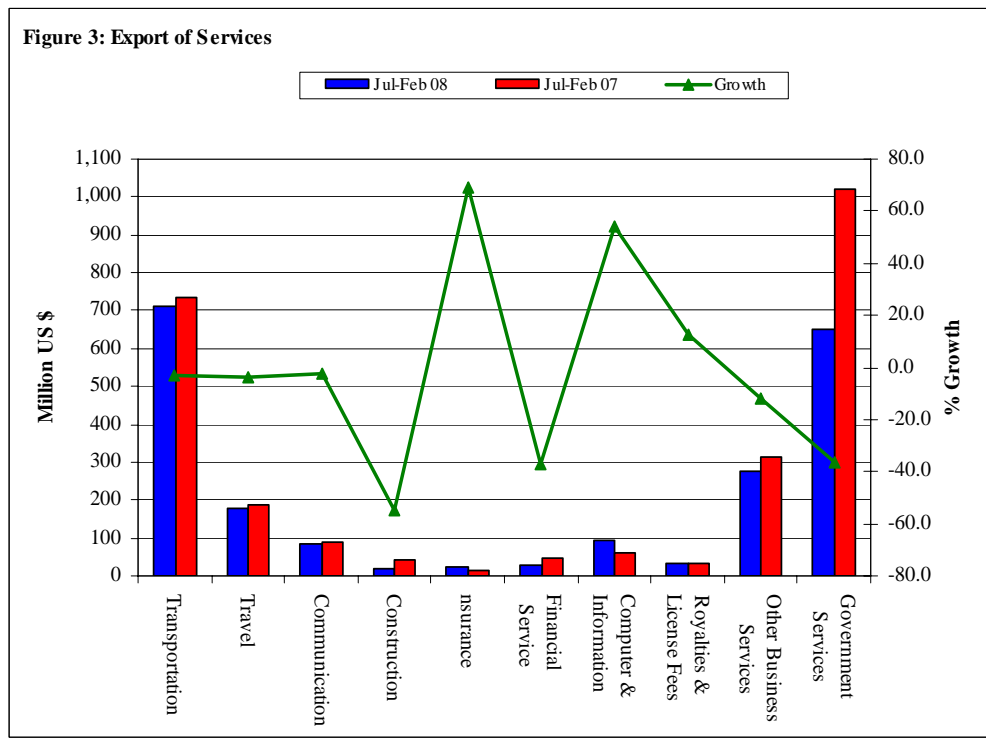

Figure 4: % Share of Major Countries in Export Receipts (Banks) During Jul-Feb 2008

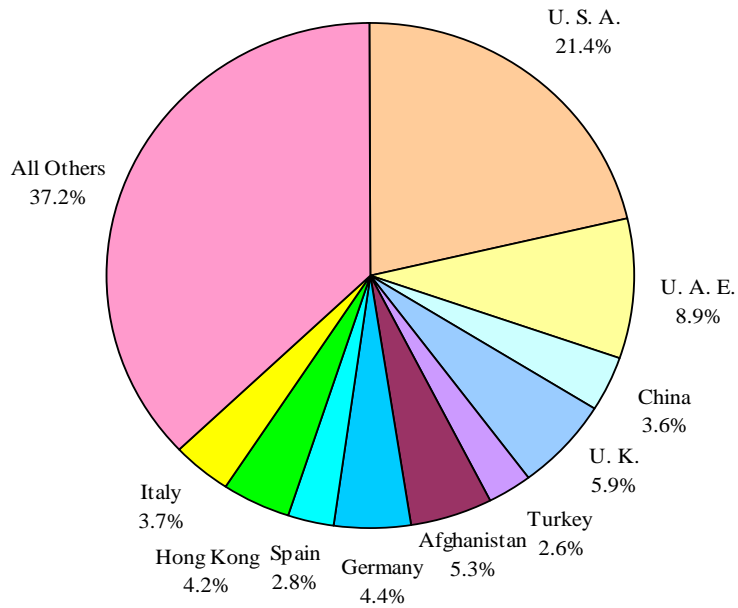
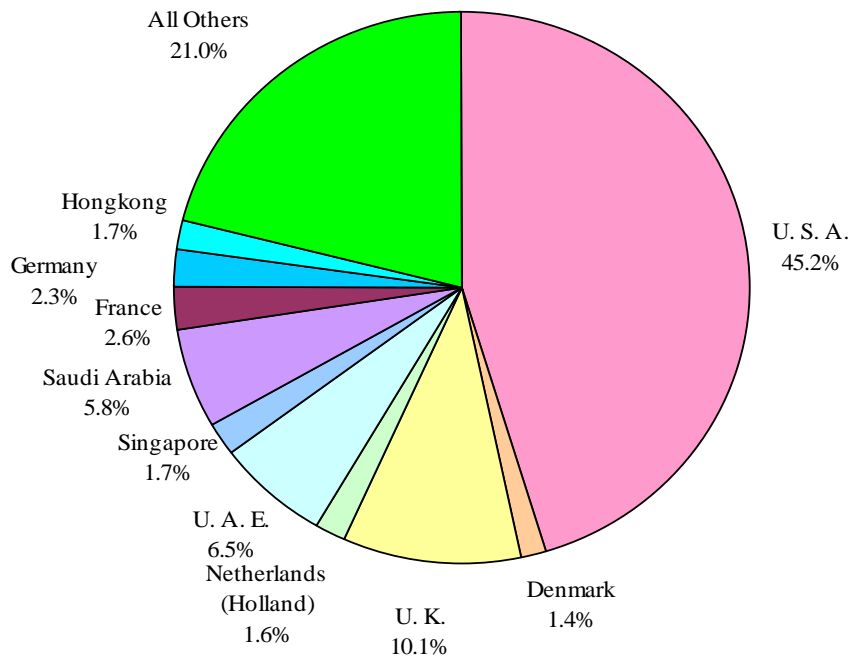
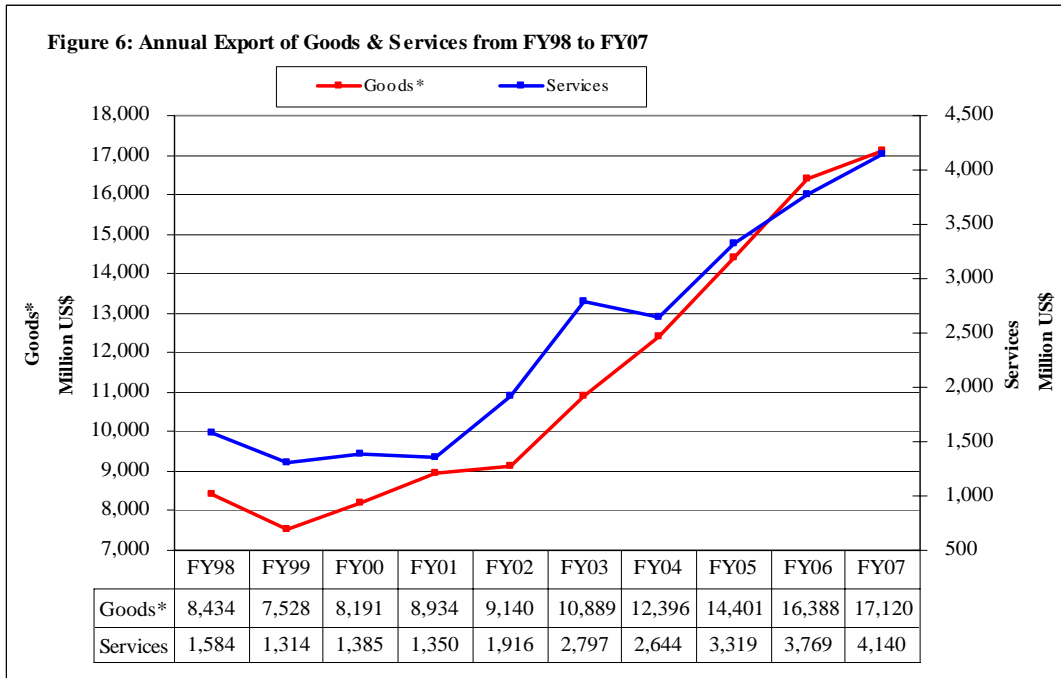


Figure 5: % Share of Major Countries in Export of Services During Jul-Feb 2008

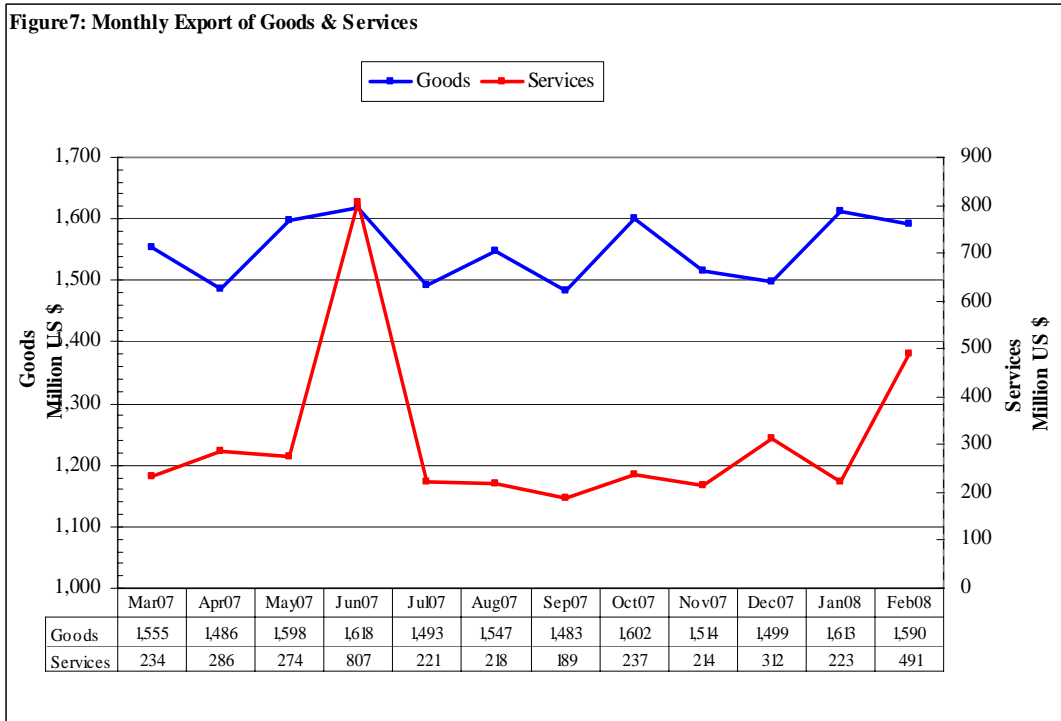
