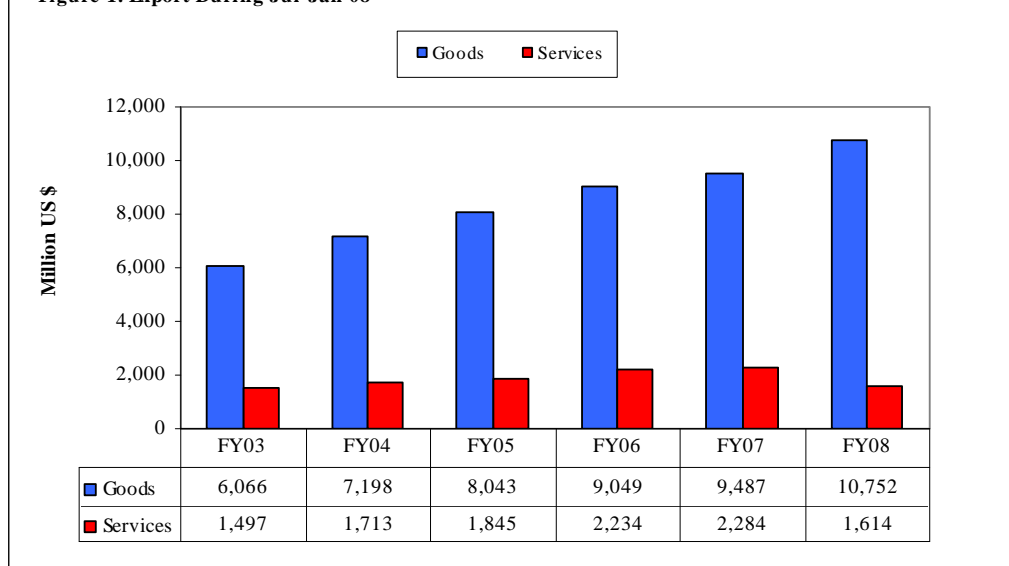

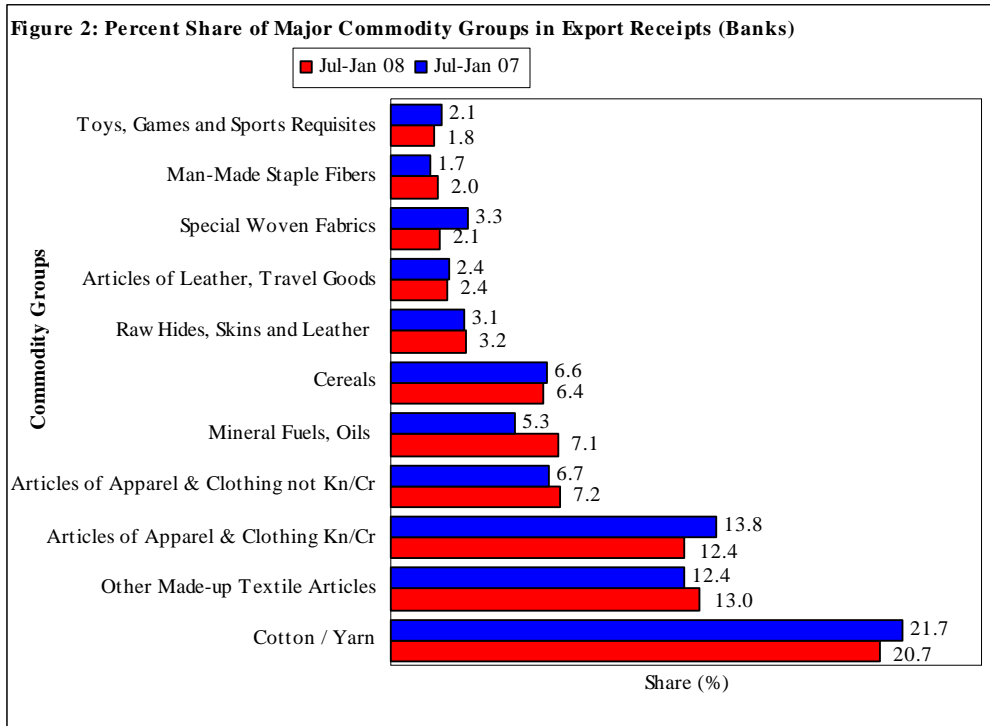
Figure 1. Export During Jul-Jan 08

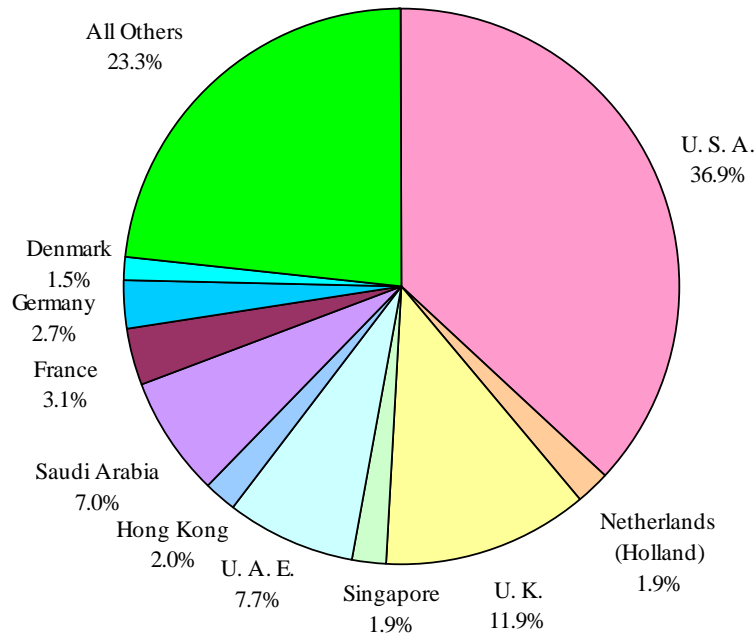

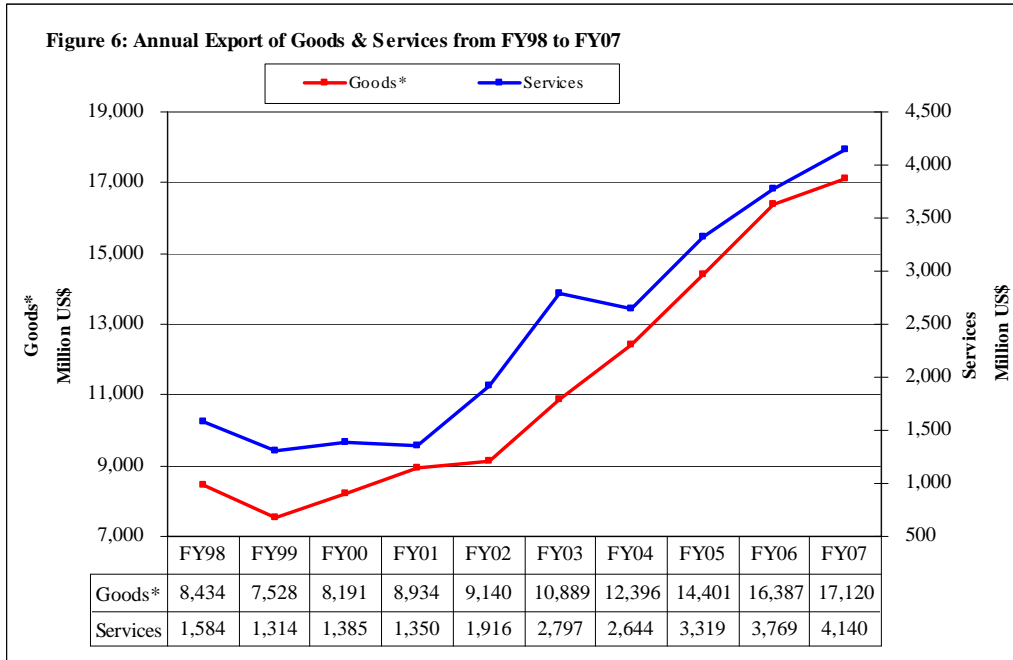

**Figure 4: % Share of Major Countries in Export Receipts (Banks) During Jul-Jan 2008**

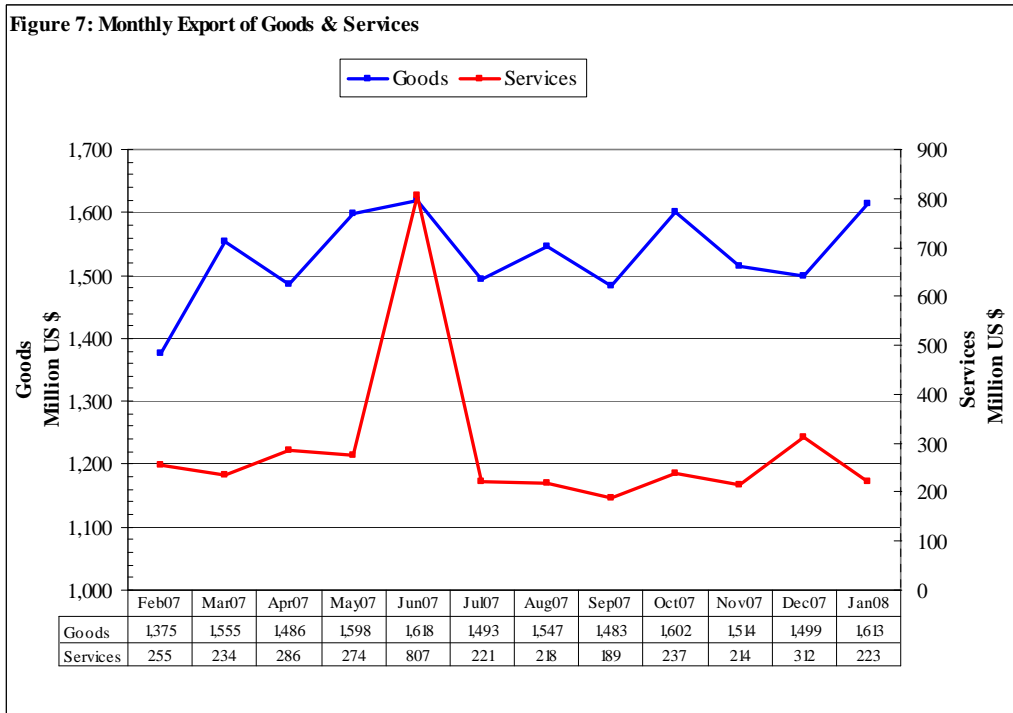


**Figure 5: % Share of Major Countries in Export of Services During Jul-Jan 2008**
