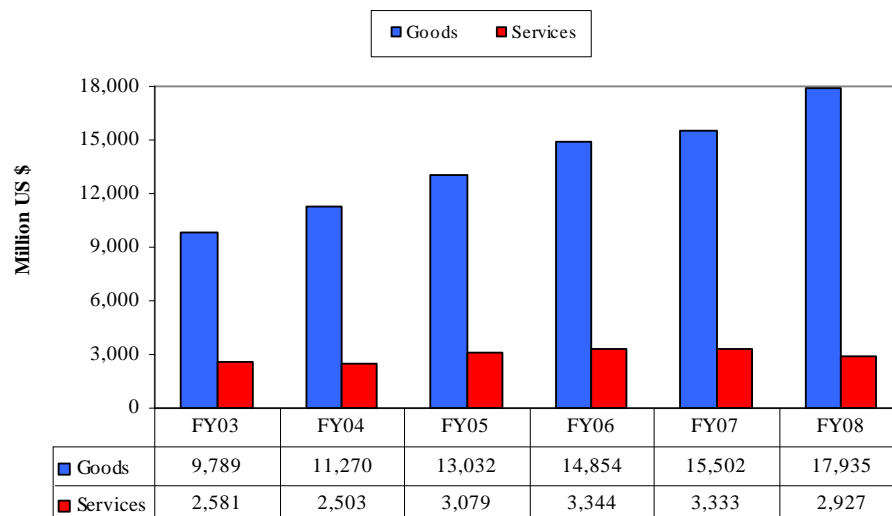
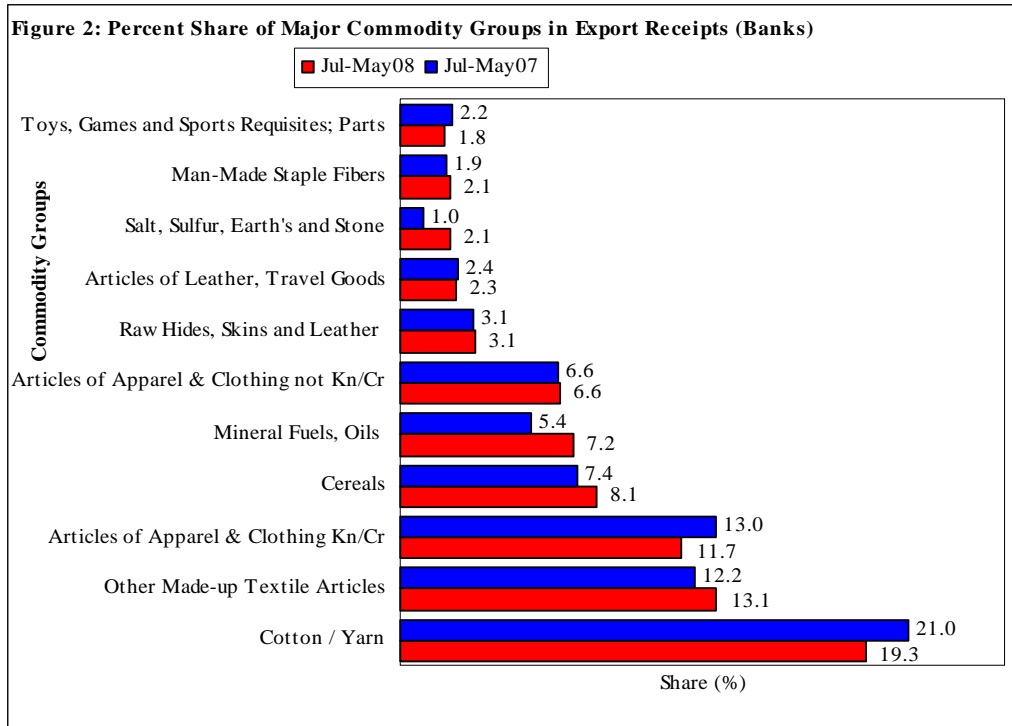
Figure 1. Export During Jul-May 08

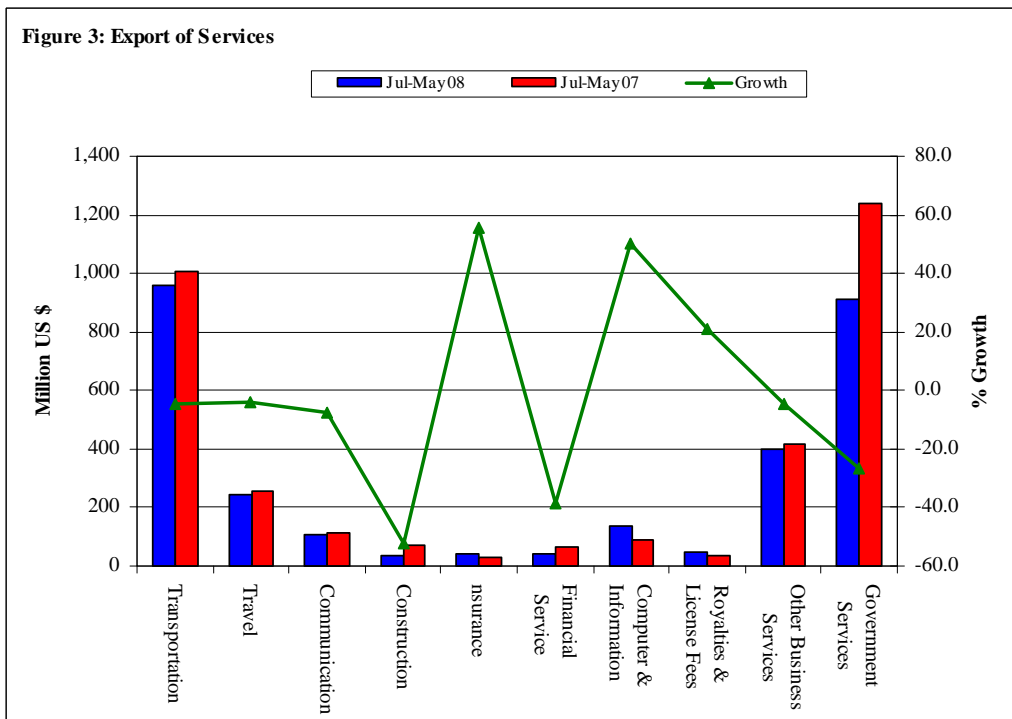

Figure 4: % Share of Major Countries in Export Receipts (Banks) During Jul-May 2008

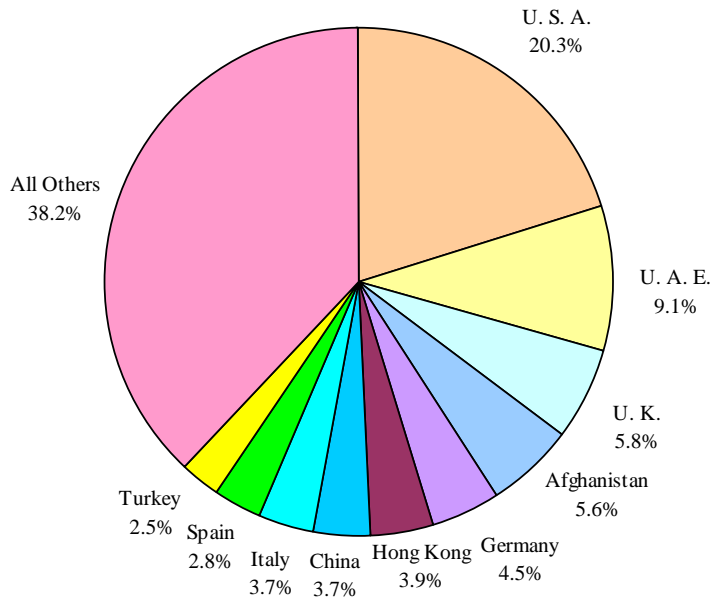
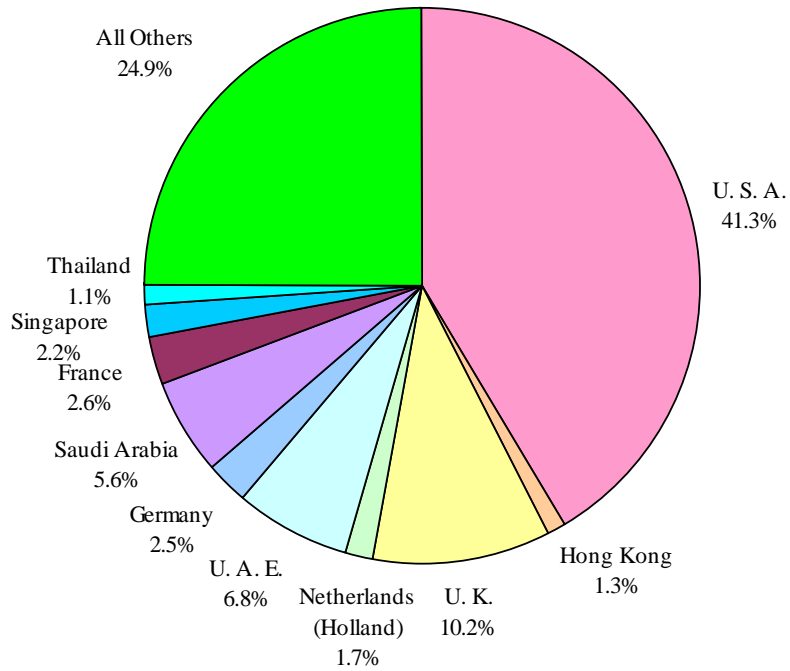
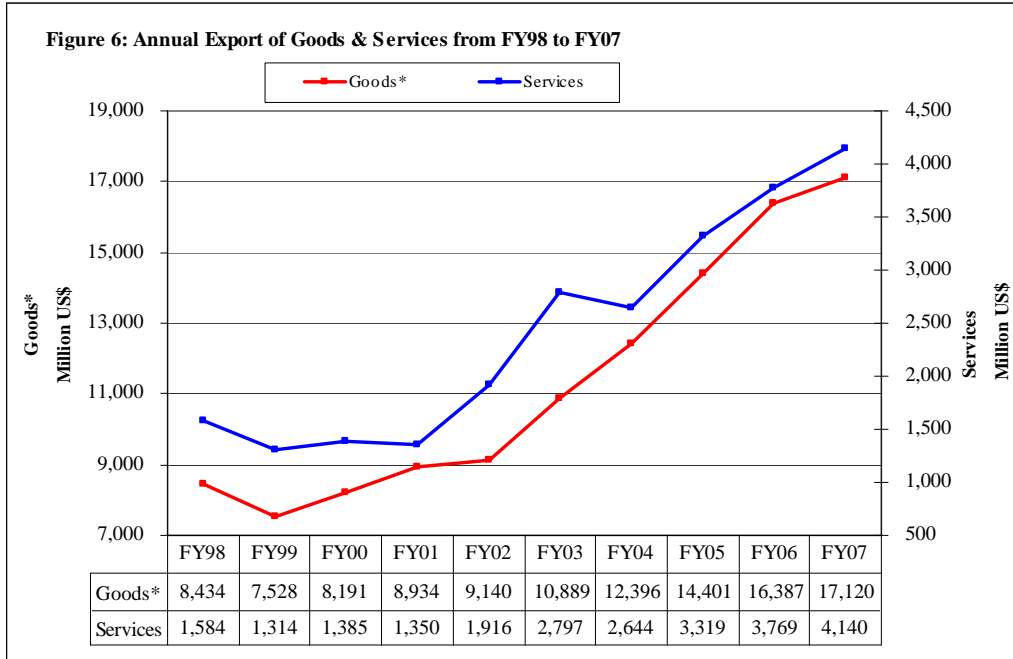


Figure 5: % Share of Major Countries in Export of Services During Jul-May 2008

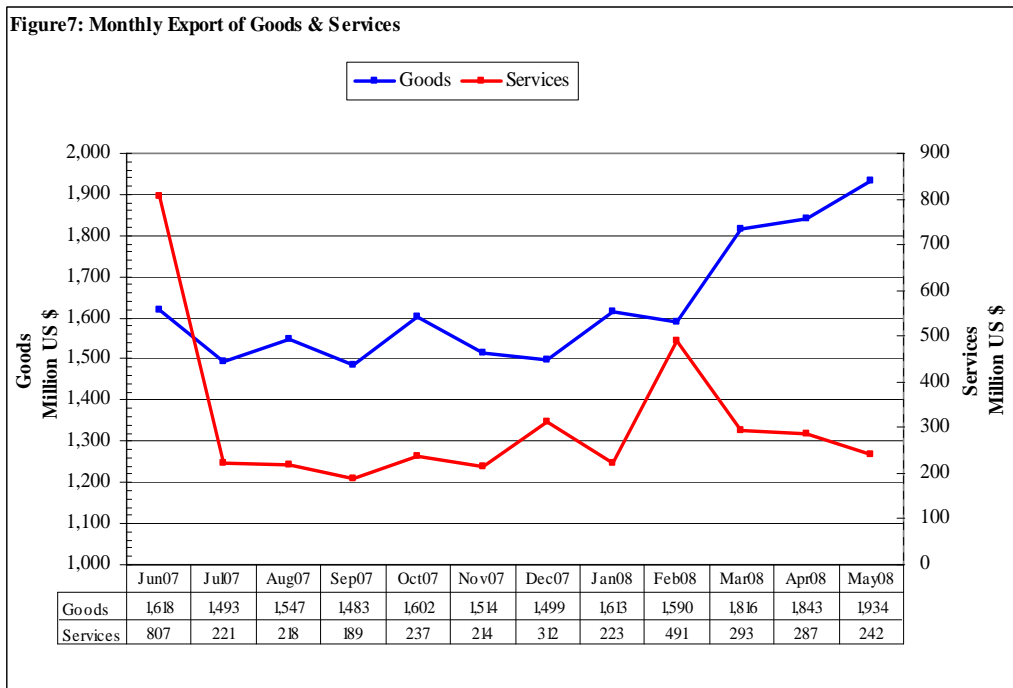
