Figure 1. Export During Jul-Nov 08

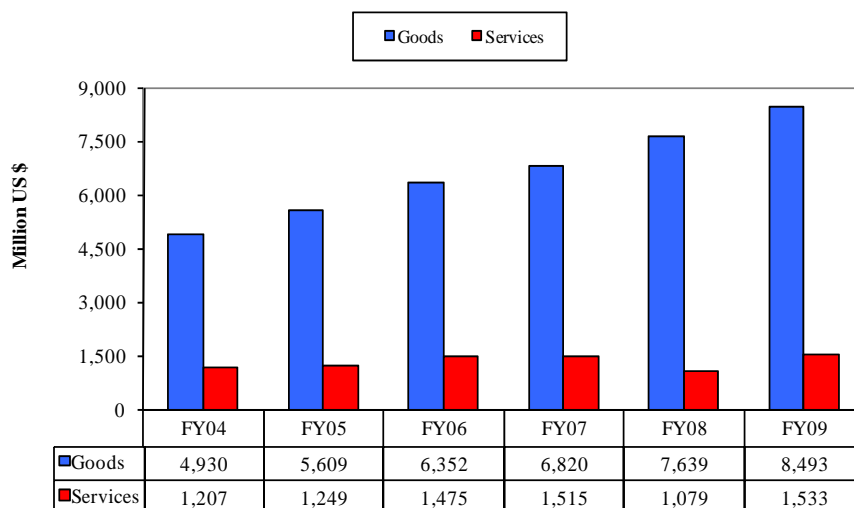
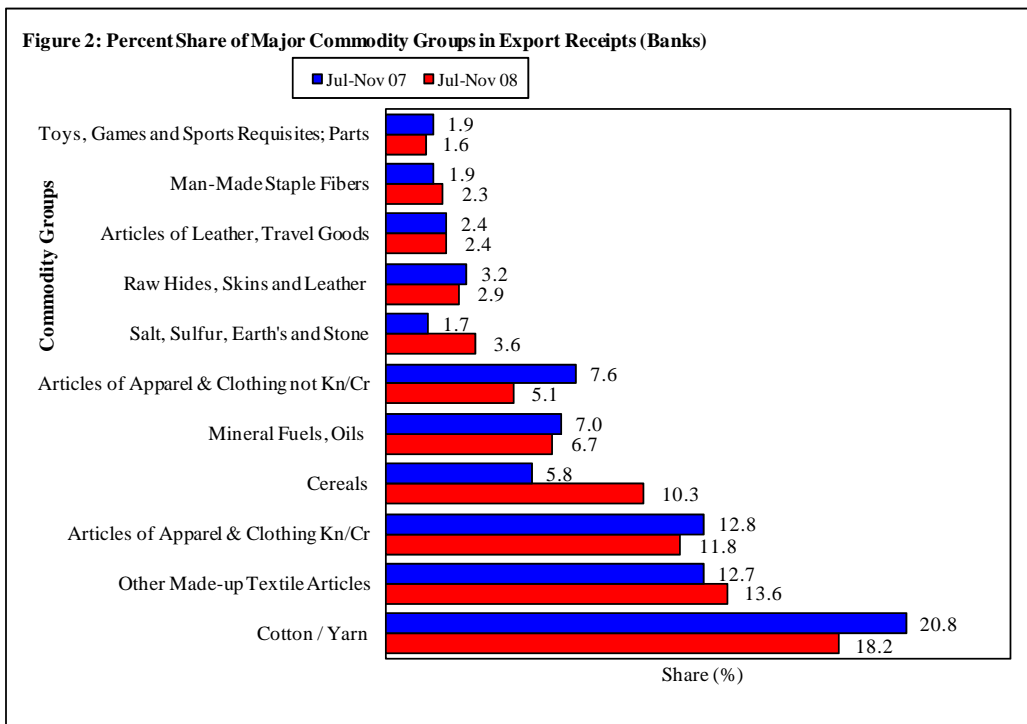

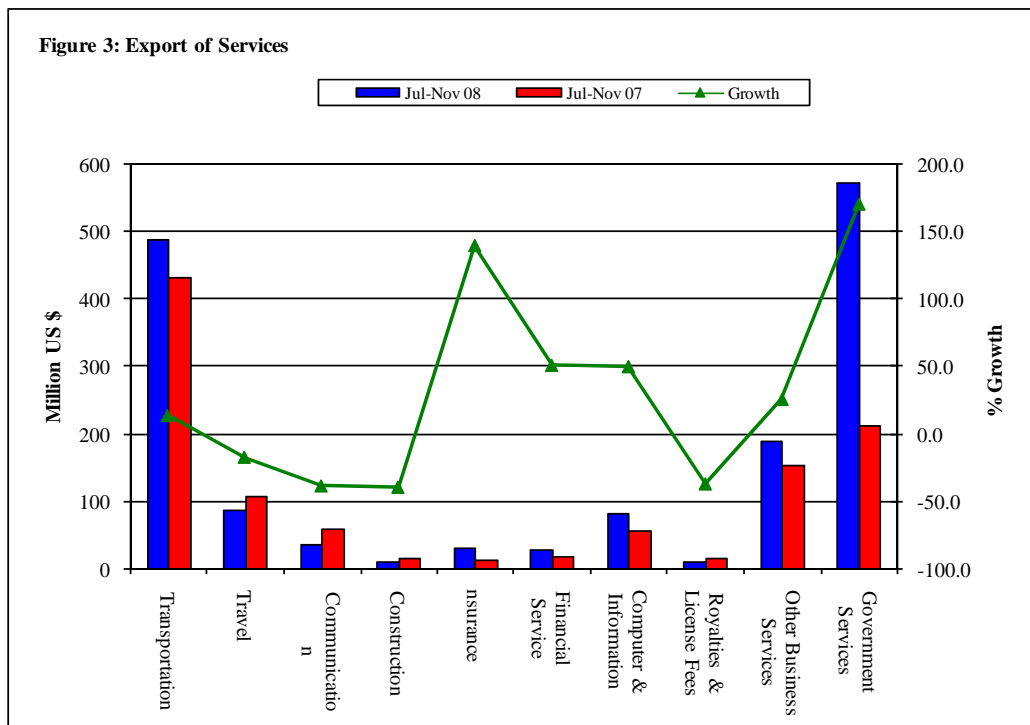

Figure 4: % Share of Major Countries in Export Receipts (Banks) During Jul-Nov 2008

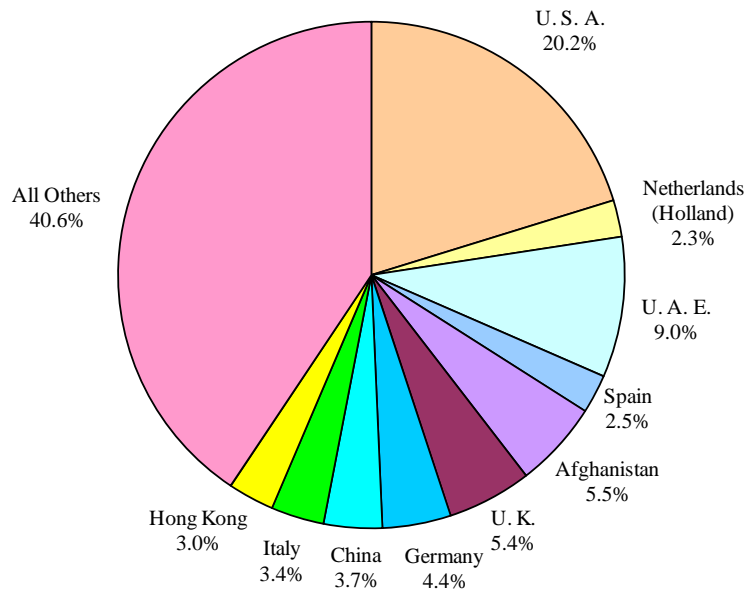
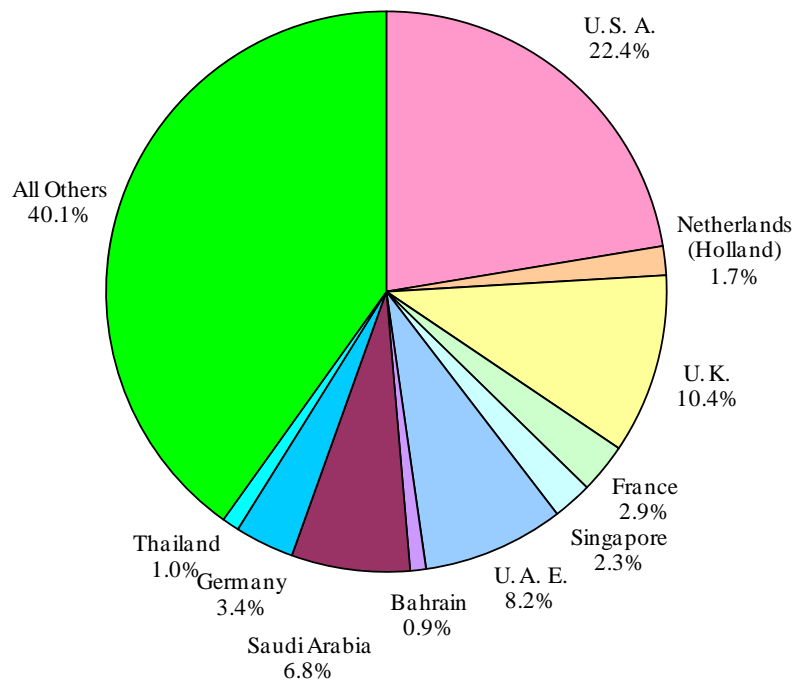
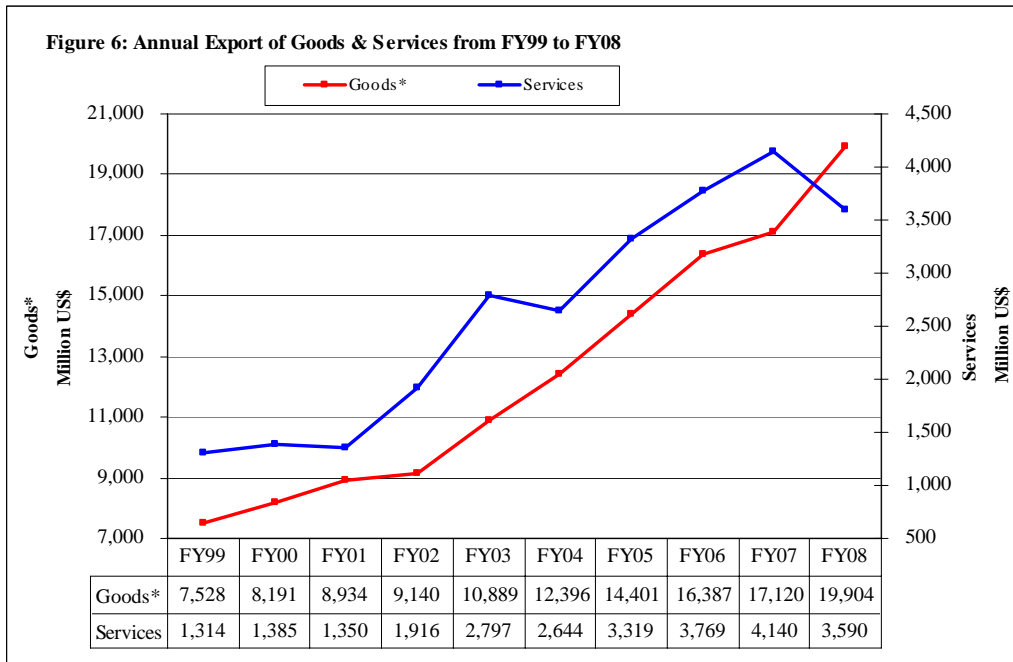


Figure 5: % Share of Major Countries in Export of Services During Jul-Nov 2008

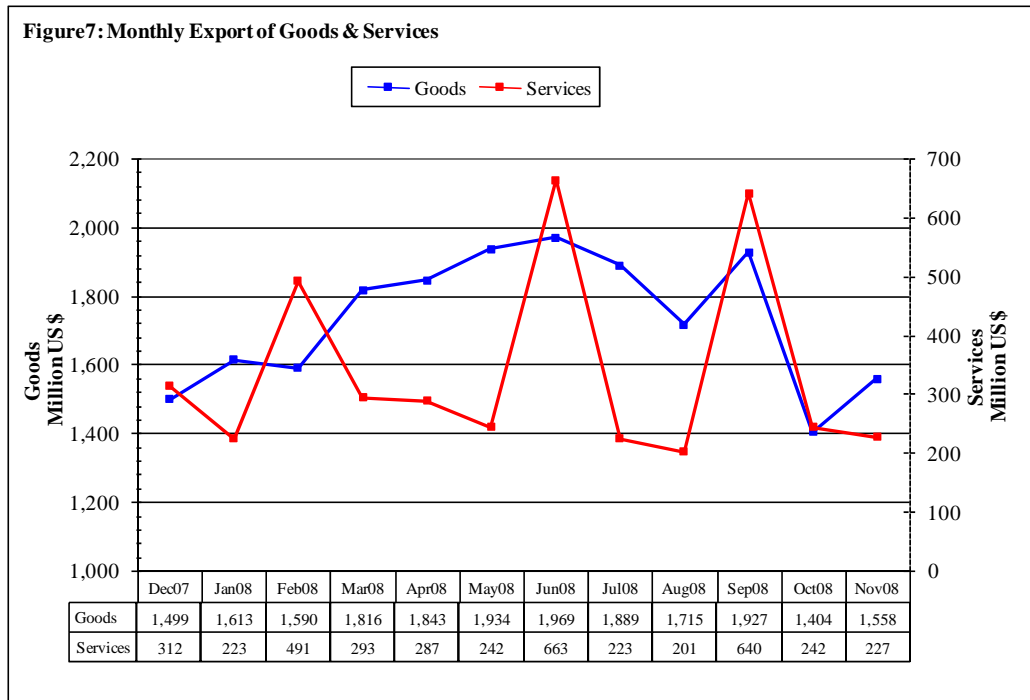
