Figure 1. Export During Jul-Oct 08

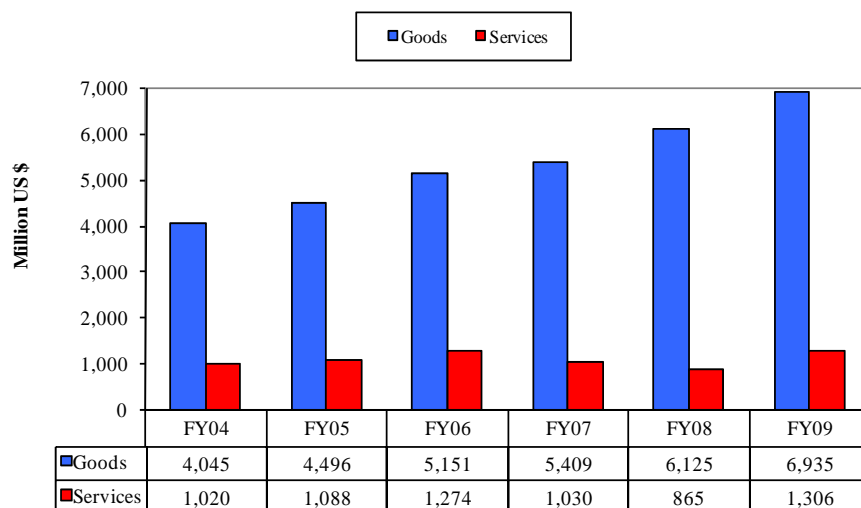
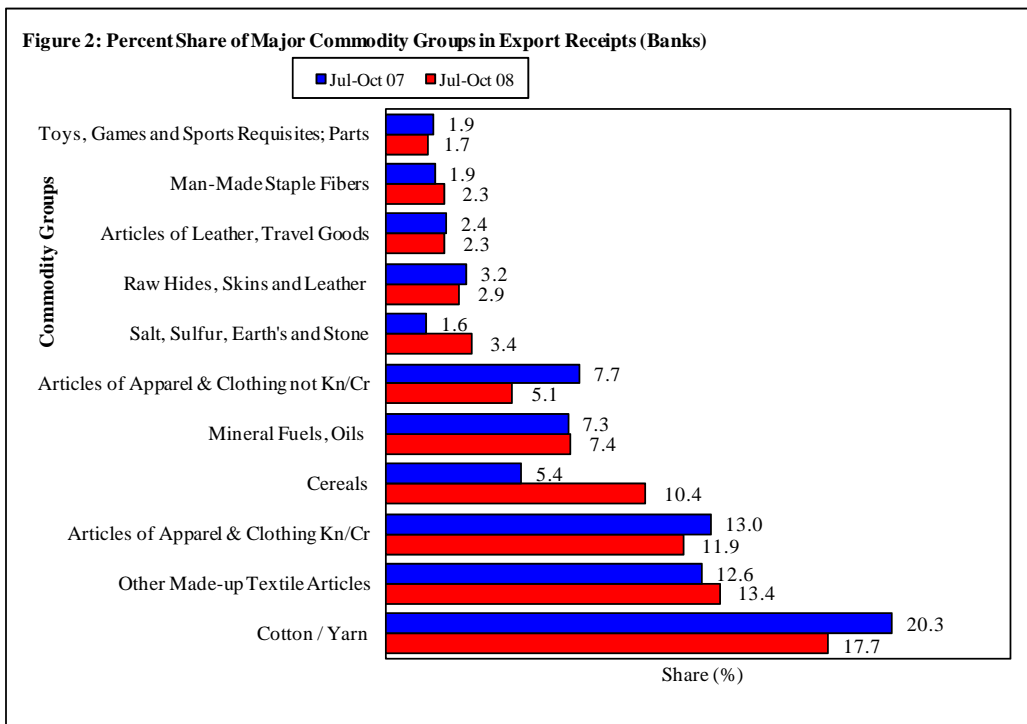

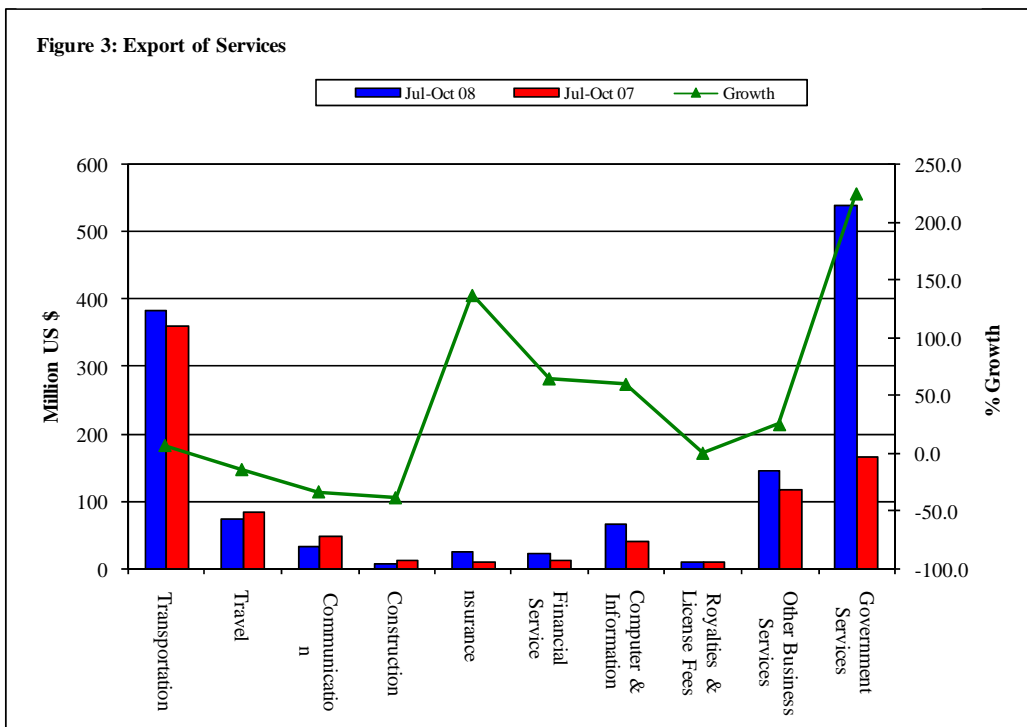

Figure 4: % Share of Major Countries in Export Receipts (Banks) During Jul-Oct 2008

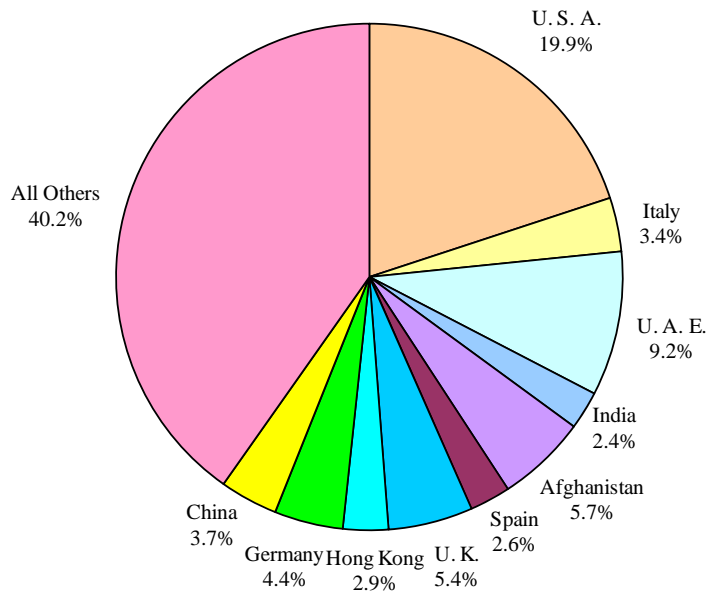
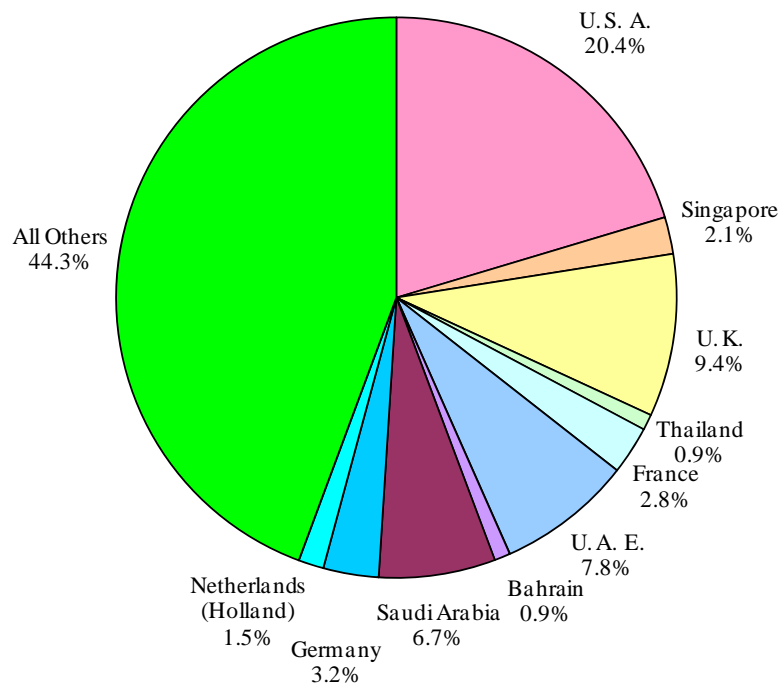
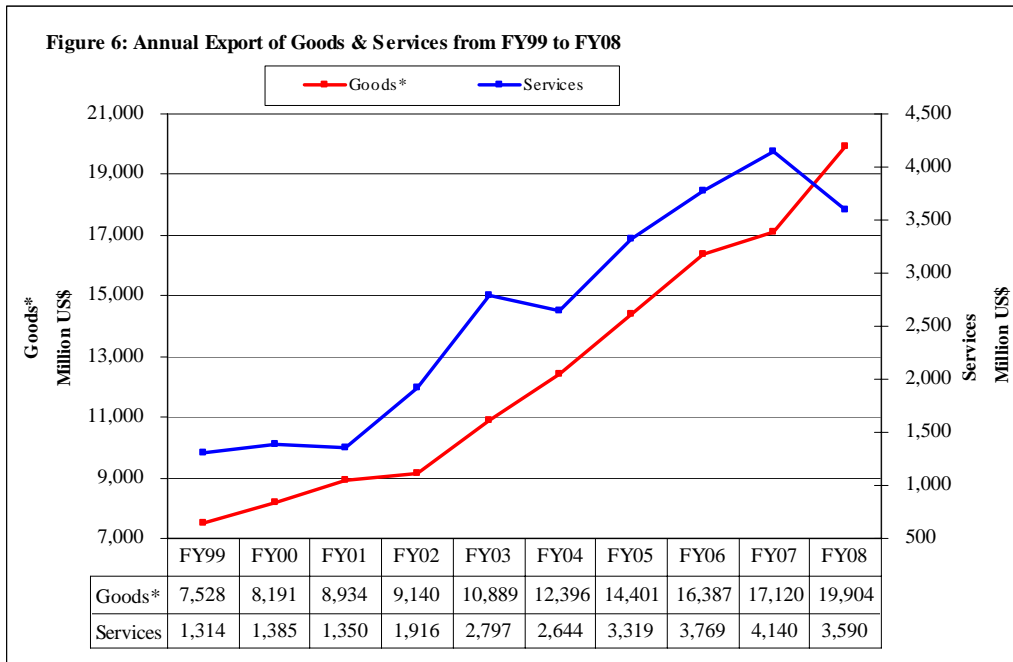


Figure 5: % Share of Major Countries in Export of Services During Jul-Oct 2008

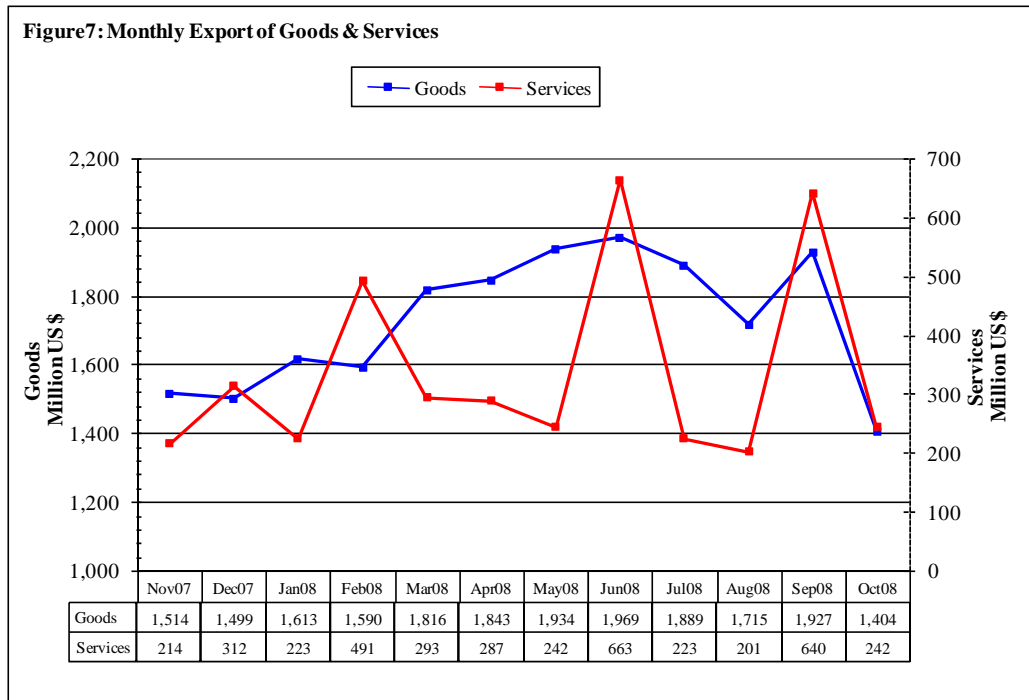
