Figure 1. Export During Jul-Feb 09

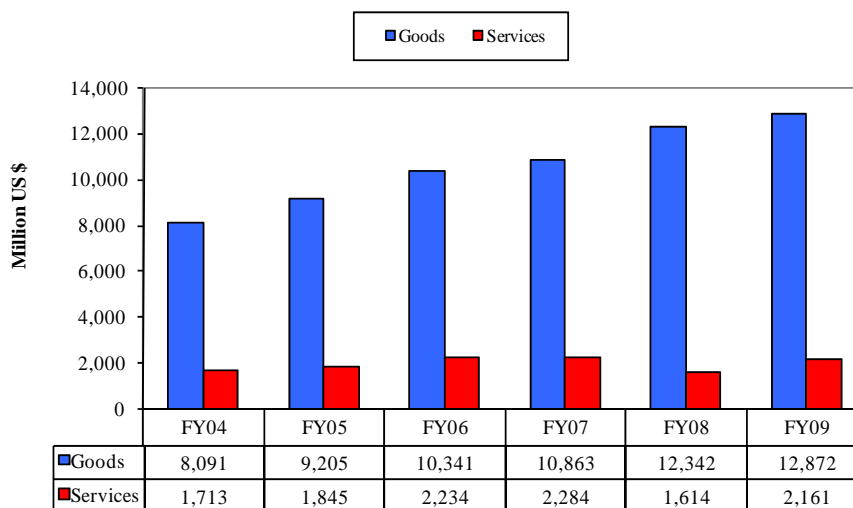
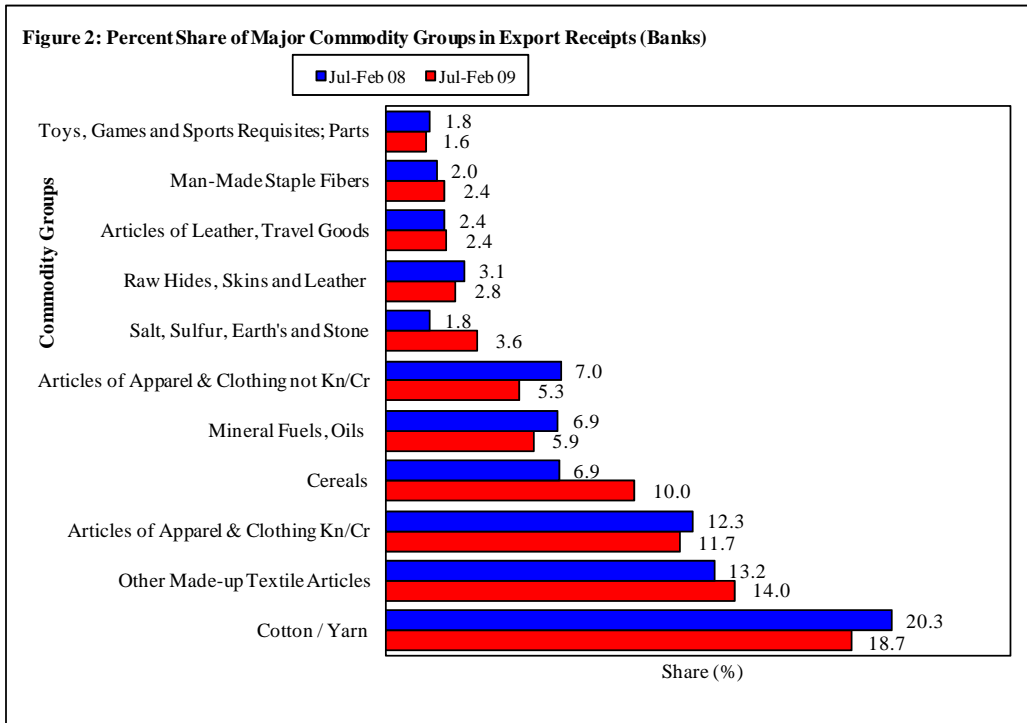

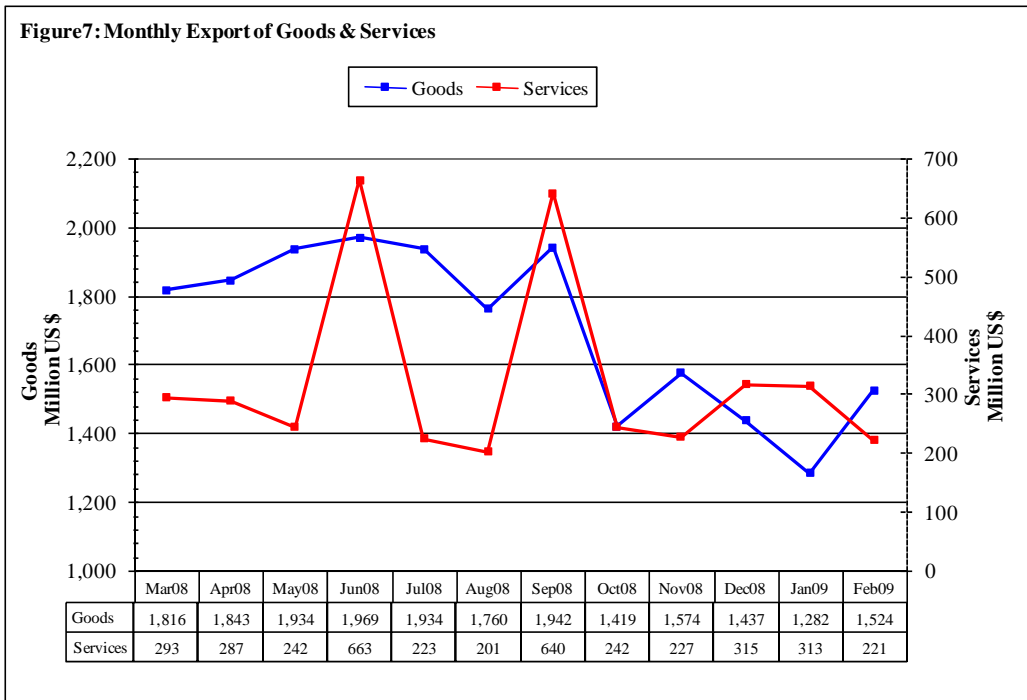
