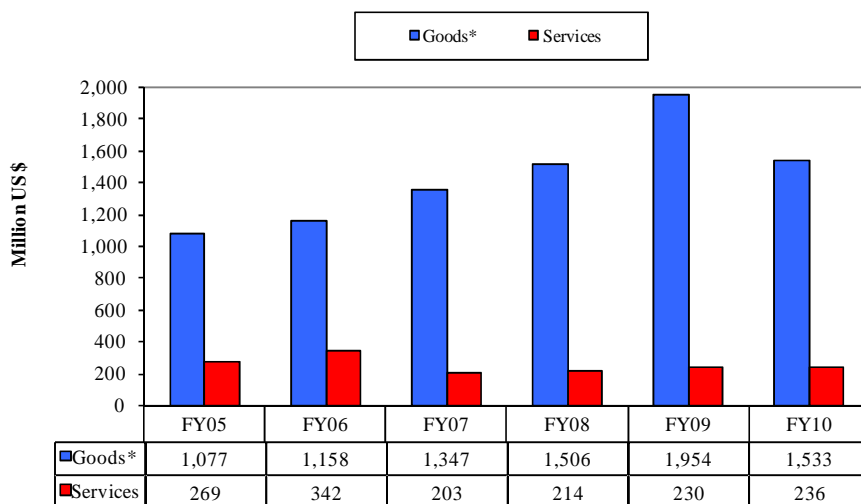

Figure 1. Export During Jul 09

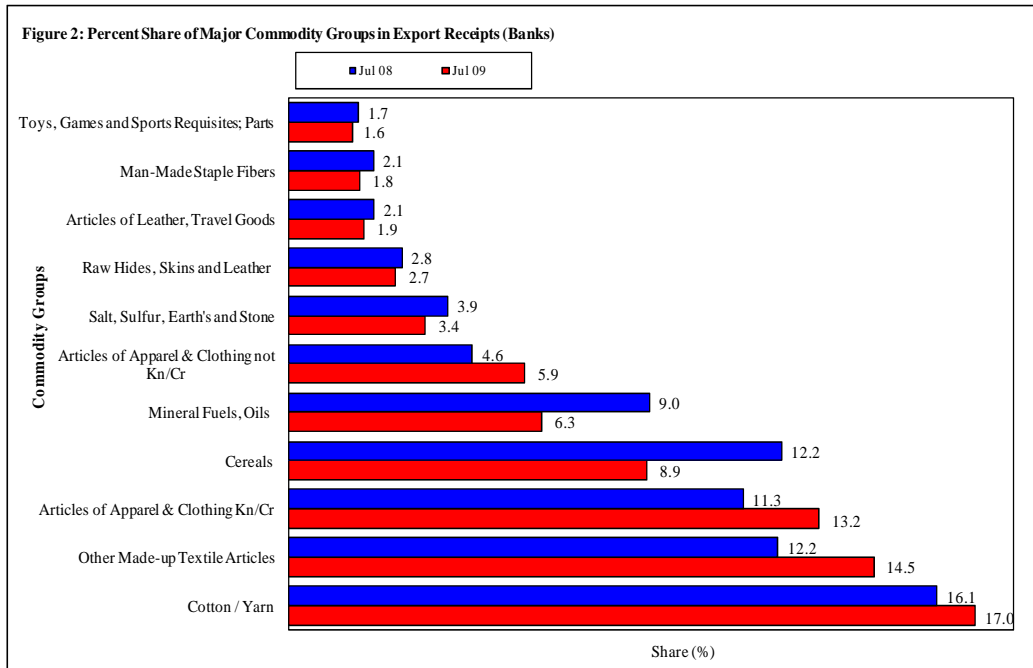

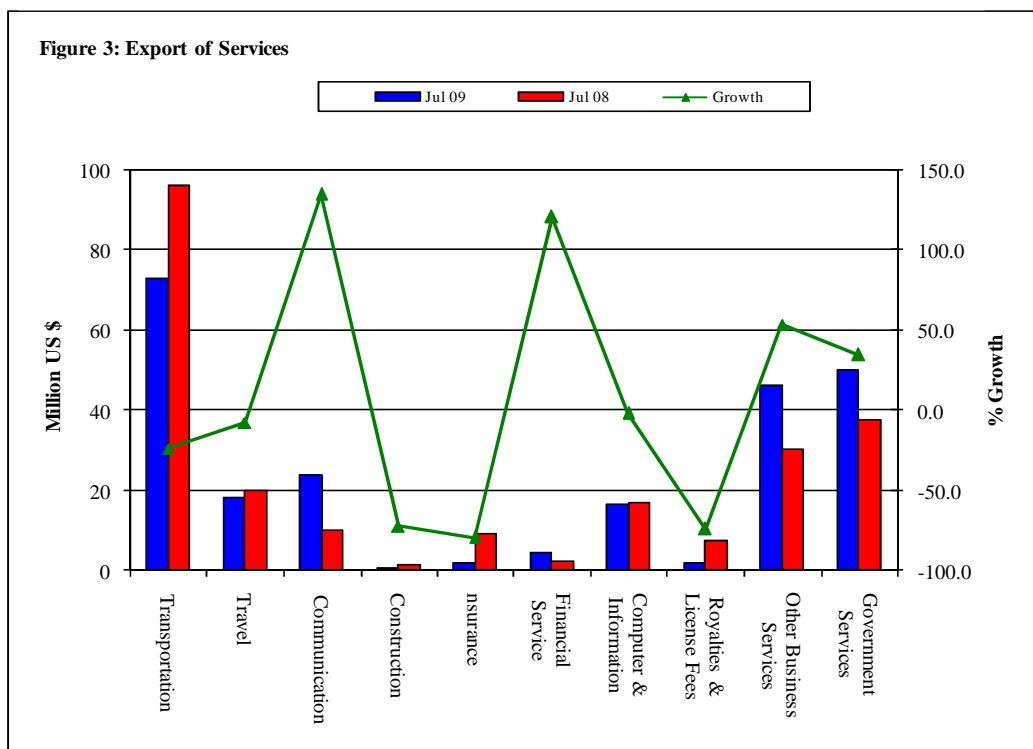
