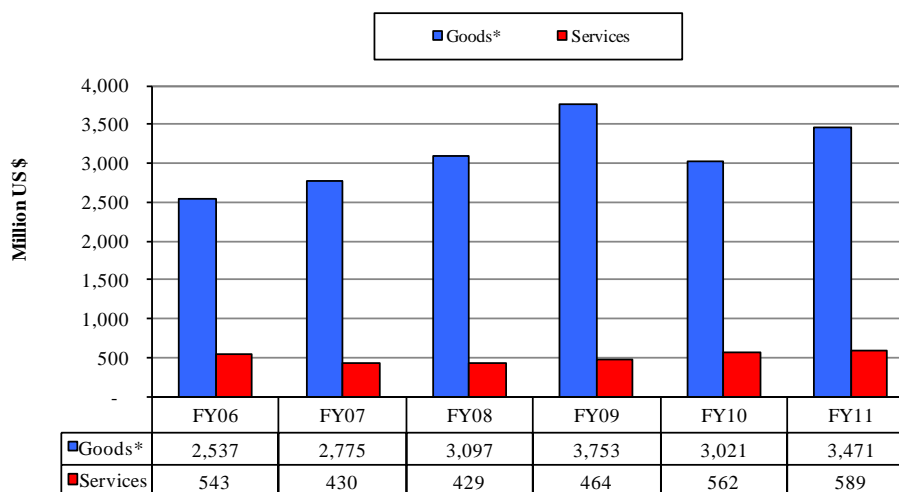

Figure 1. Export During Jul-Aug

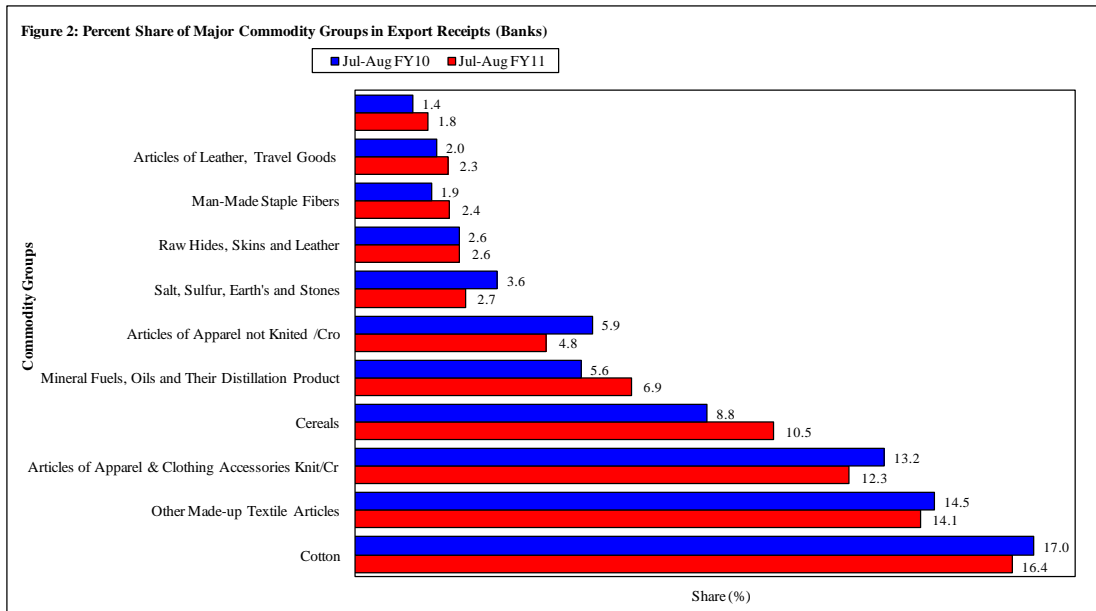
