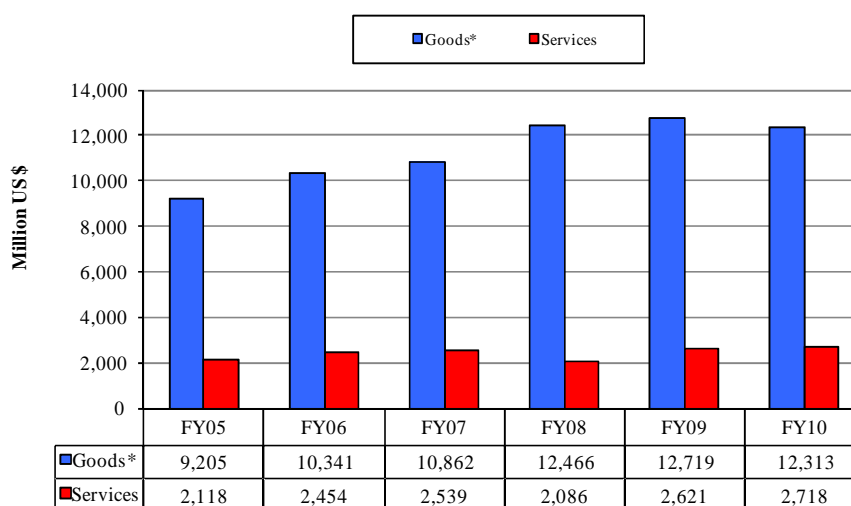

Figure 1. Export During Jul-Feb

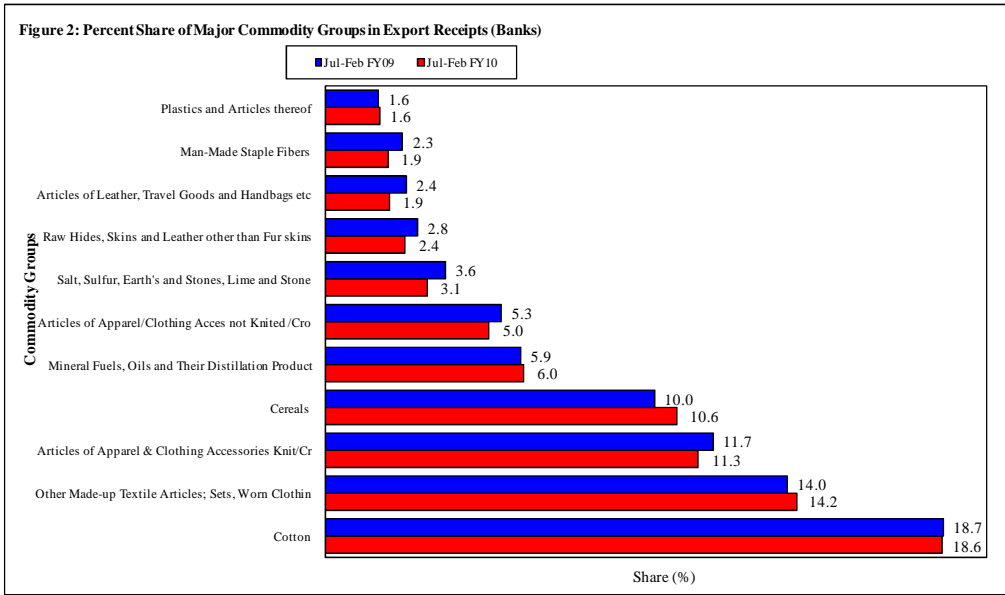

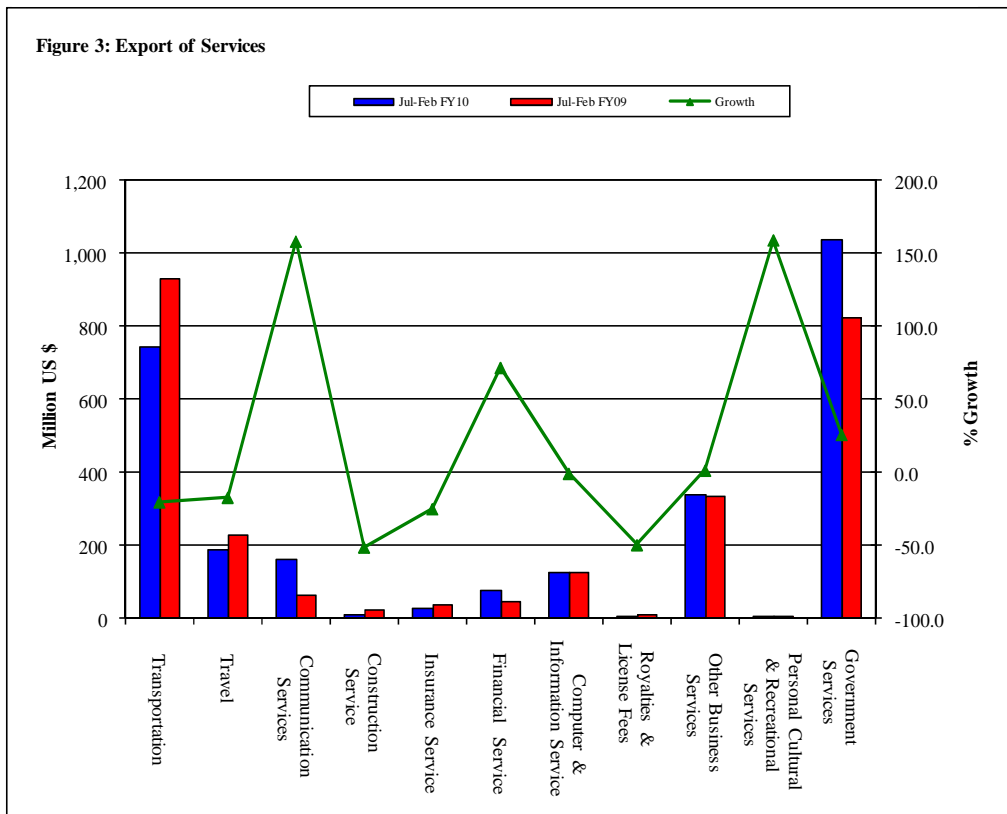

Figure 4: % Share of Major Countries in Export Receipts (Banks) During Jul-Feb FY10

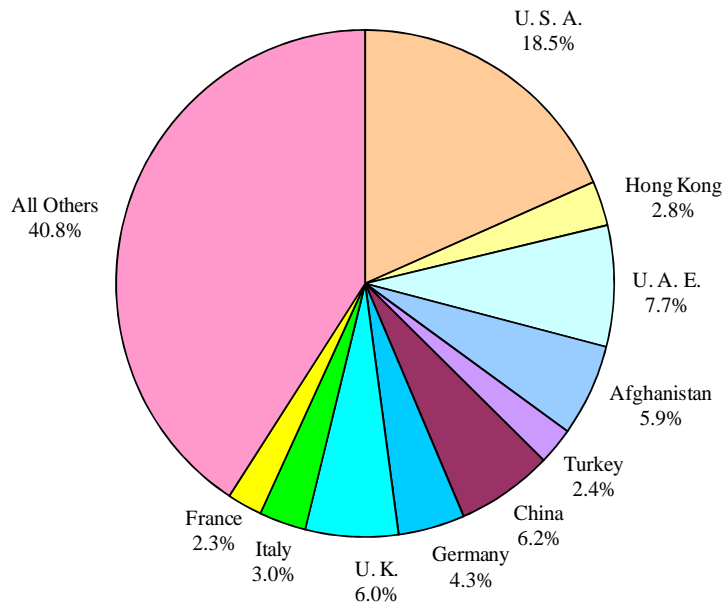
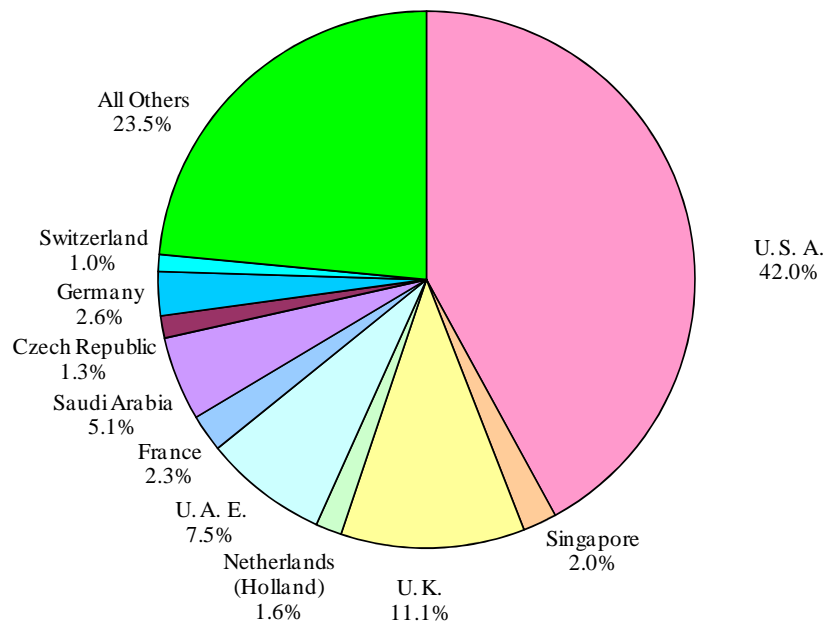
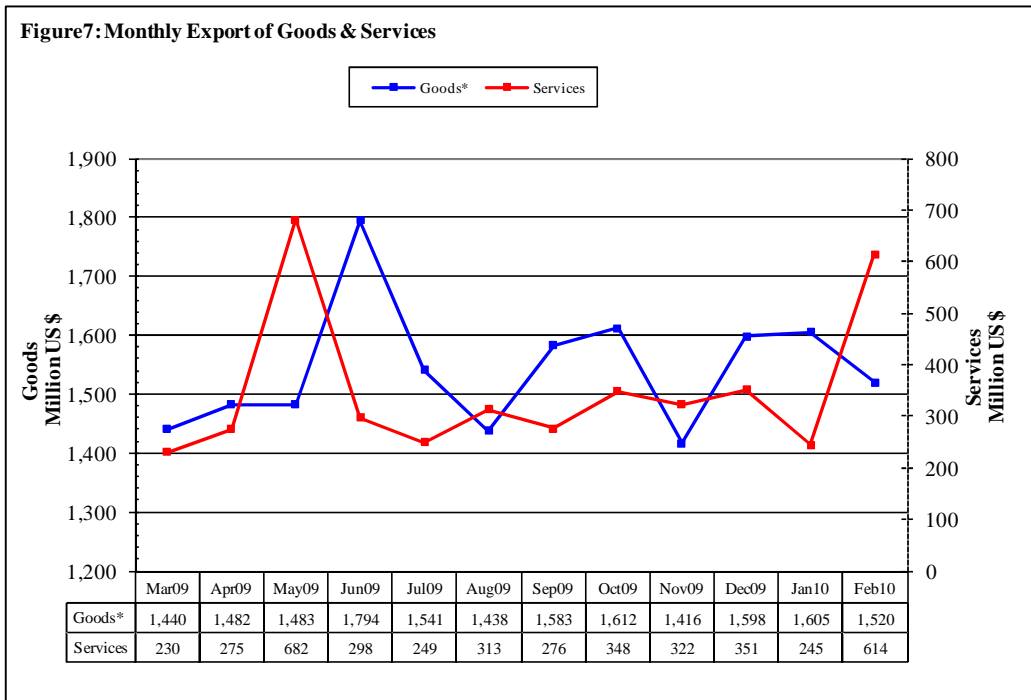
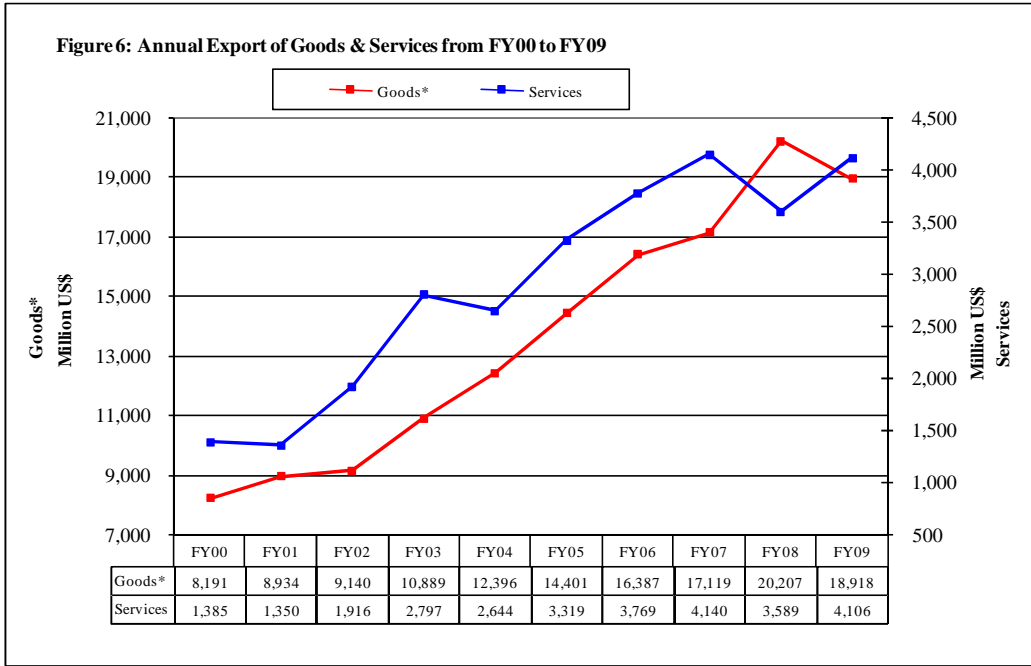


Figure 5: % Share of Major Countries in Export of Services During Jul-Feb FY10
