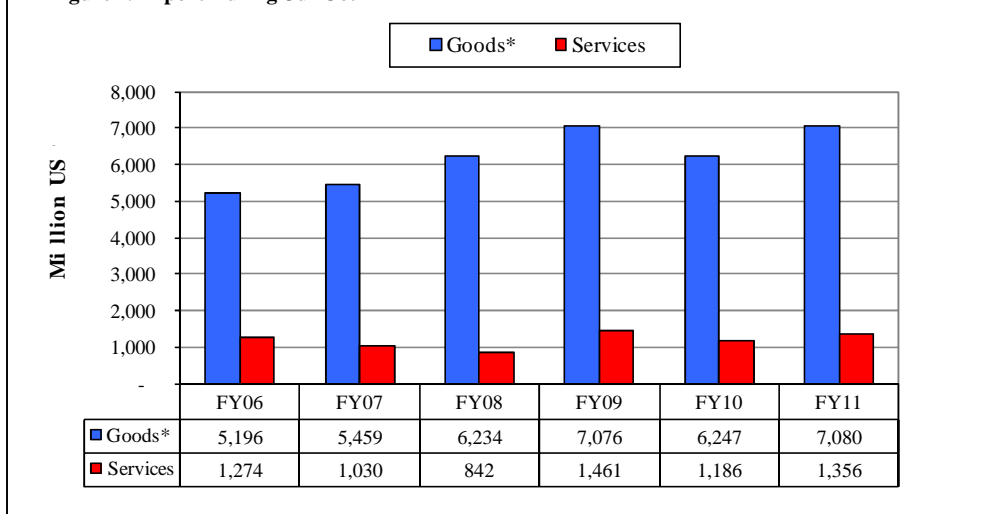

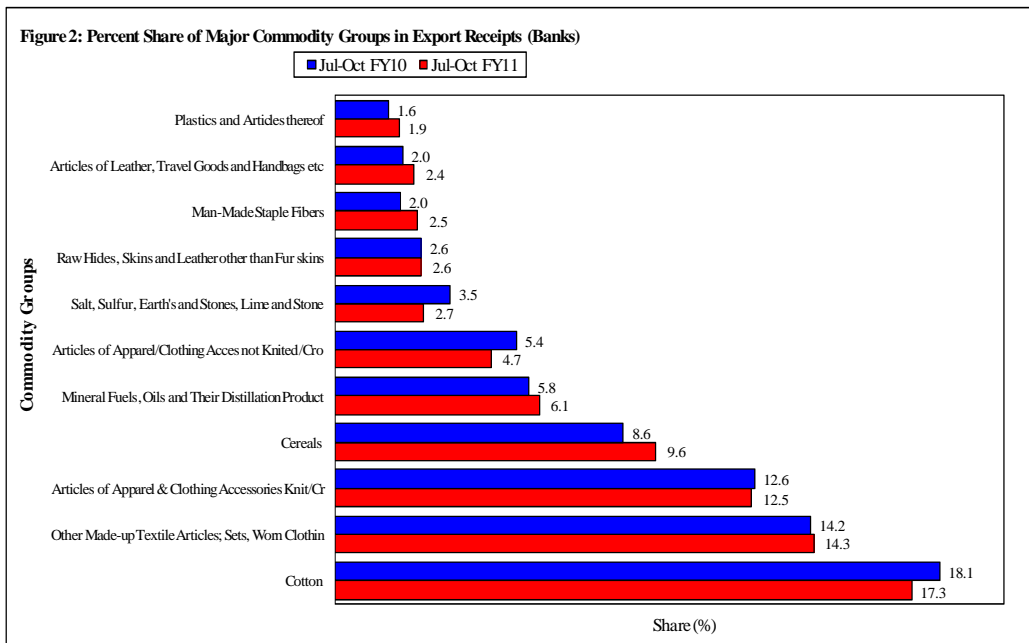
**Figure 1. Export During Jul-Oct**

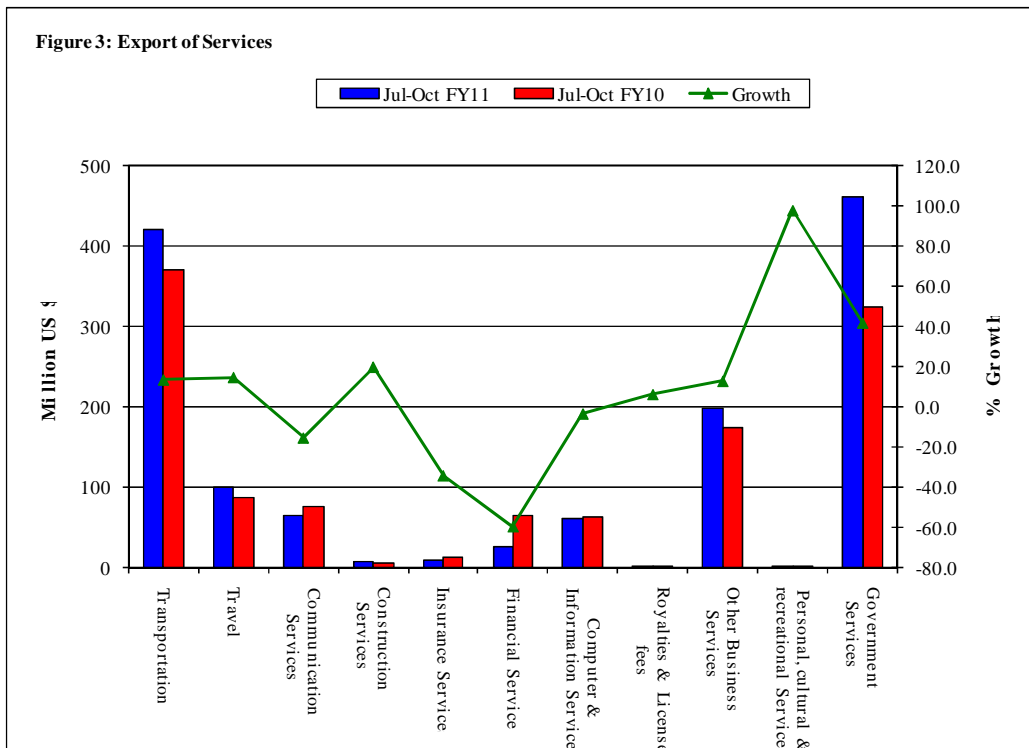

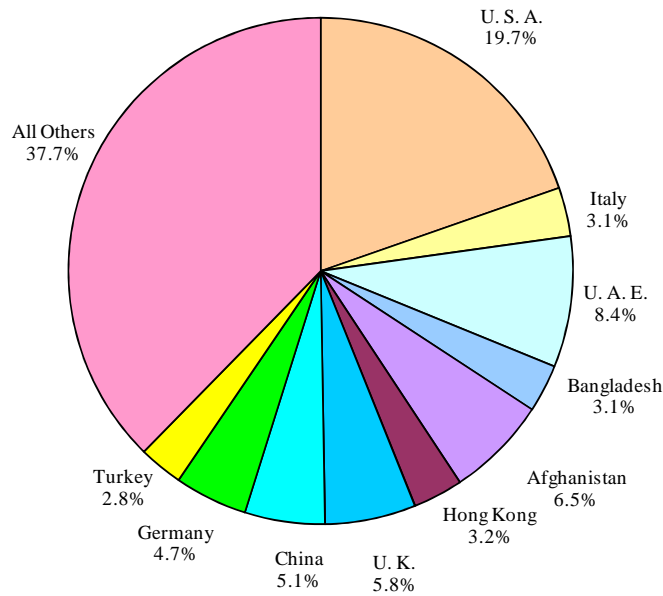

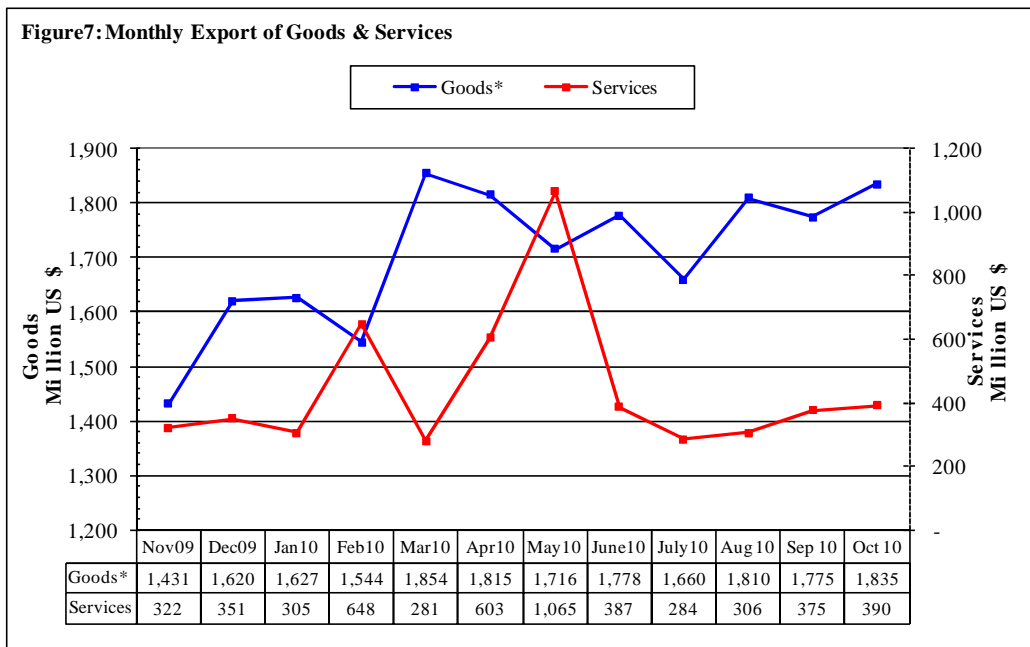
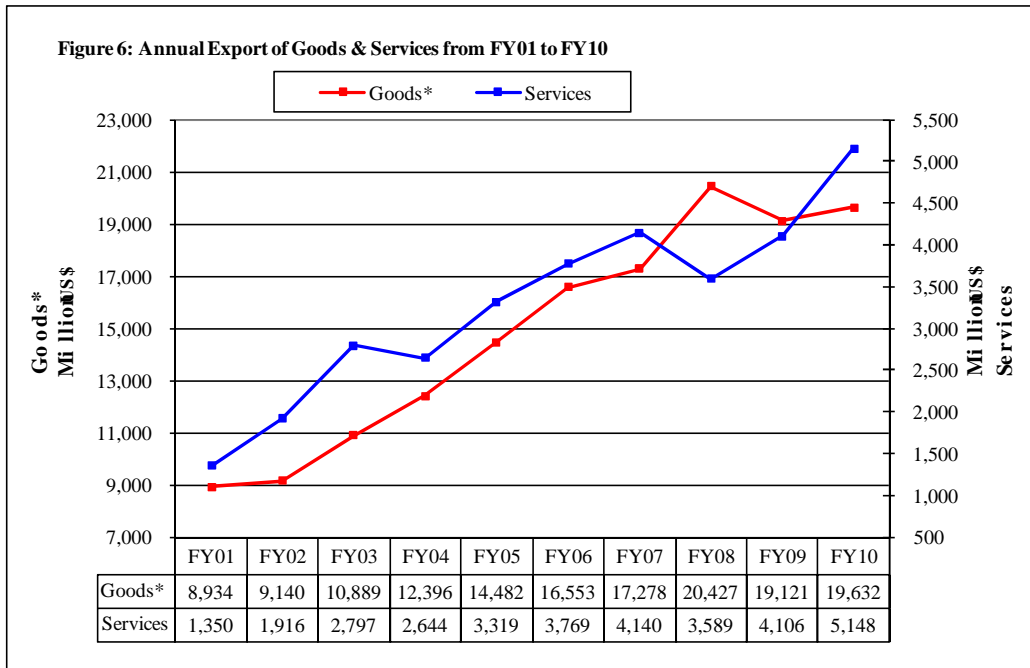
