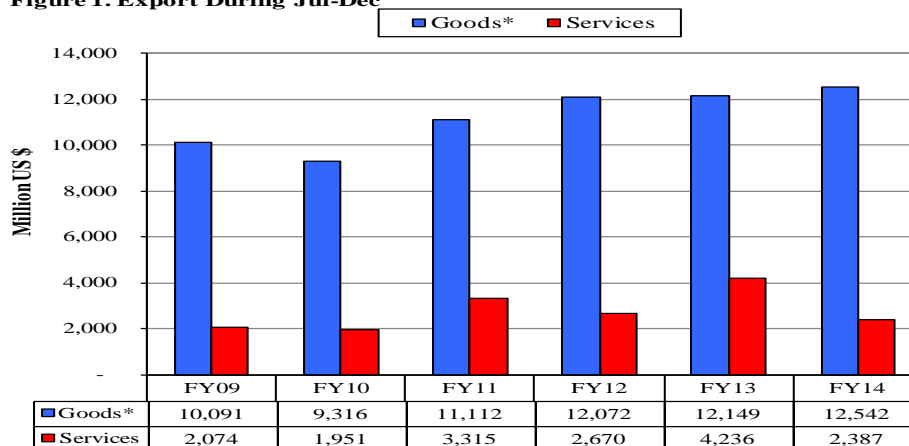

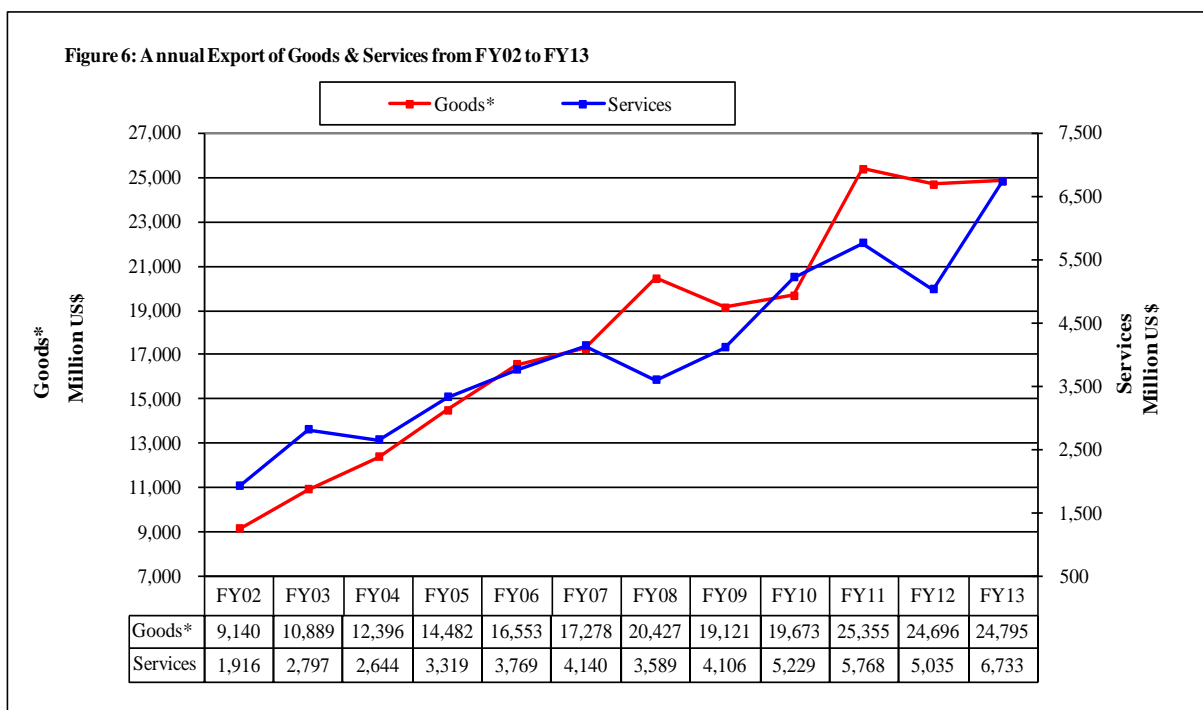
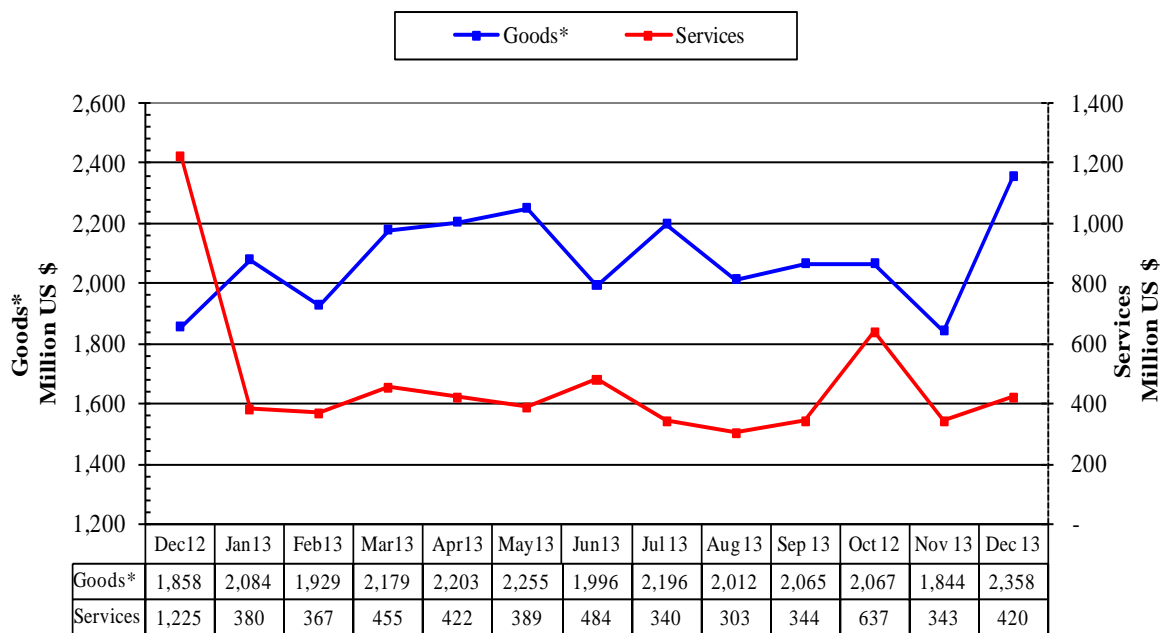


Figure 7: Monthly Export of Goods & Services
