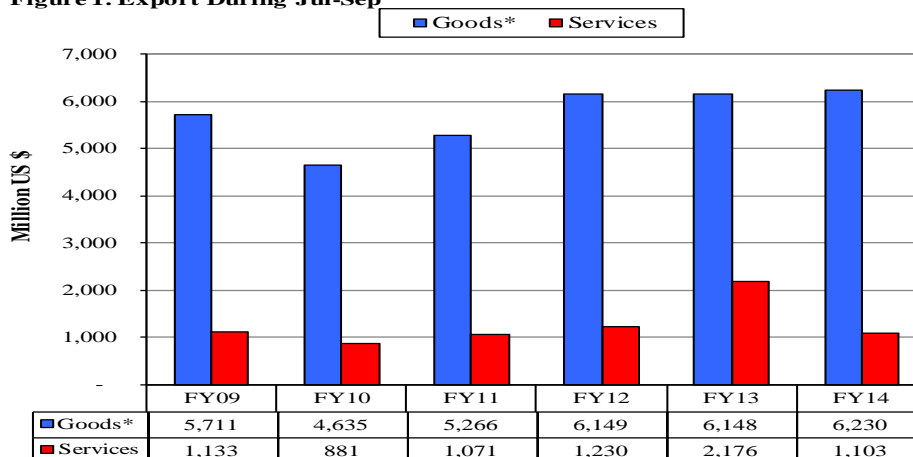

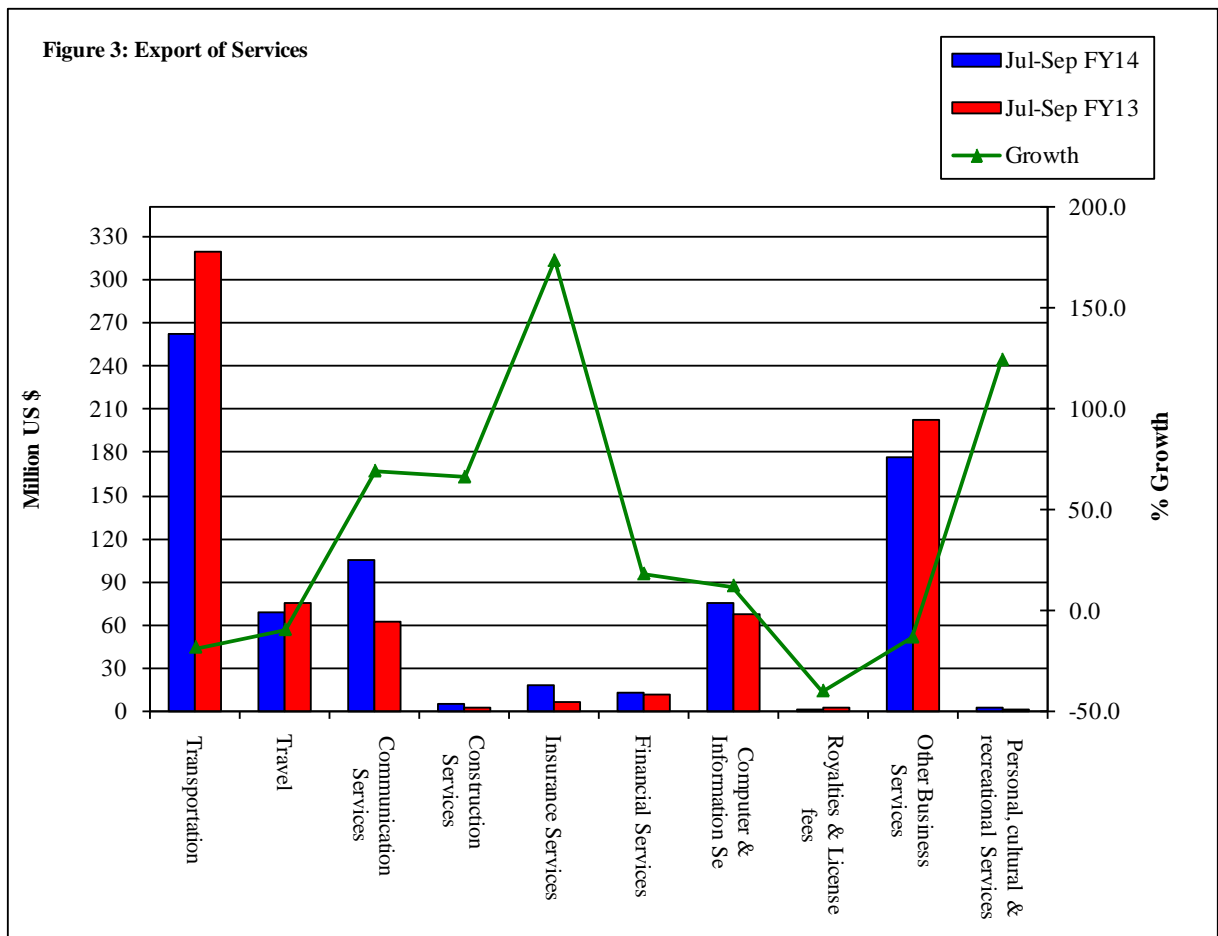
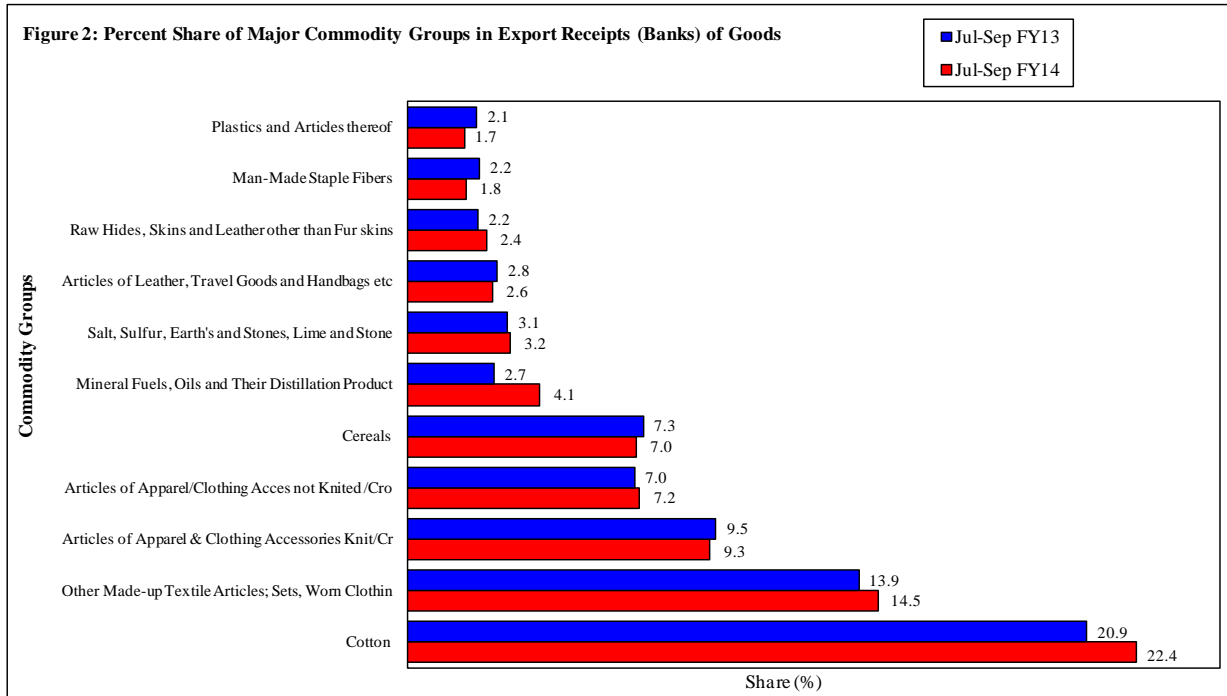
**Figure 1. Export During Jul-Sep**

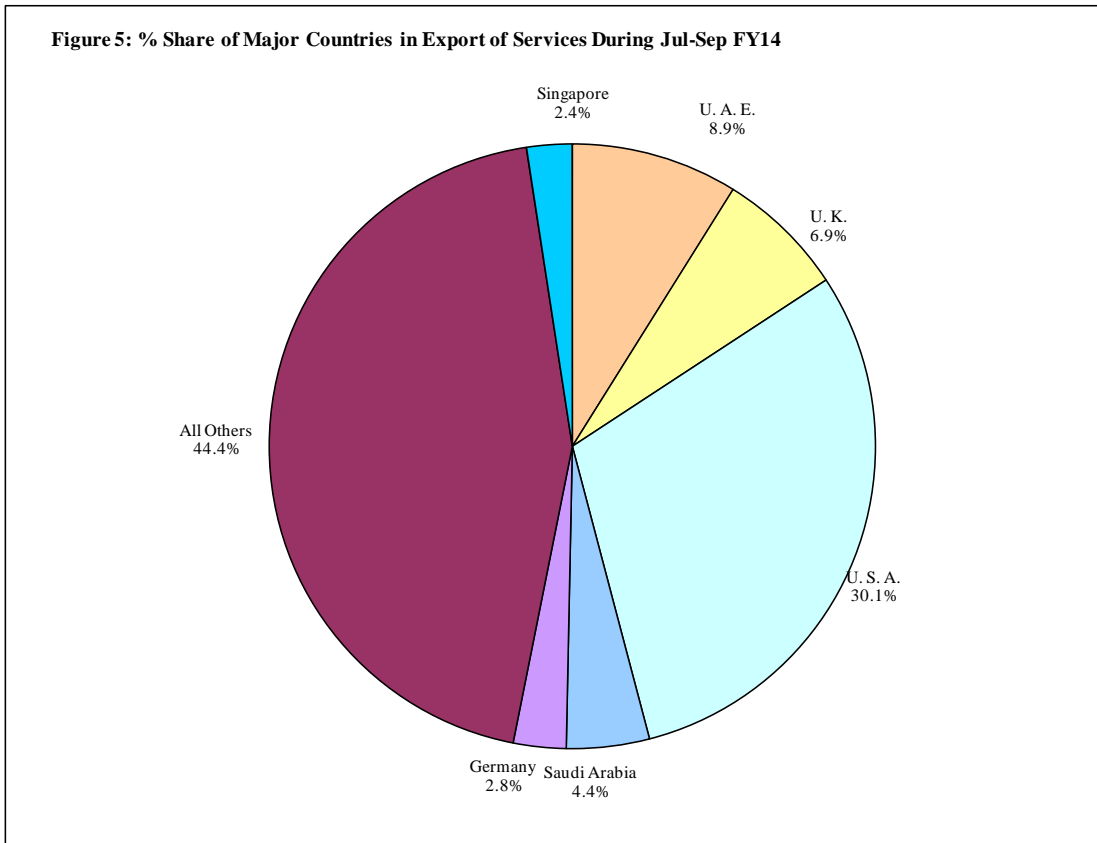

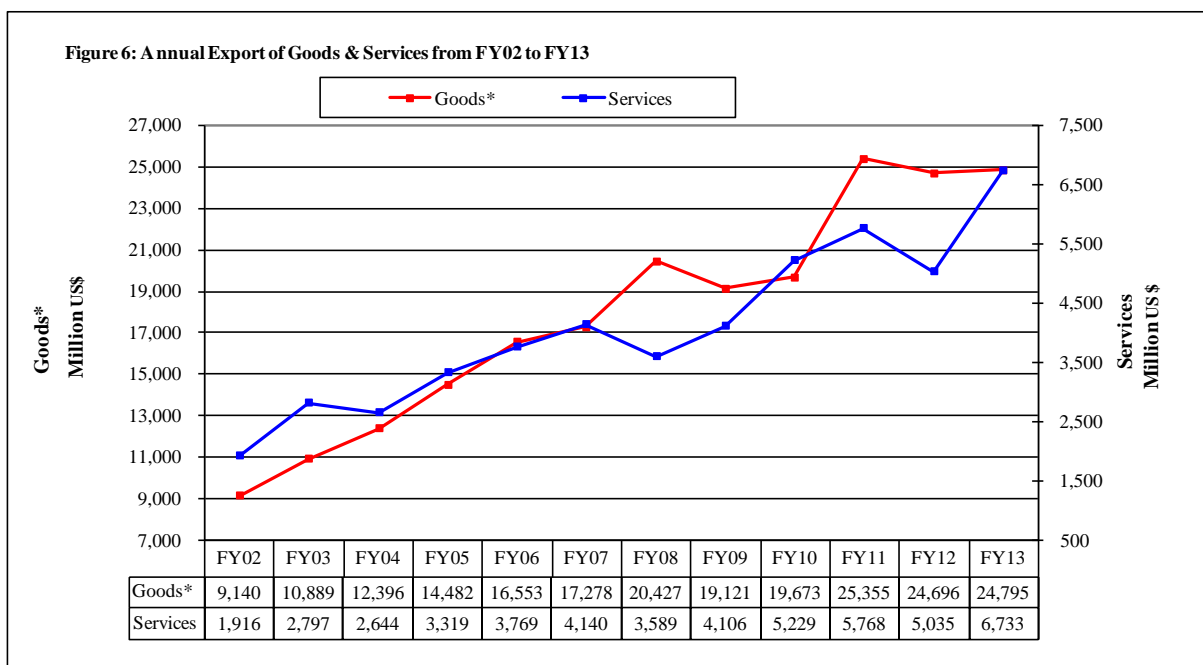

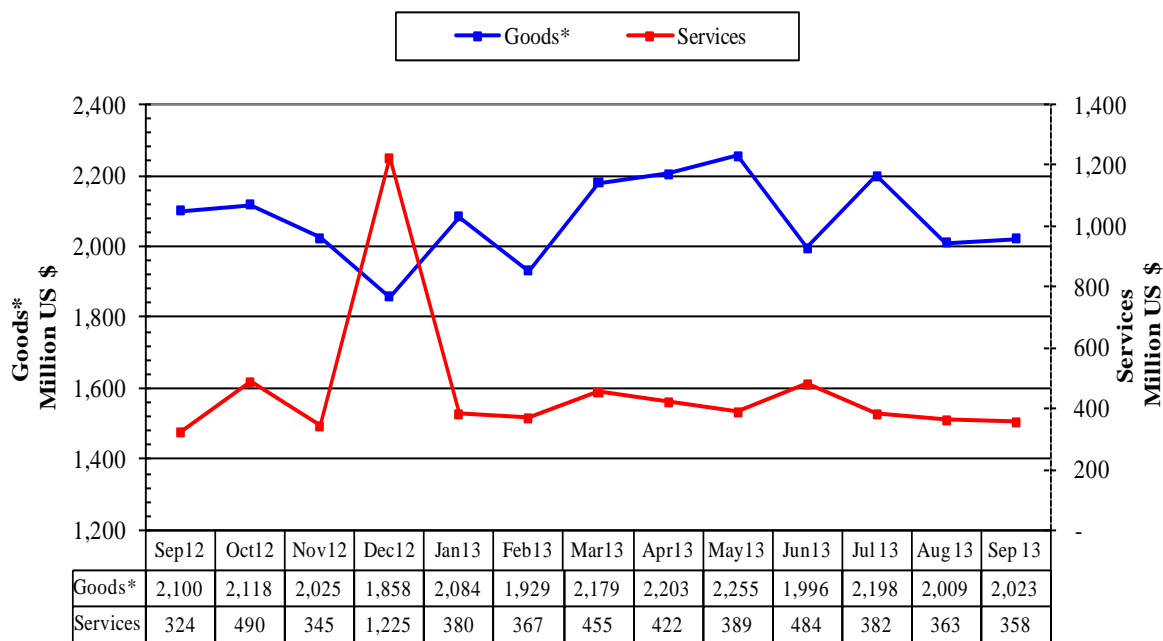
