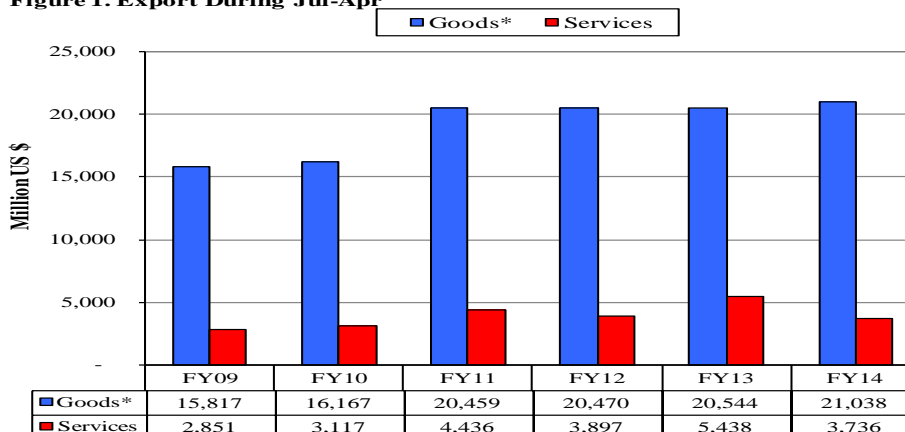

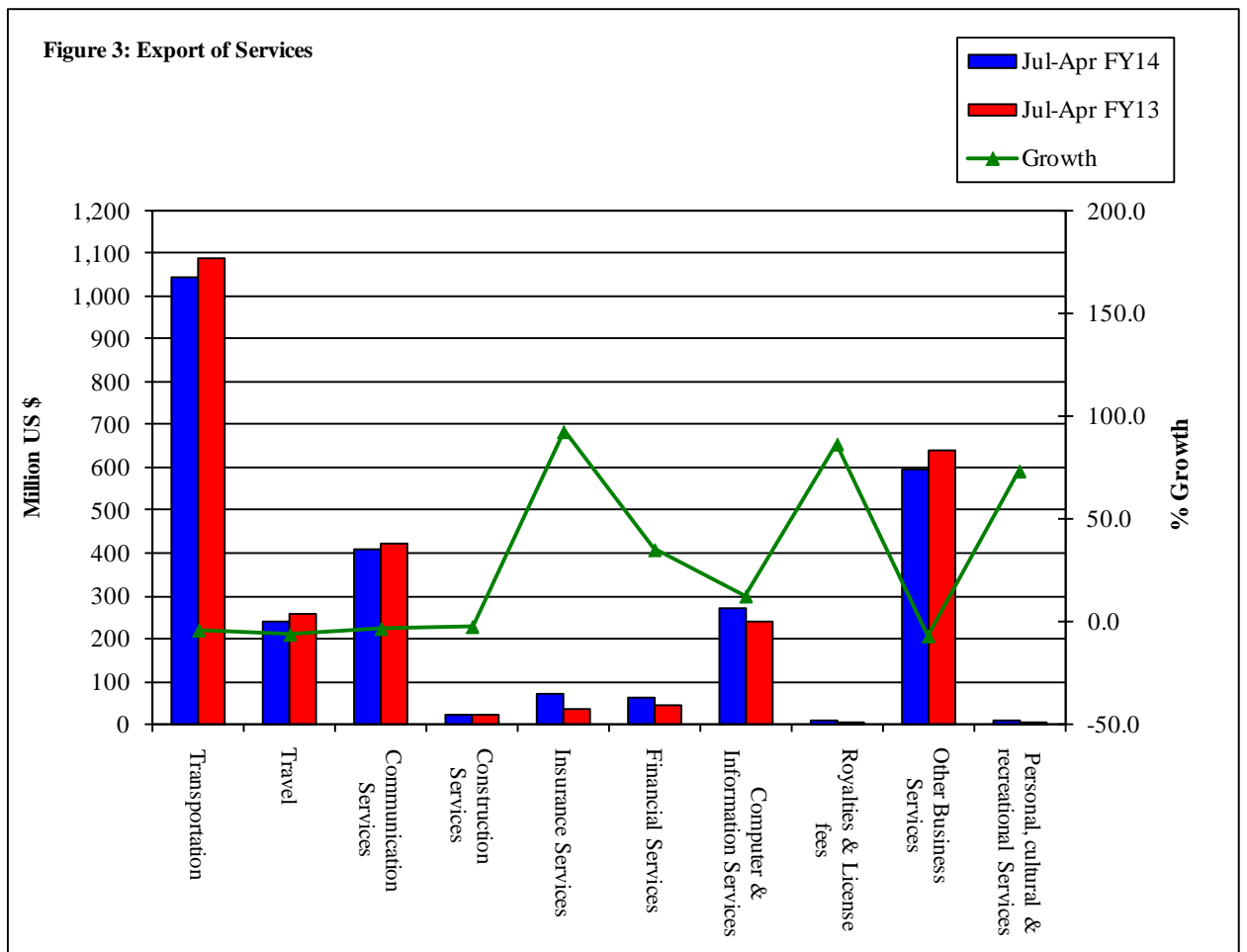
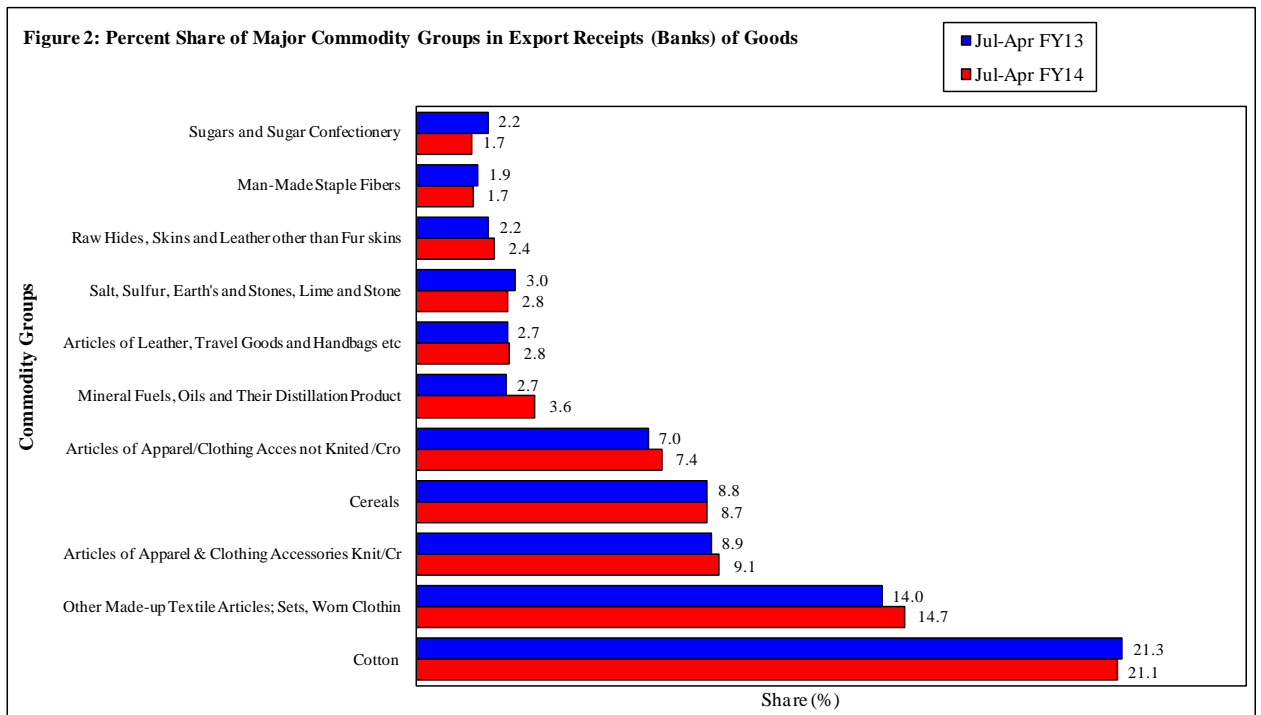
**Figure 1. Export During Jul-Apr**

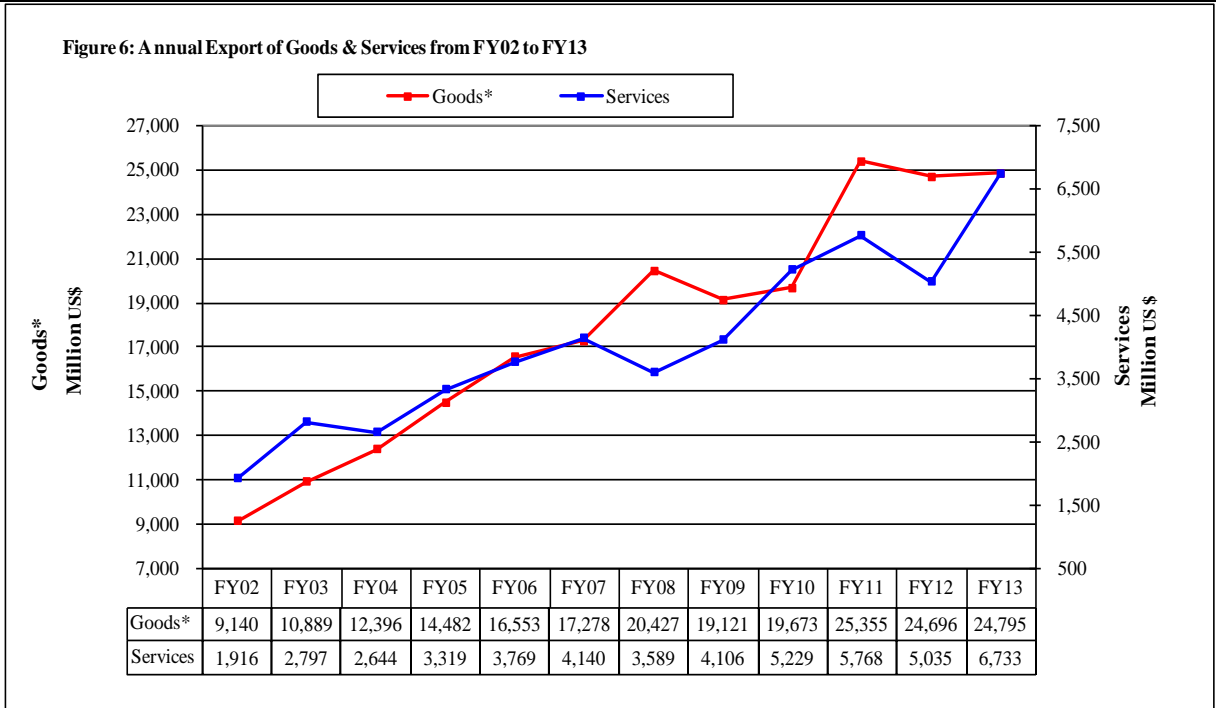

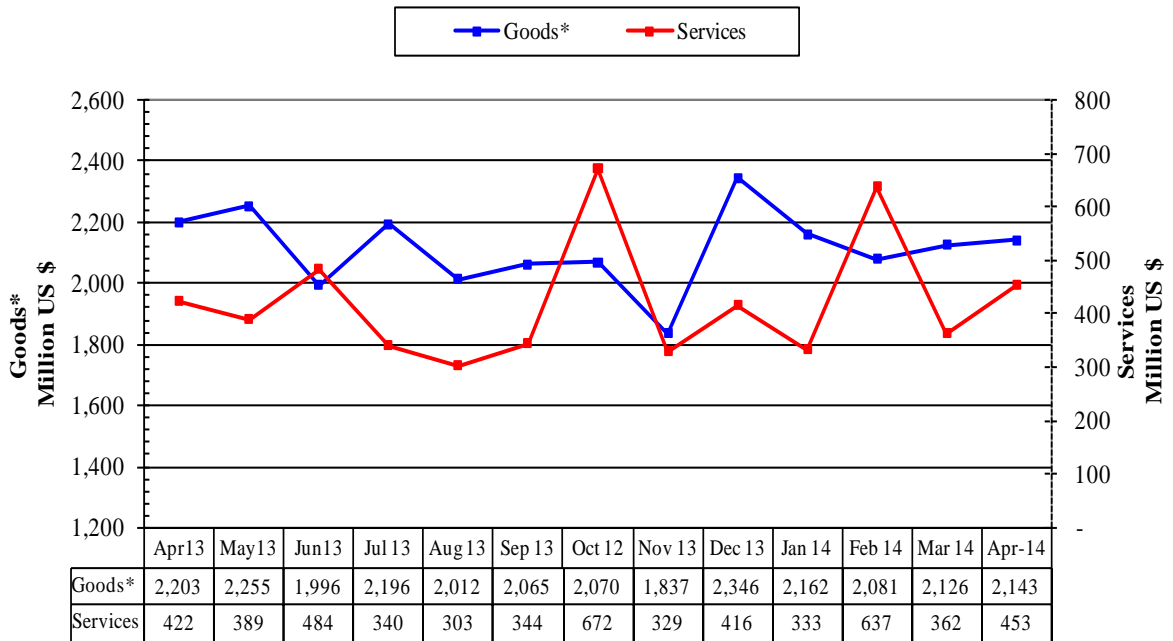
