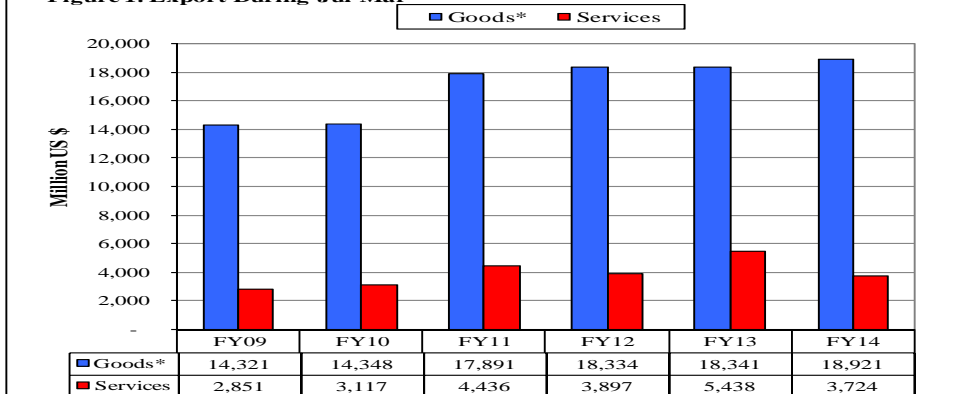

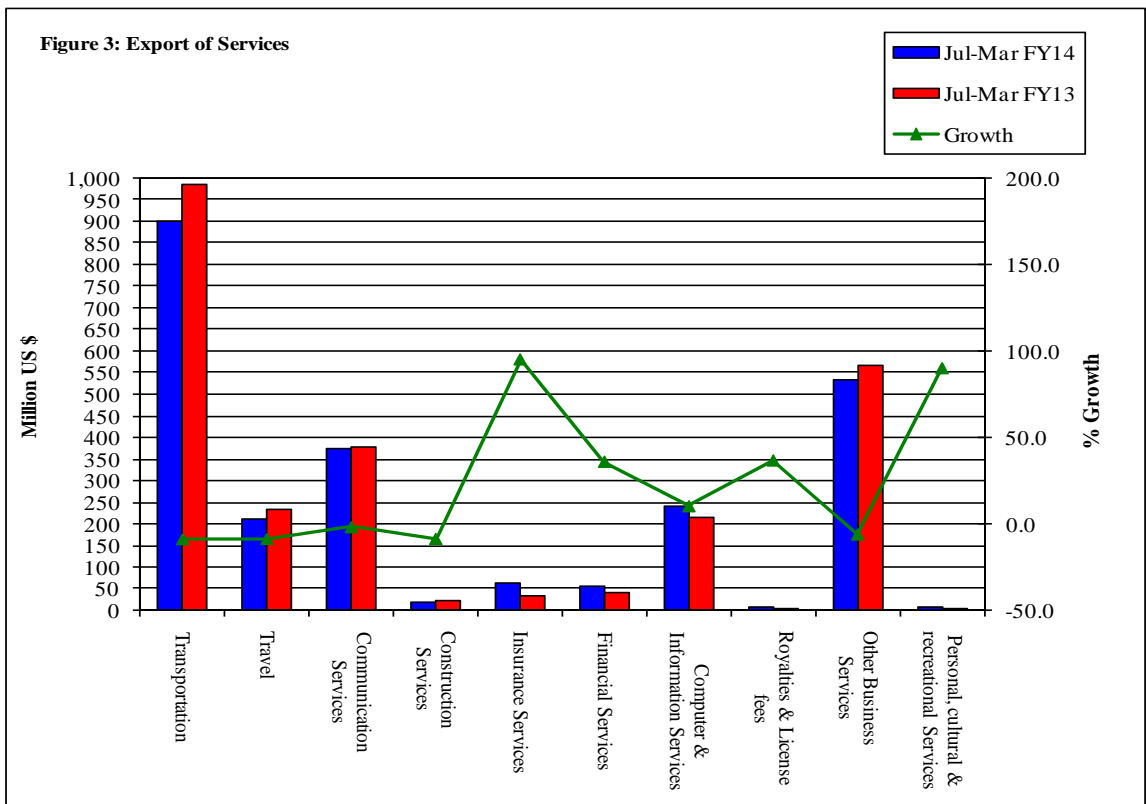
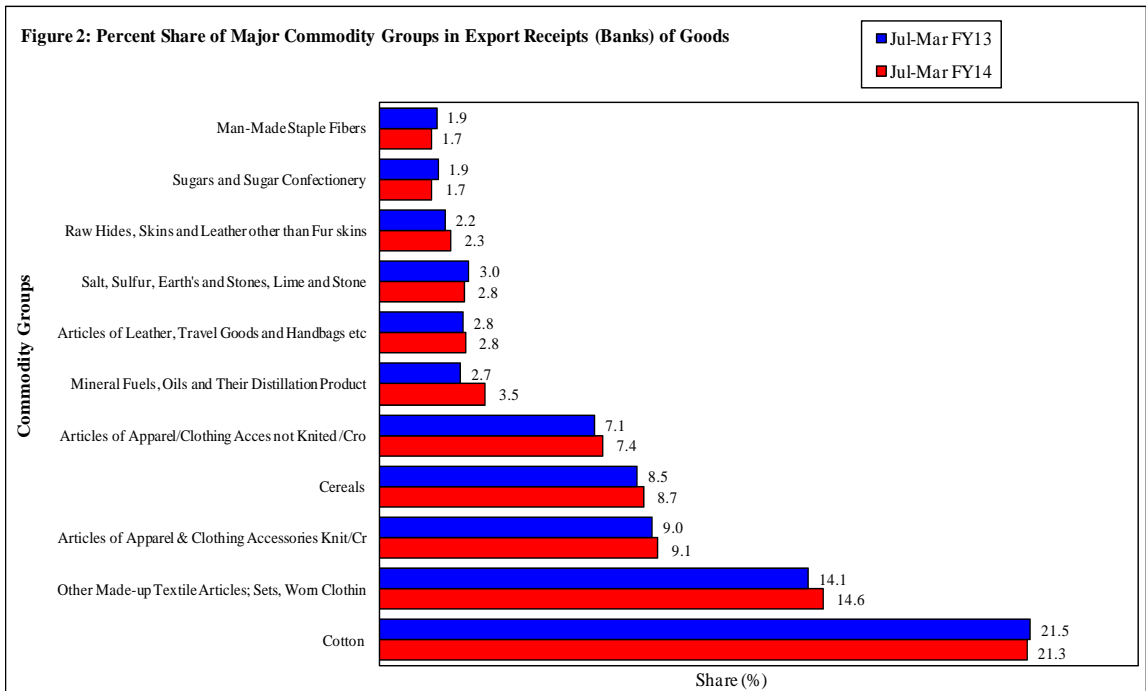
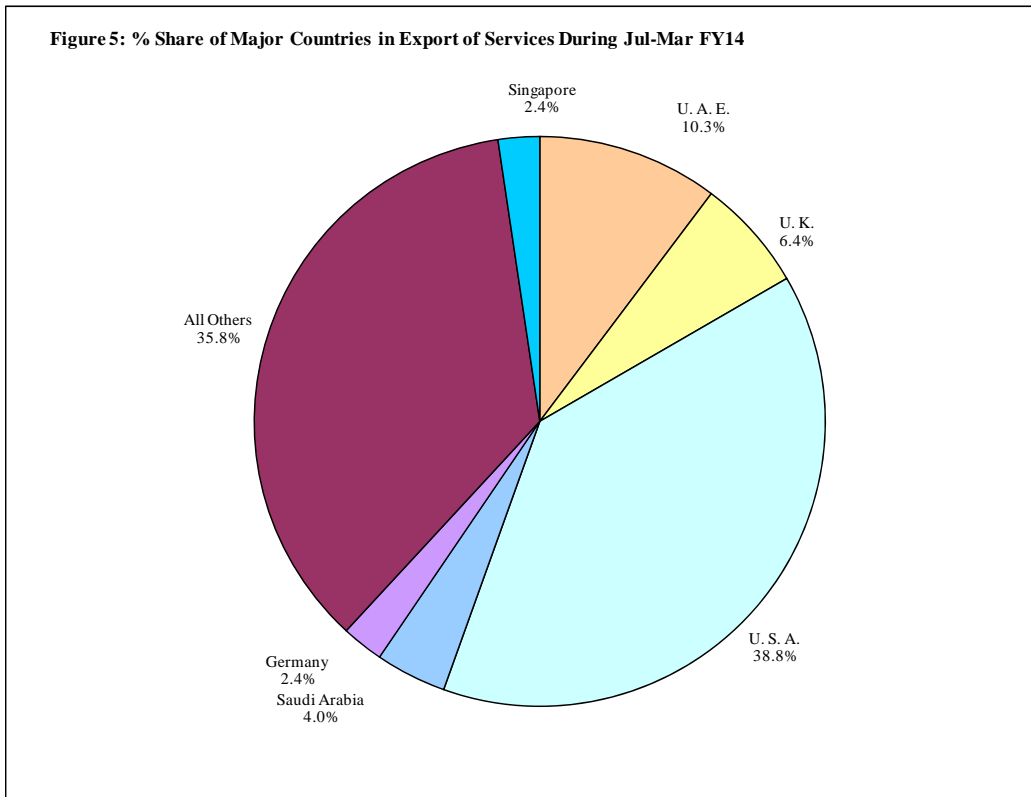
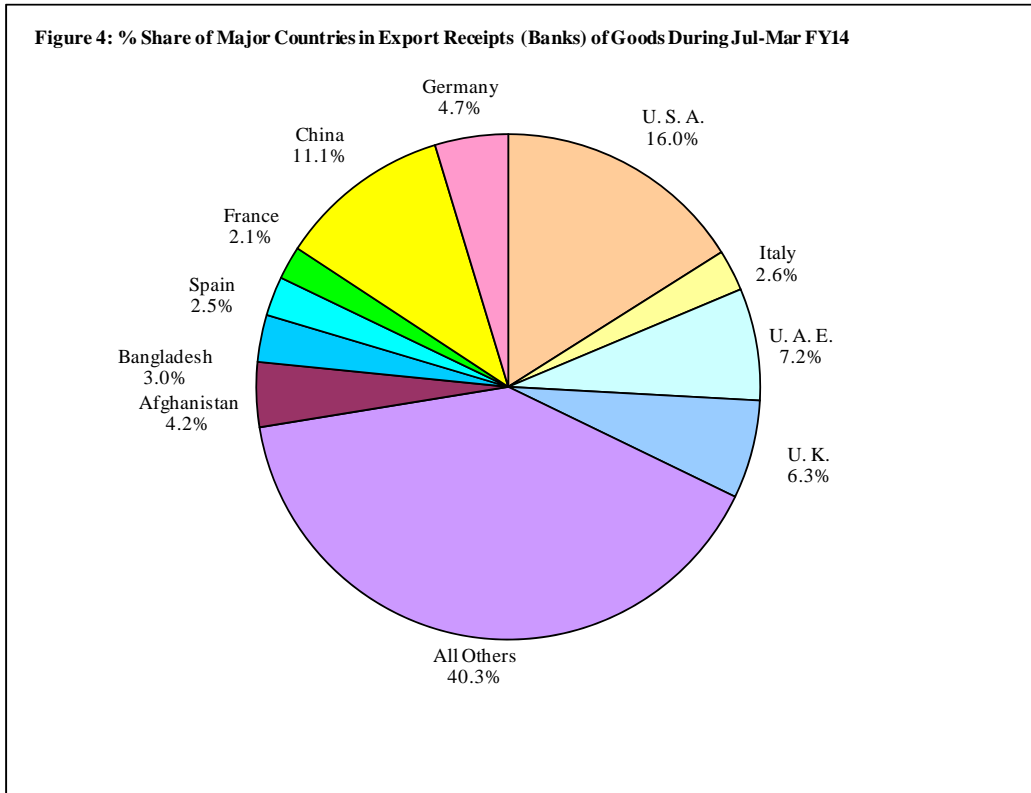

Figure 6: Annual Export of Goods & Services from FY02 to FY13

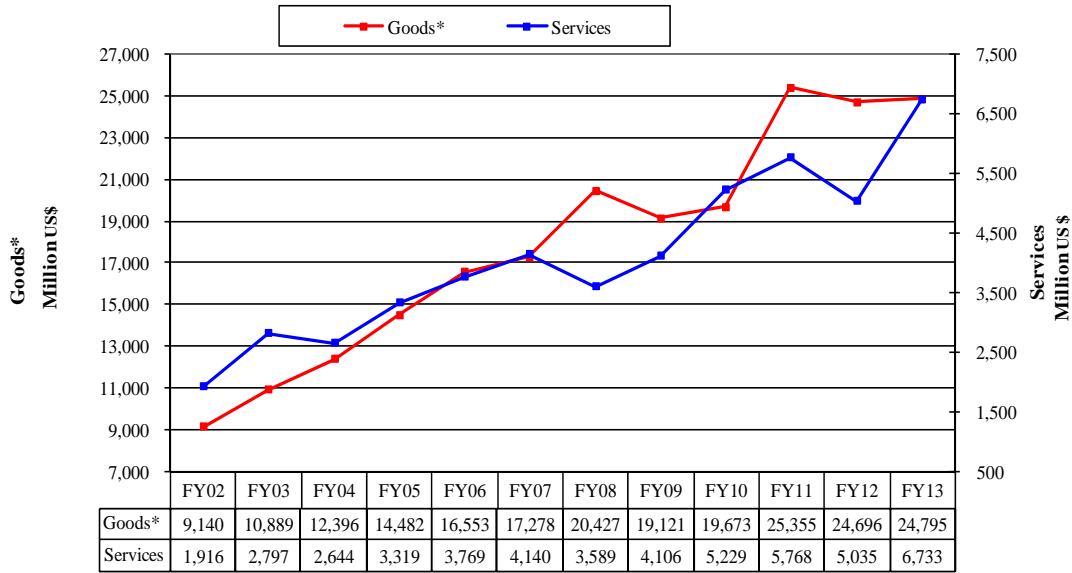
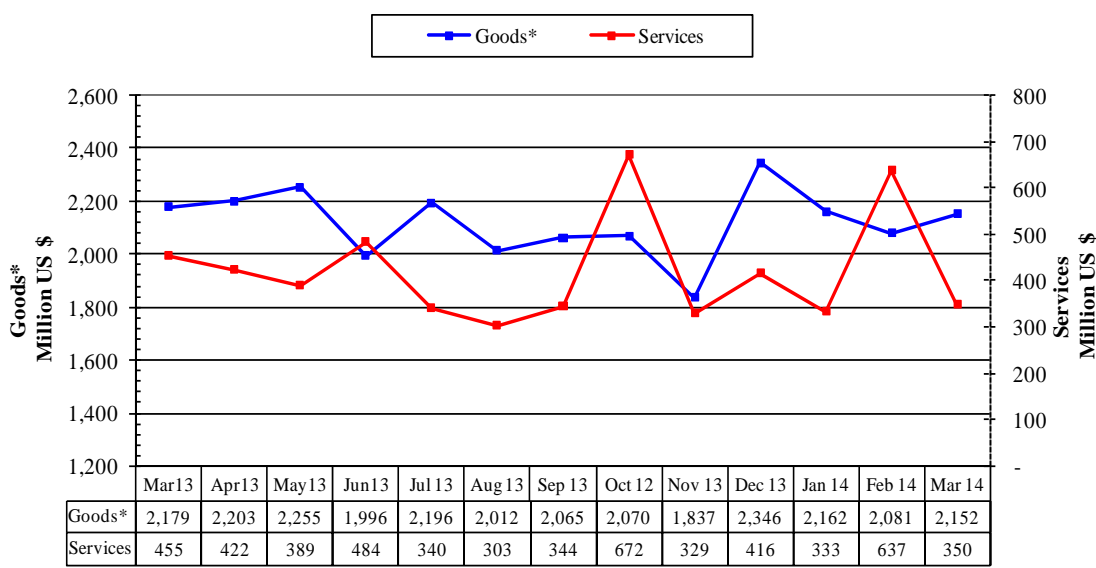


Figure 7: Monthly Export of Goods & Services
