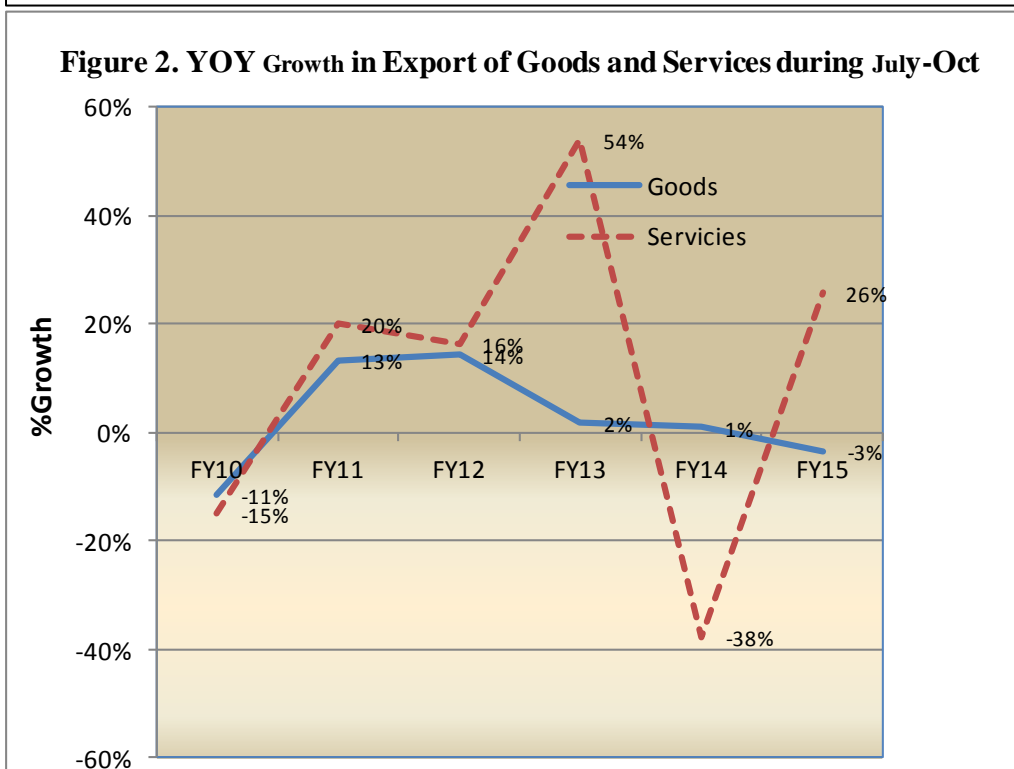
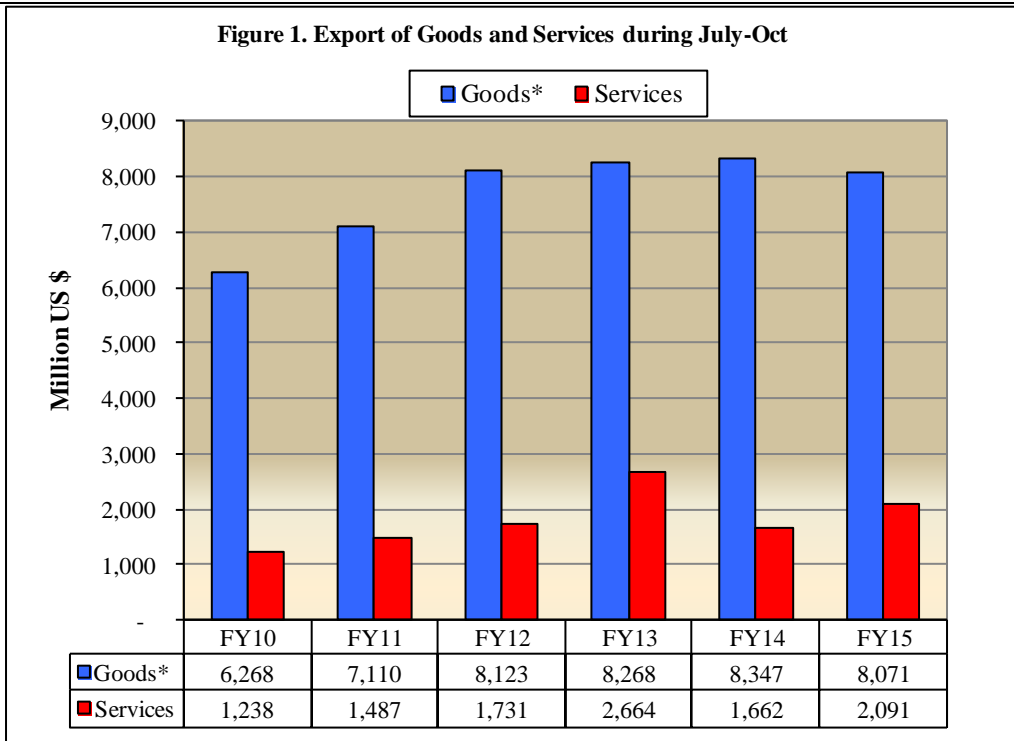

Figure 2: Percent Share of Major Commodity Groups in Export Receipts (Banks) of Goods

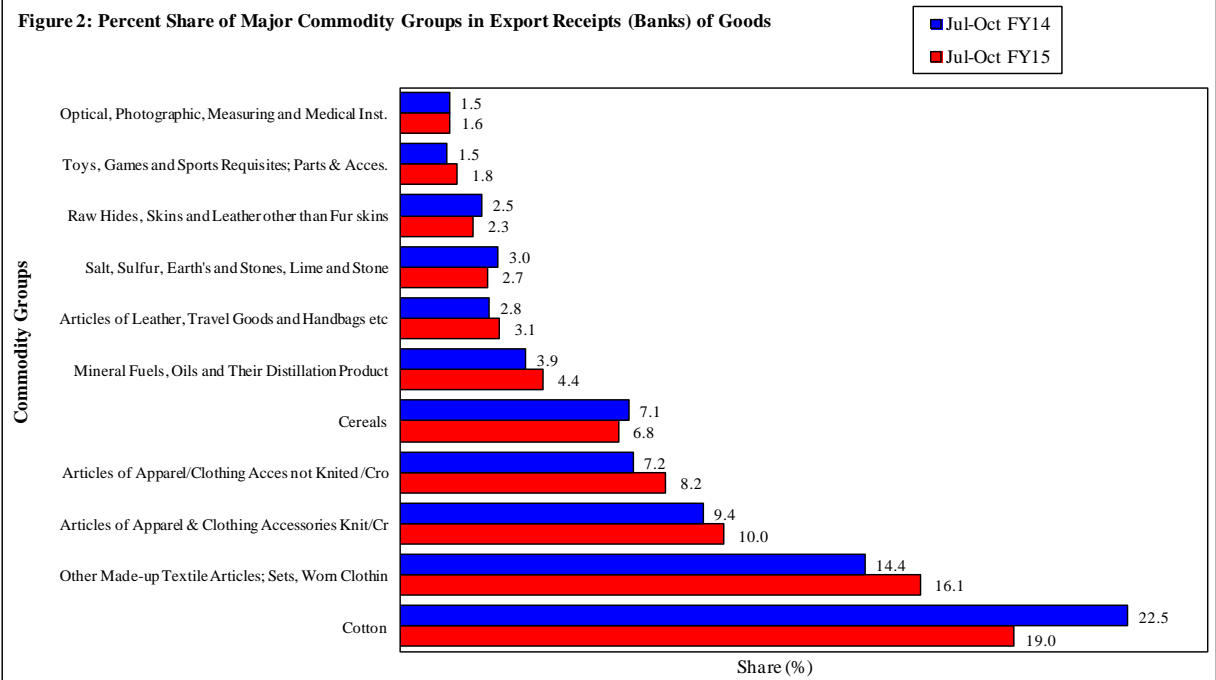


Figure 3: Export of Services

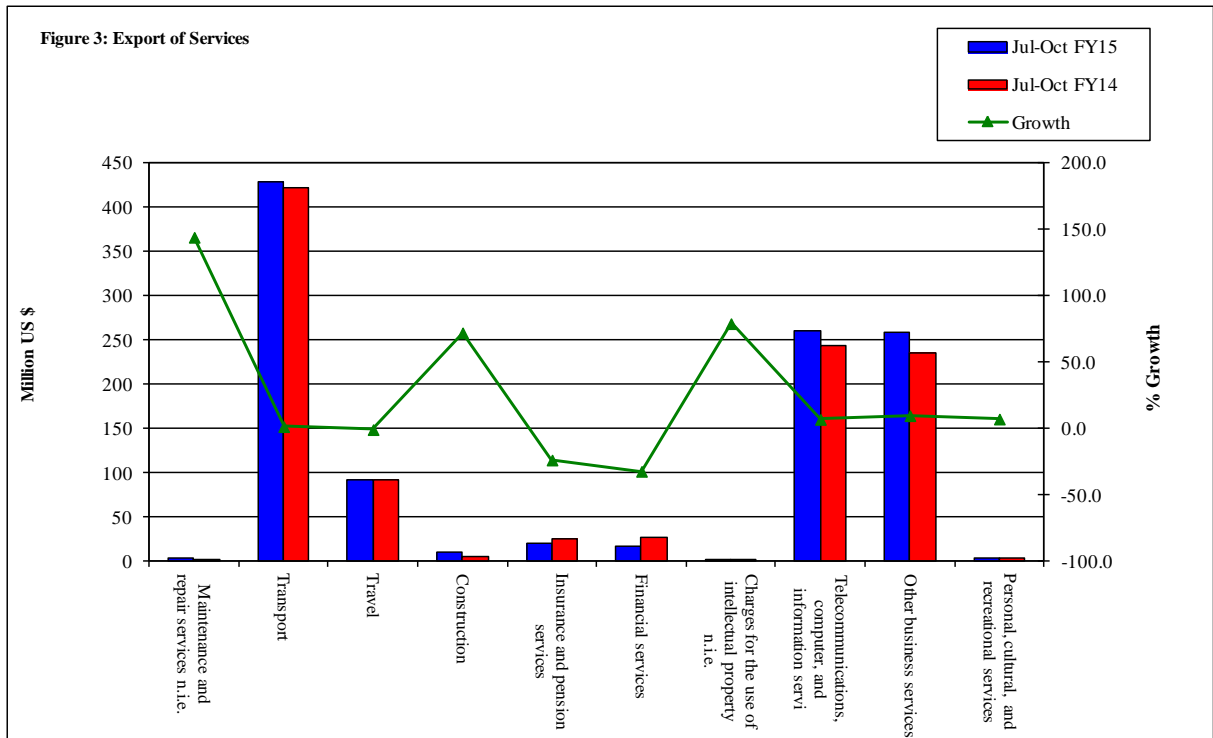

Figure 4: % Share of Major Countries in Export Receipts (Banks) of Goods During Jul-Oct FY15

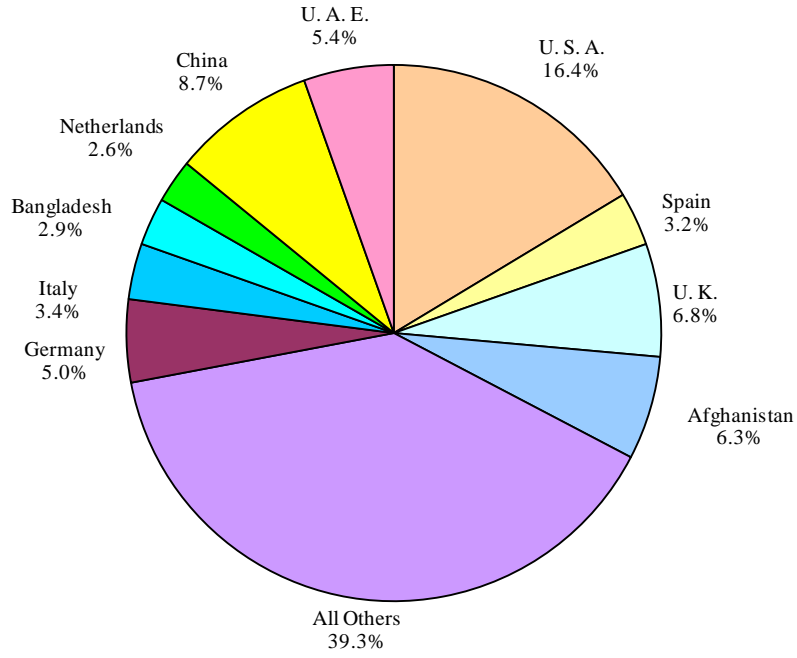
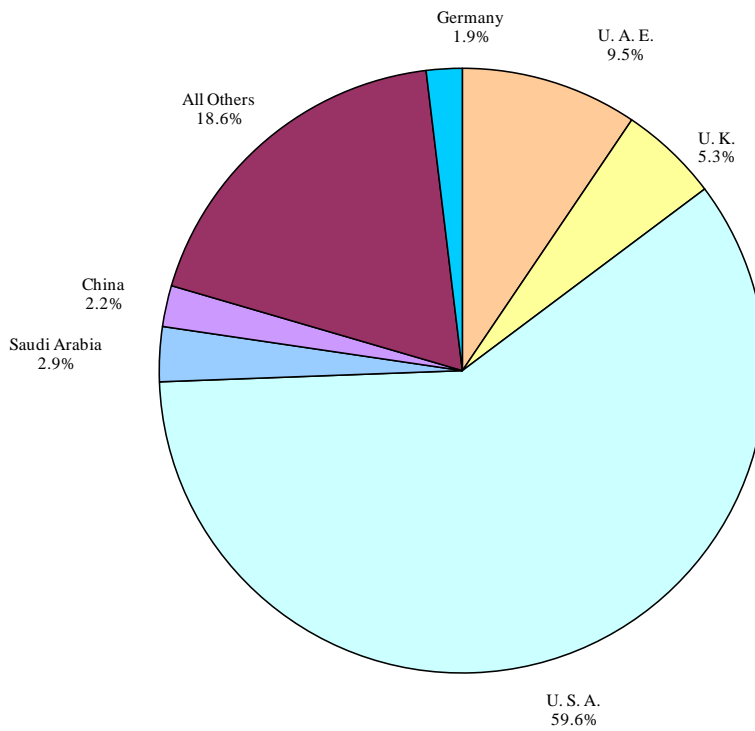
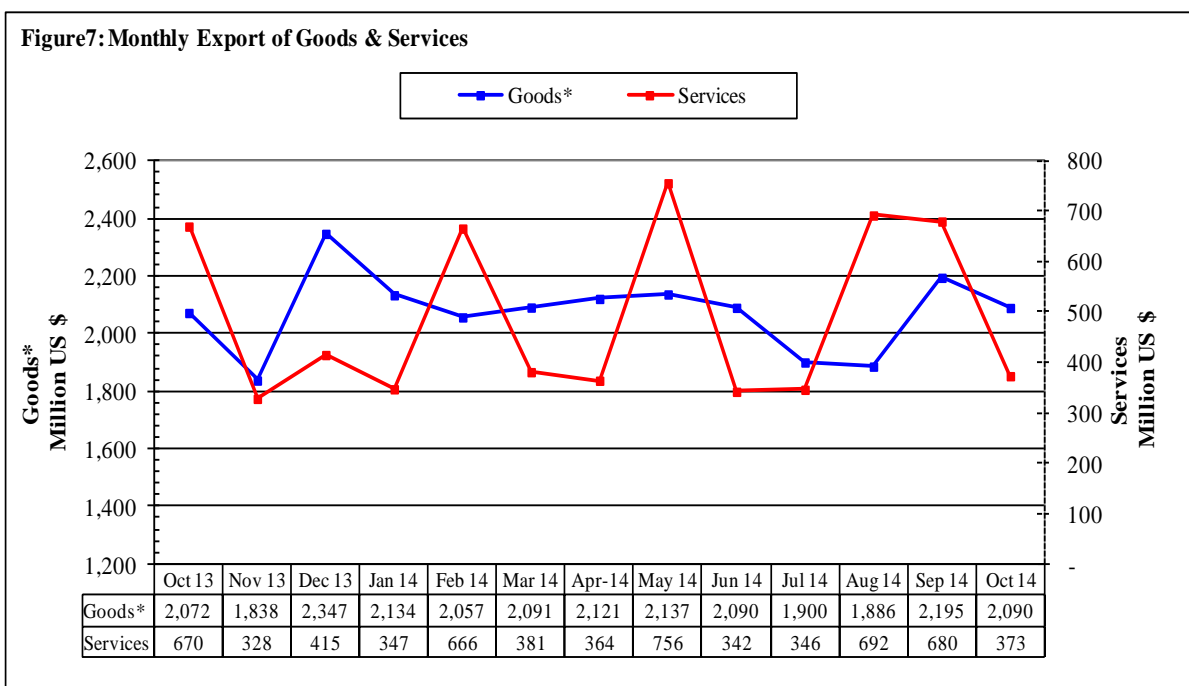
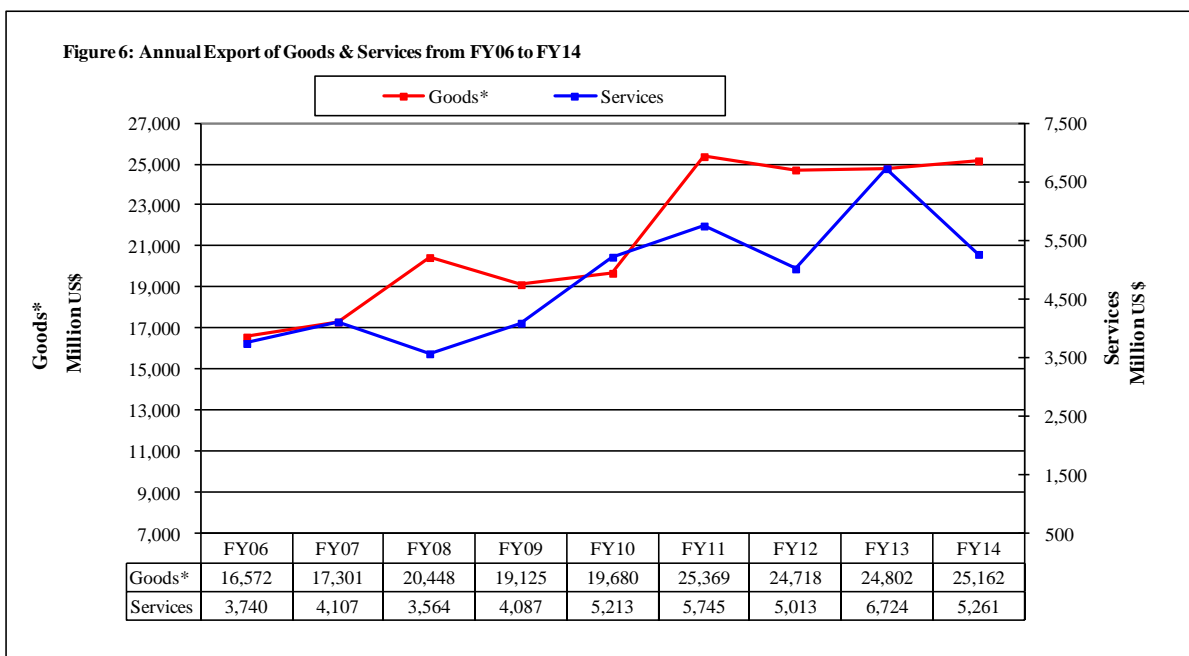


Figure 5: % Share of Major Countries in Export of Services During Jul-Oct FY15
