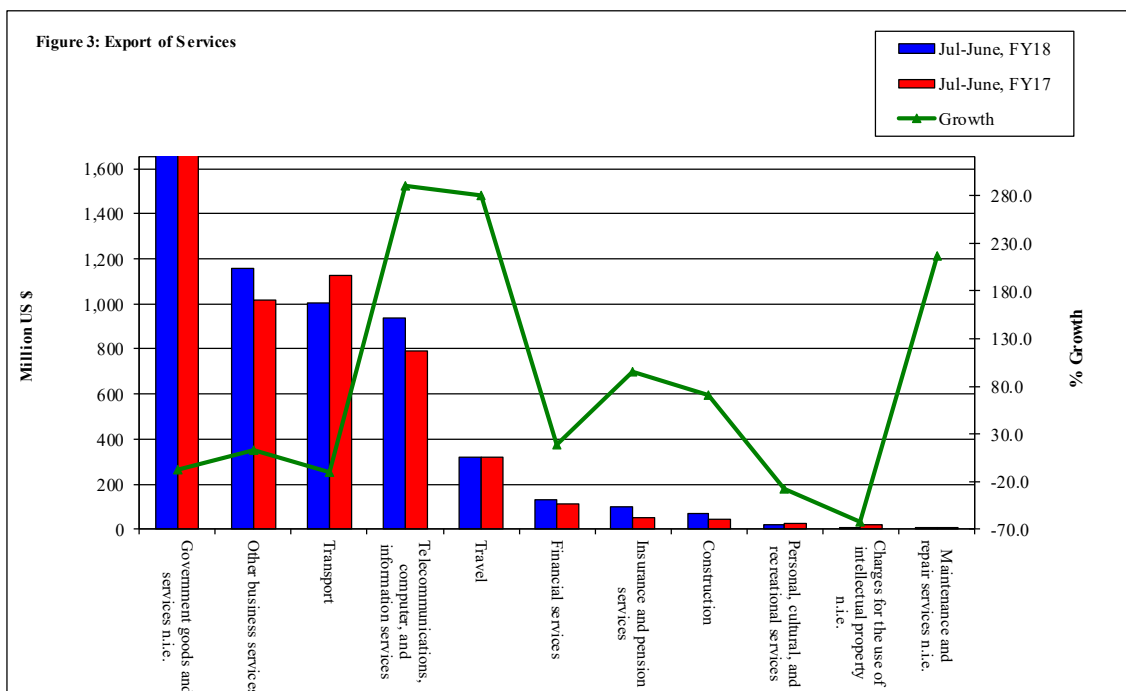
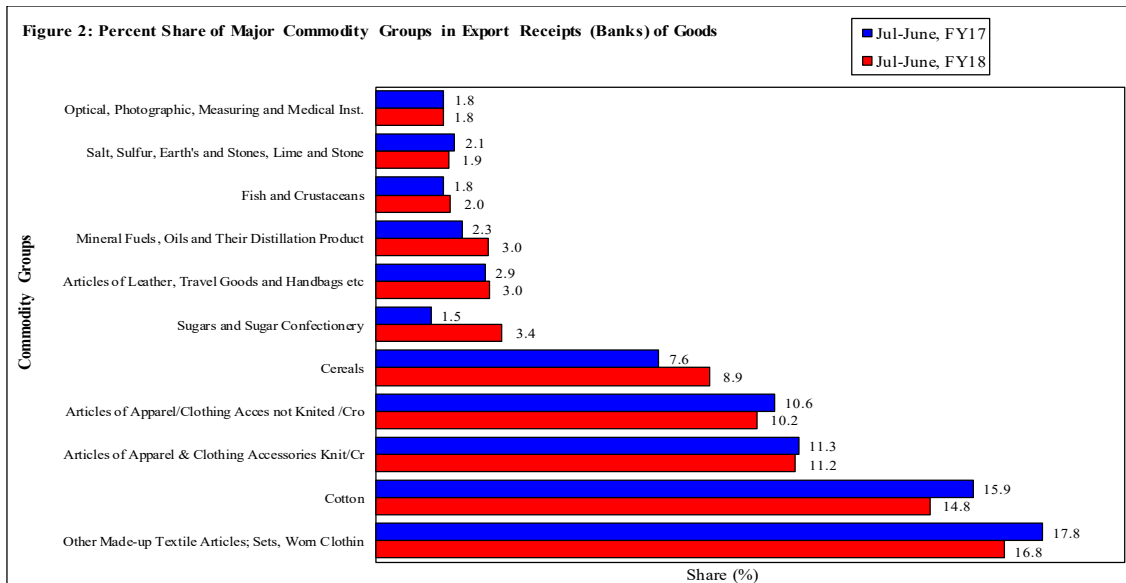

Figure 4: % Share of Major Countries in Export Receipts (Banks) of Goods During Jul-June, FY18

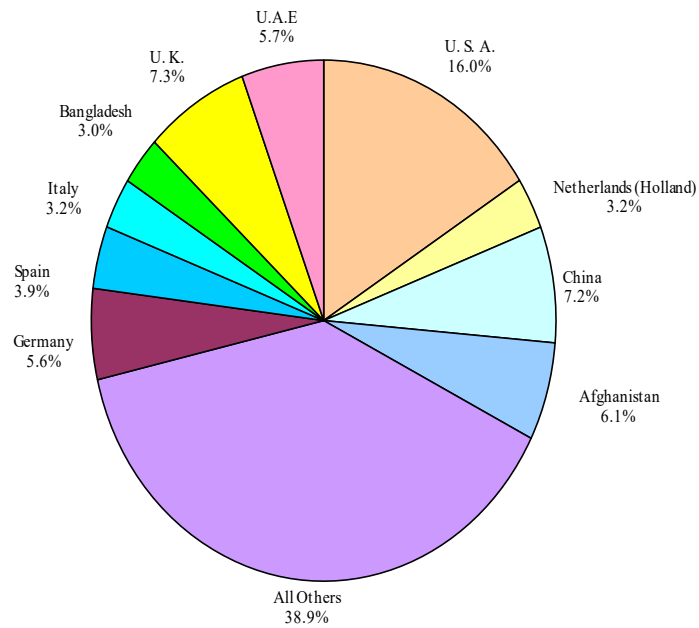
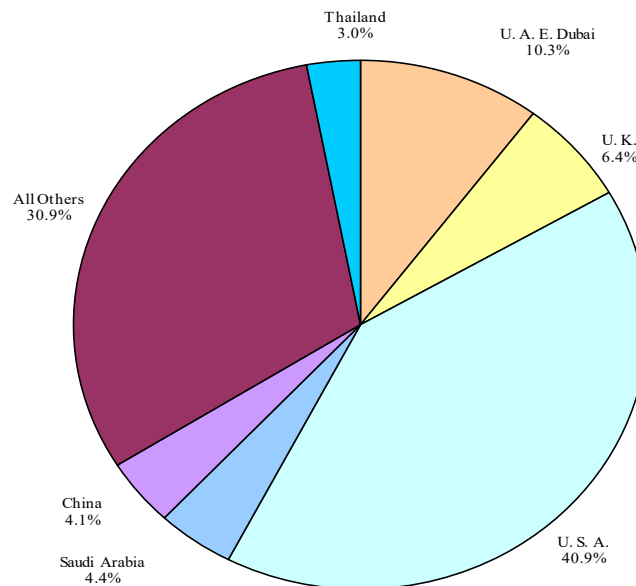
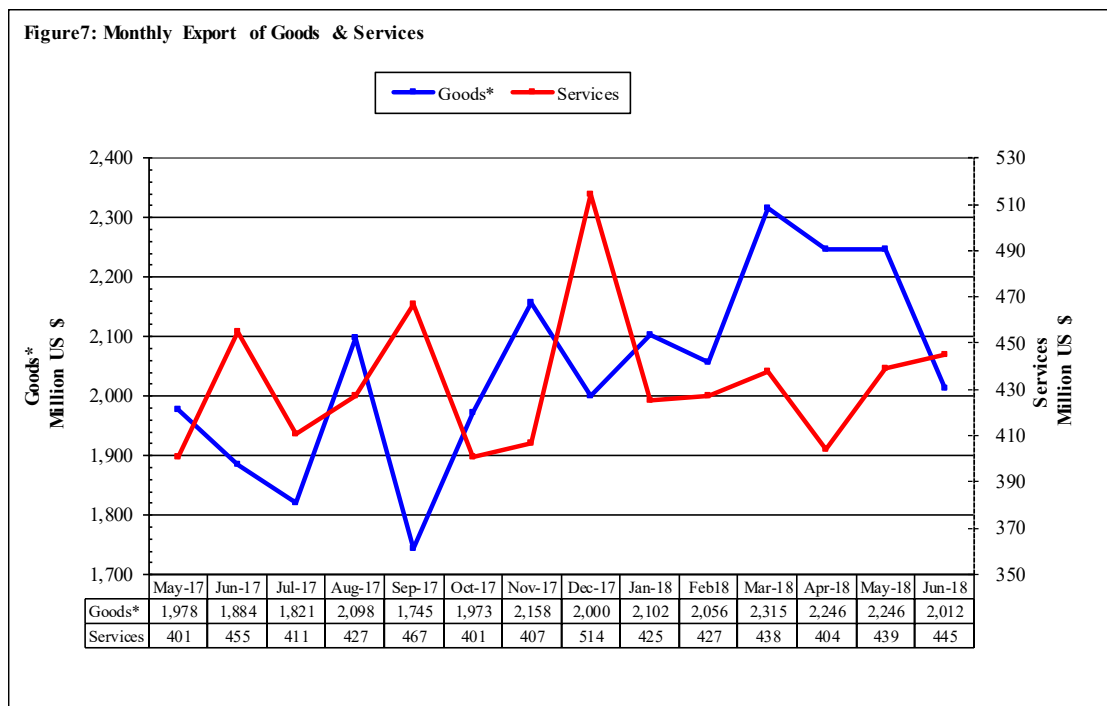
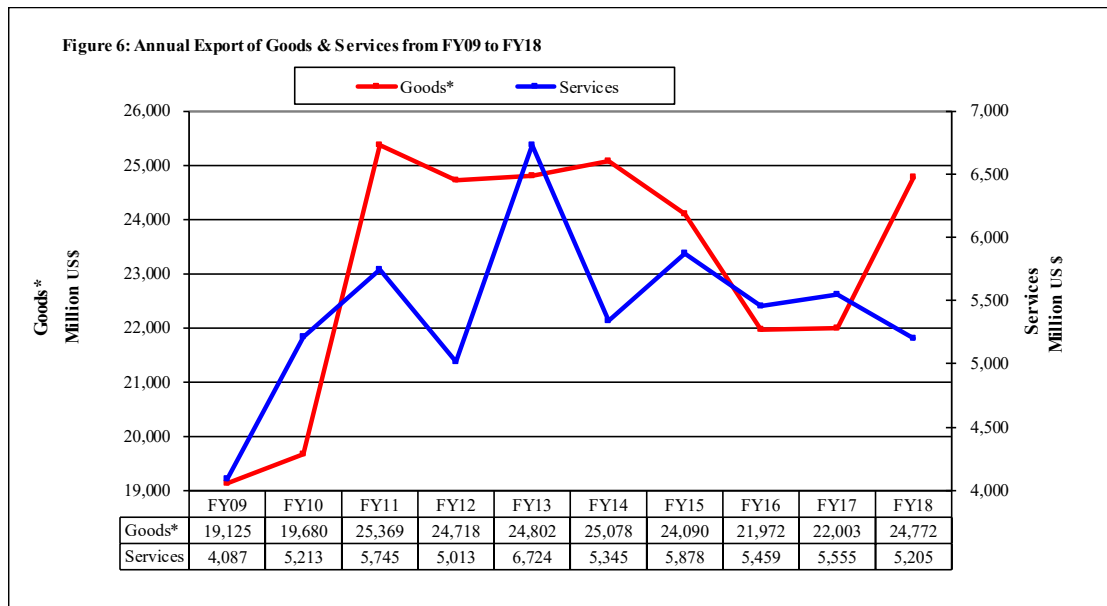


Figure 5: % Share of Major Countries in Export of Services During Jul-June, FY18
