Figure 1. Export of Goods and Services during Jul-Aug

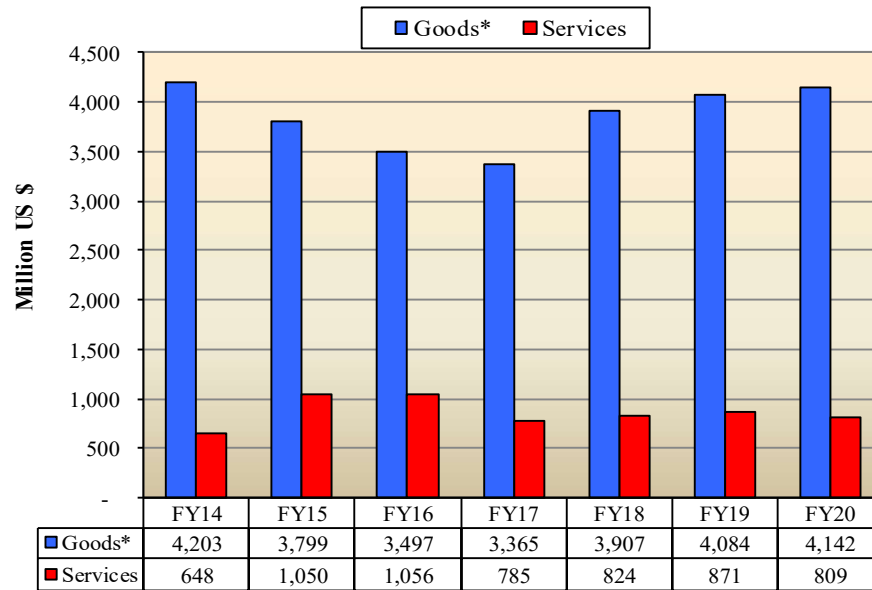
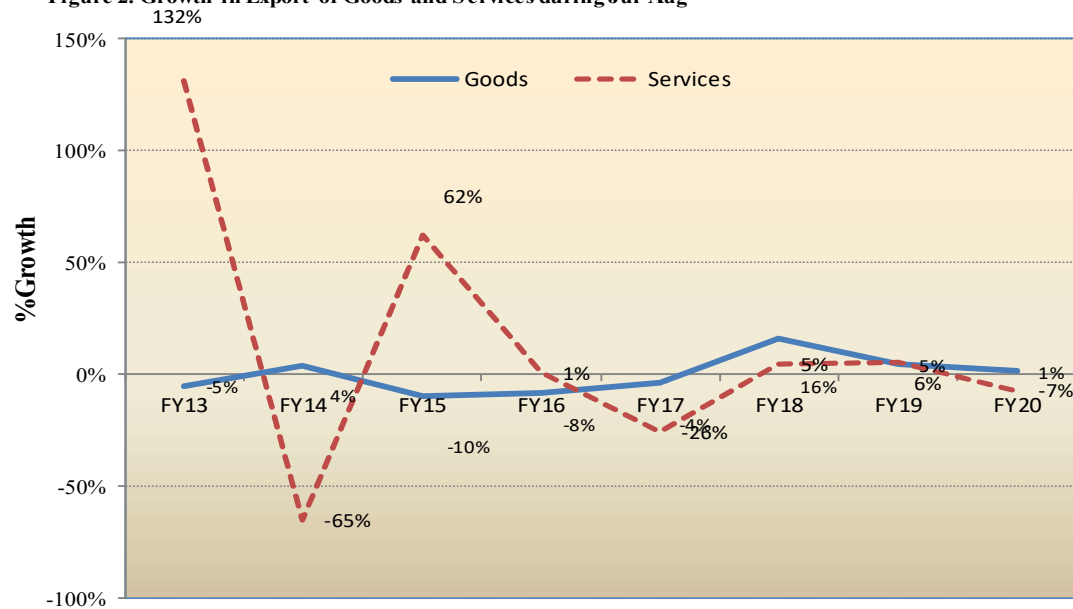


Figure 2. Growth in Export of Goods and Services during Jul-Aug

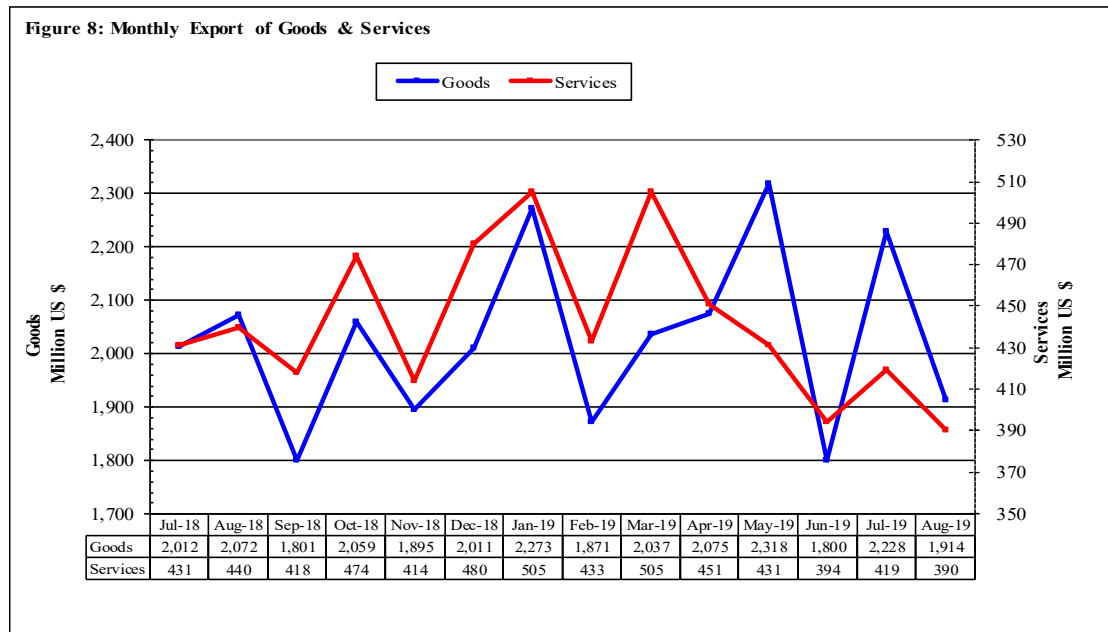
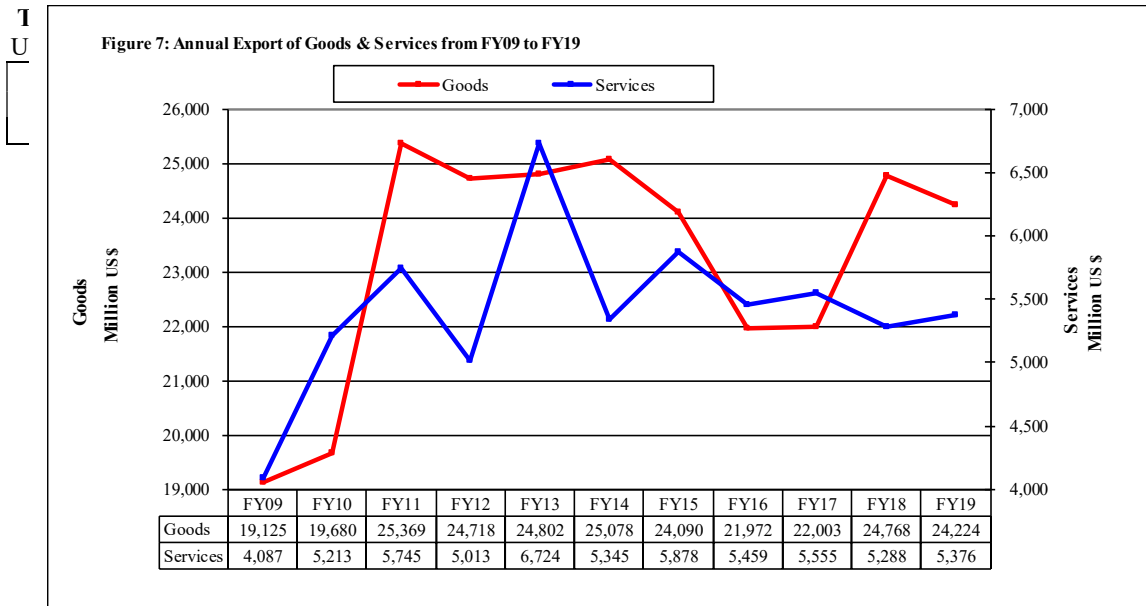
