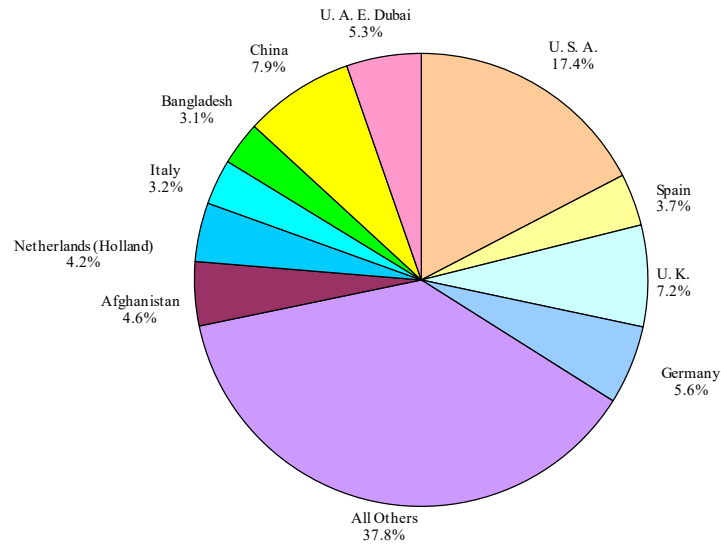

**Figure 6: Percent Share of Major Countries in Export of Services during Jul-Dec, FY20**

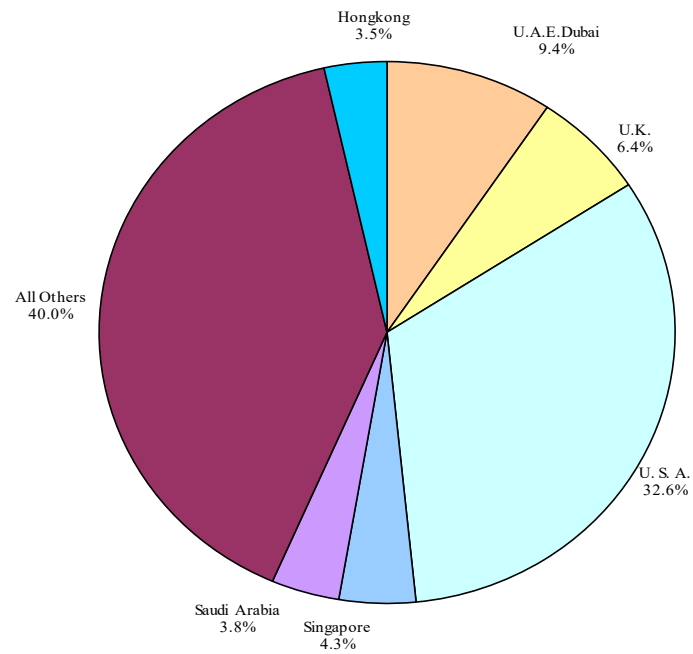


Figure 7: Annual Export of Goods &amp; Services from FY09 to FY19

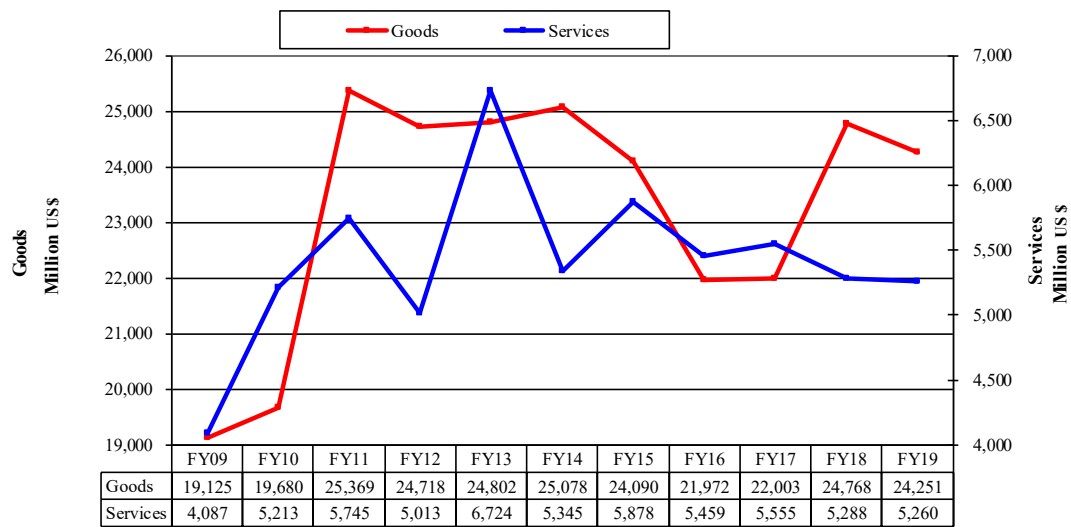
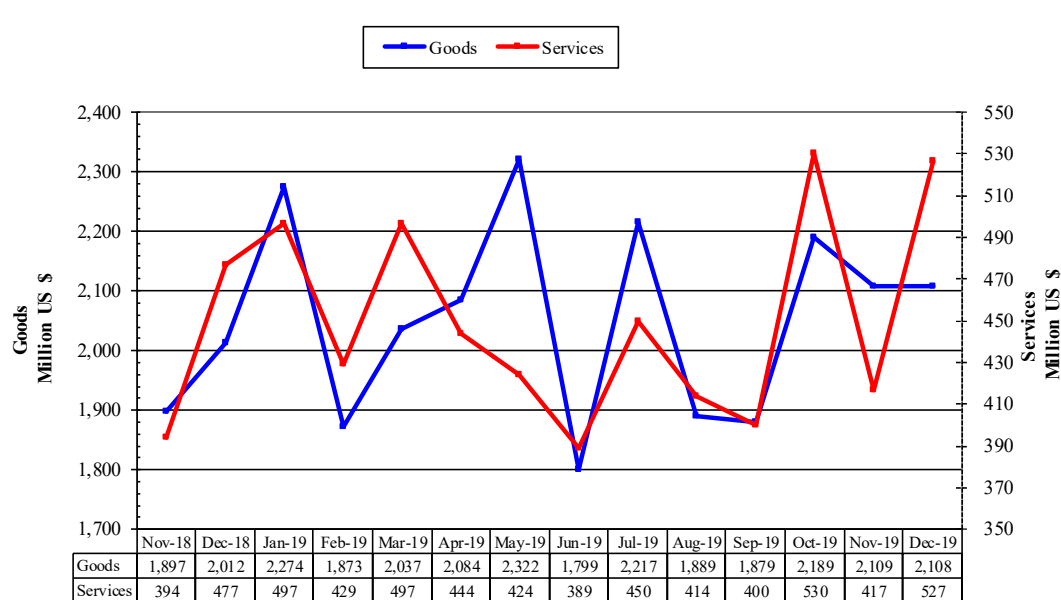


Figure 8: Monthly Export of Goods &amp; Services
