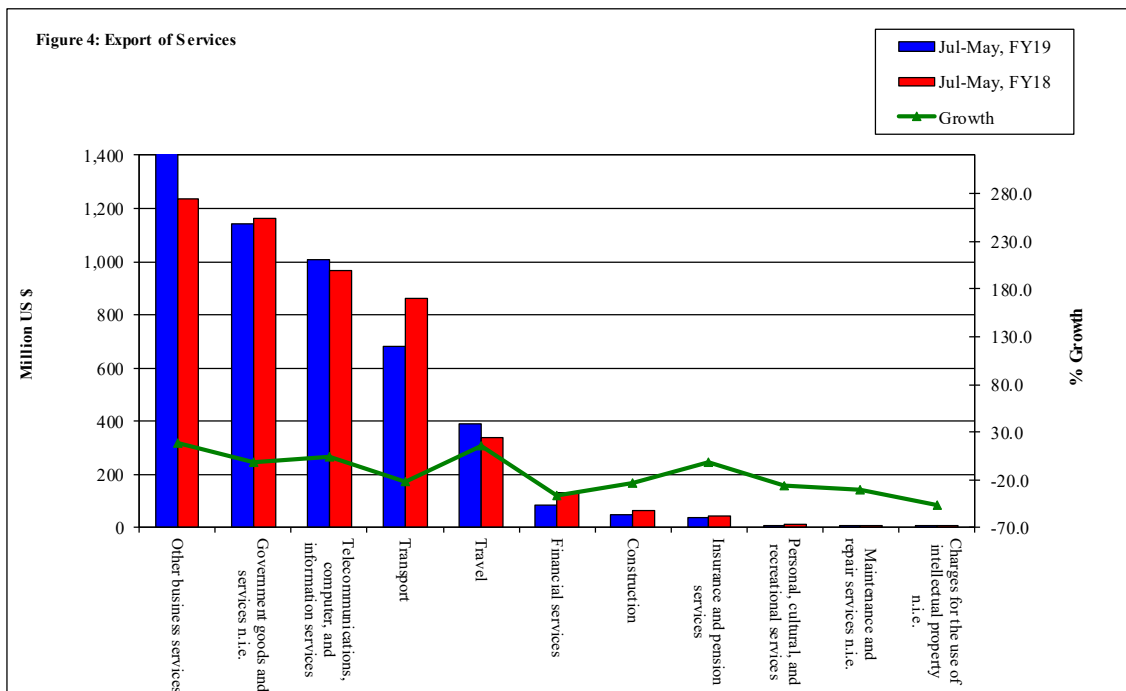
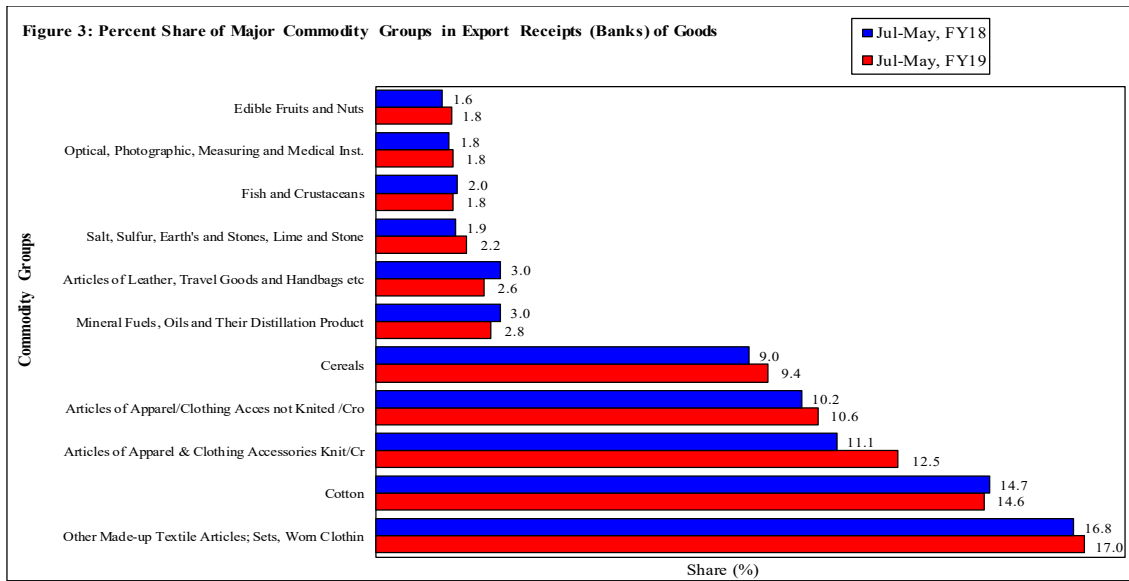

Figure 5: Percent Share of Major Countries in Export Receipts (Banks) of Goods during Jul-May, FY19

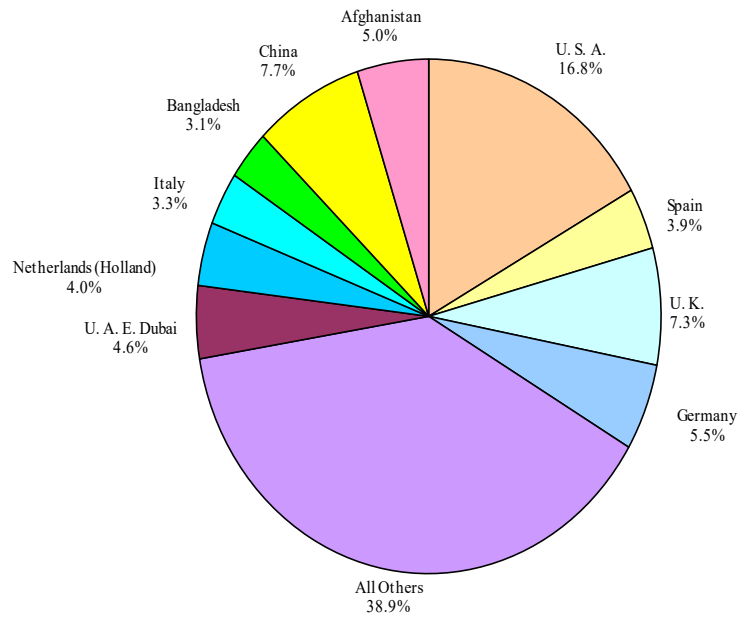


Figure 6: Percent Share of Major Countries in Export of Services during Jul-May, FY19

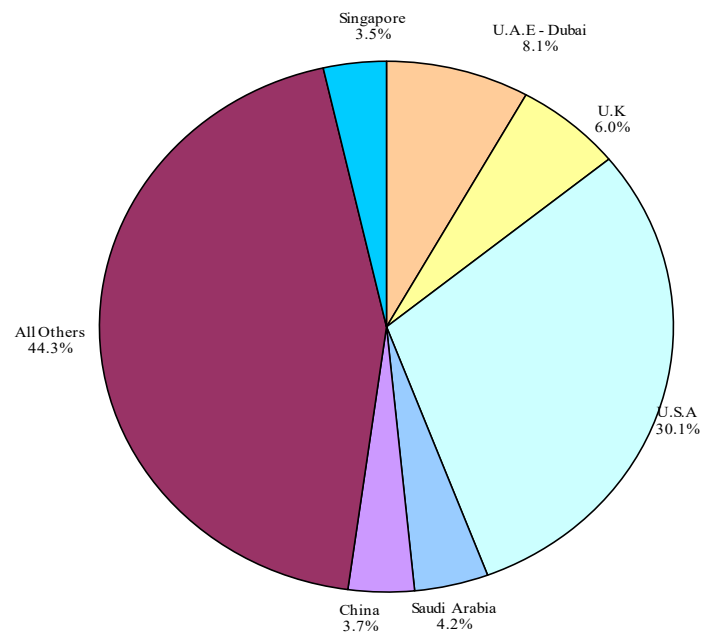


Figure 7: Annual Export of Goods & Services from FY09 to FY18

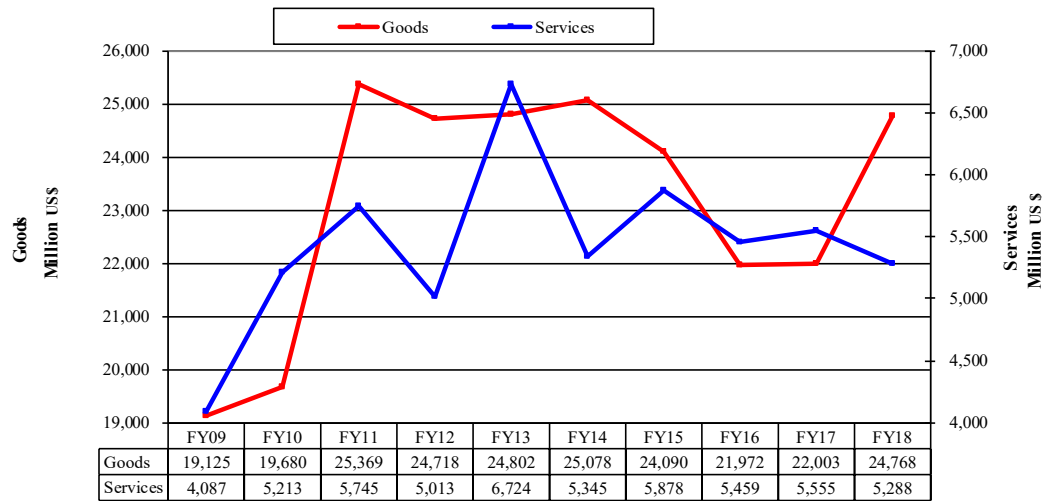


Figure 8: Monthly Export of Goods & Services

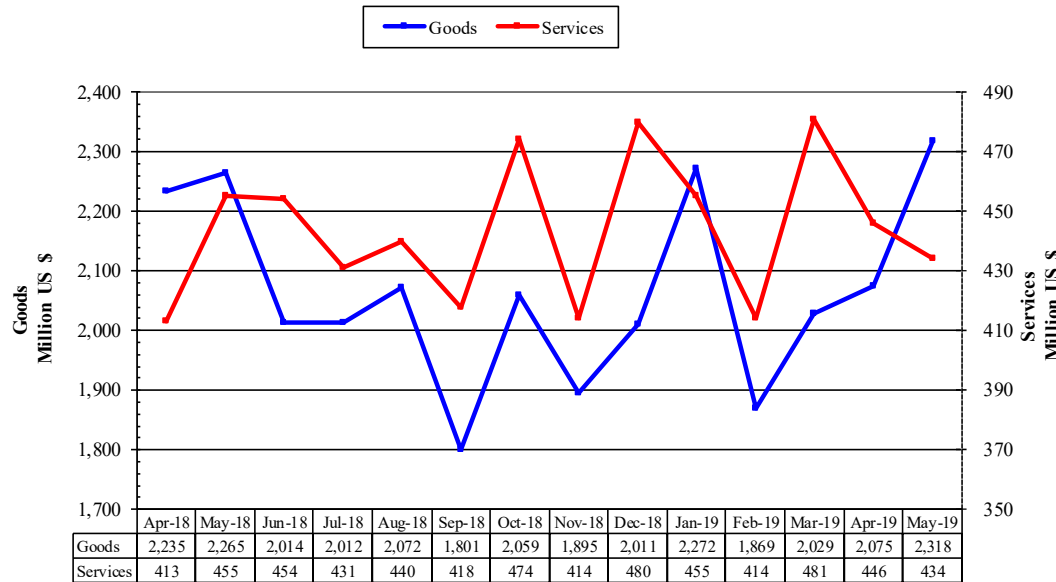
