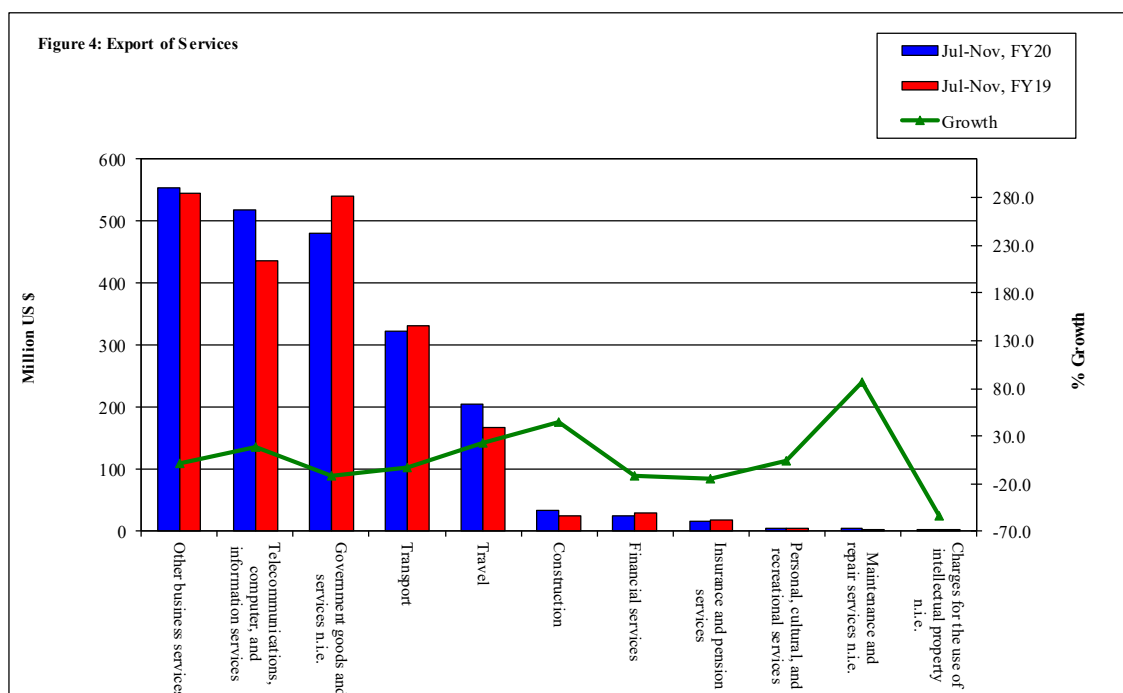
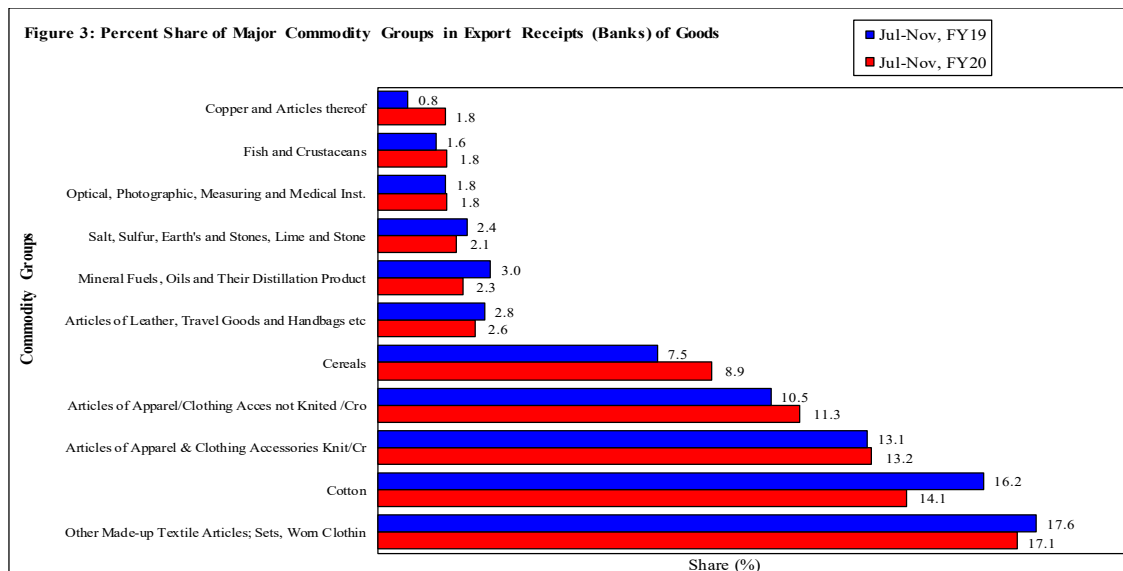

Figure 5: Percent Share of Major Countries in Export Receipts (Banks) of Goods during Jul-Nov, FY20

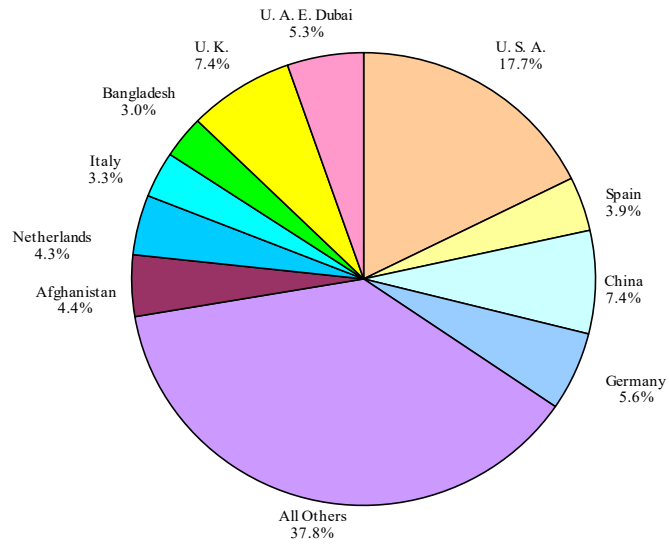


Figure 6: Percent Share of Major Countries in Export of Services during Jul-Nov, FY20

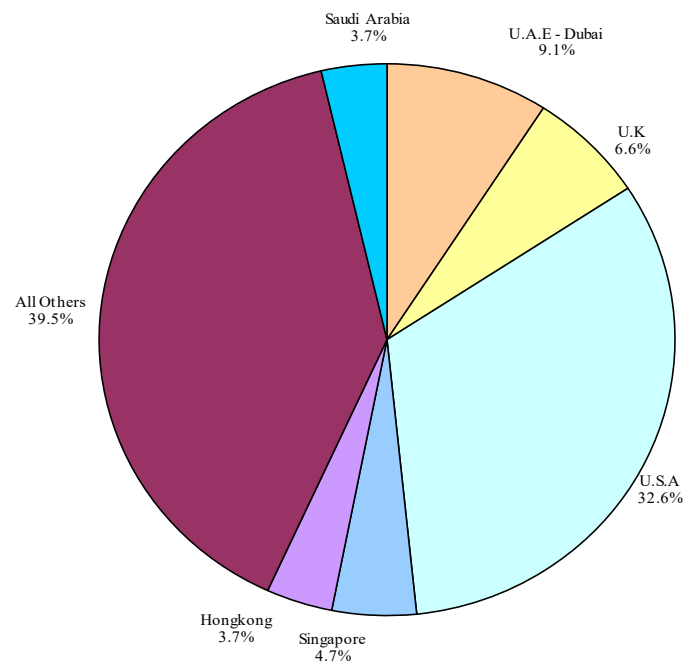


Figure 7: Annual Export of Goods & Services from FY09 to FY19

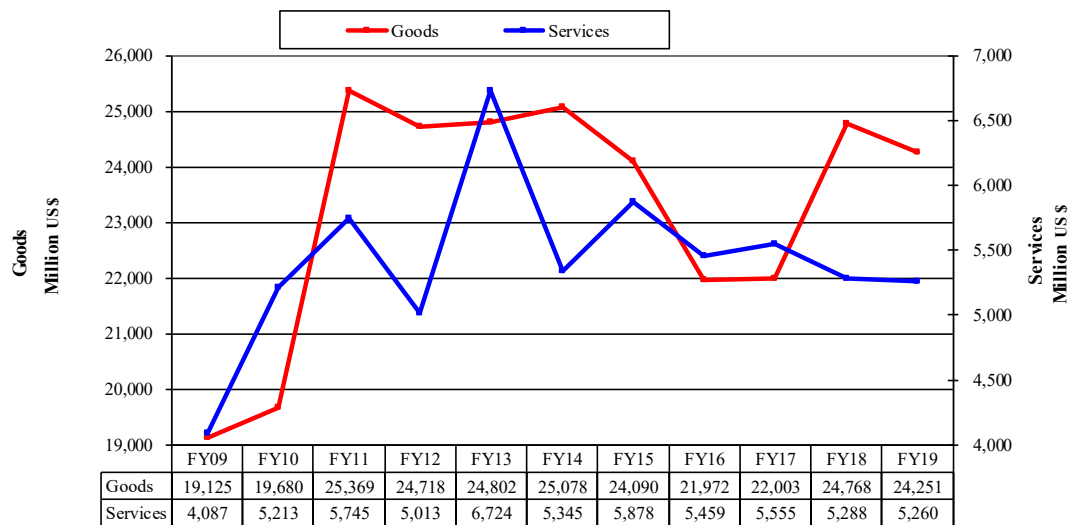


Figure 8: Monthly Export of Goods & Services

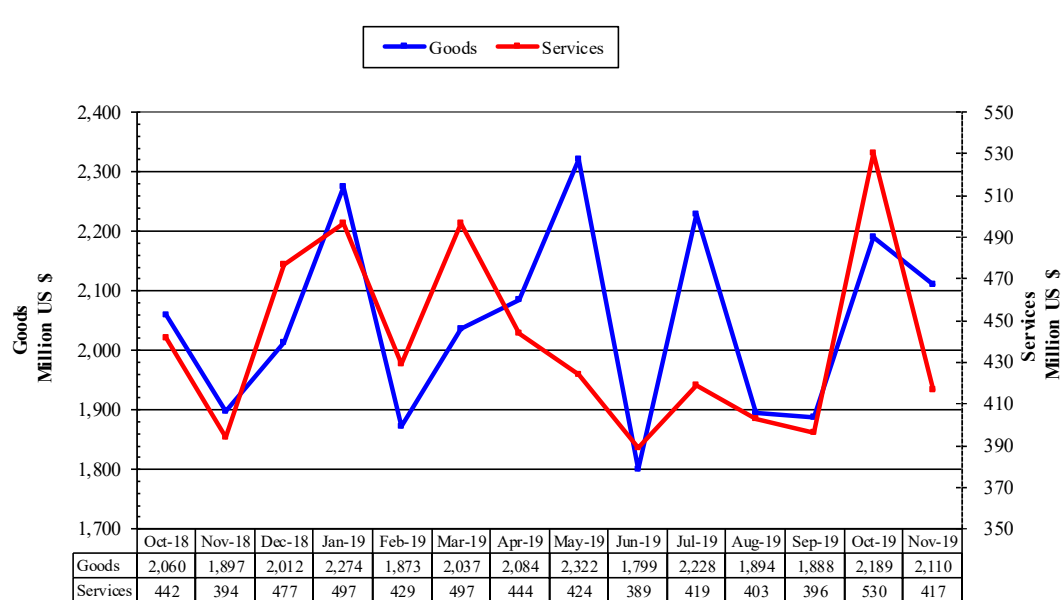
