Figure 1. Export of Goods and Services during Jul-Sep

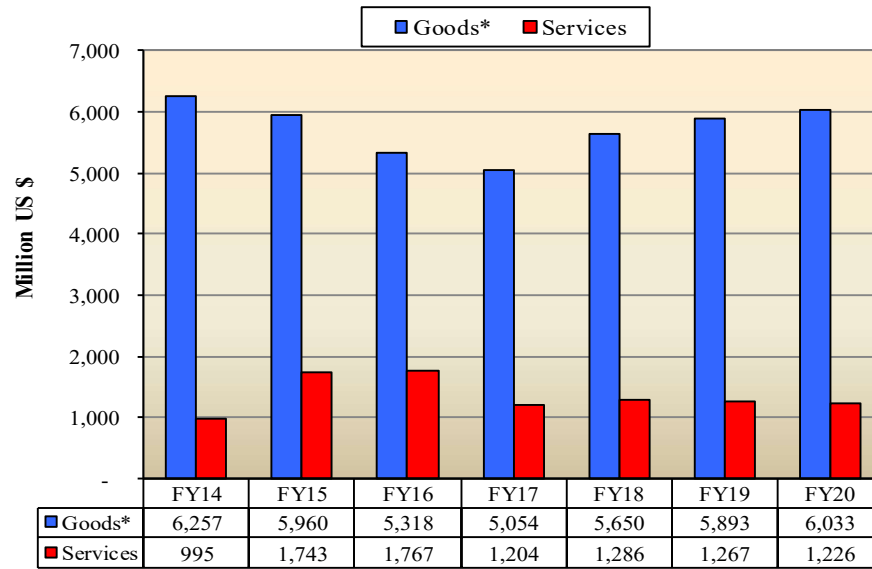
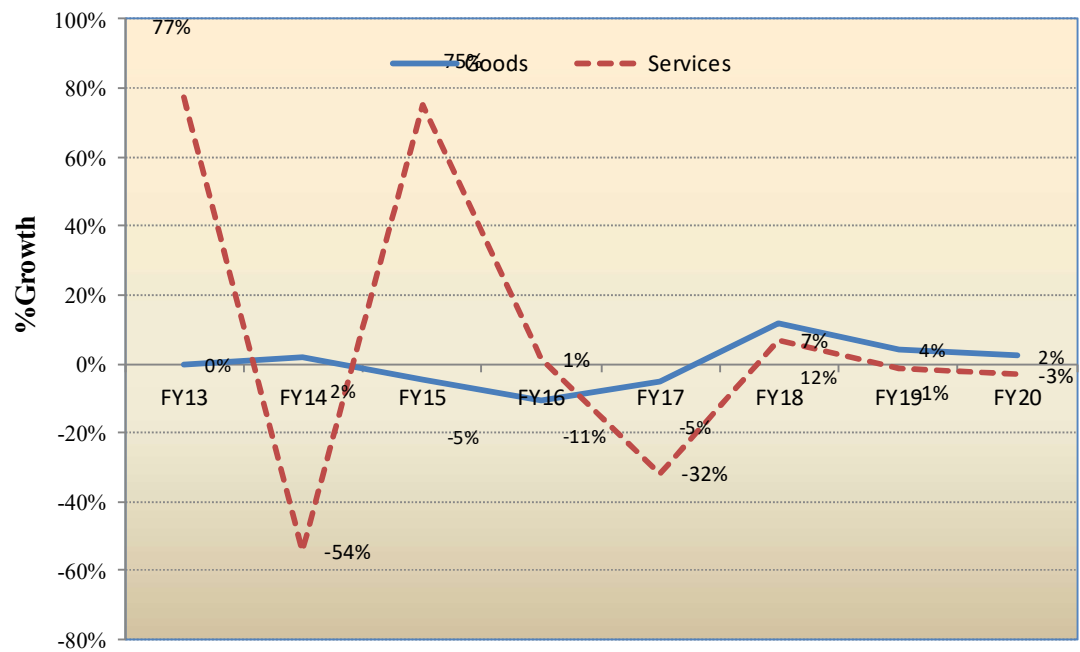


Figure 2. Growth in Export of Goods and Services during Jul-Sep

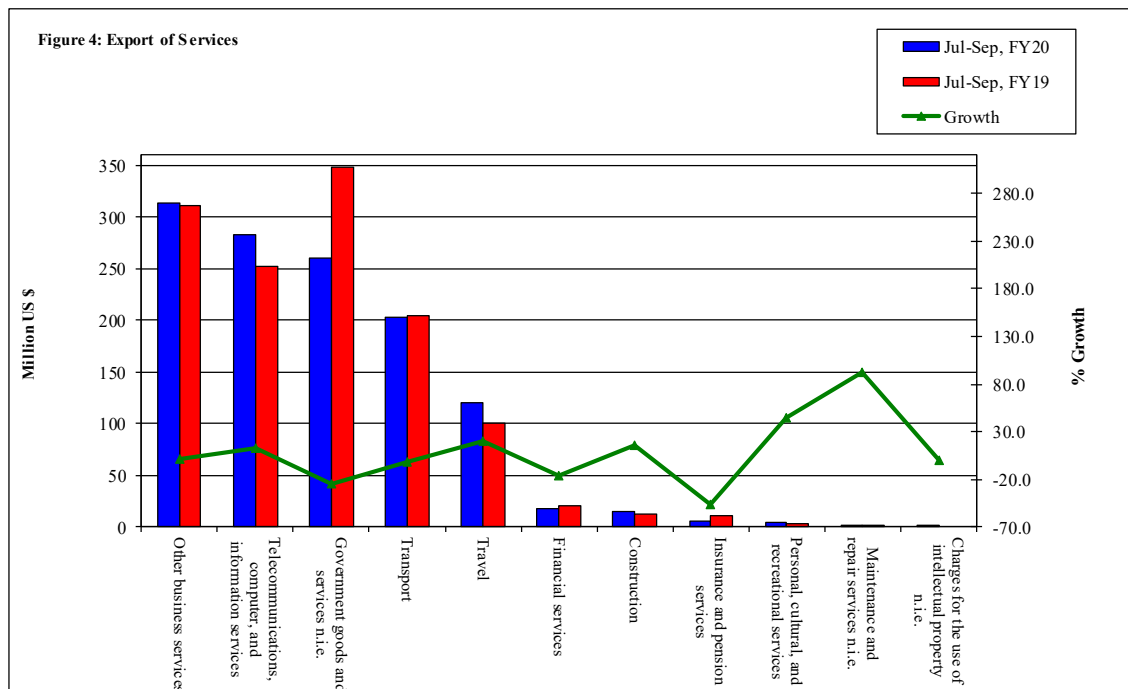
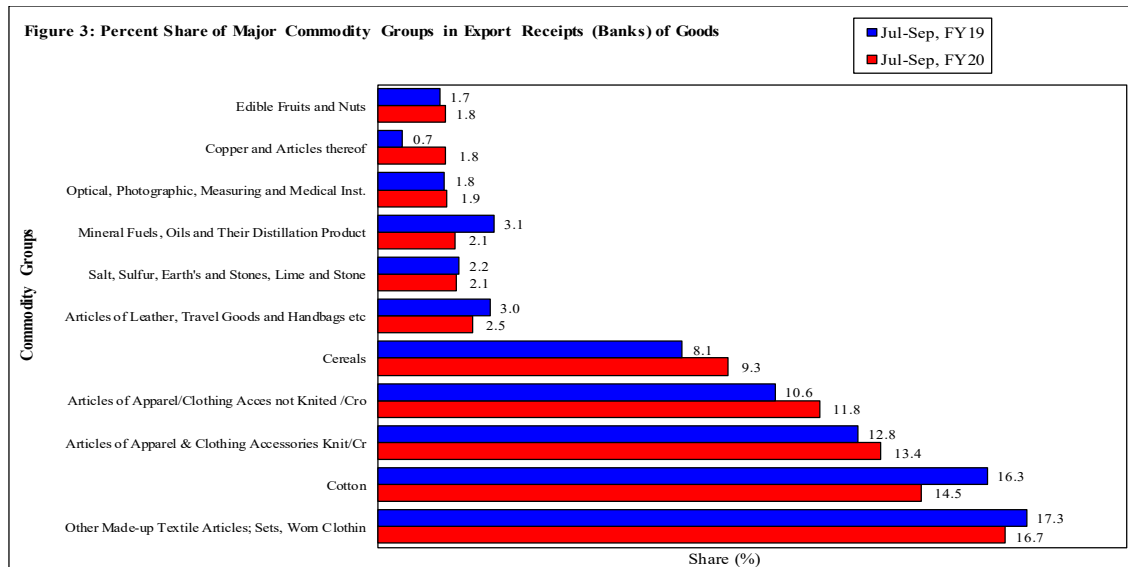

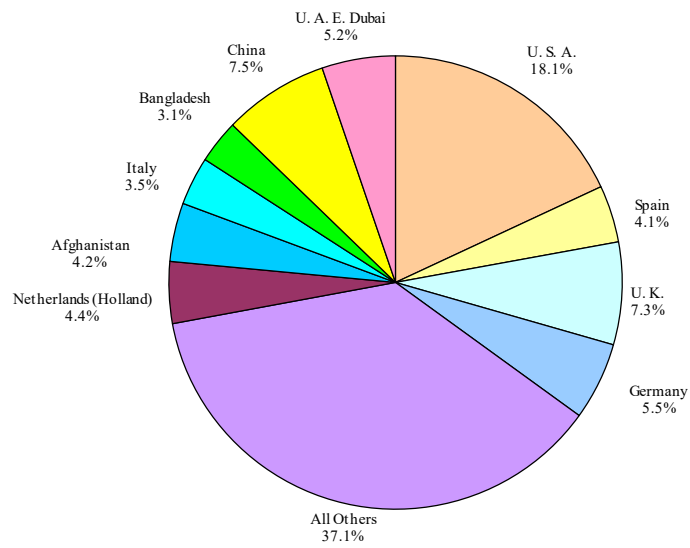
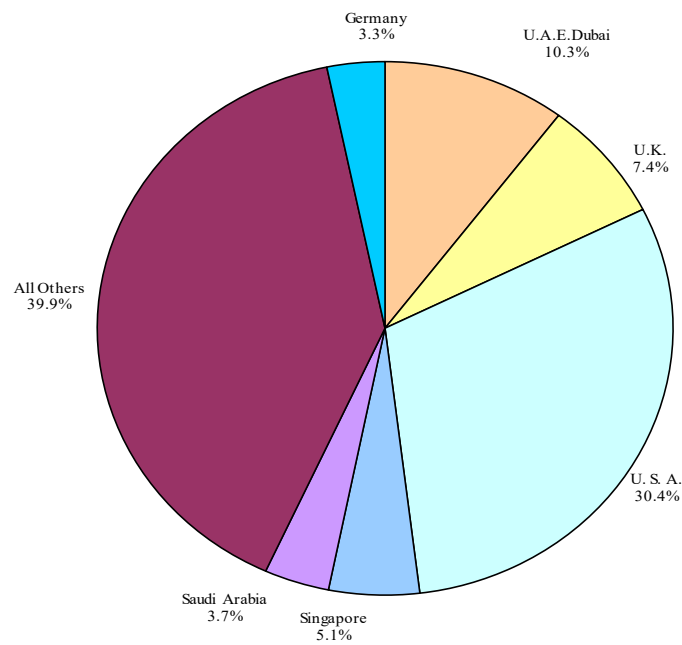
Figure 5: Percent Share of Major Countries in Export Receipts (Banks) of Goods during Jul-Sep, FY20**Figure 6: Percent Share of Major Countries in Export of Services during Jul-Sep, FY20**

Figure 7: Annual Export of Goods & Services from FY09 to FY19

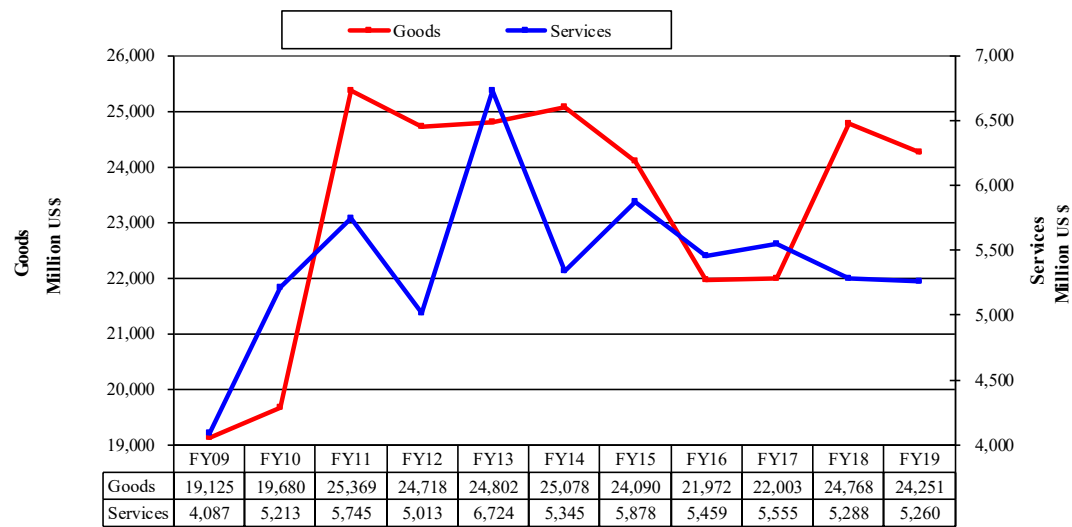


Figure 8: Monthly Export of Goods & Services

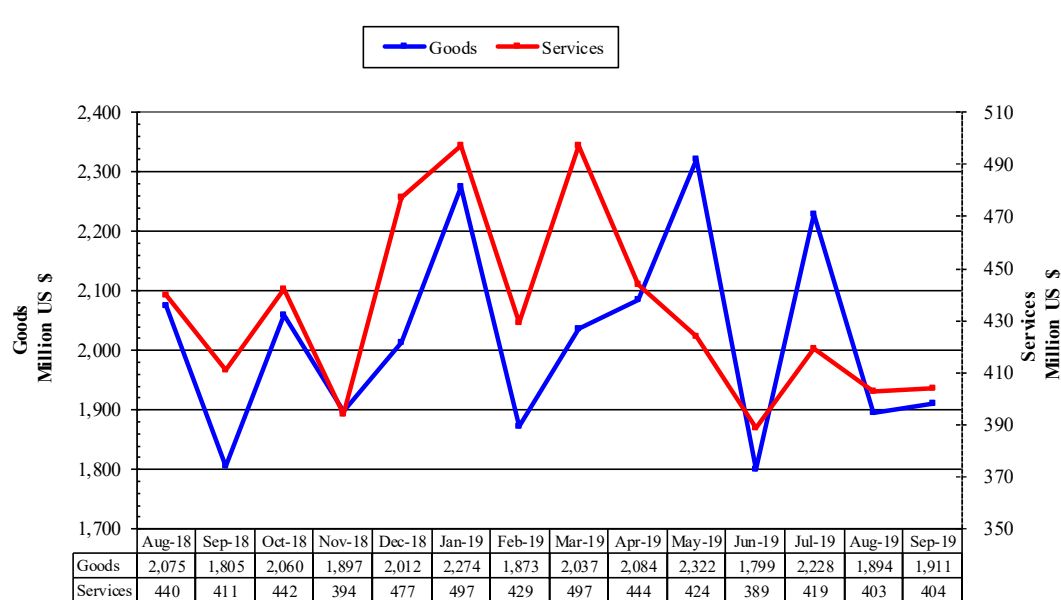
