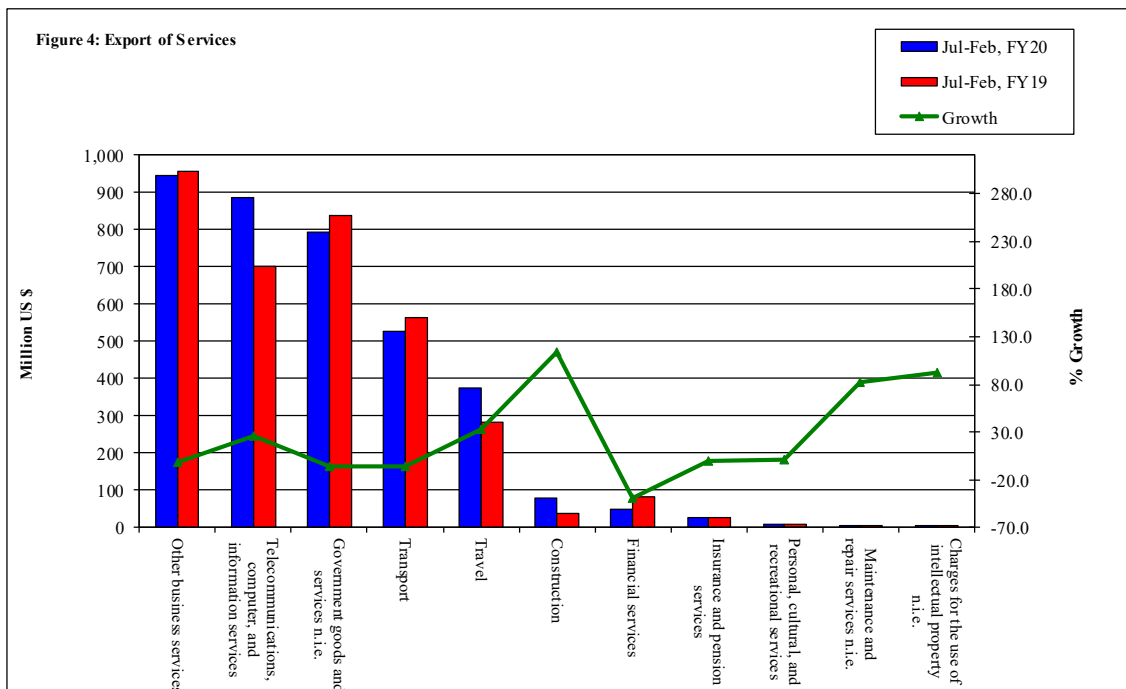

Figure 5: Percent Share of Major Countries in Export Receipts (Banks) of Goods during Jul-Feb, FY20

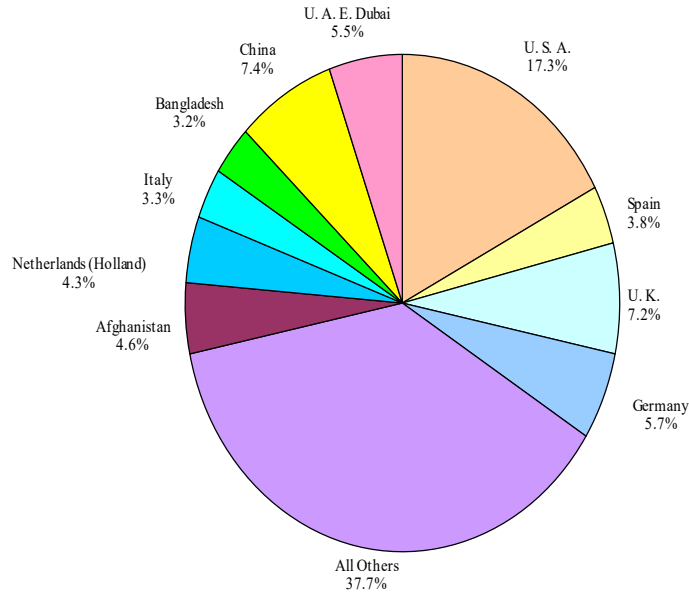
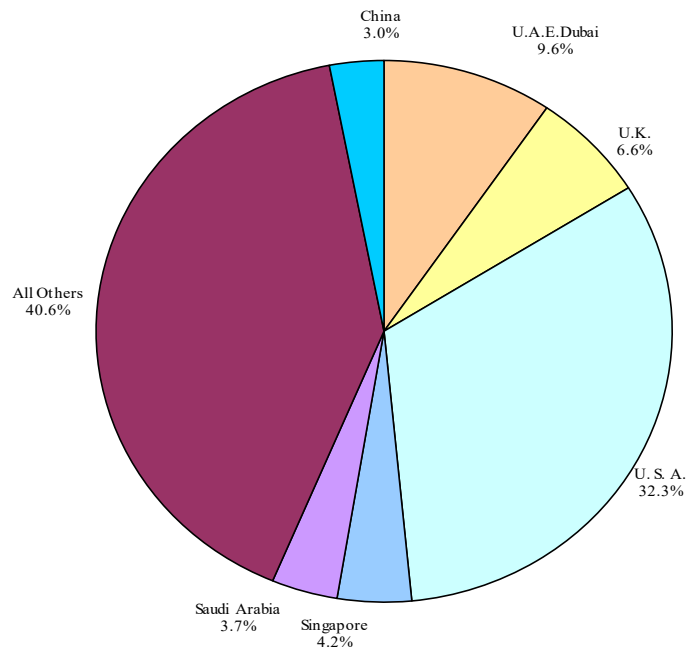


Figure 6: Percent Share of Major Countries in Export of Services during Jul-Feb, FY20



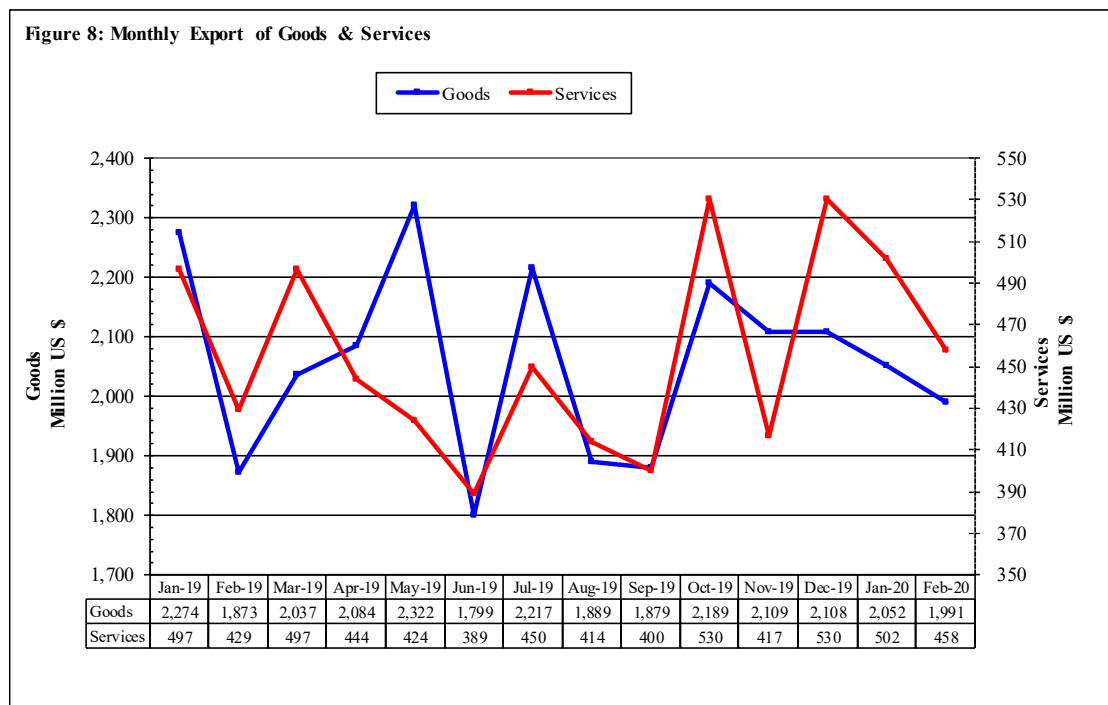
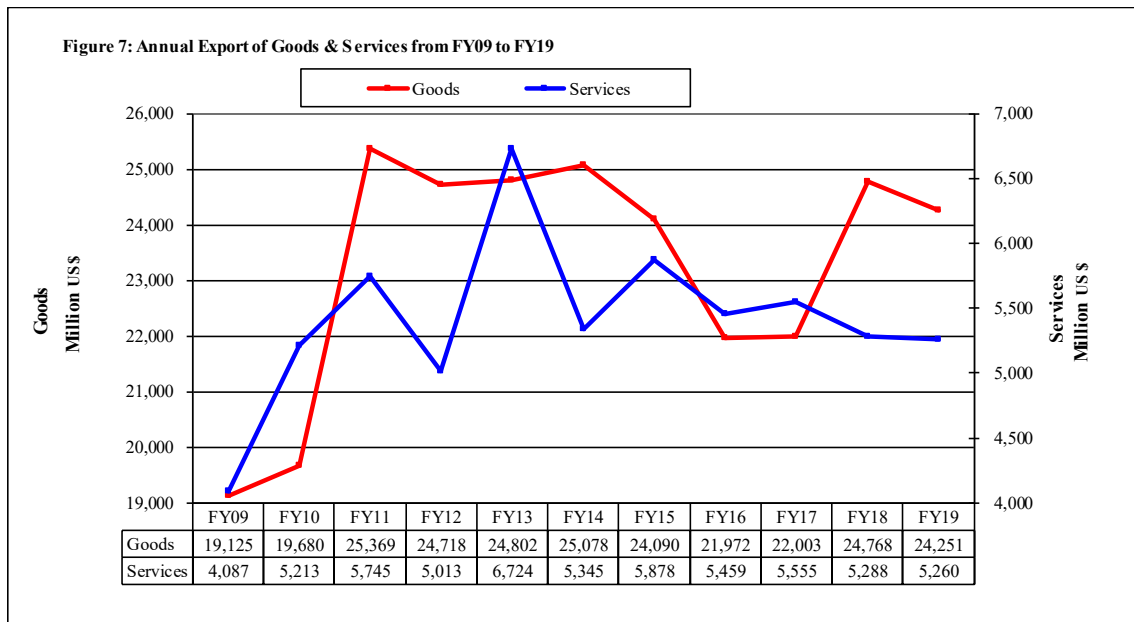
