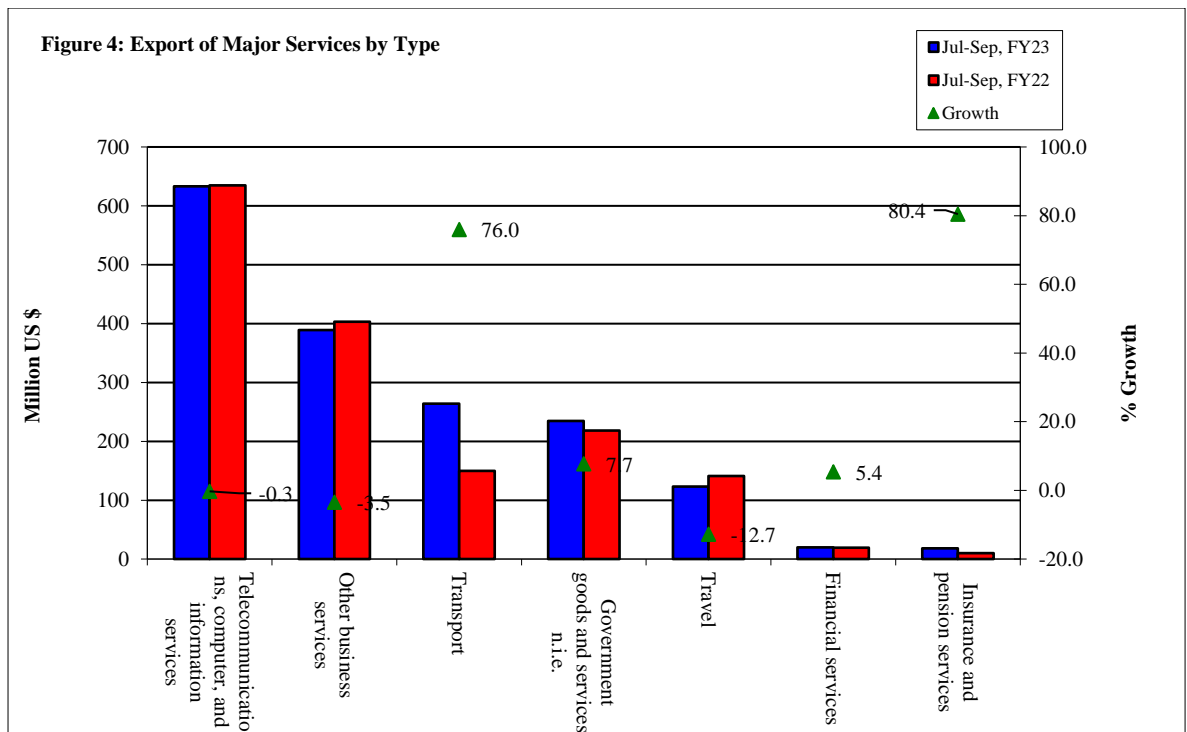

Figure 5: % Share of Major Countries in Export Receipts (Banks) of Goods during Jul-Sep, FY23

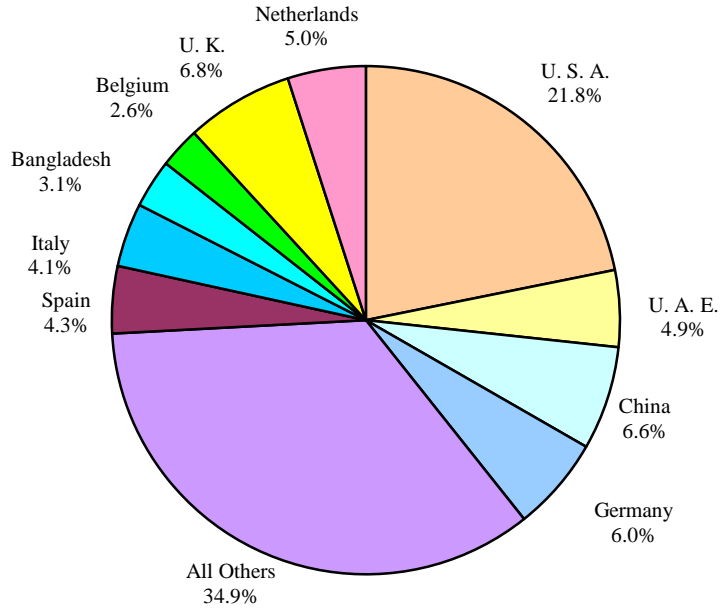
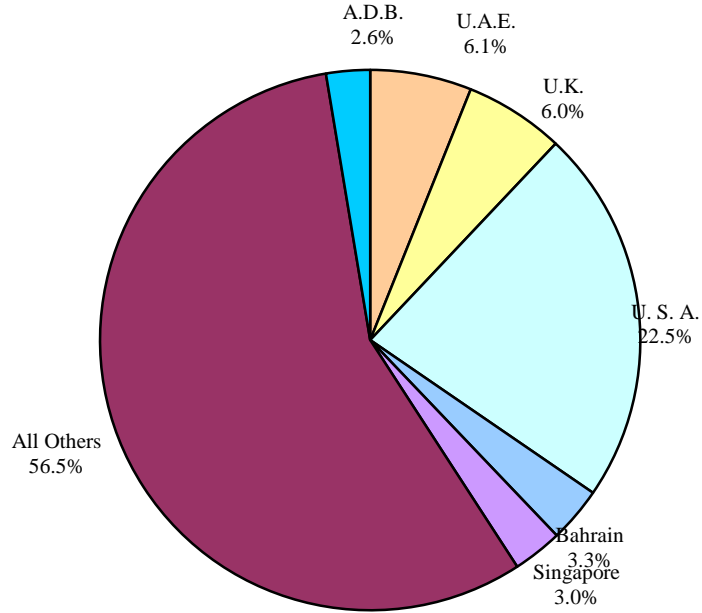


Figure 6: % Share of Major Countries in Export of Services during Jul-Sep, FY23



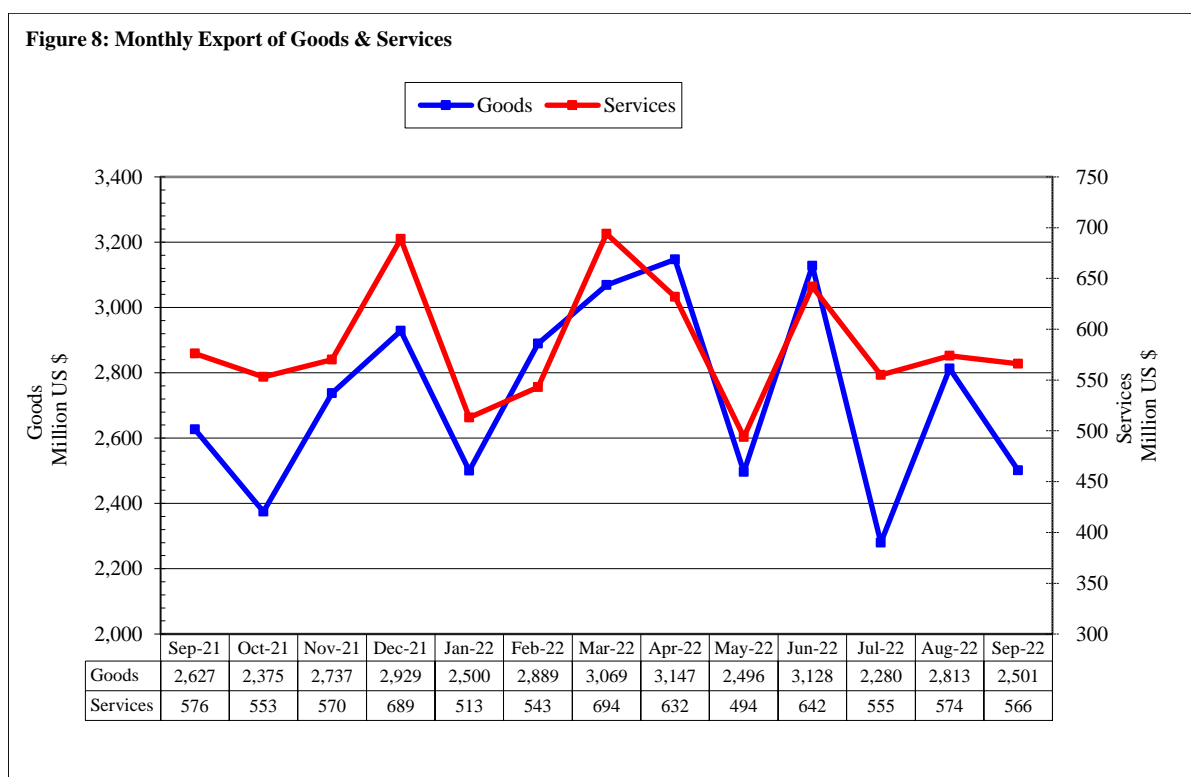
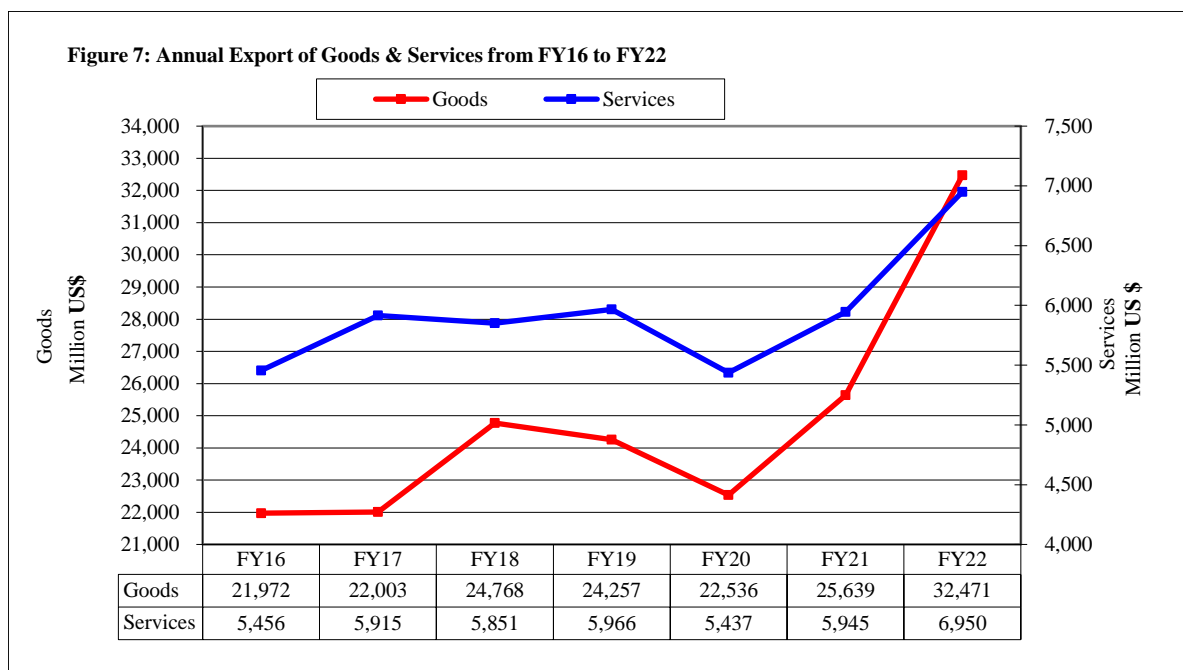
