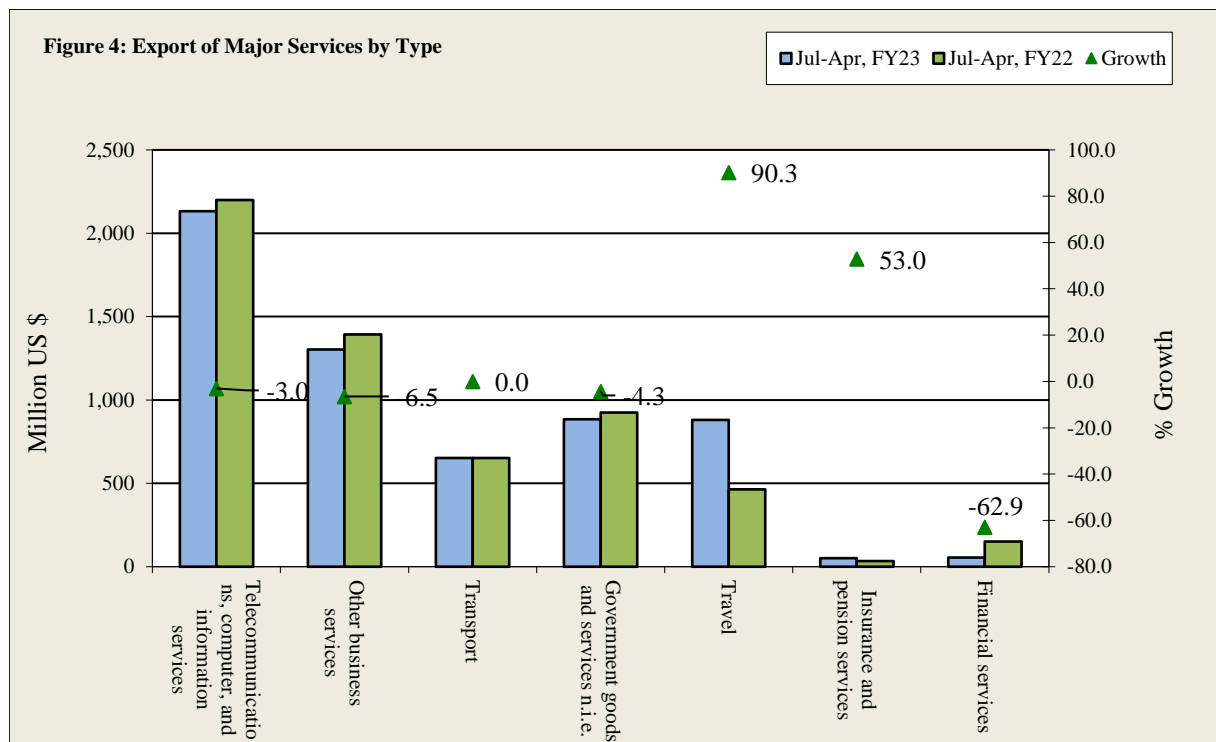
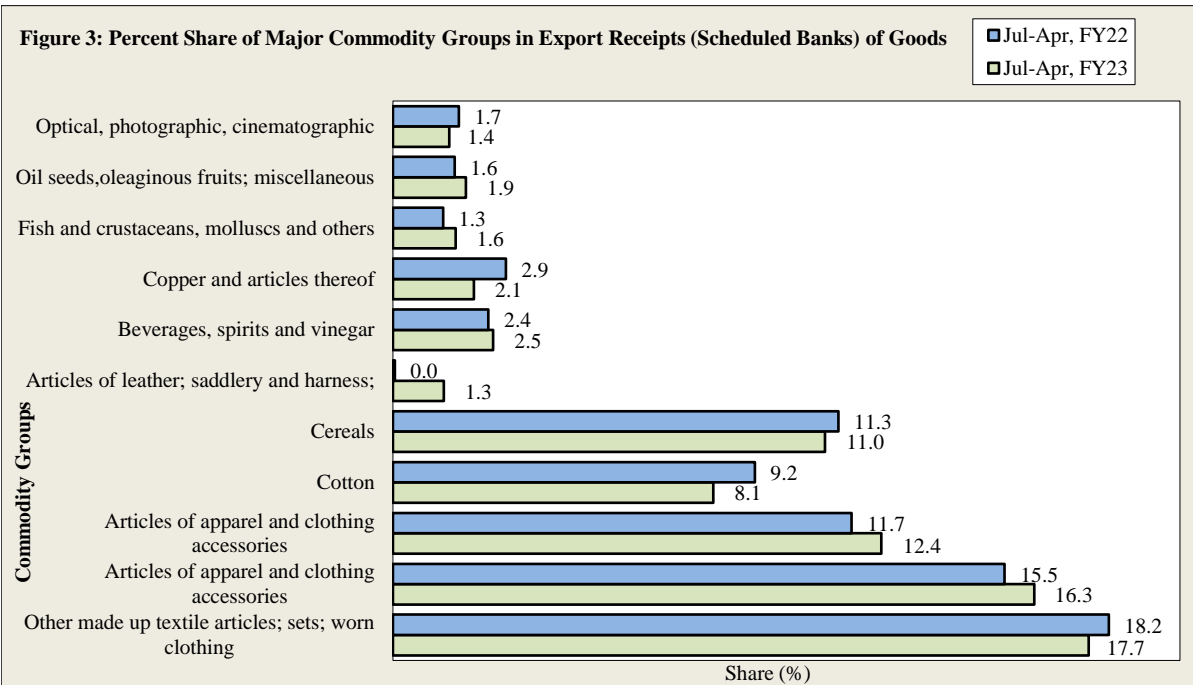

Figure 5: % Share of Major Countries in Export Receipts of Goods during Jul-Apr, FY23

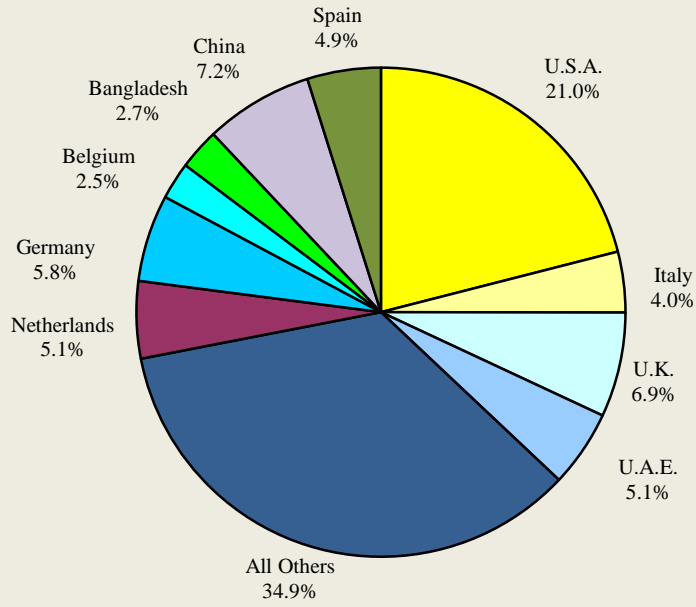
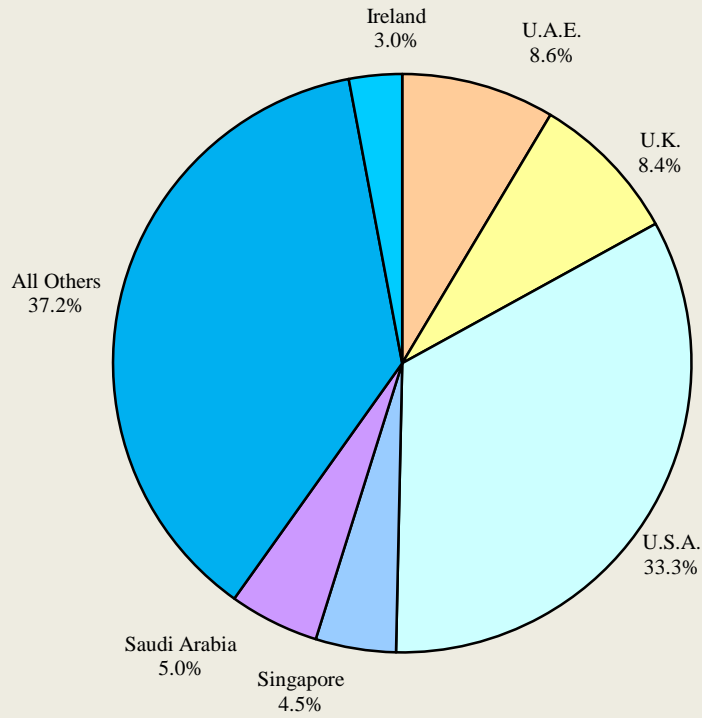


Figure 6: % Share of Major Countries in Export of Services during Jul-Apr, FY23



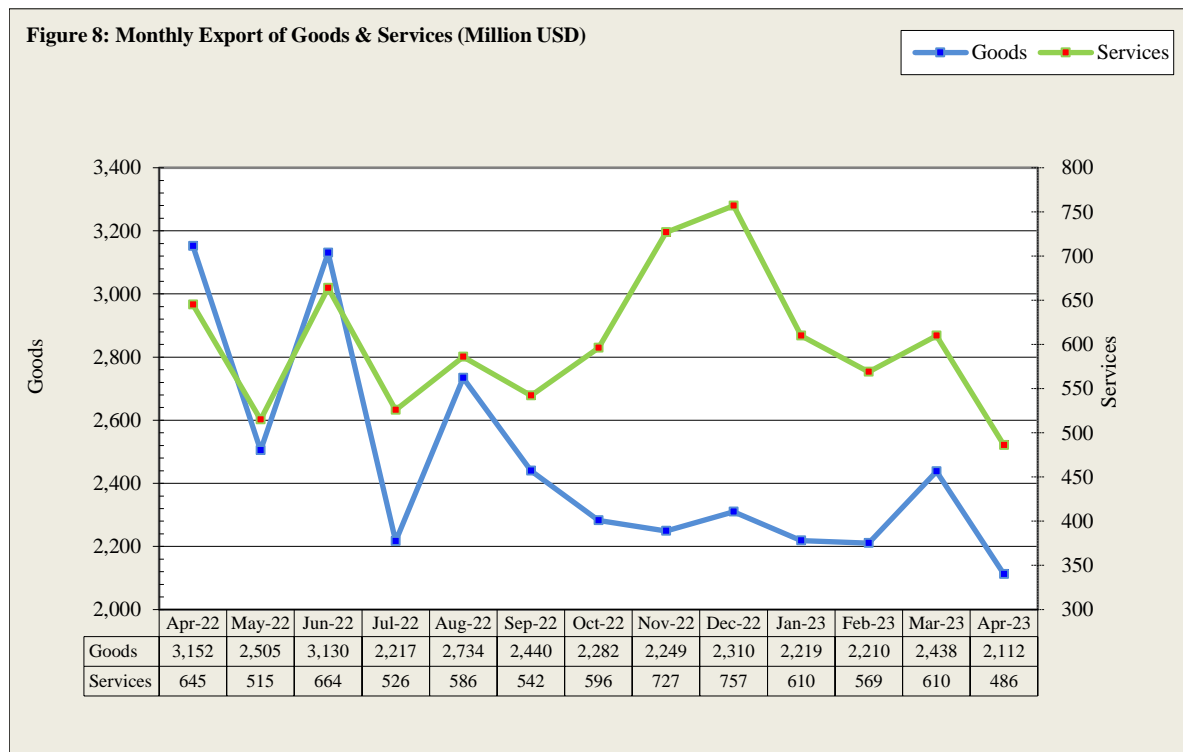
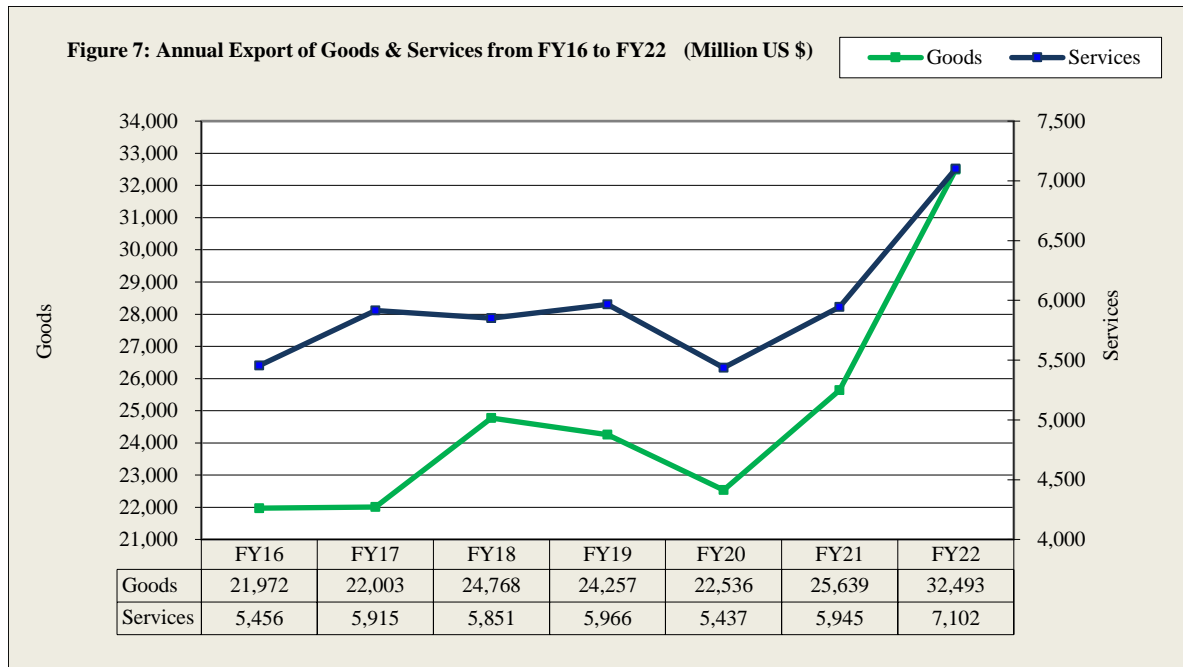
