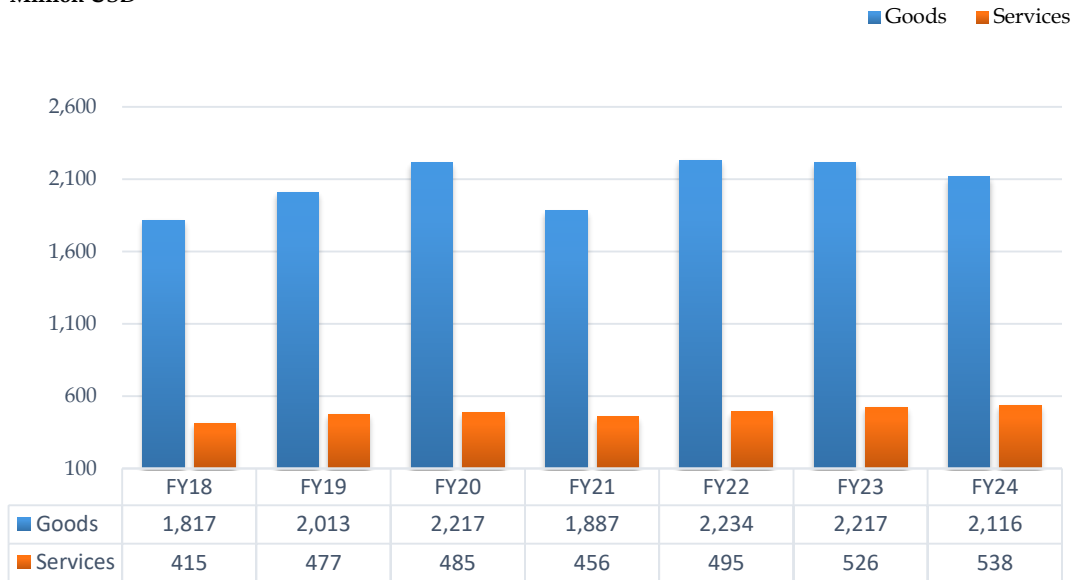

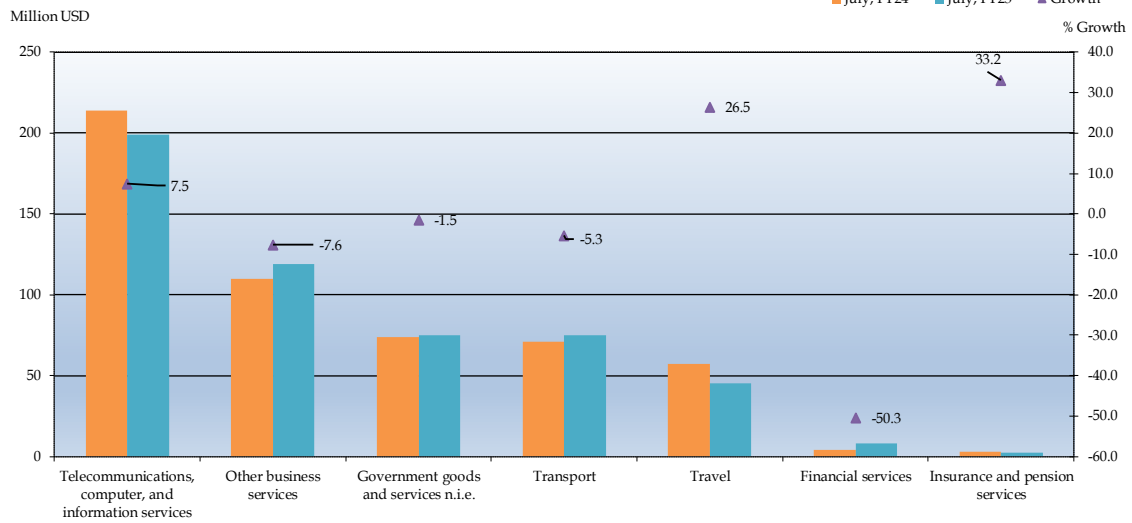
Percent Share of Major Commodity Groups in Export Receipts (Banks) of Goods

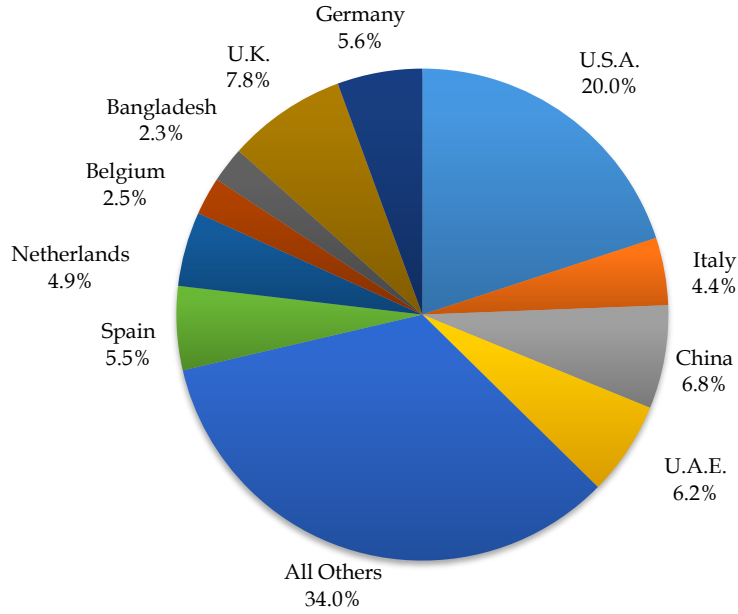

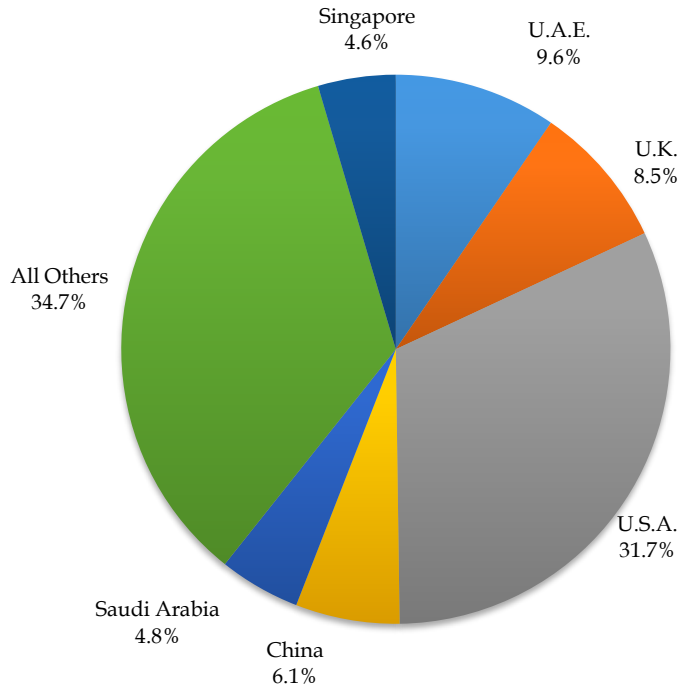
Percent share of Major Countries in Export Receipts (Banks) of Goods during July, FY24

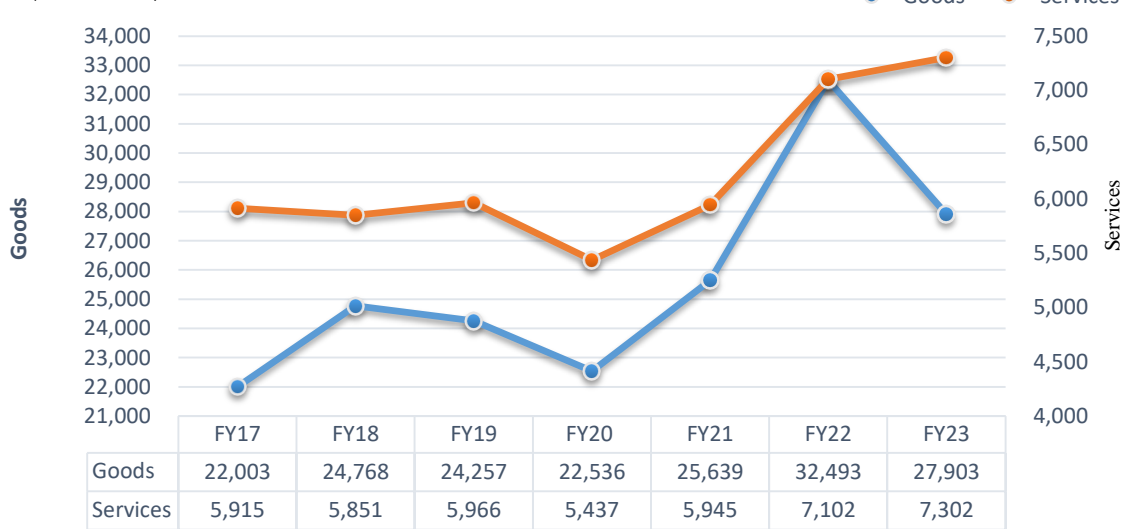


Percent Share of Major Countries in Export of Services during July, FY24

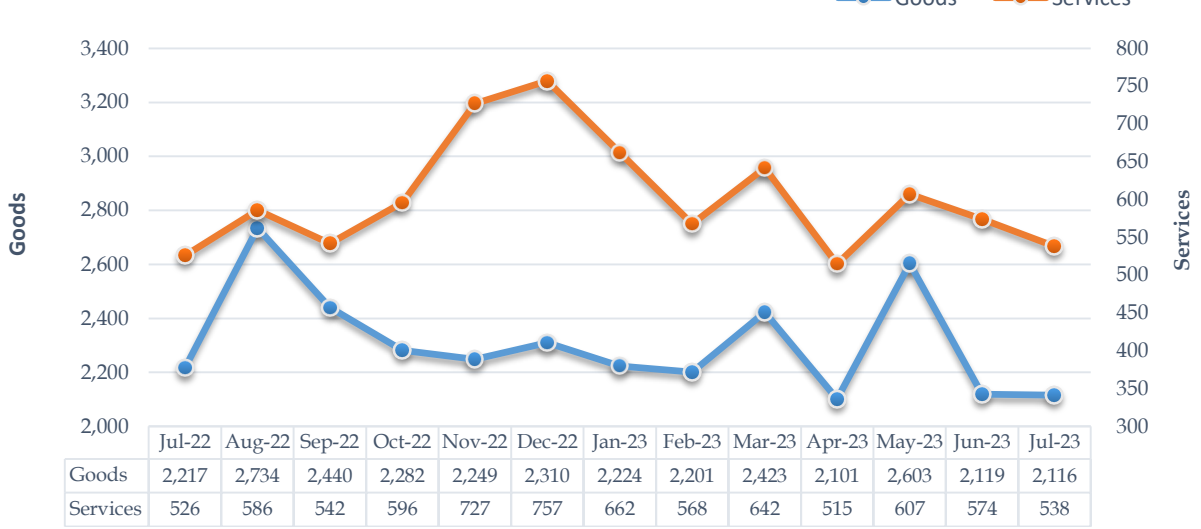
