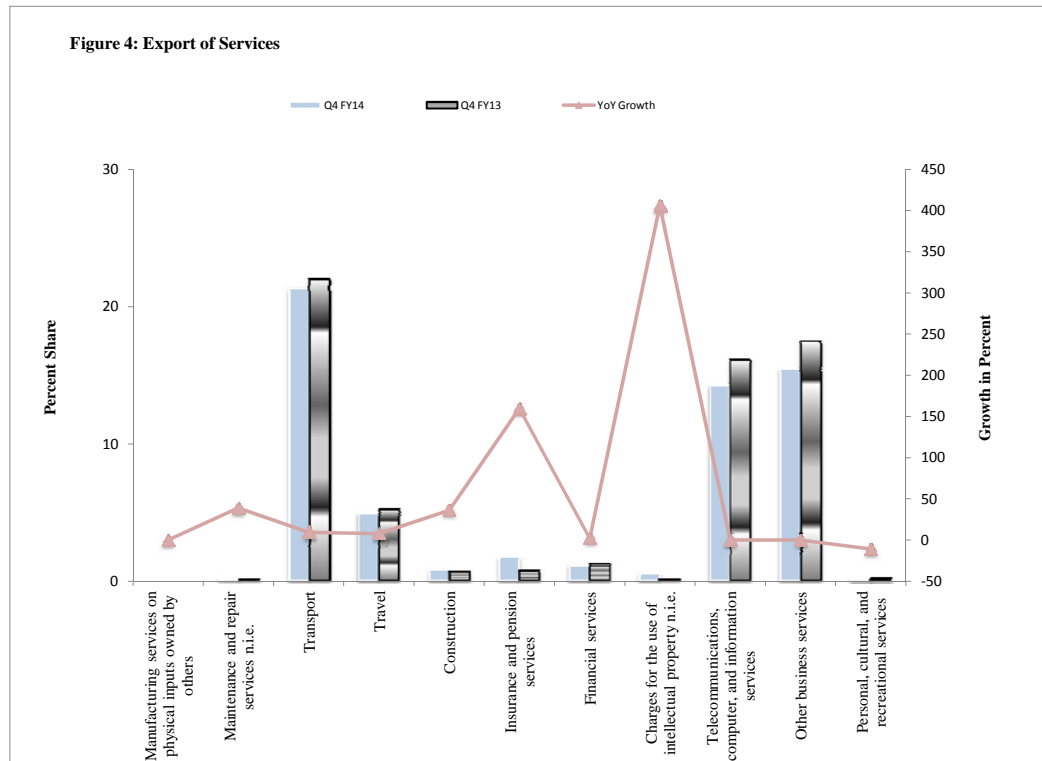
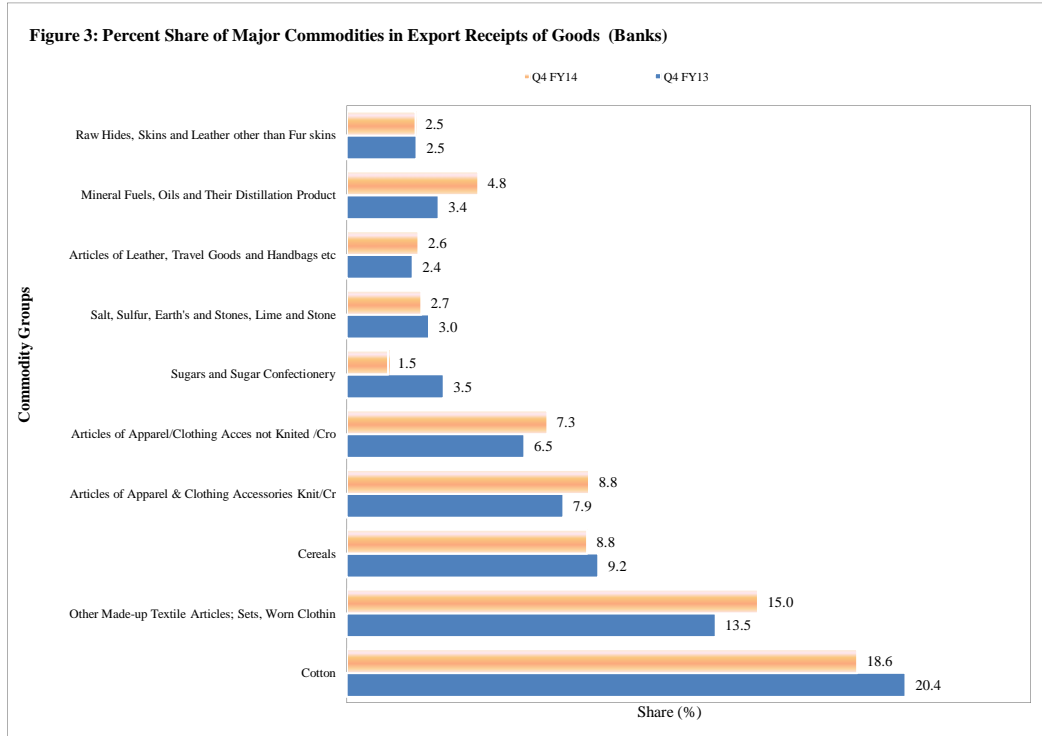

Figure 5: Percent Share of Major Countries in Export Receipts of Goods (Banks)

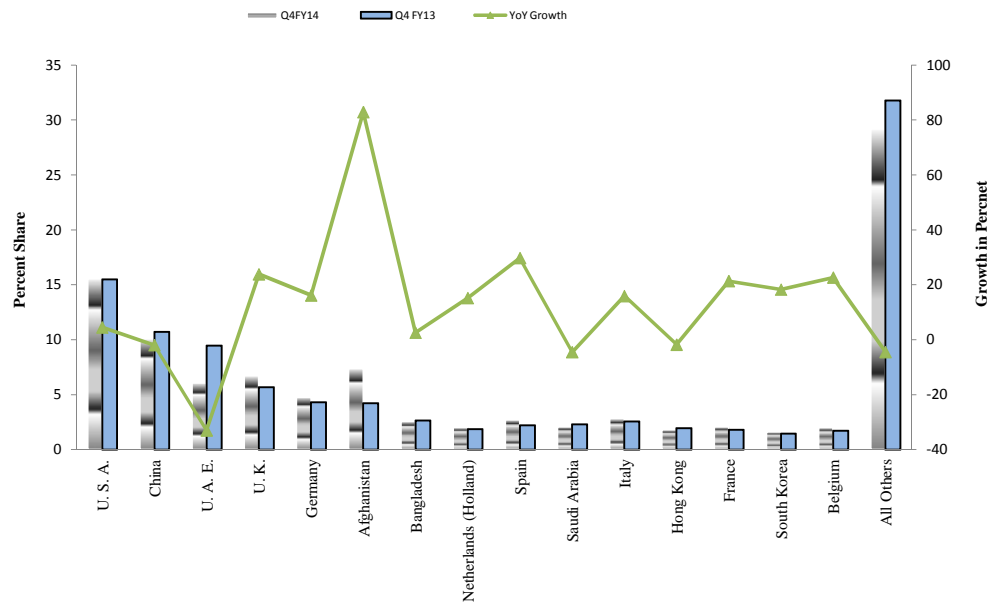
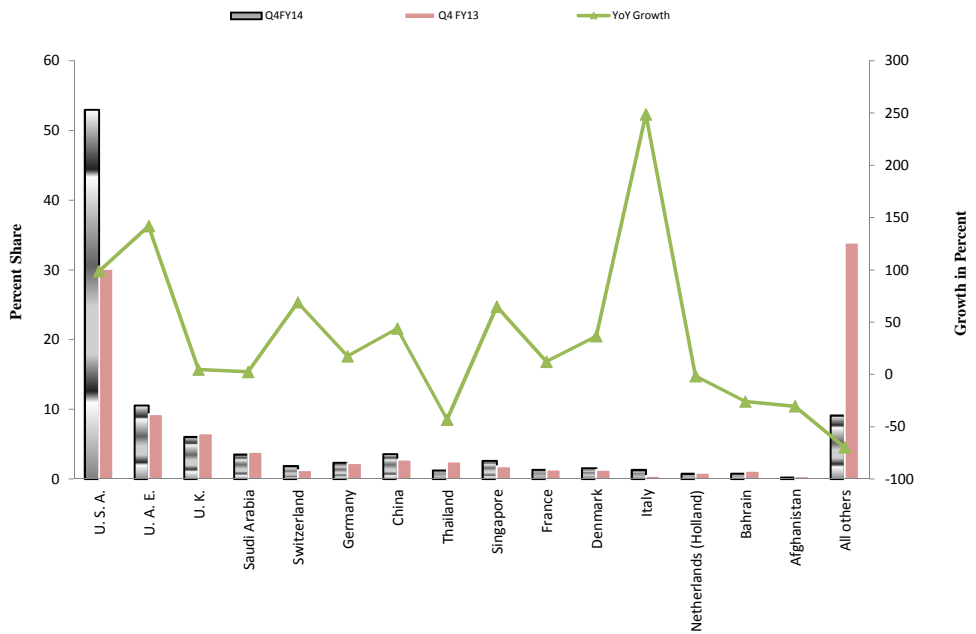


Figure 6: Percent Share of Major Countries in Export of Services



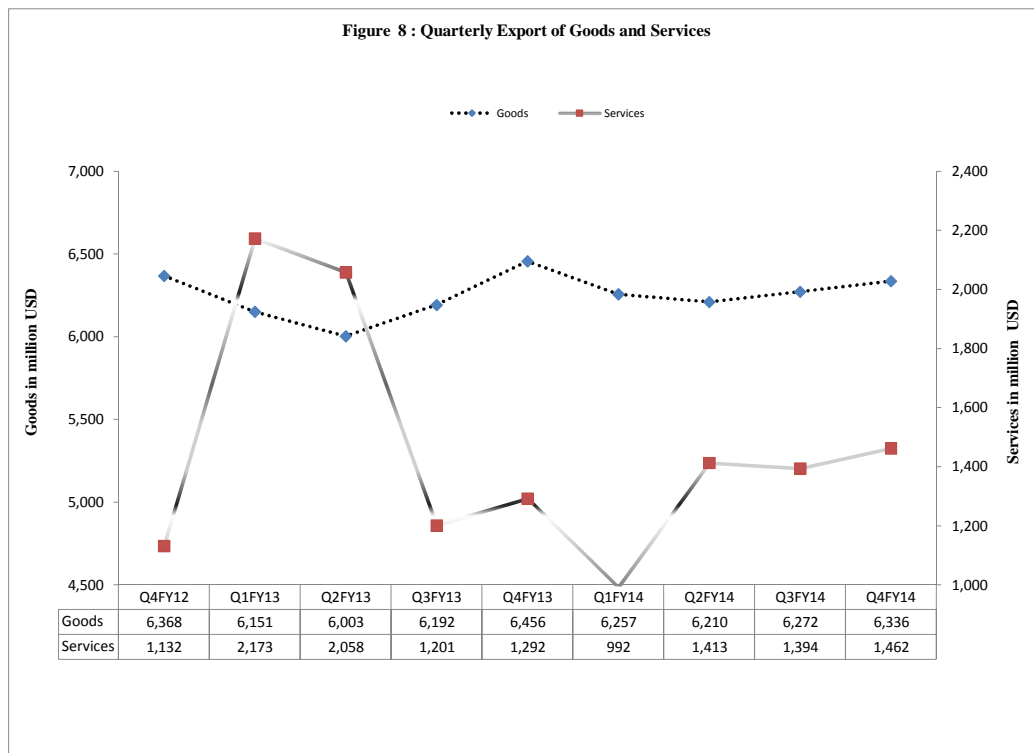
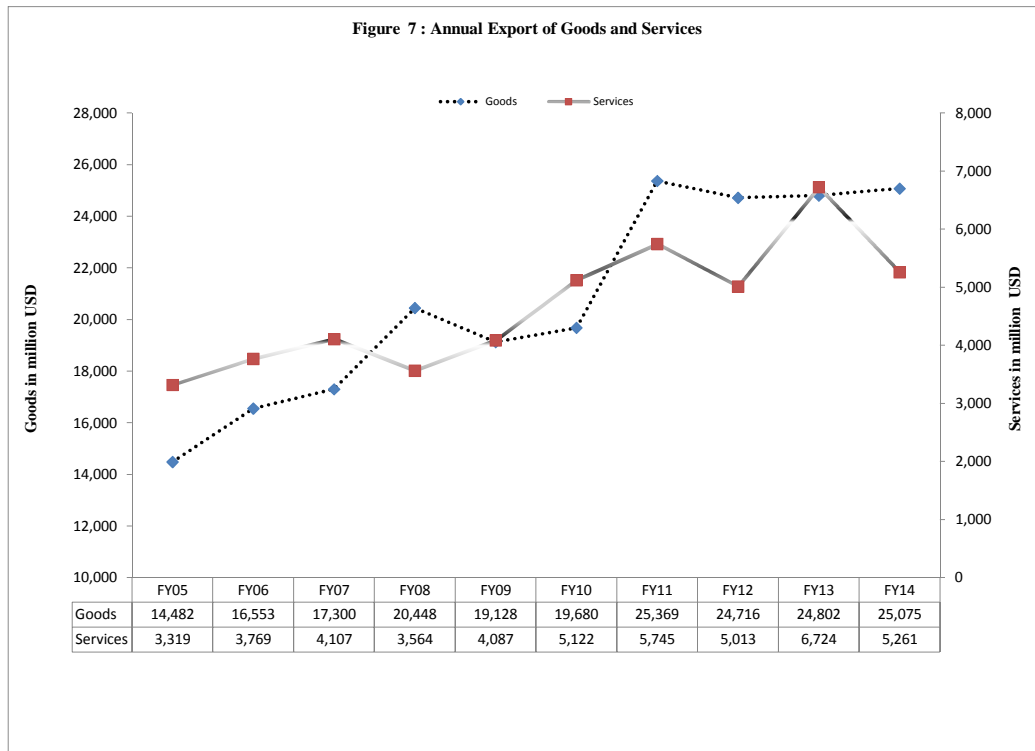
