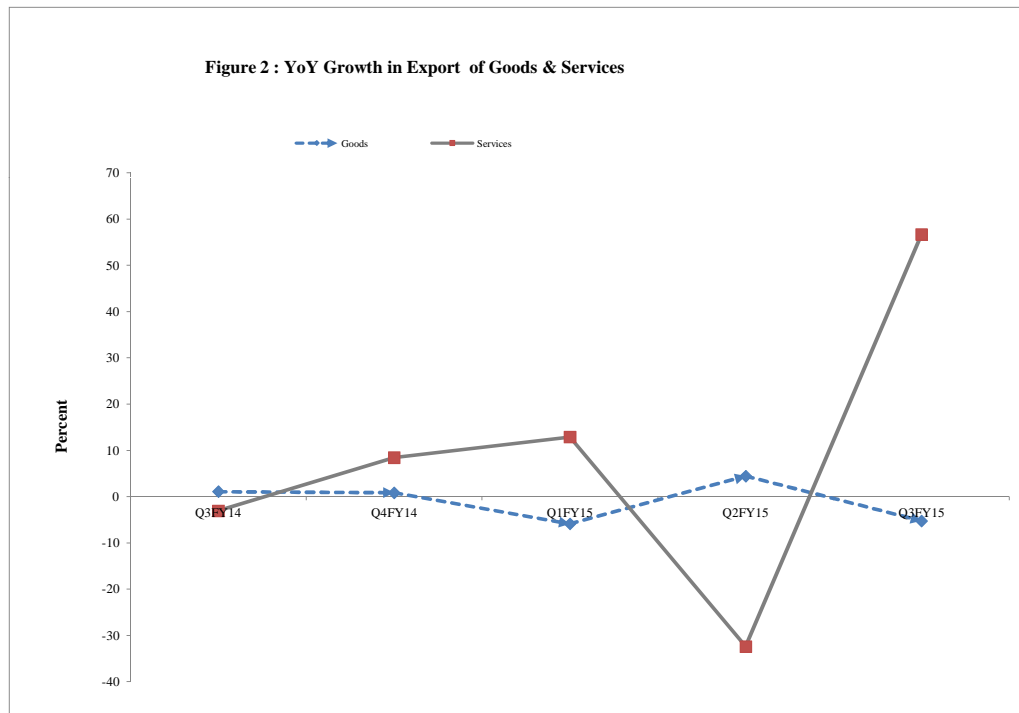
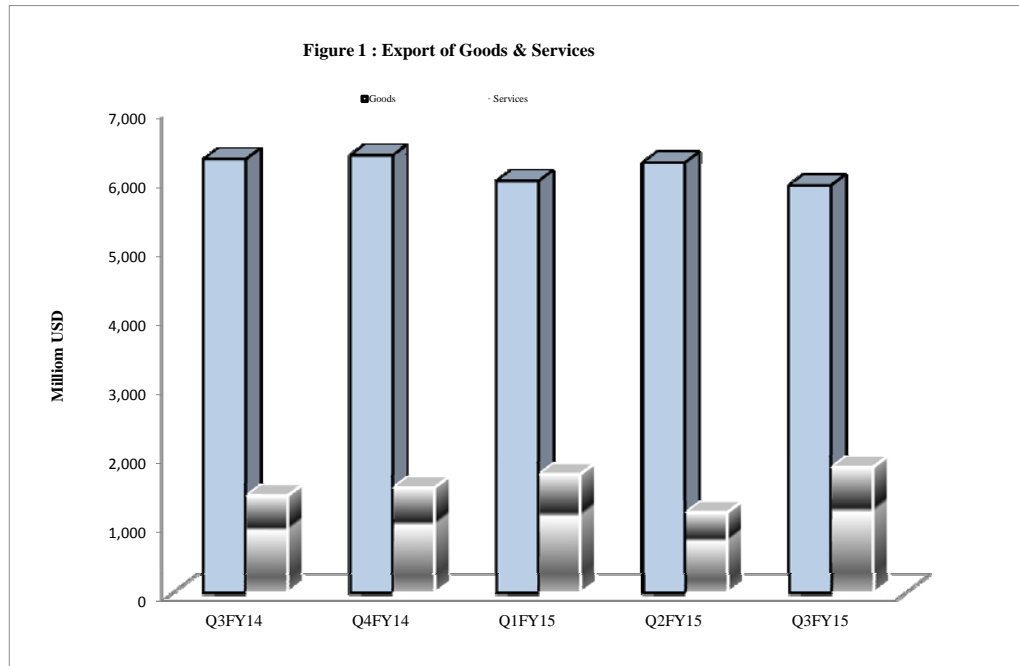

Figure 3: Percent Share of Major Commodities in Exports Receipts of Goods (Banks)

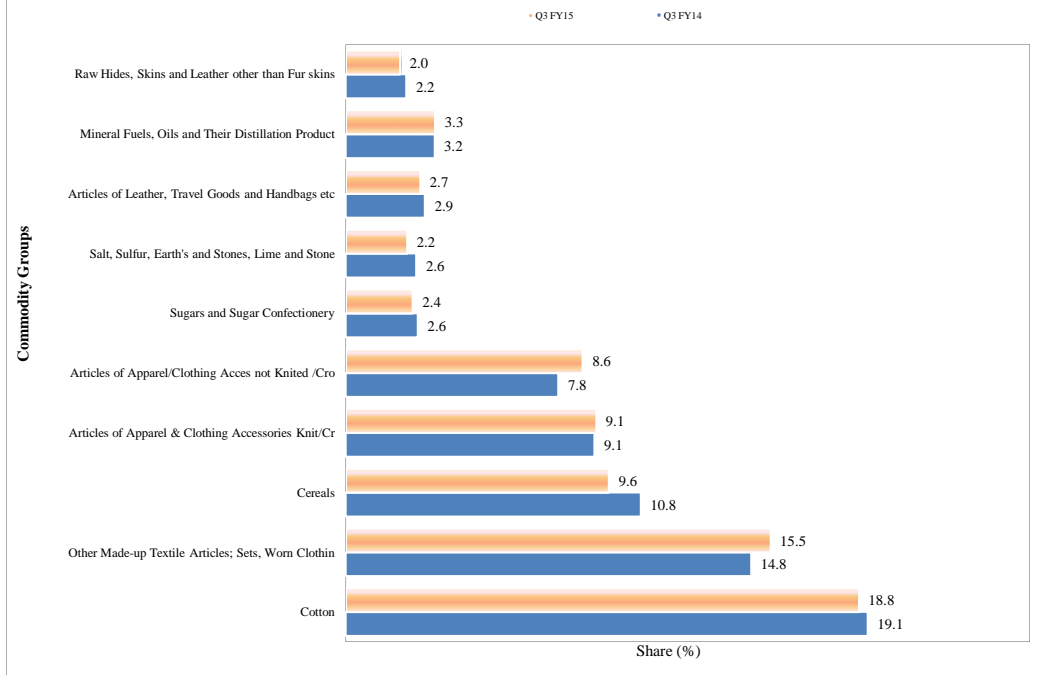


Figure 4: Exports of Services

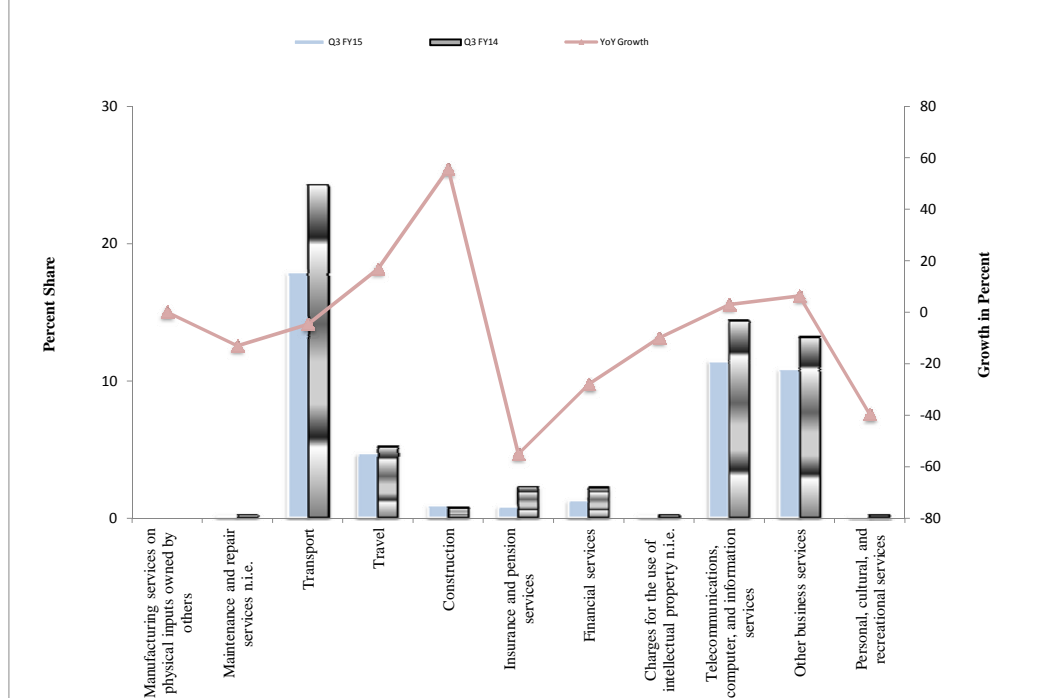

Figure 5: Percent Share of Major Countries in Exports Receipts of Goods (Banks)

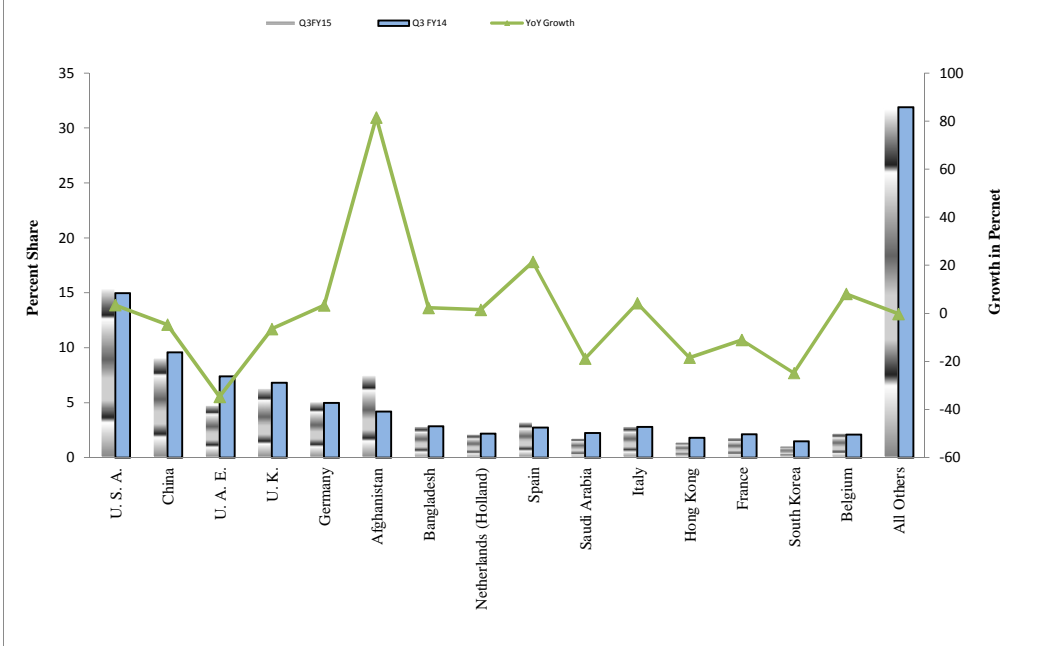
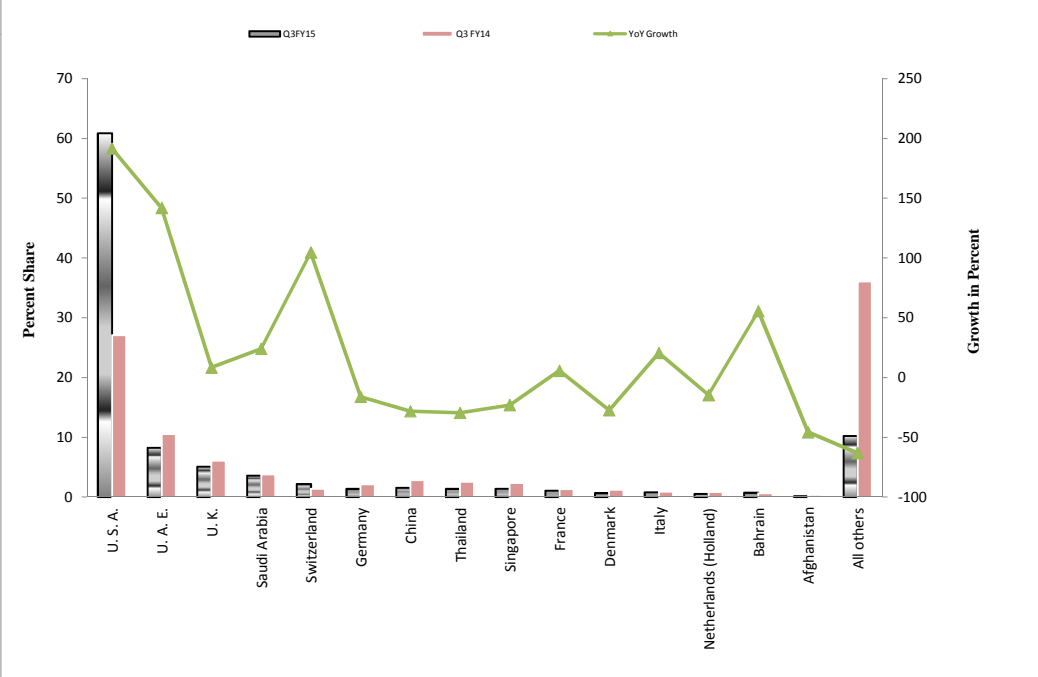


Figure 6: Percent Share of Major Countries in Exports of Services



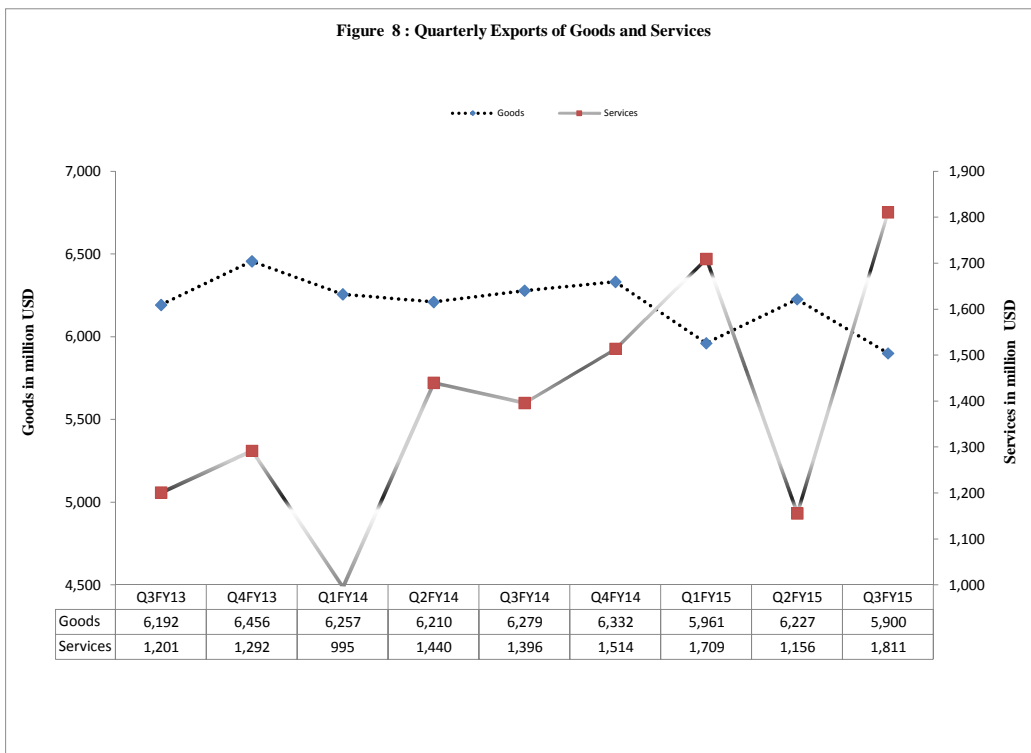
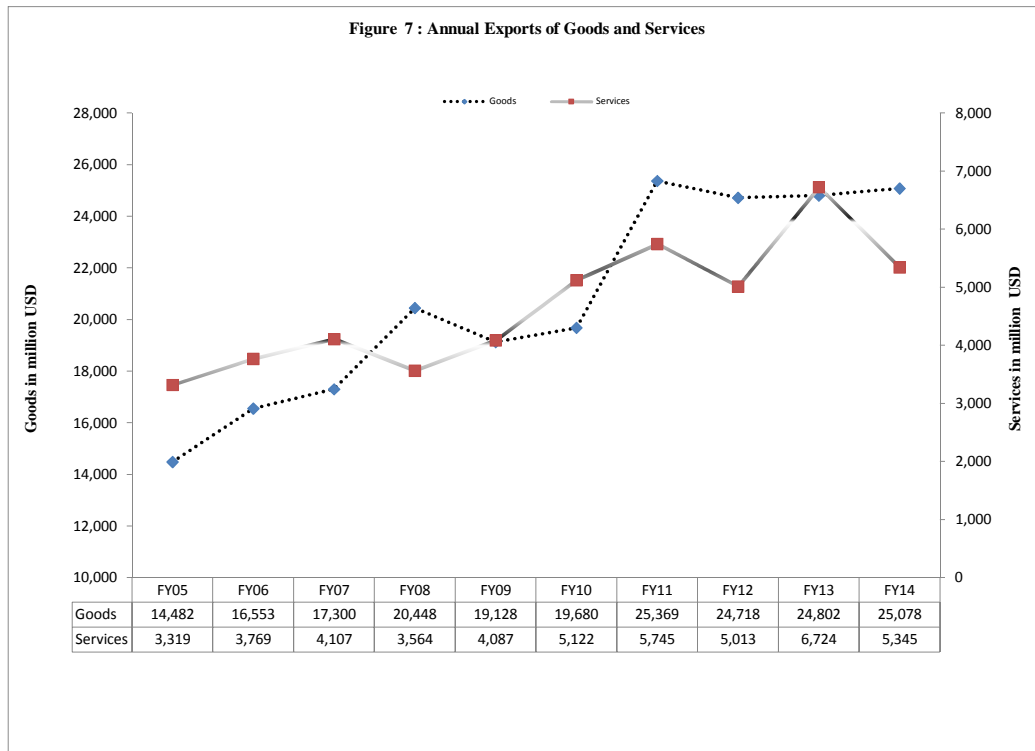
