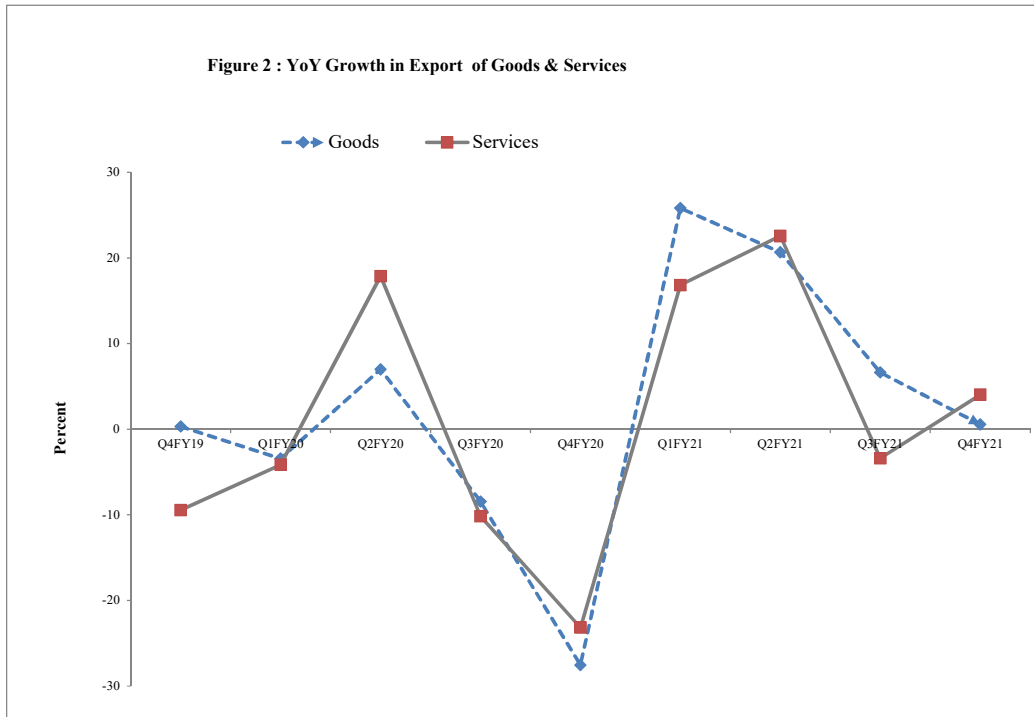
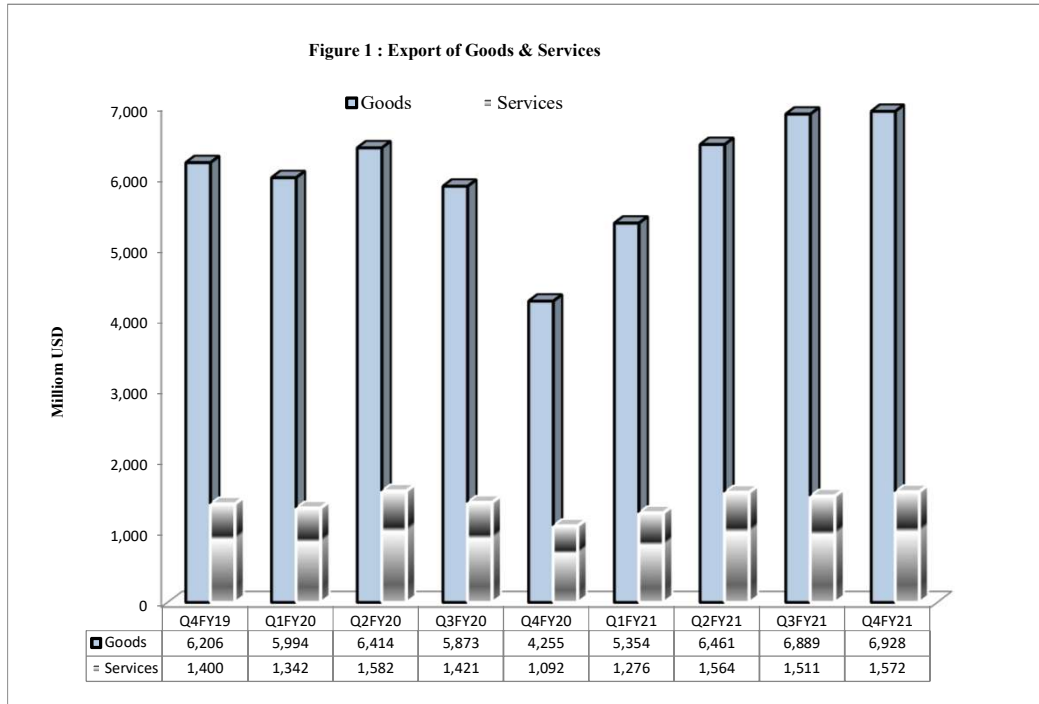

Figure 3: Percent Share of Major Commodities in Export Receipts of Goods (Banks)

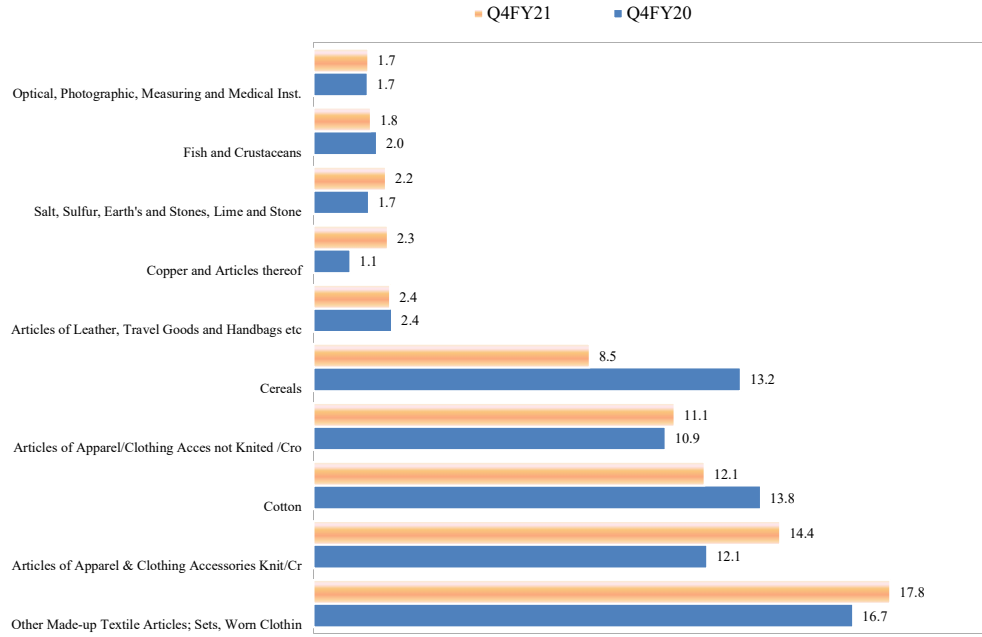


Figure 4: Export of Services (By Type)

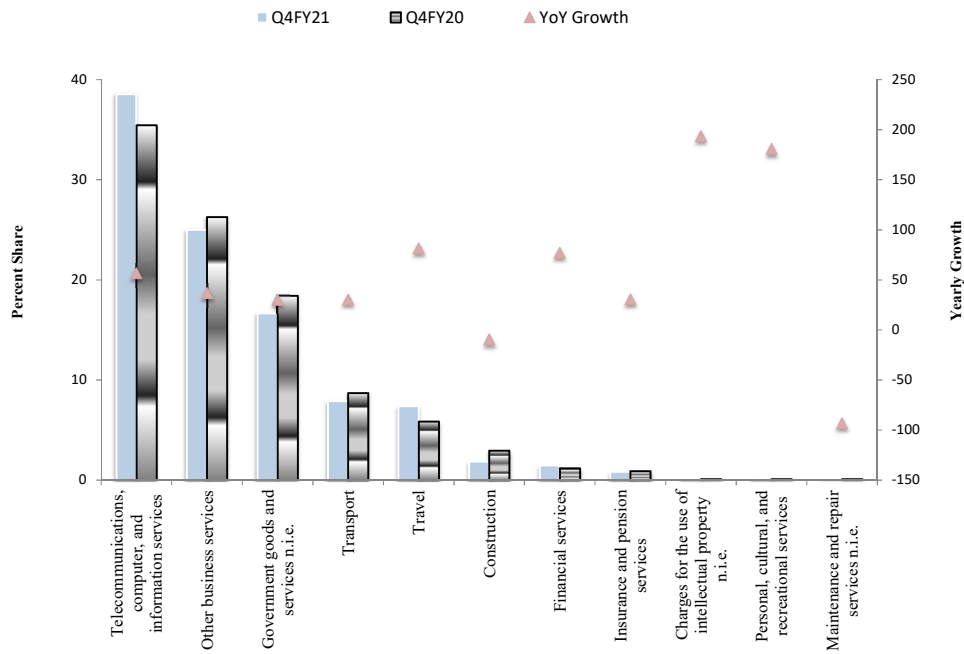
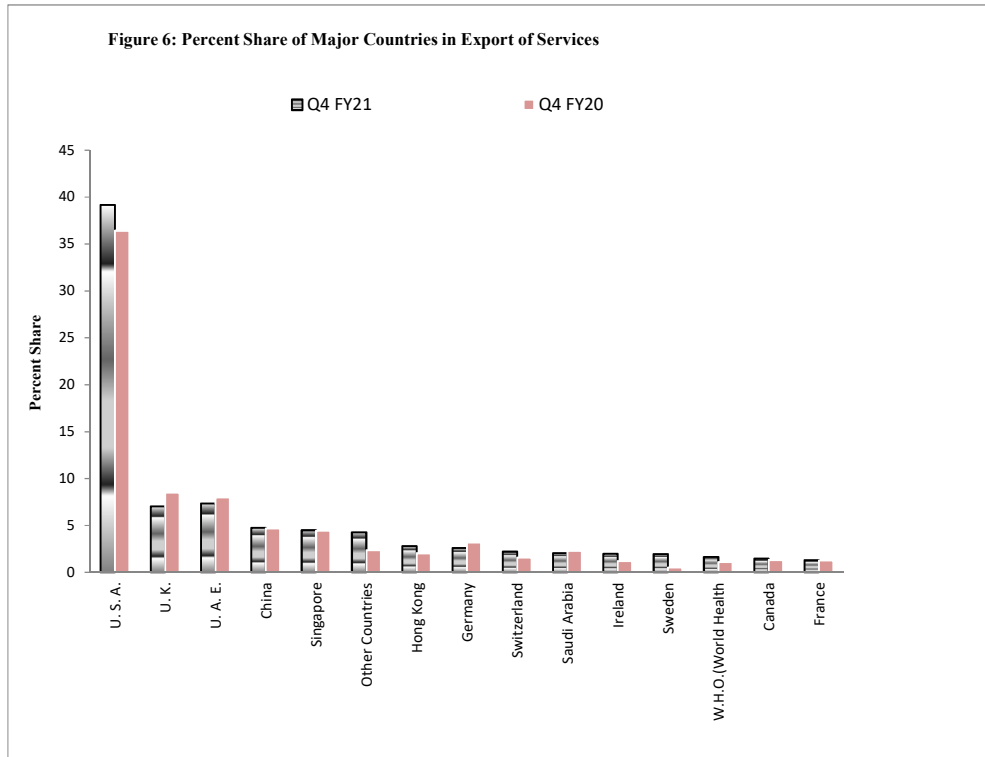
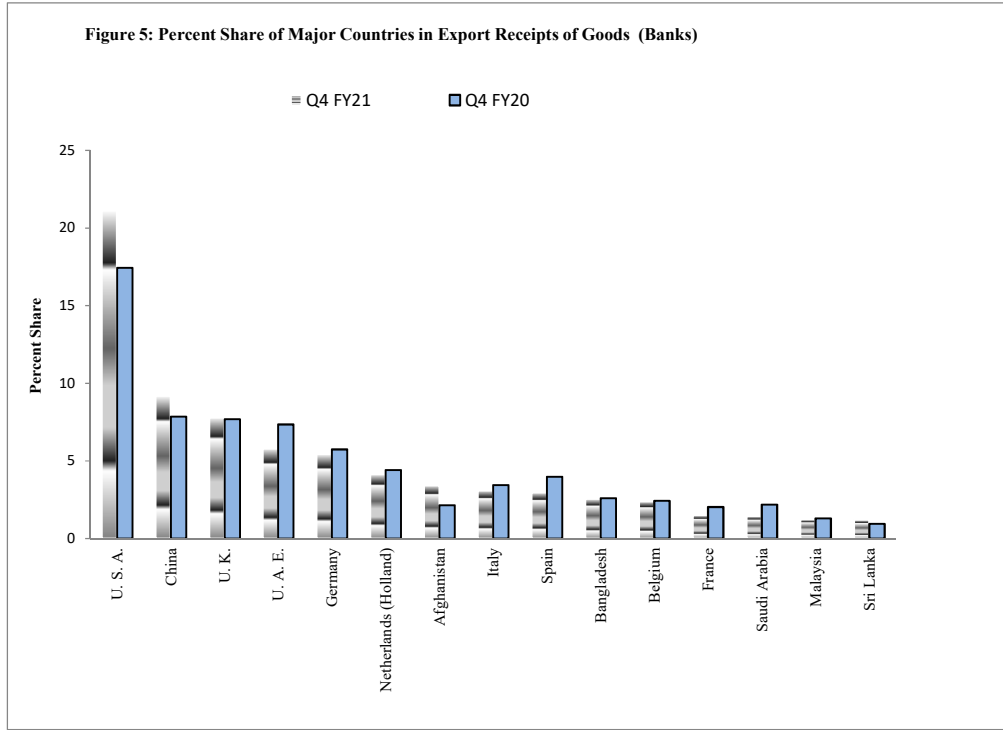

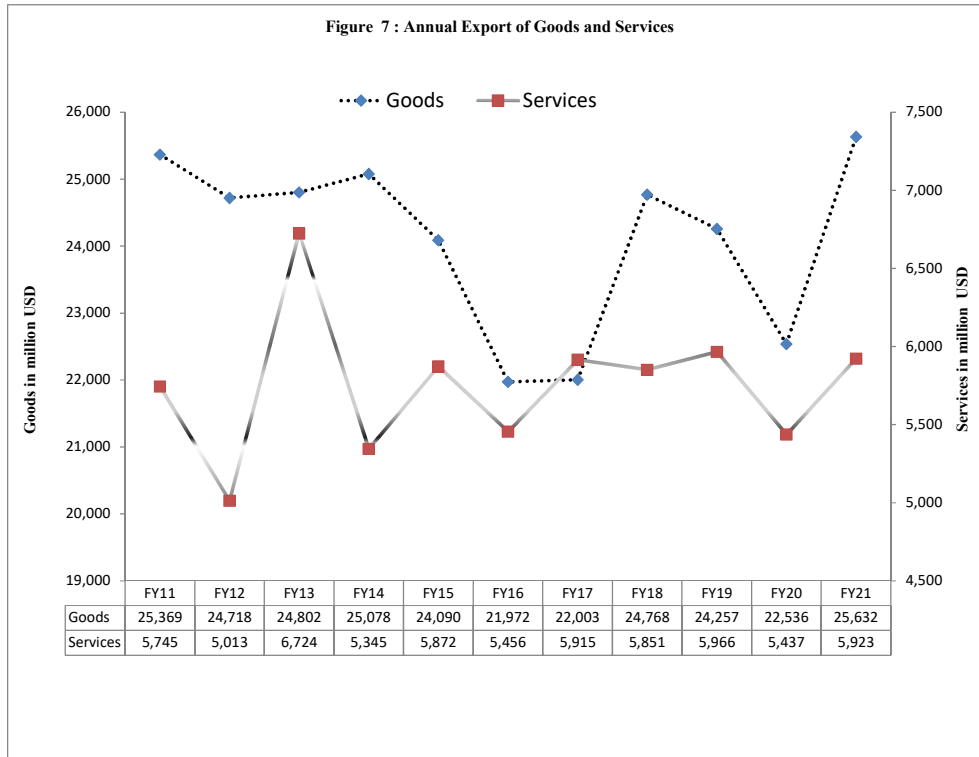
