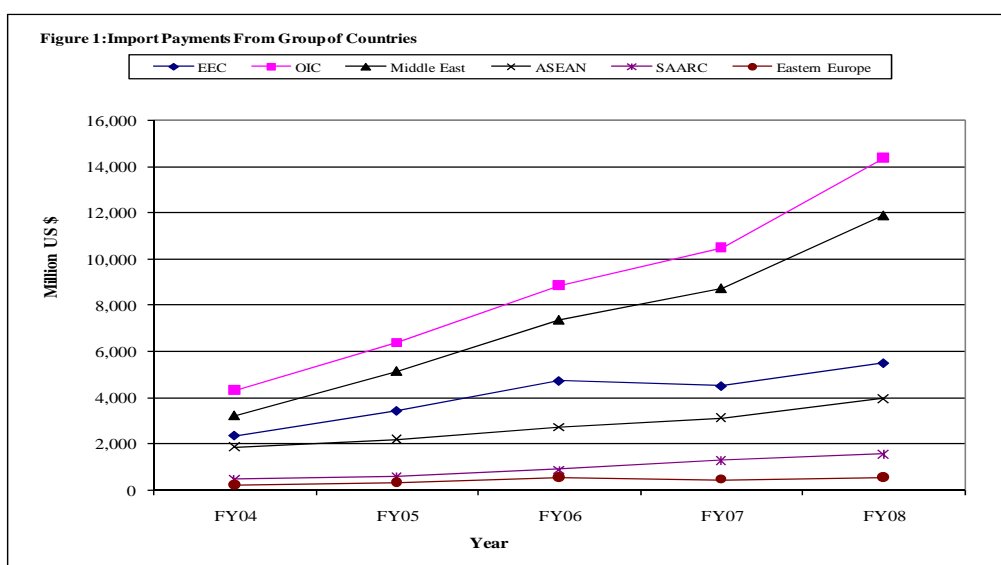

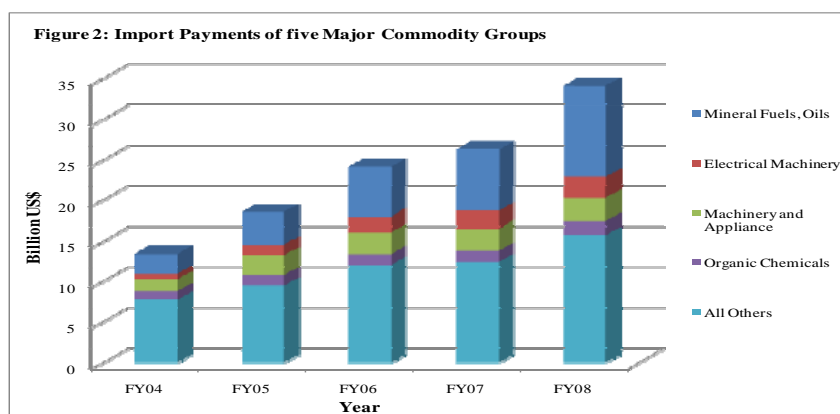

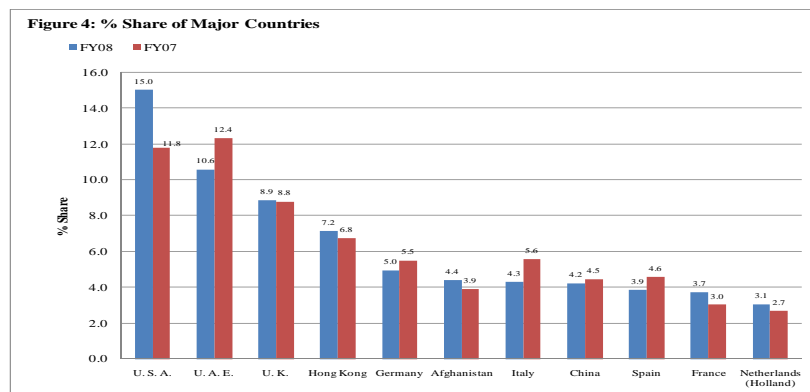


Figure 3: % Share of Major Commodities

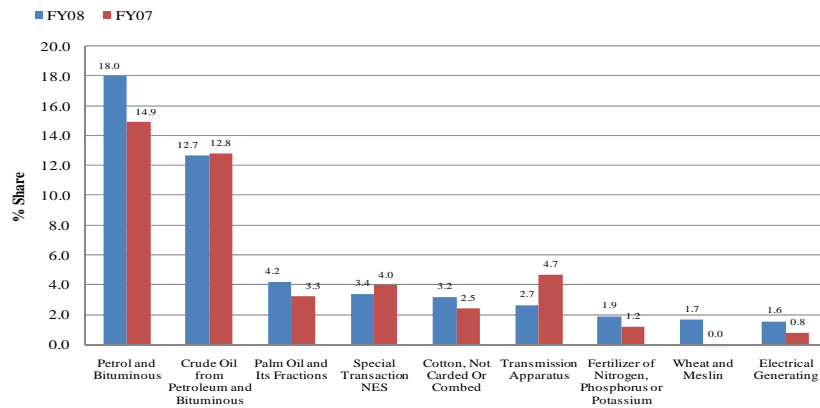


Figure 5: Year-wise Imports

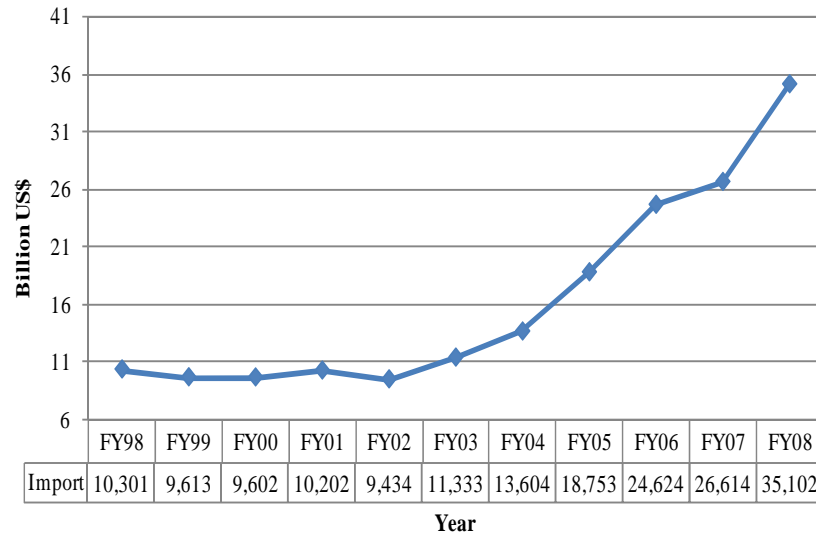
