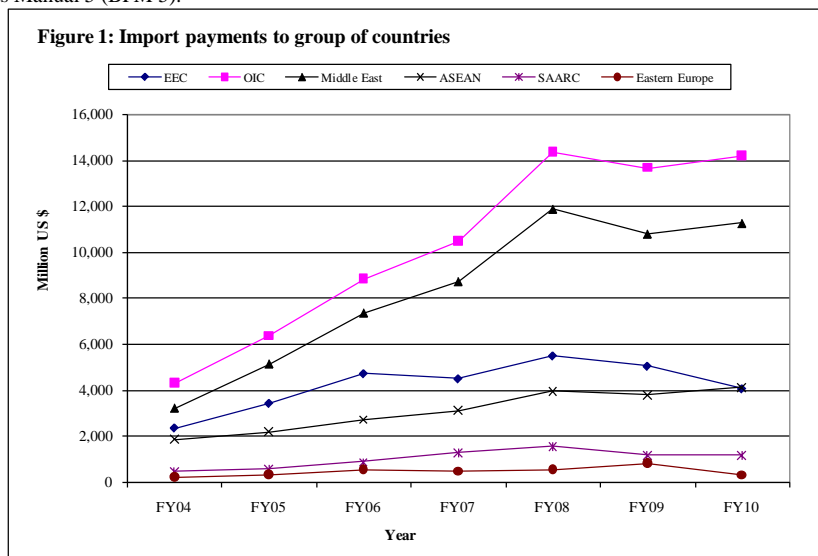

Figure 2: % Share of major commodities in import payments

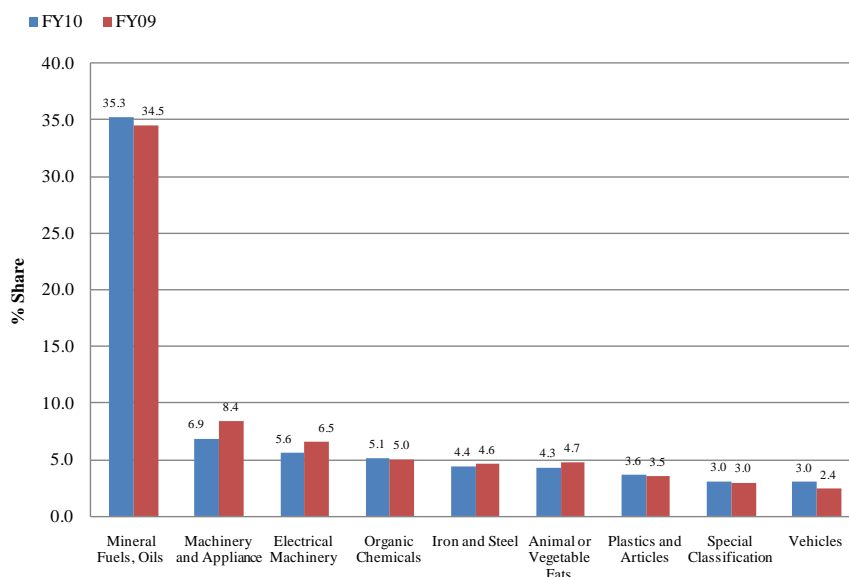

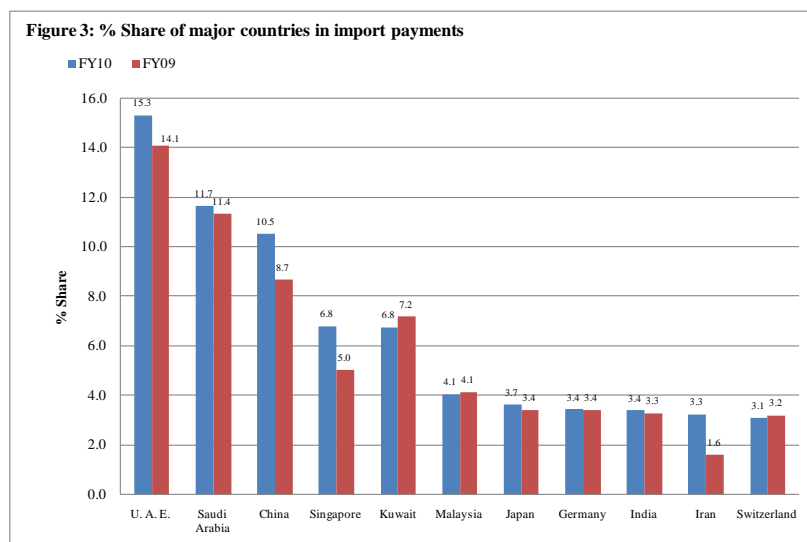
