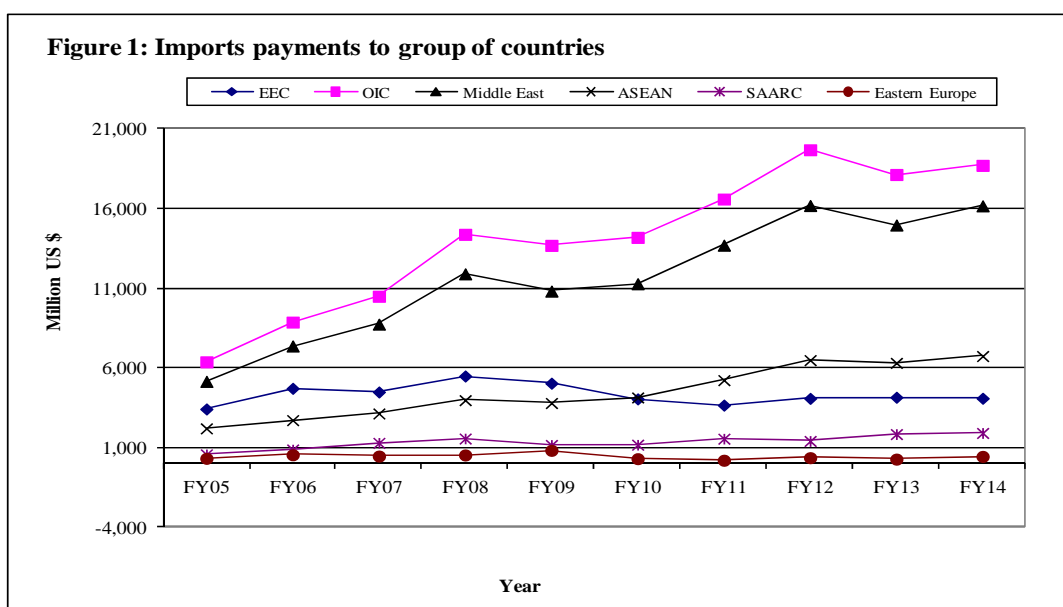

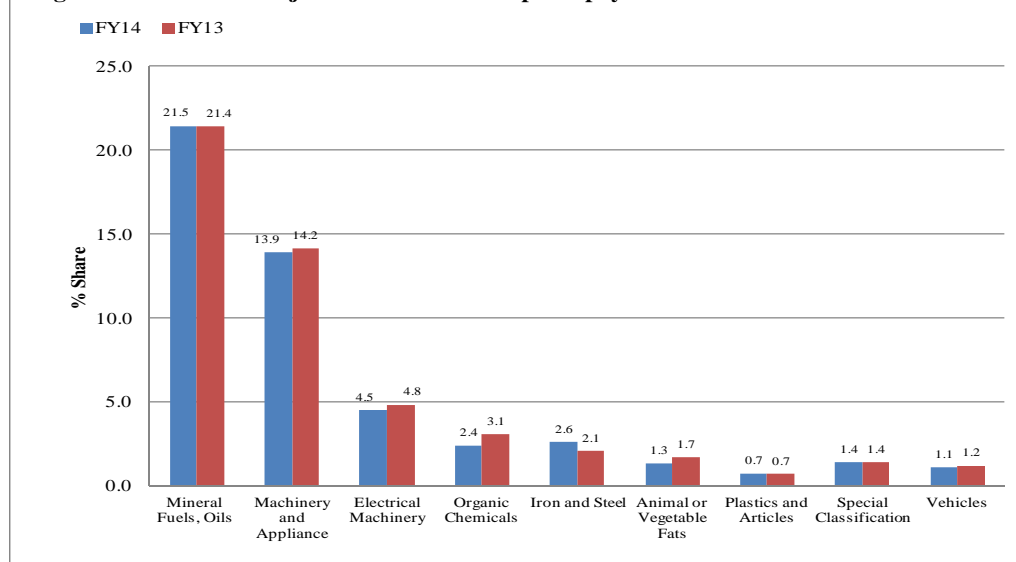
Figure 2: % Share of major commodities in imports payments

Figure 3: % Share of major countries in imports payments

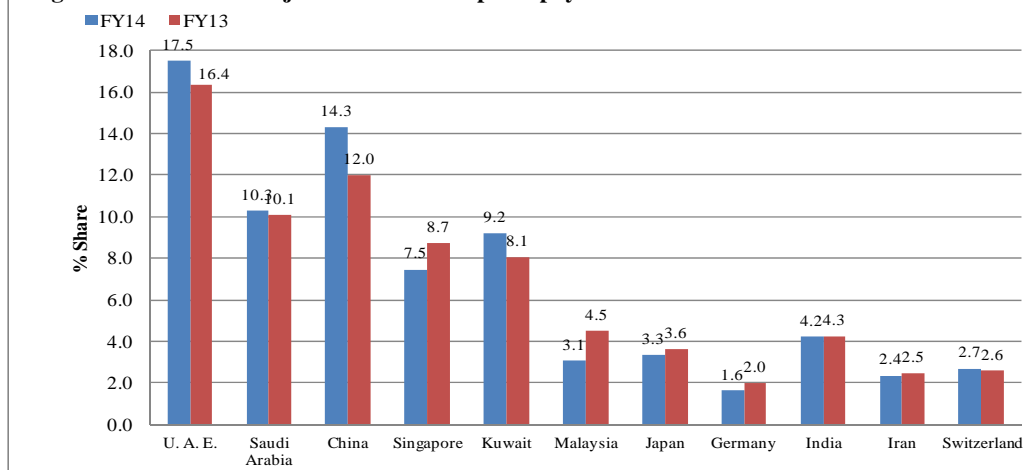

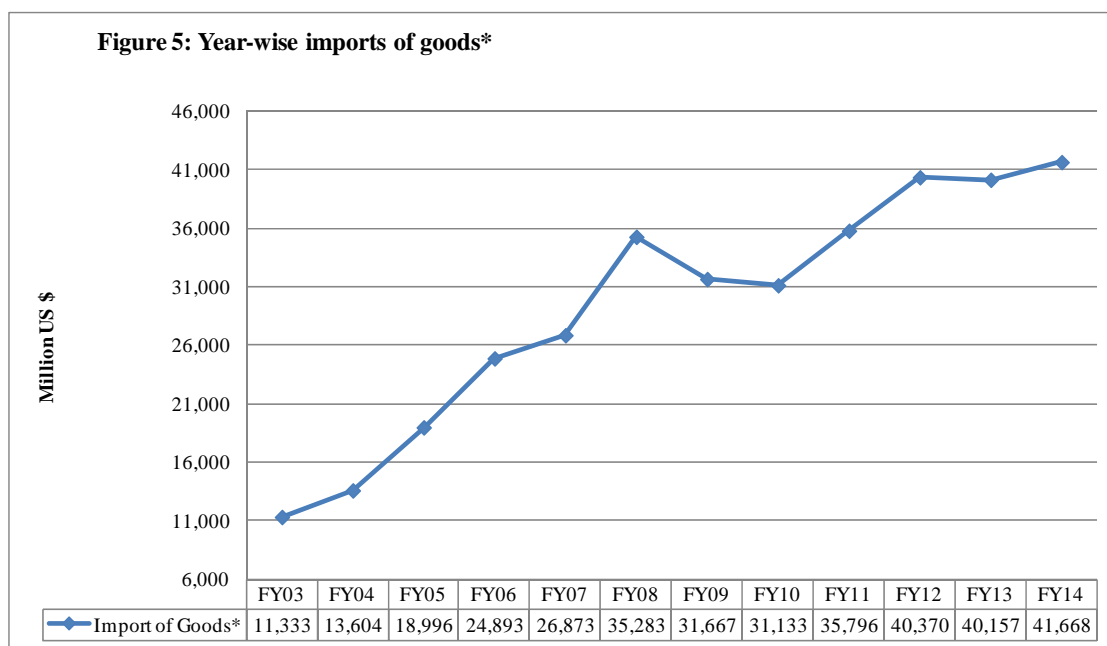
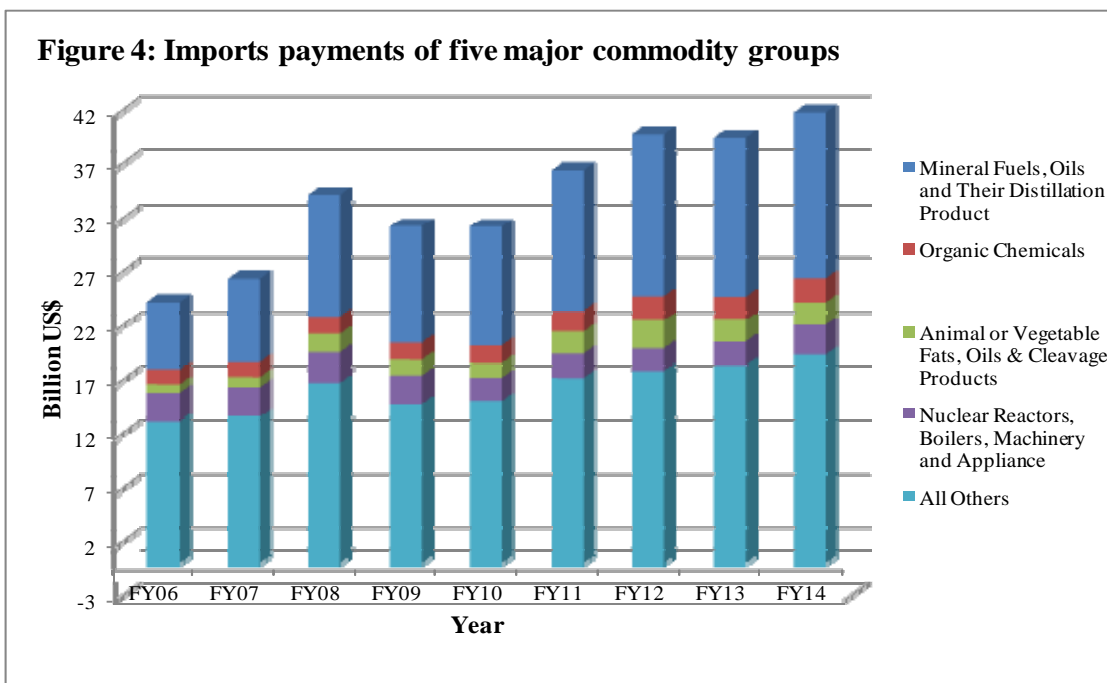
