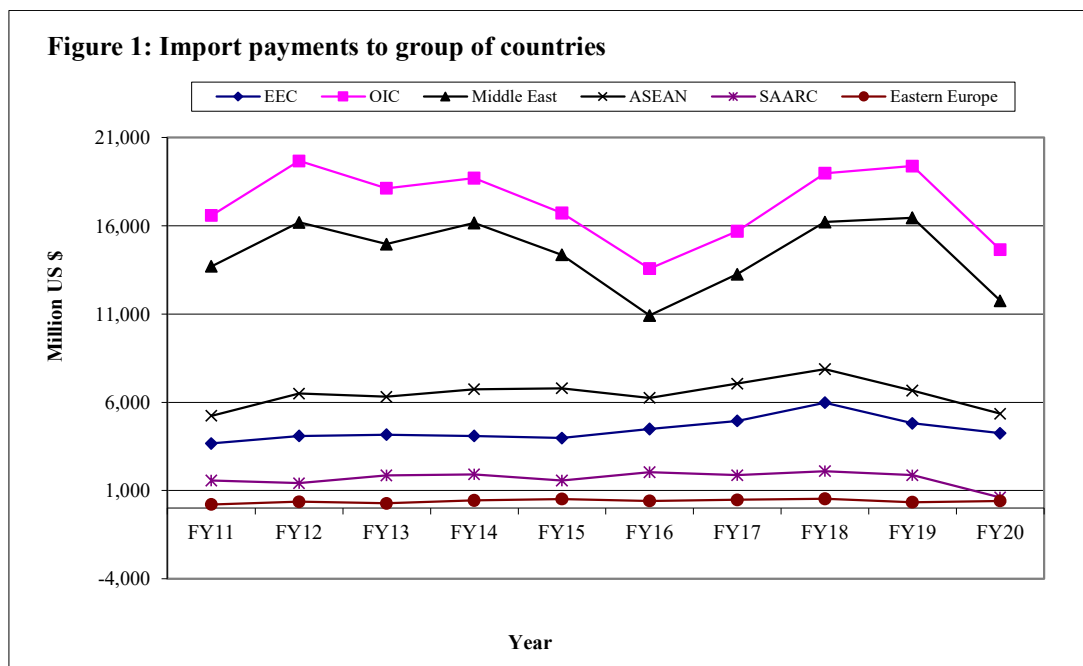

Figure 2: % Share of Major Commodities in Goods Import Payments

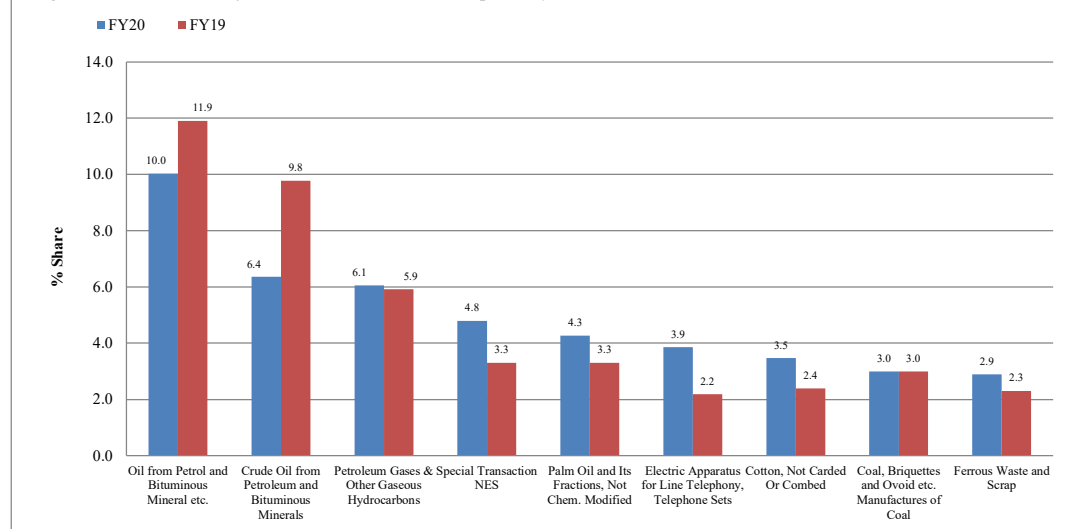

Figure 3: % Share of Major Countries in Goods Import Payments

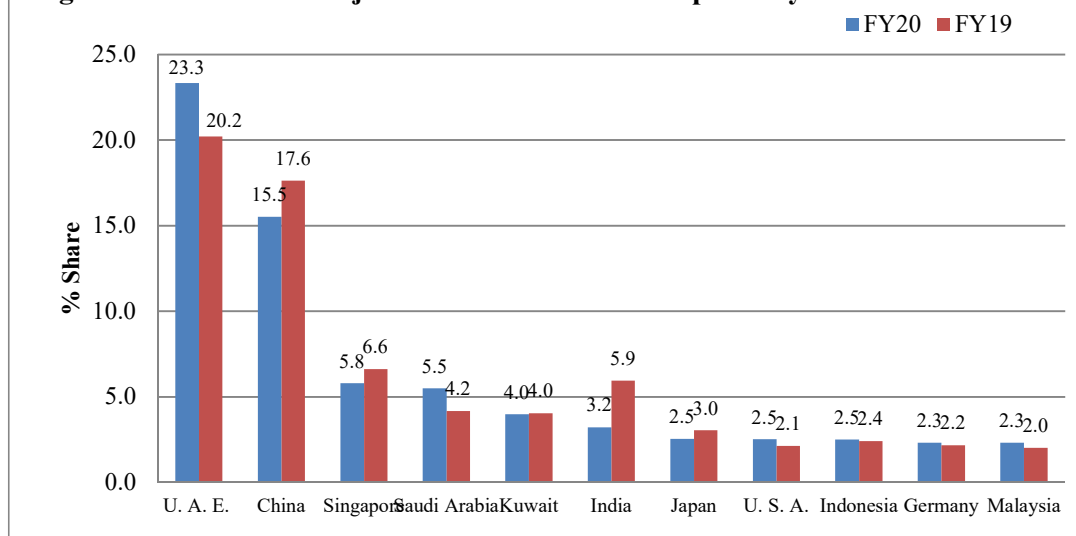

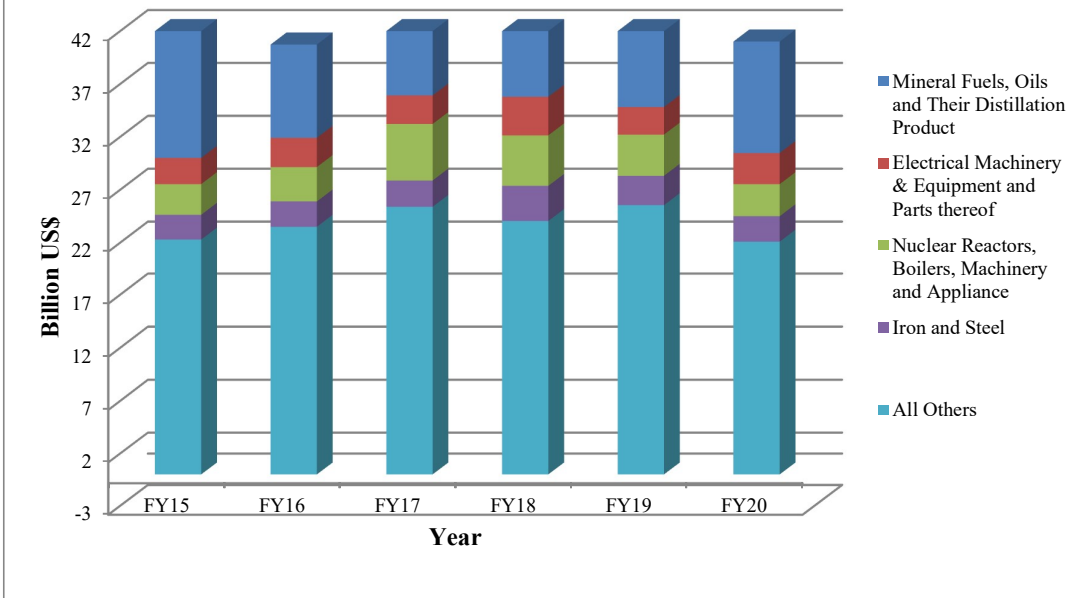

**Figure 5: Annual Import of Goods & Services**

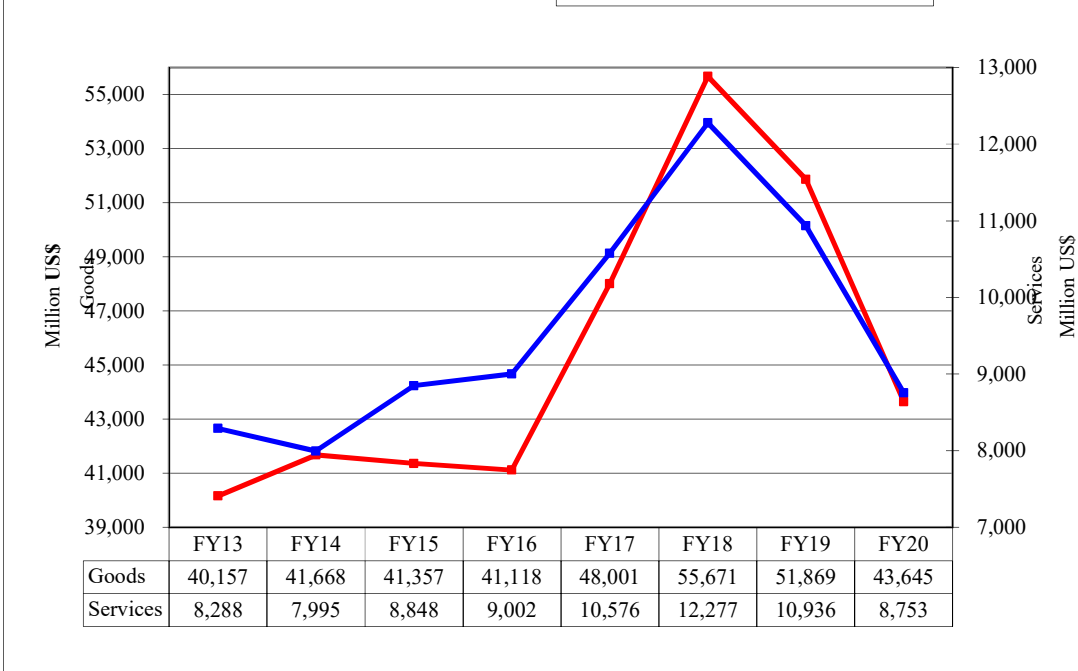
