

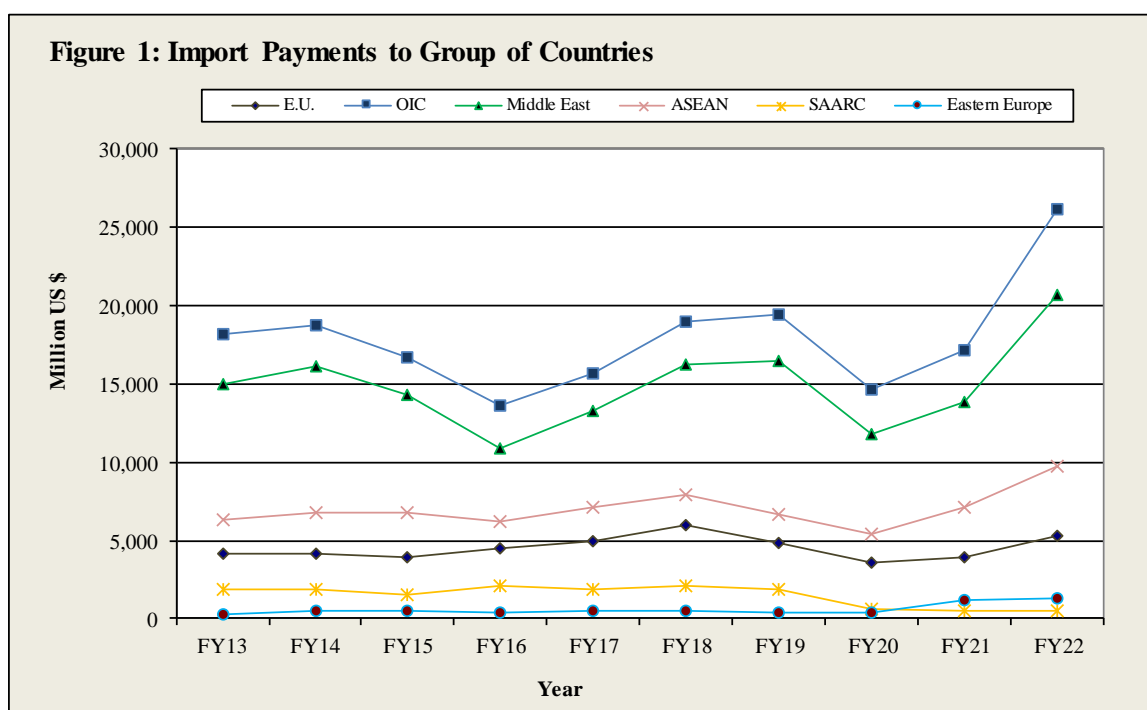

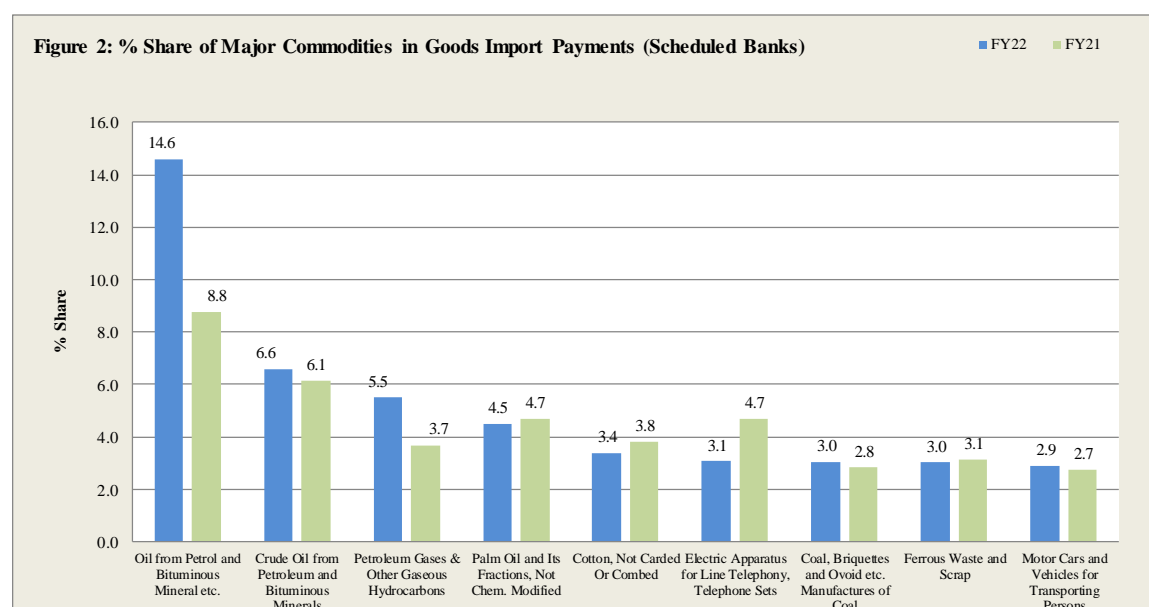

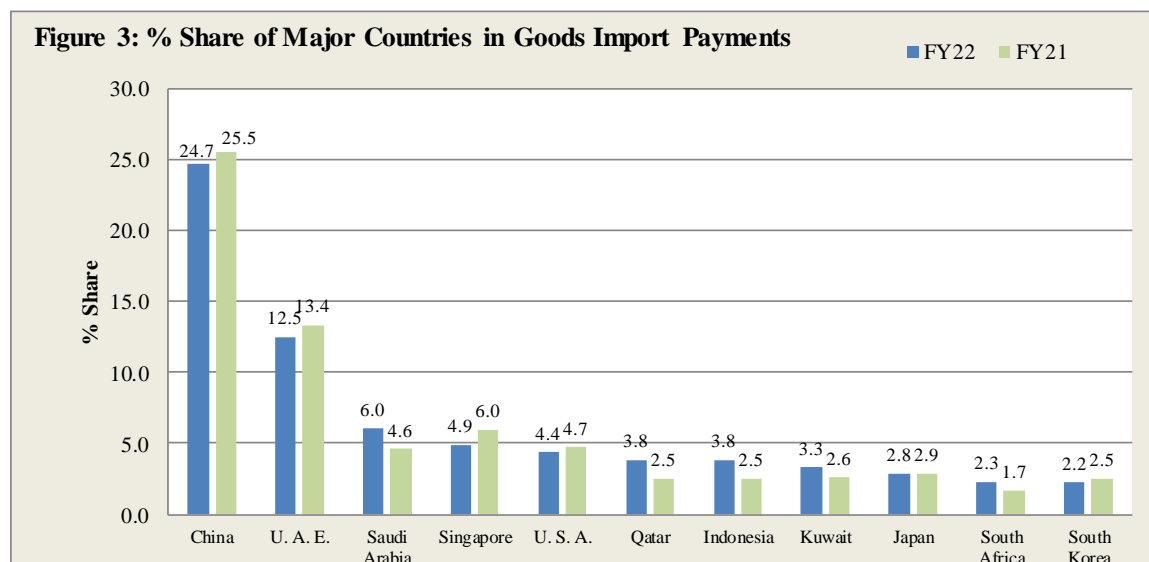
**Figure 3: % Share of Major Countries in Goods Import Payments**

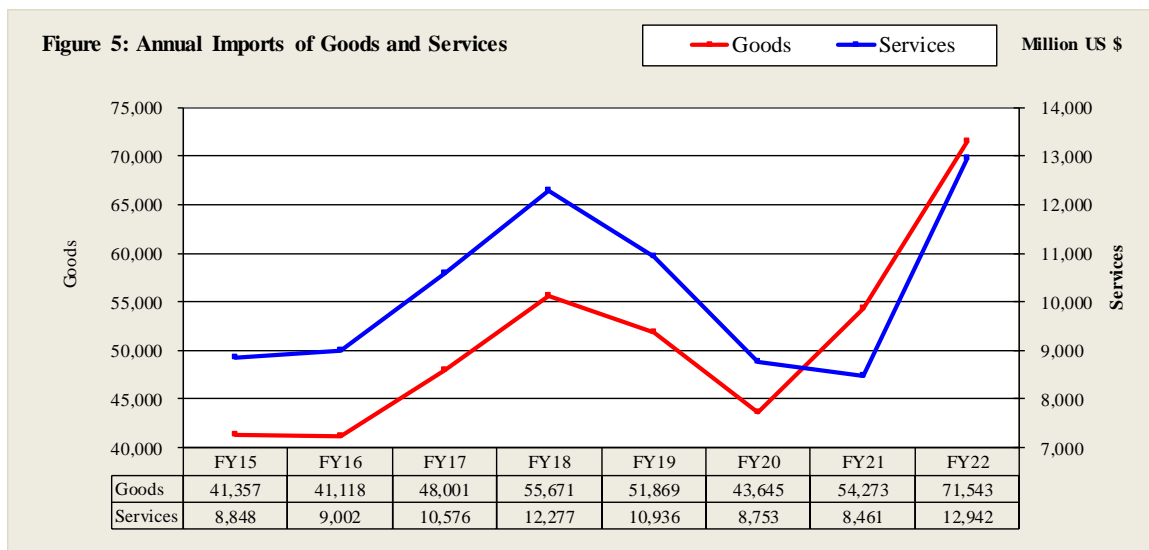
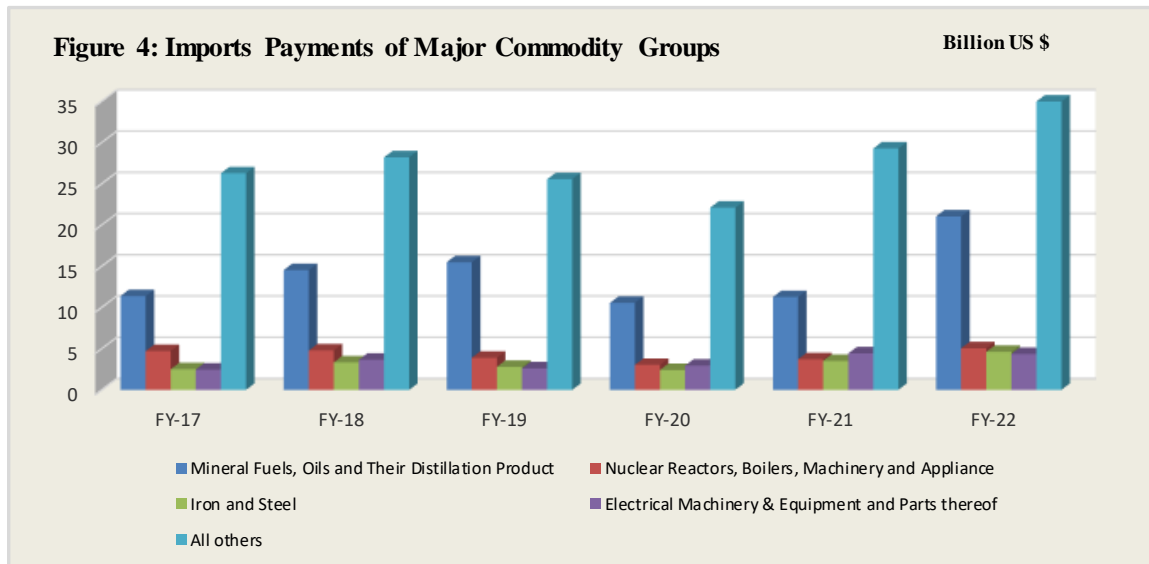
