Figure 1. Imports During Jul-May

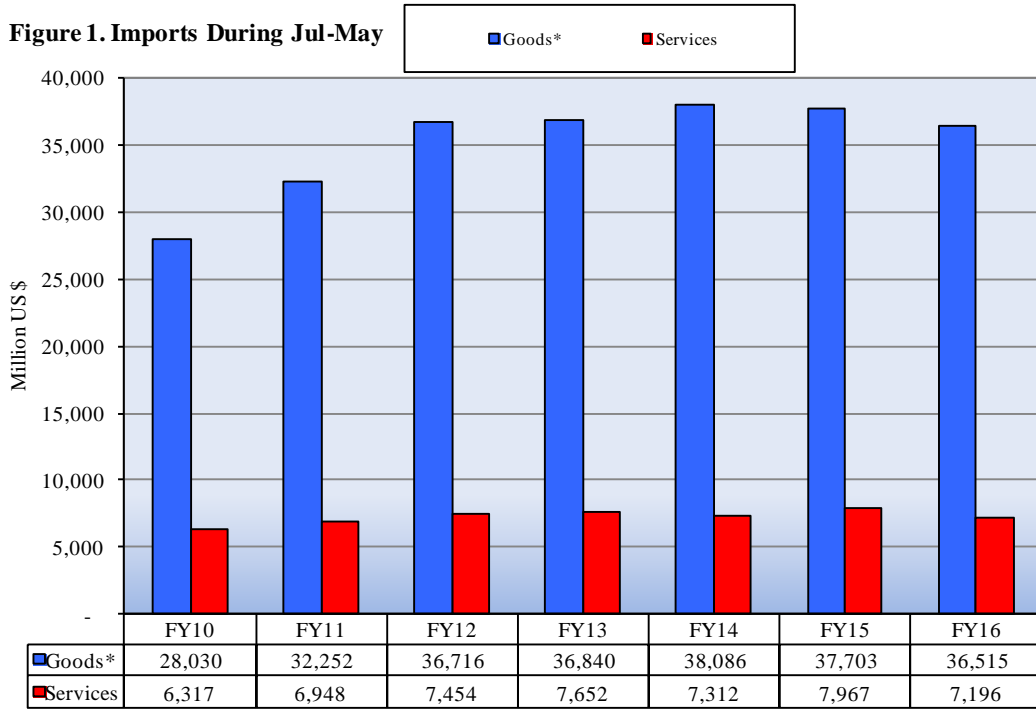


Figure 2: YOY Growth in Imports of Goods & Services

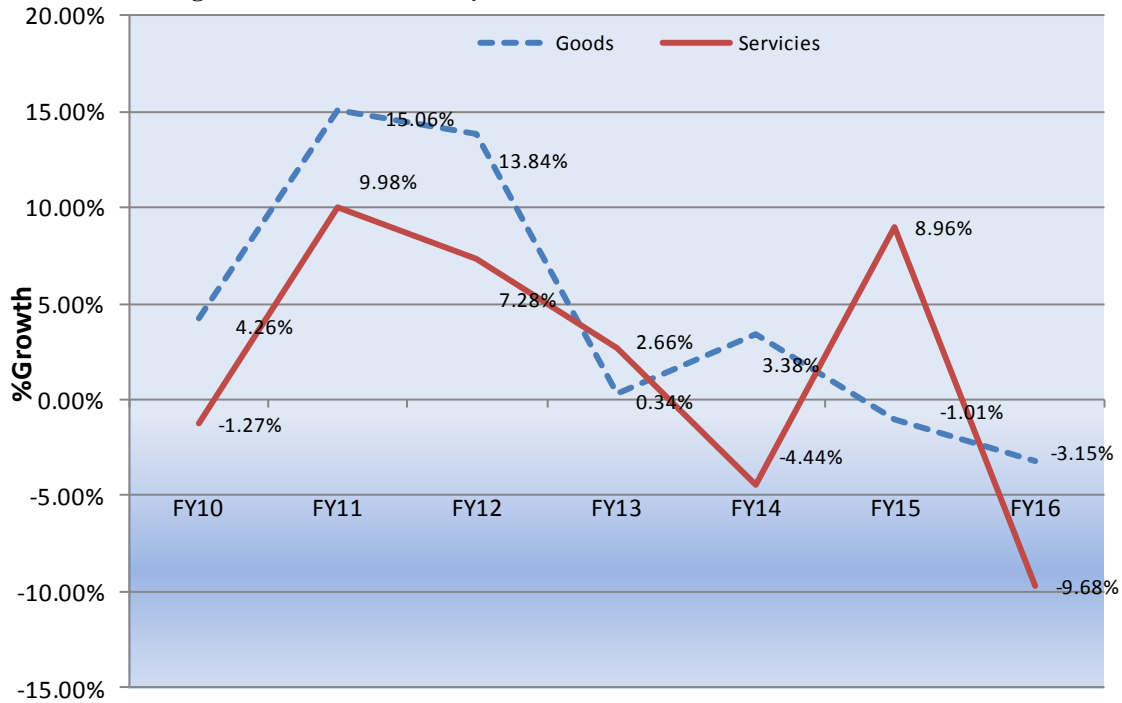

Figure 3: Percent Share of Major Commodity Groups in Imports Payments (Banks)

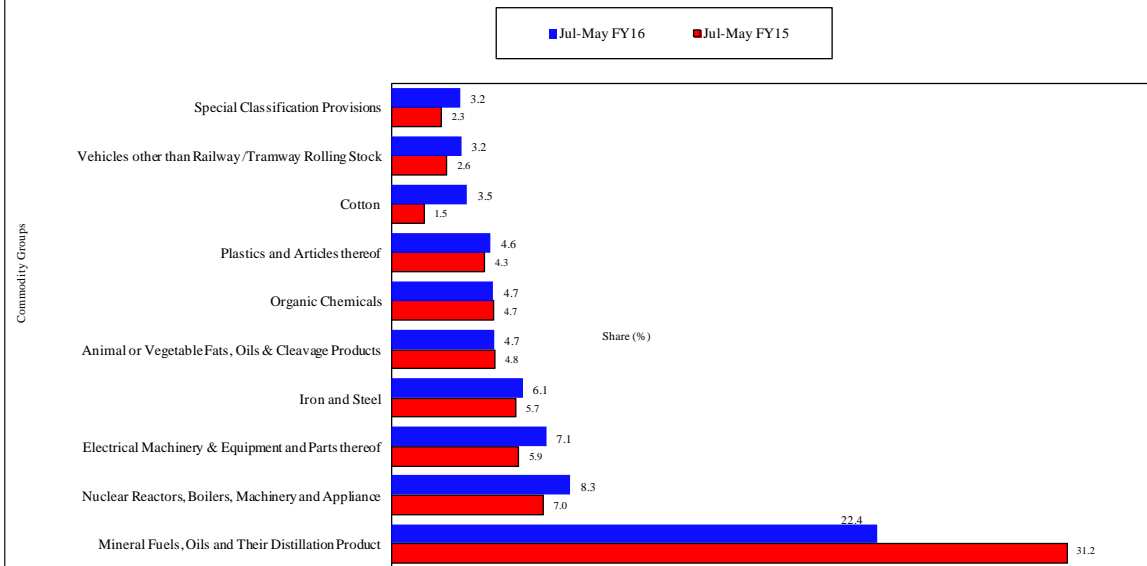
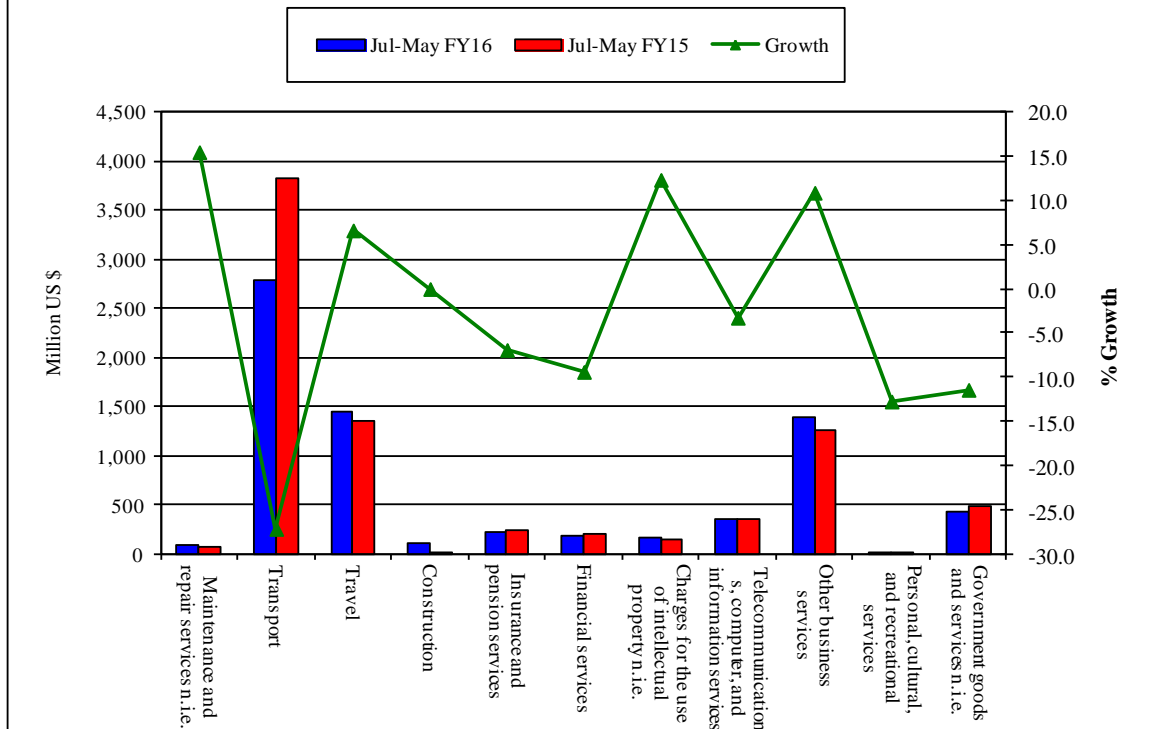


Figure 4: Imports of Services

Figure 5: % Share of Major Countries in Imports Payments of Goods During Jul-May FY16

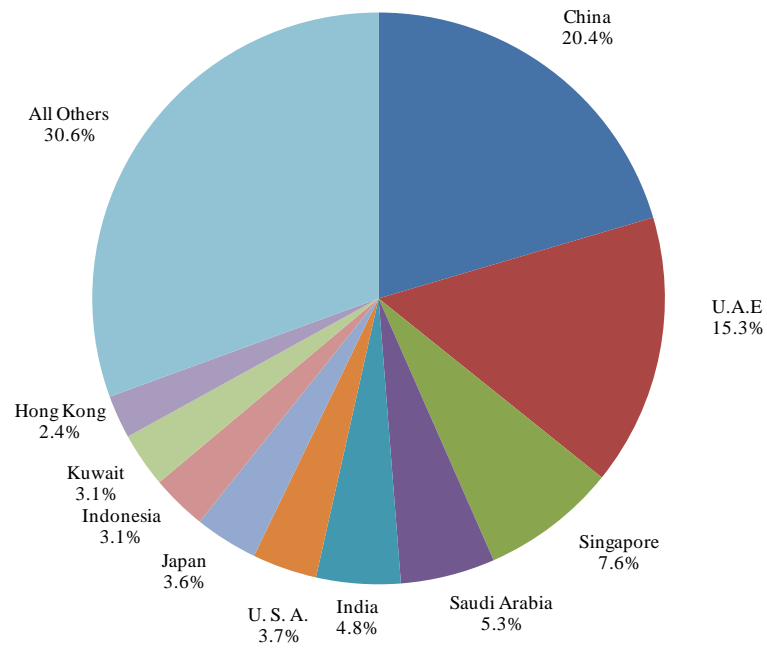
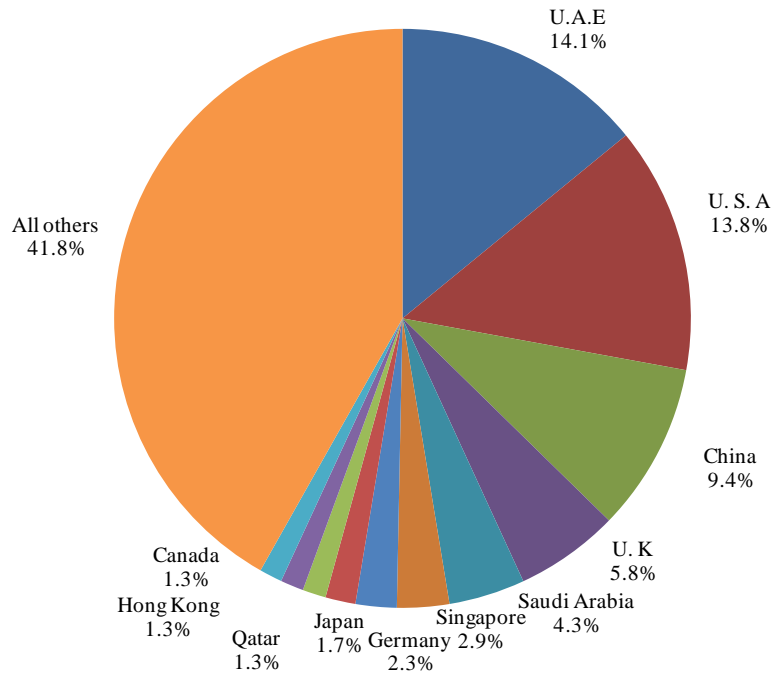


Figure 6: % Share of Major Countries in Imports of Services During July-May FY16

Figure 7: Annual Imports of Goods & Services from FY08 to FY15

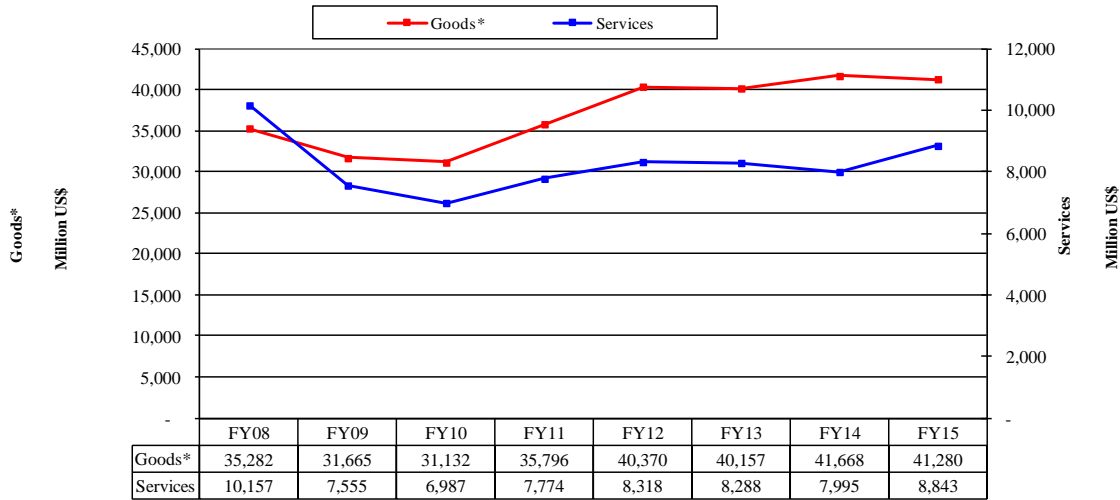
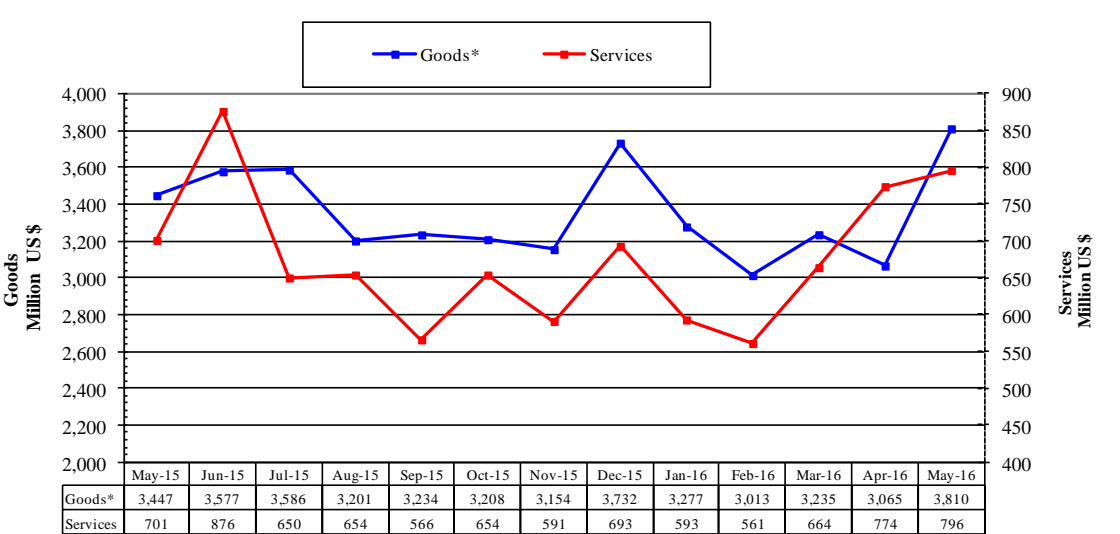


Figure 8: Monthly Imports of Goods & Services
