Figure 1. Imports During Jul-Oct

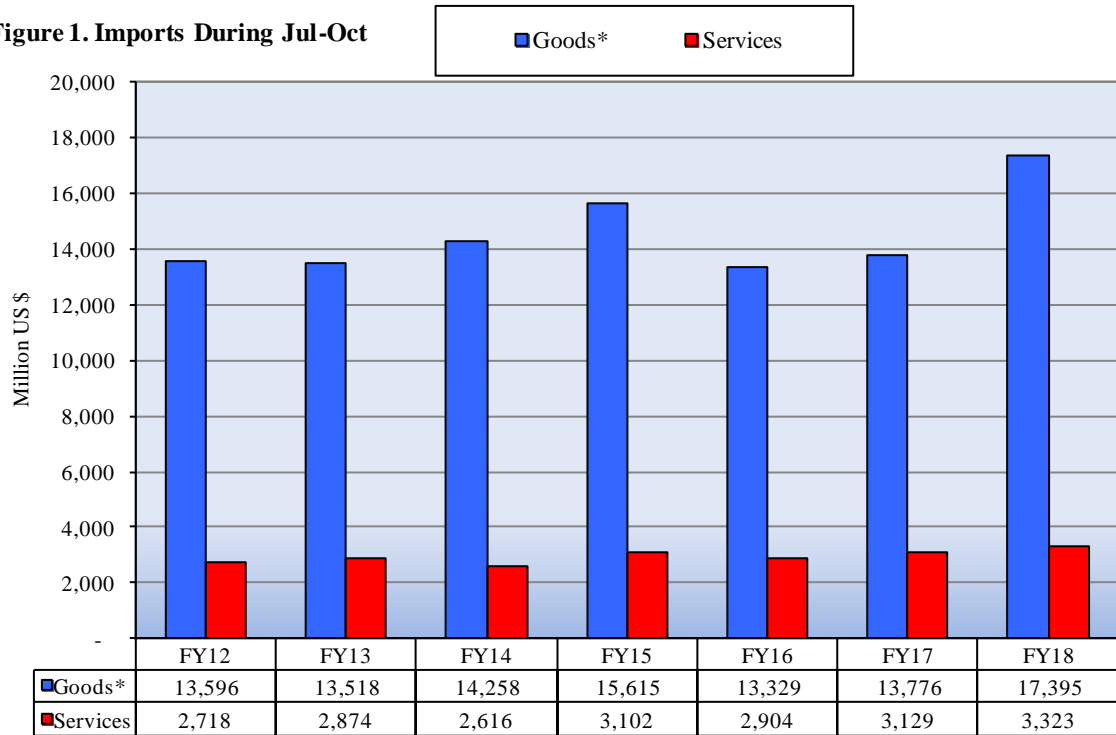


Figure 2: YOY Growth in Imports of Goods & Services

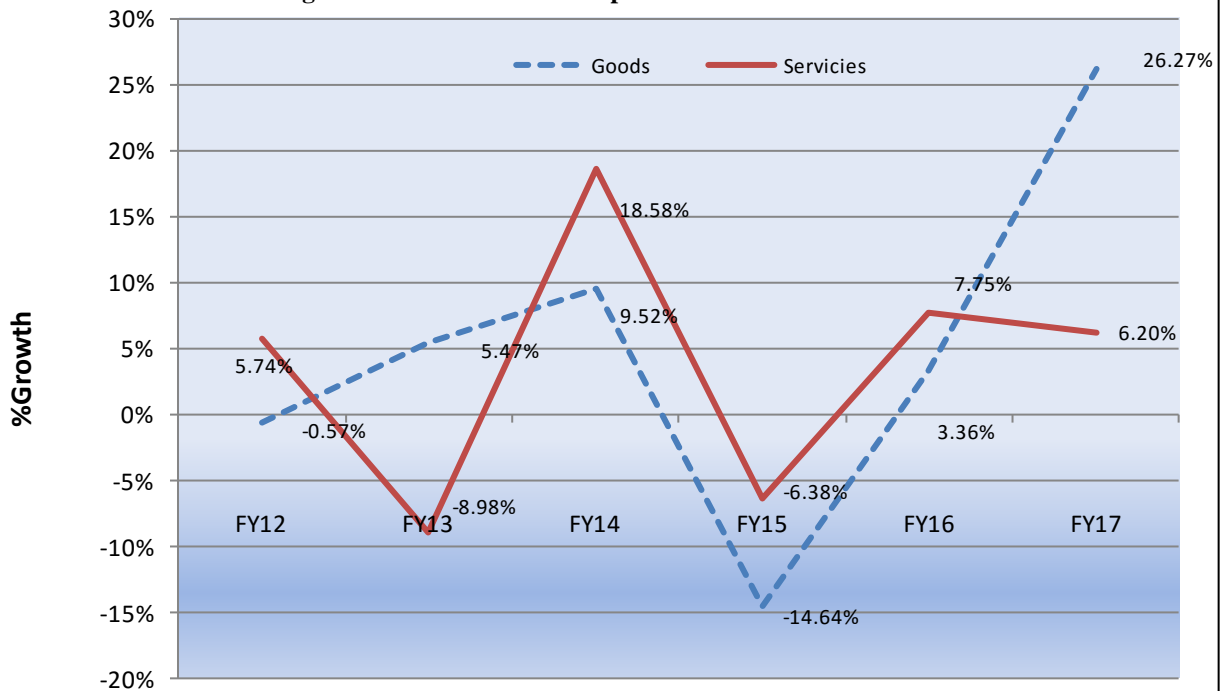

Figure 3: Percent Share of Major Commodity Groups in Imports Payments (Banks)

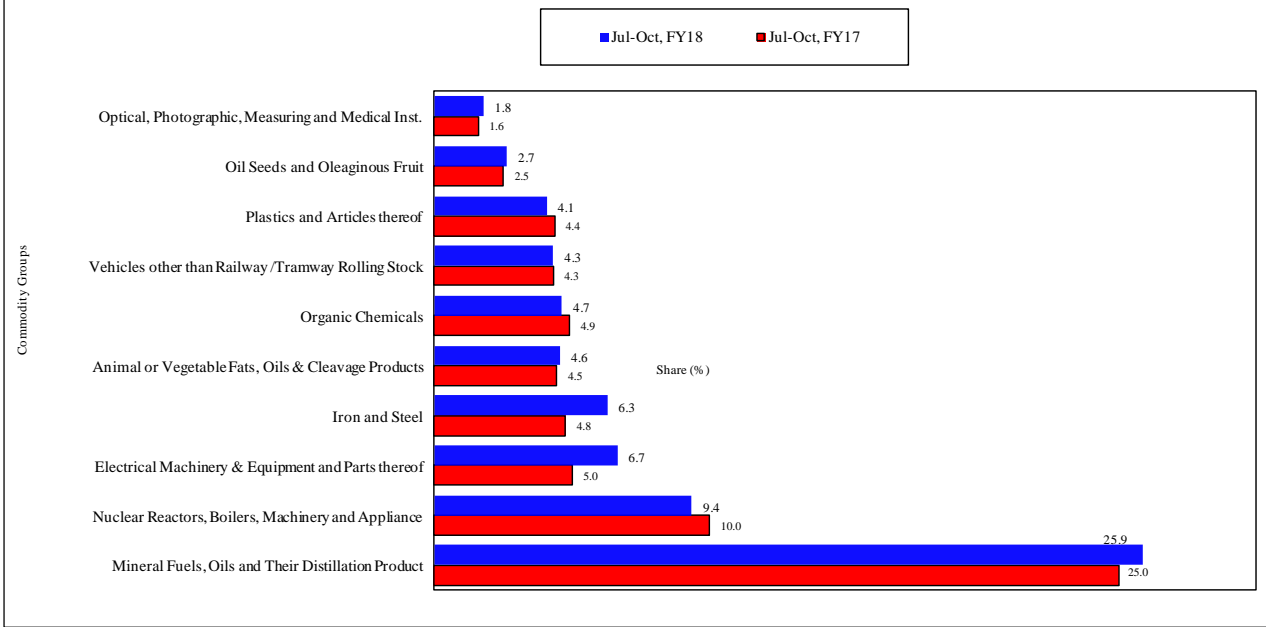
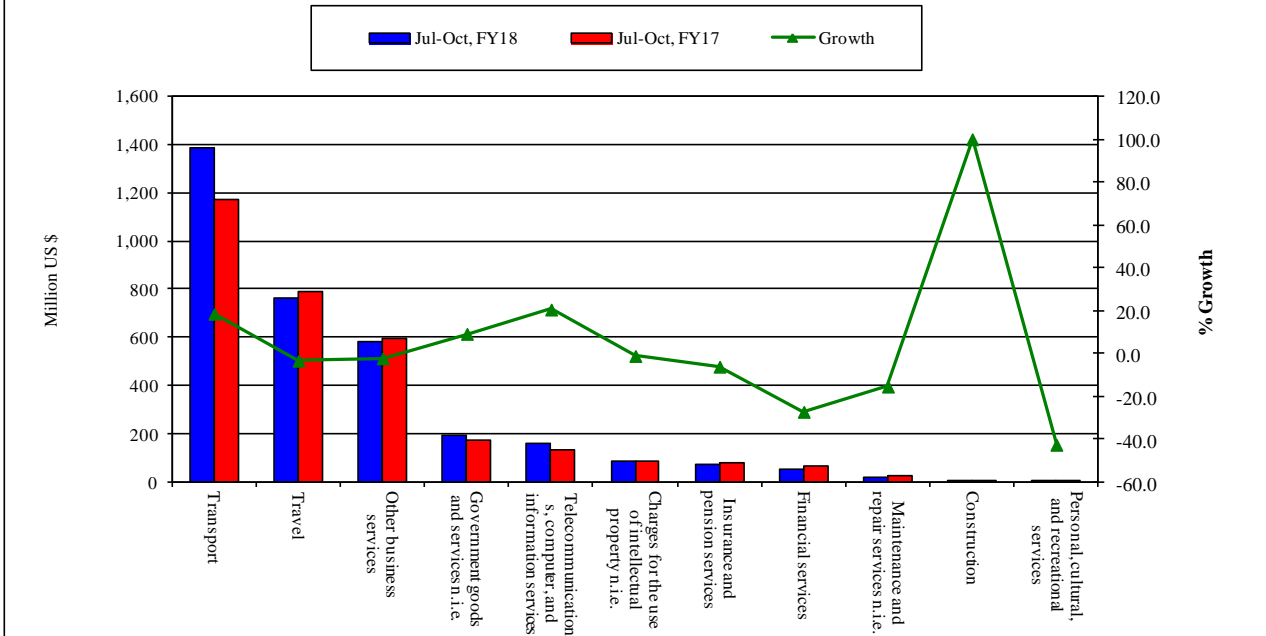


Figure 4: Imports of Services

Figure 5: % Share of Major Countries in Imports Payments of Goods During Jul-Oct, FY18

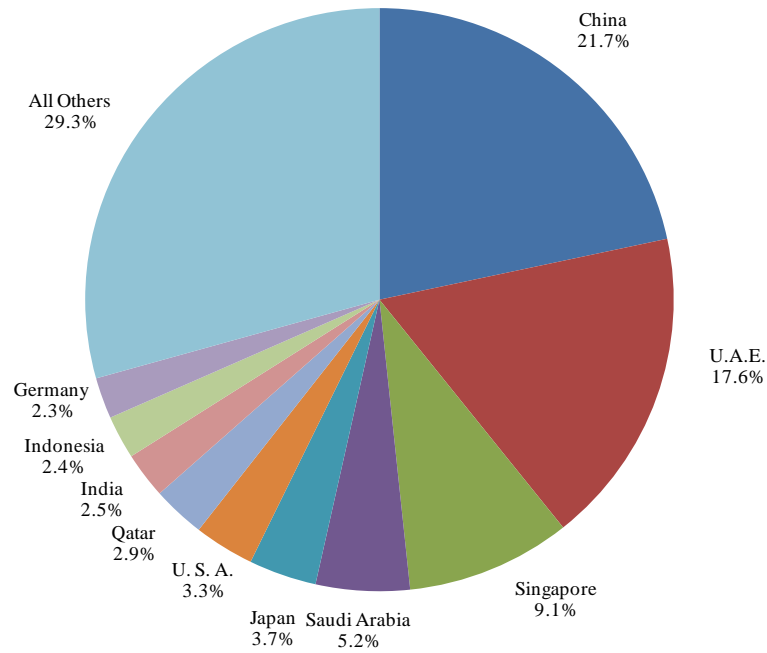
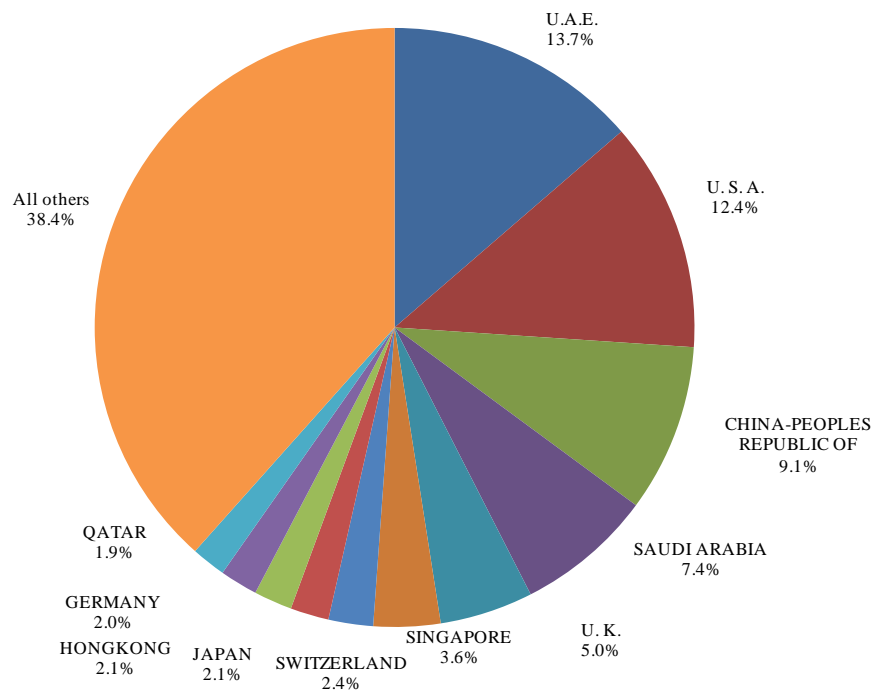
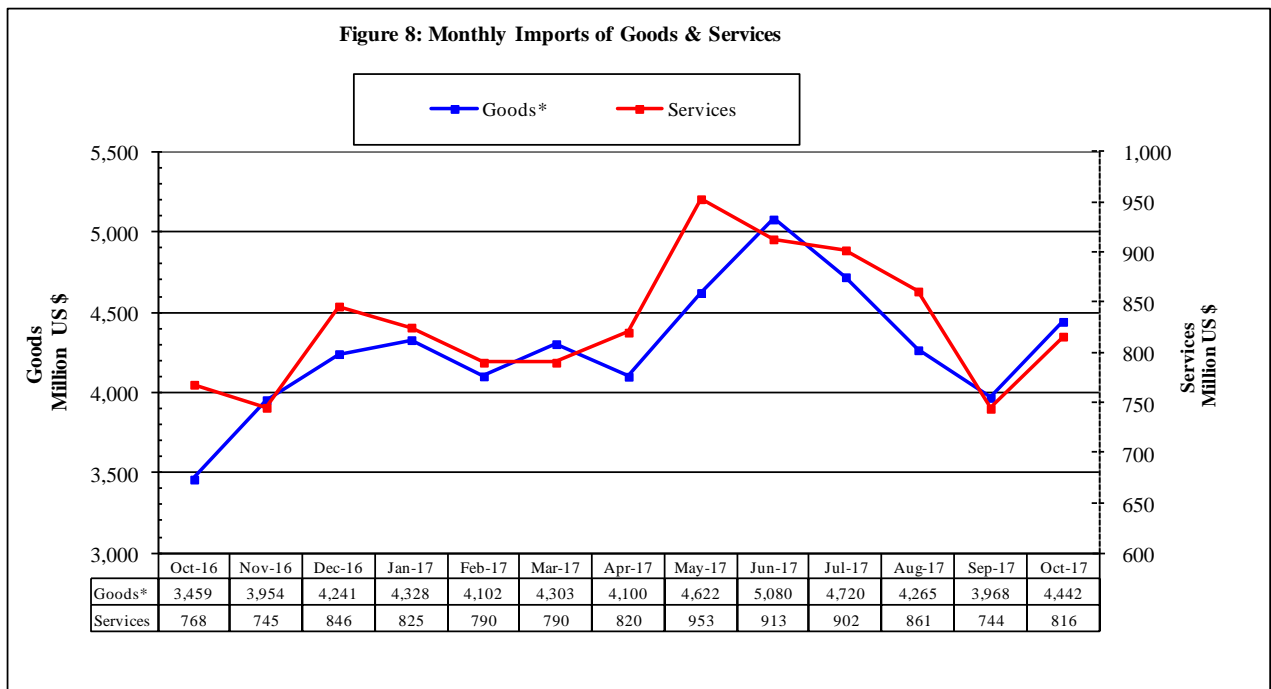
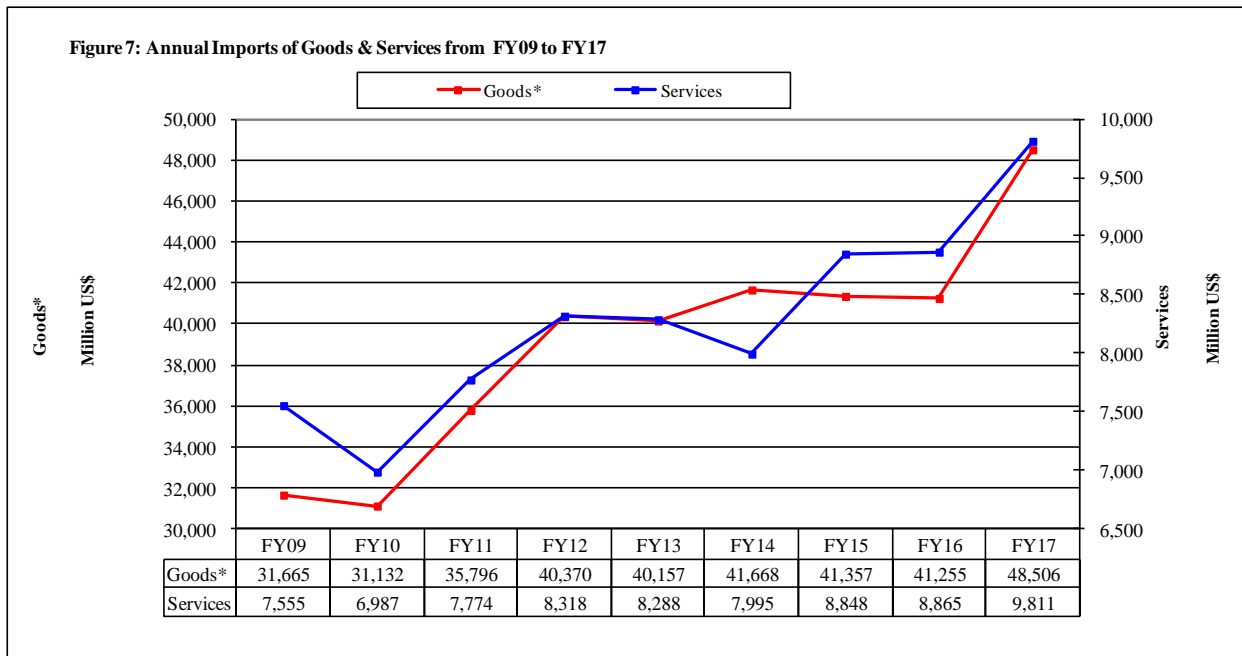


Figure 6: % Share of Major Countries in Imports of Services During Jul-Oct, FY18
