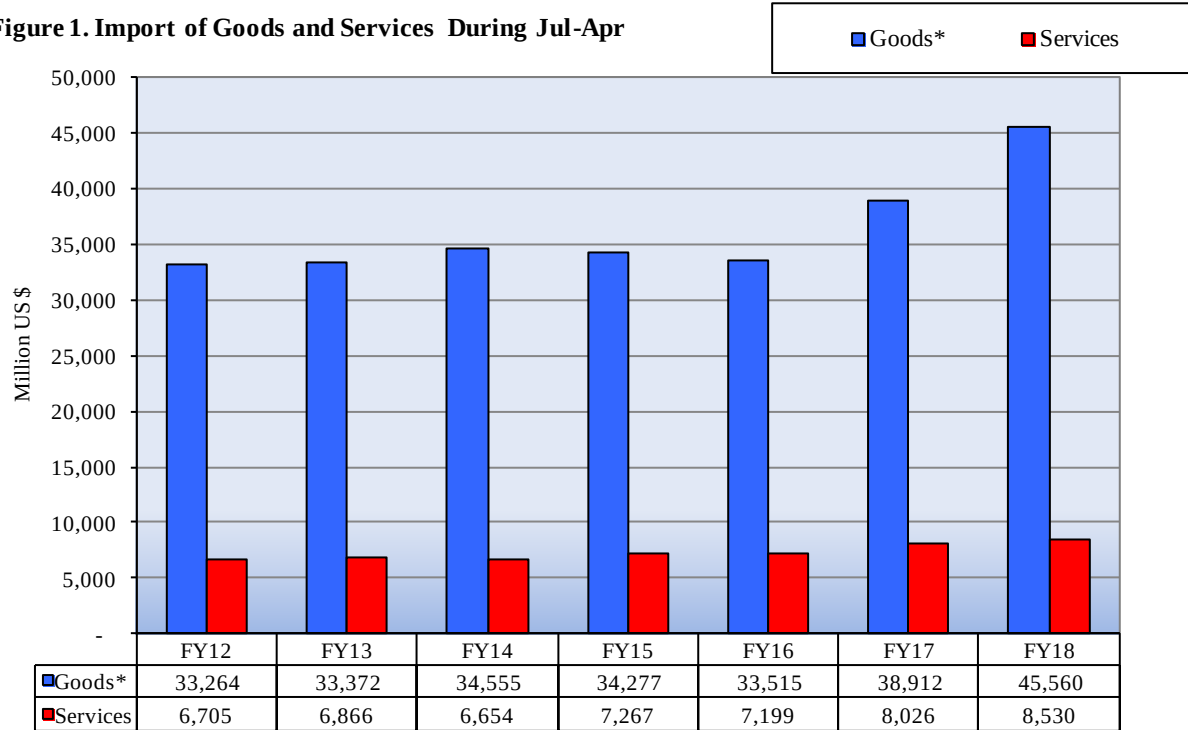
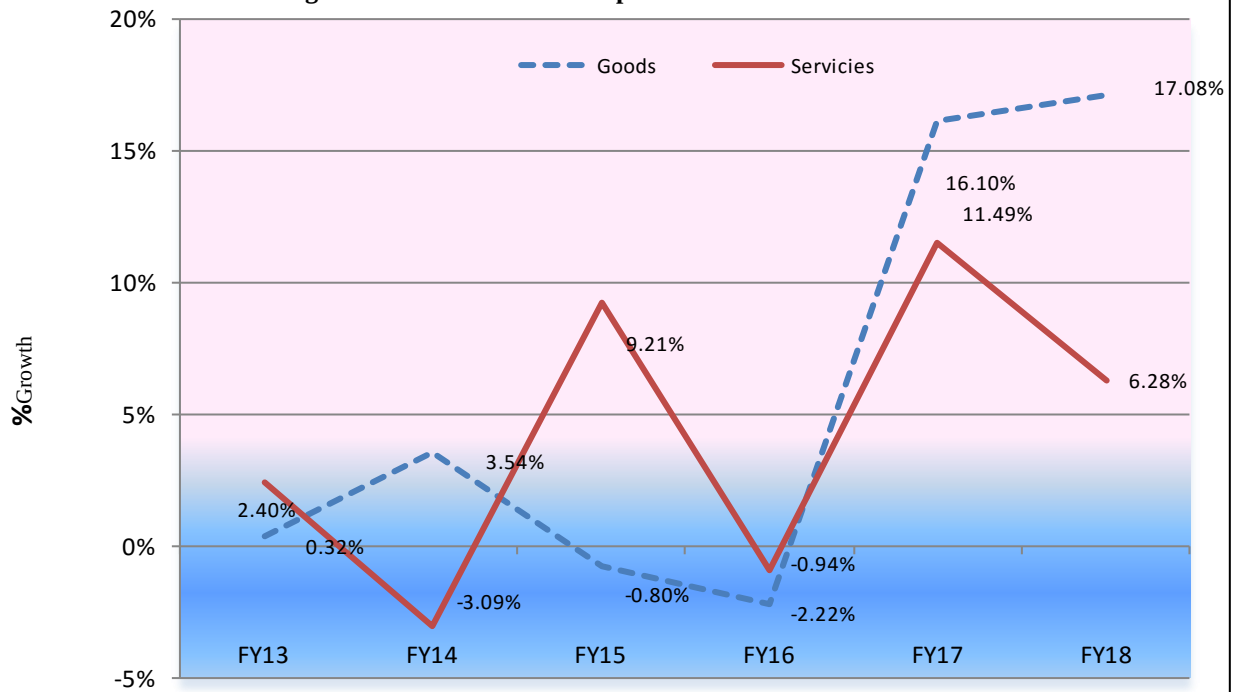
Figure 1. Import of Goods and Services During Jul-Apr**Figure 2: YOY Growth in Import of Goods & Services**

Figure 3: Percent Share of Major Commodity Groups in Import Payments (Banks)

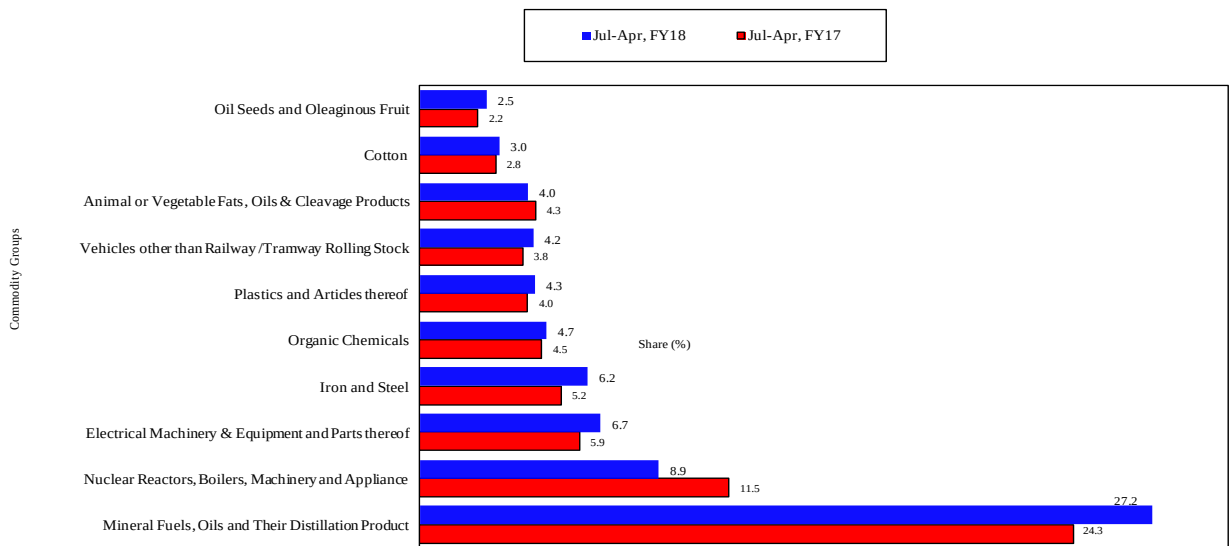
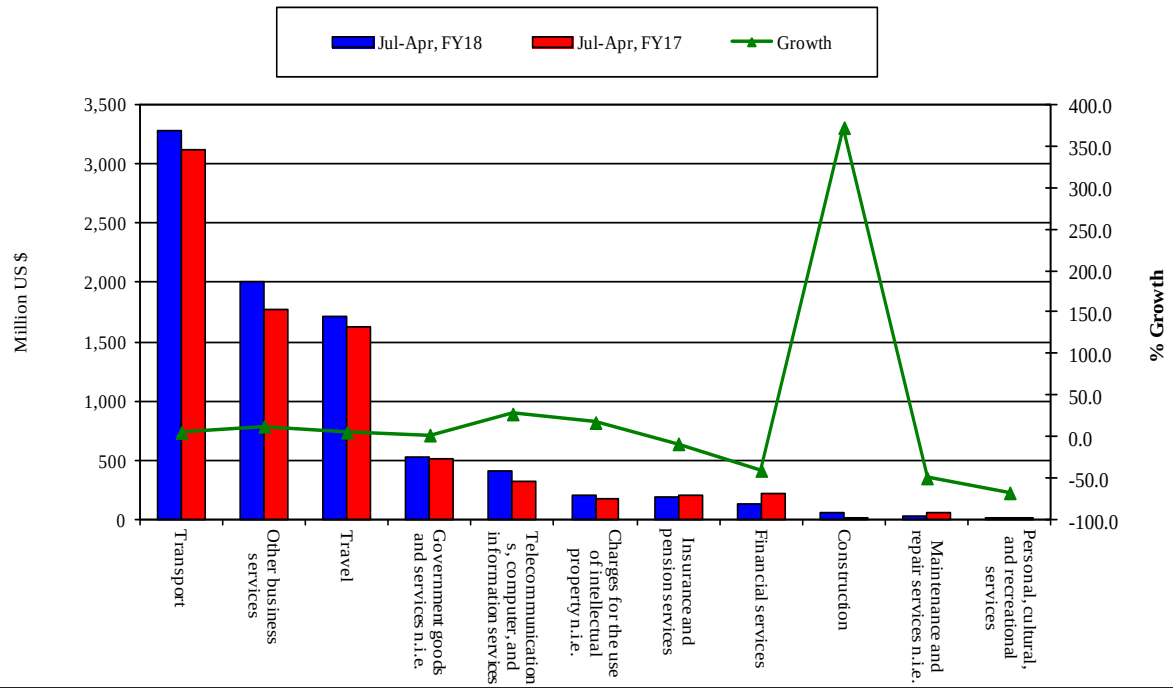


Figure 4: Import of Services

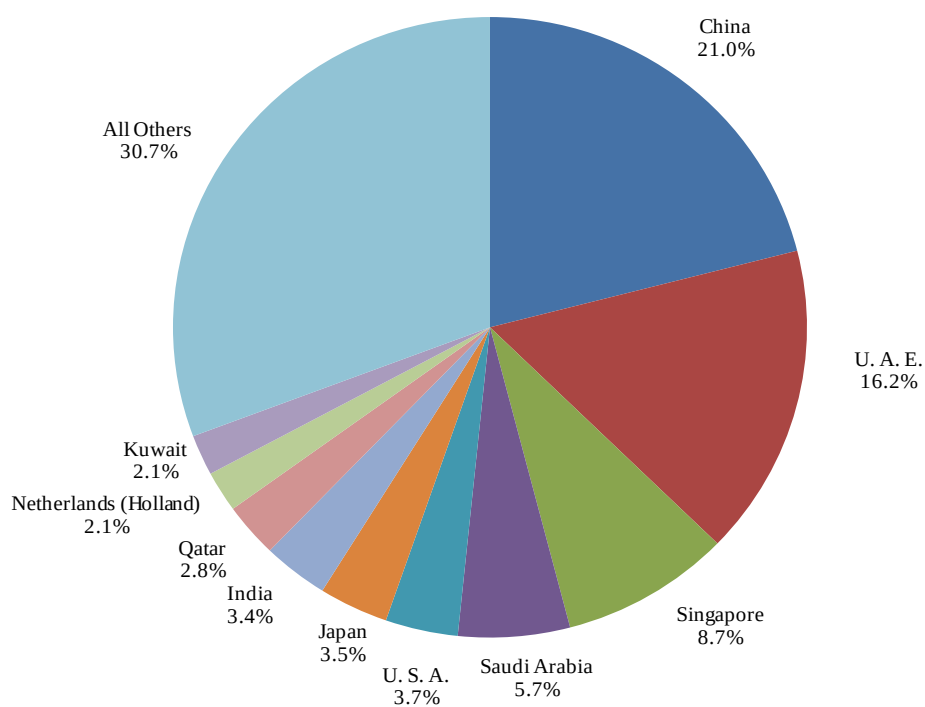
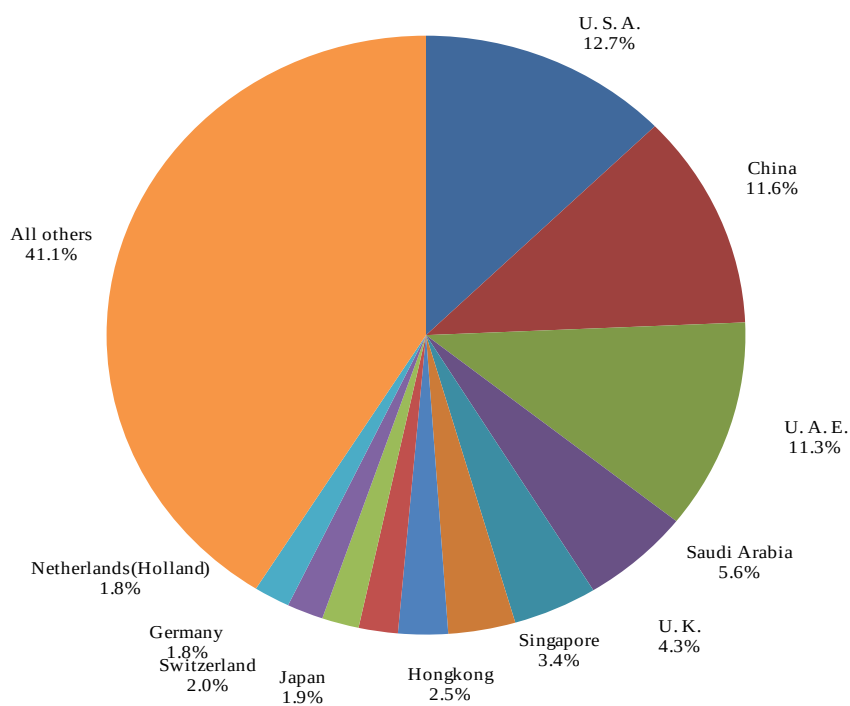

Figure 7: Annual Import of Goods & Services from FY09 to FY17

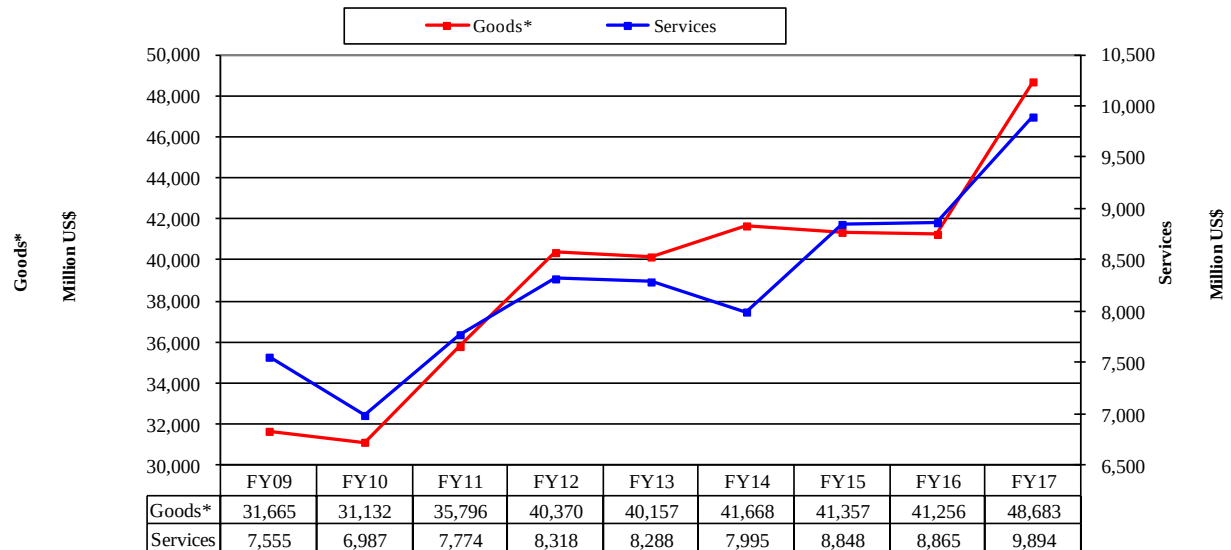
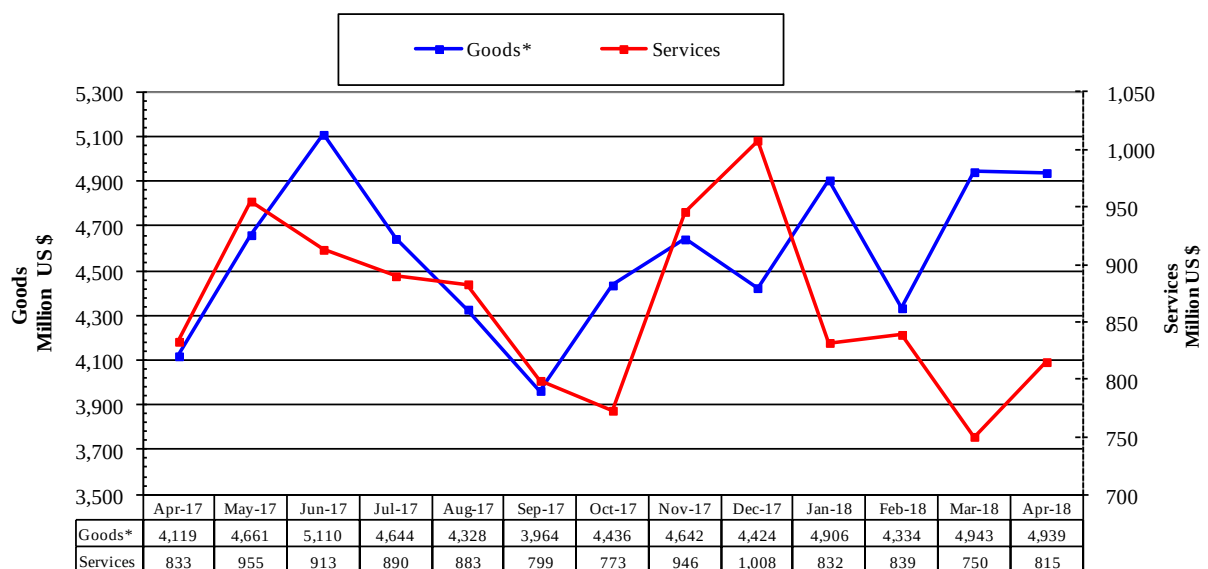


Figure 8: Monthly Import of Goods & Services
