Figure 1. Import of Goods and Services during July-August FY19

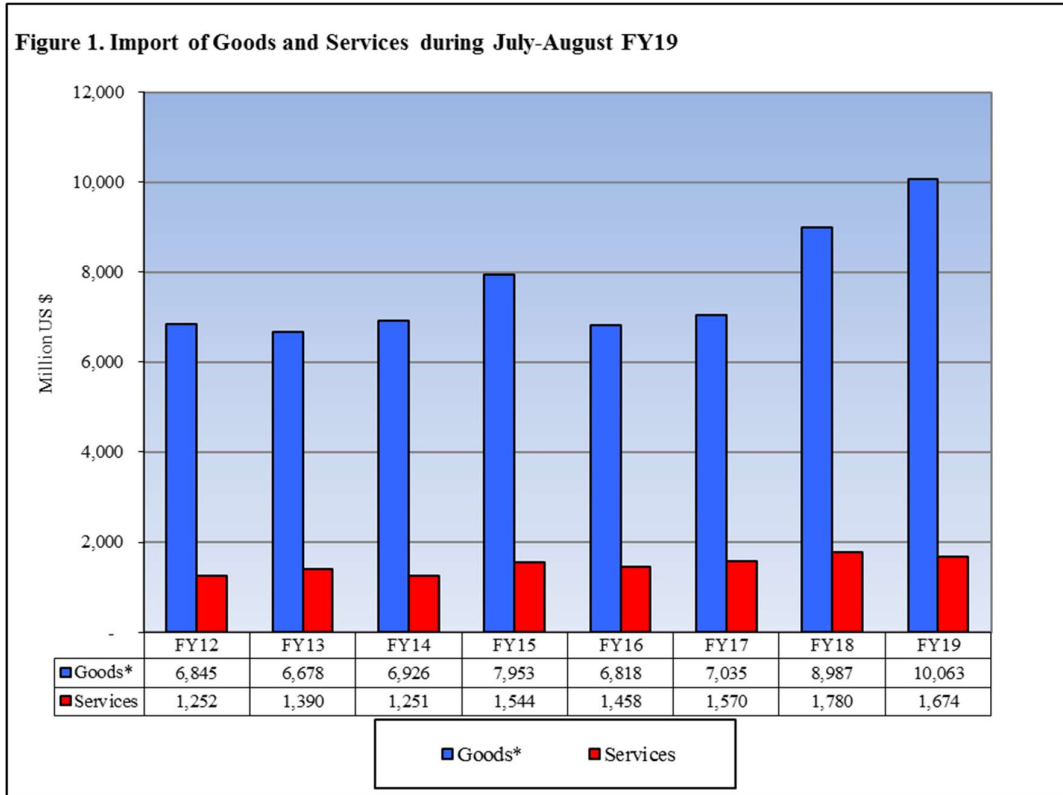
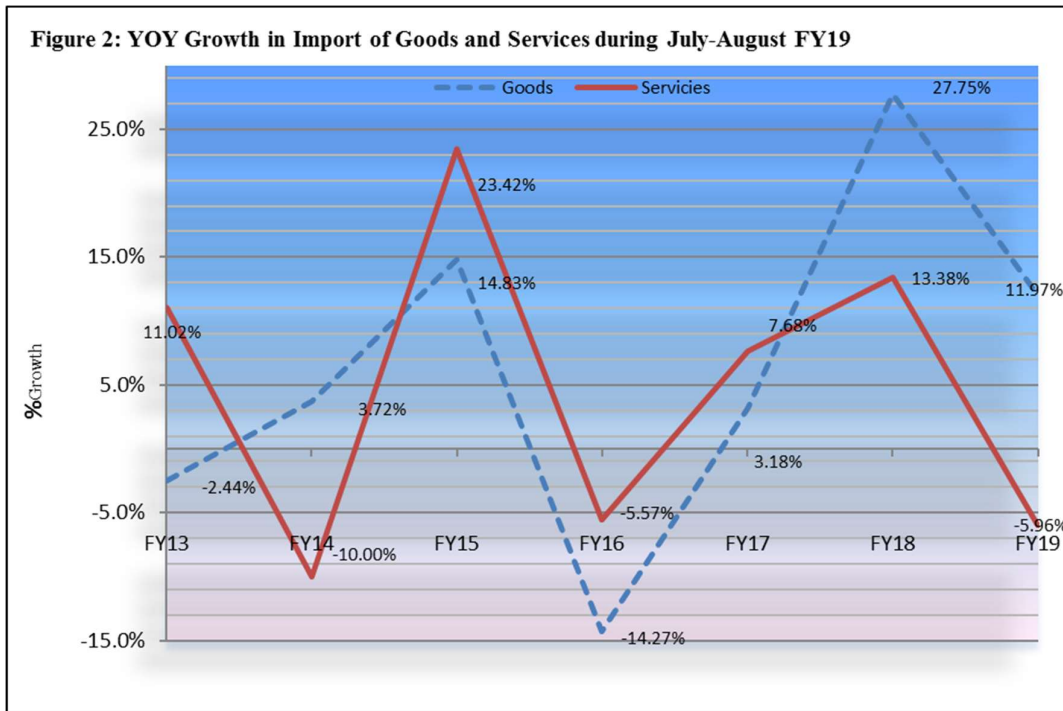


Figure 2: YOY Growth in Import of Goods and Services during July-August FY19

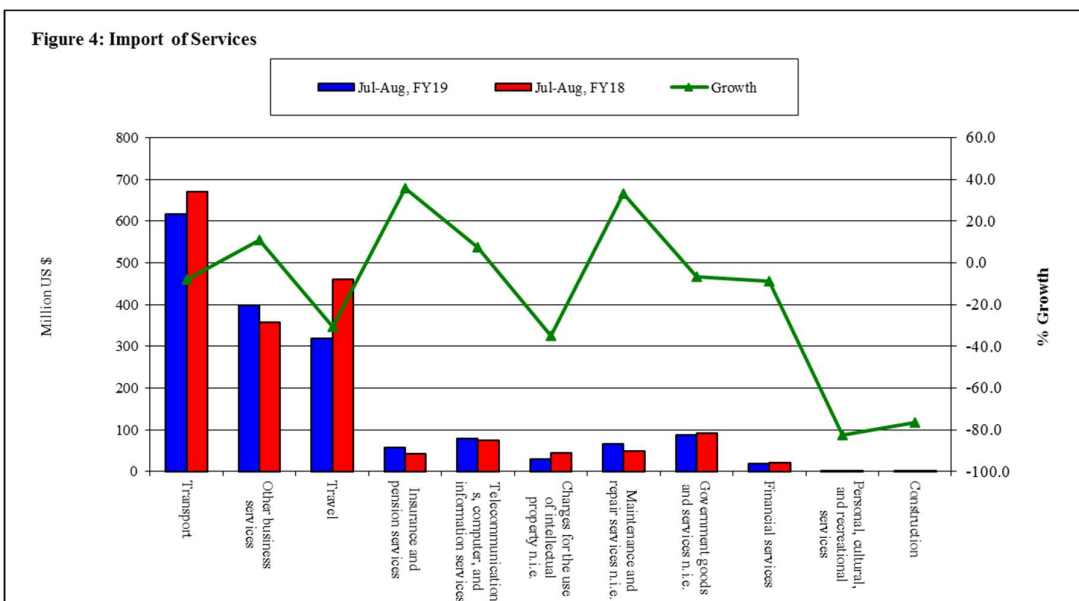
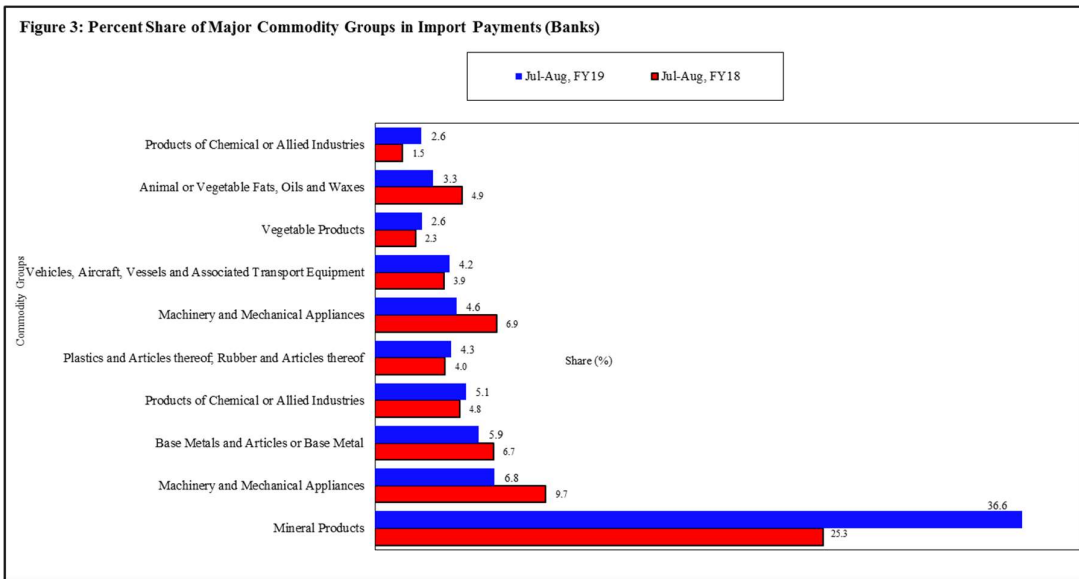

Figure 5: % Share of Major Countries in Import Payments of Goods During July-August, FY19

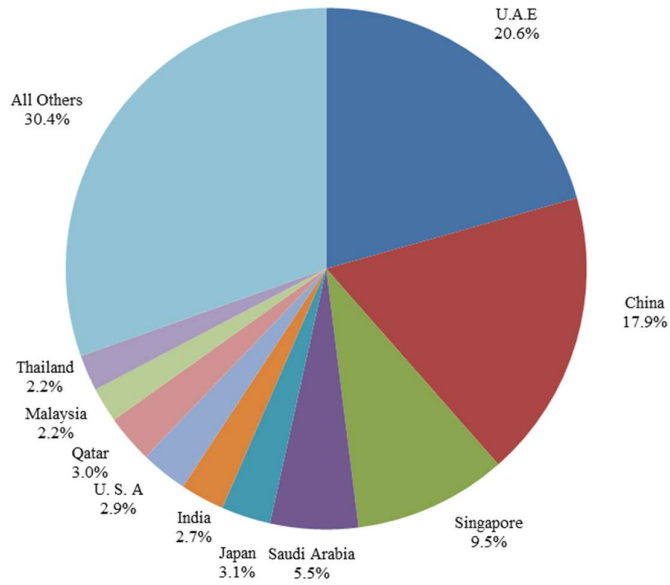
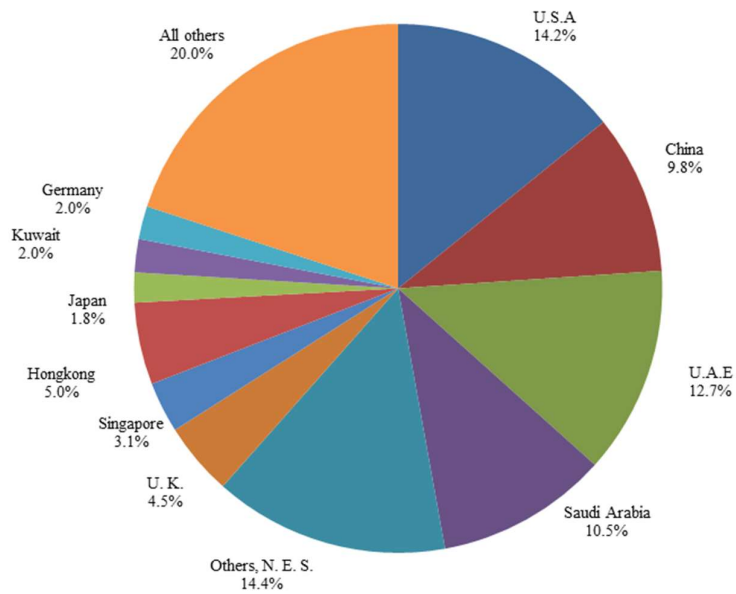
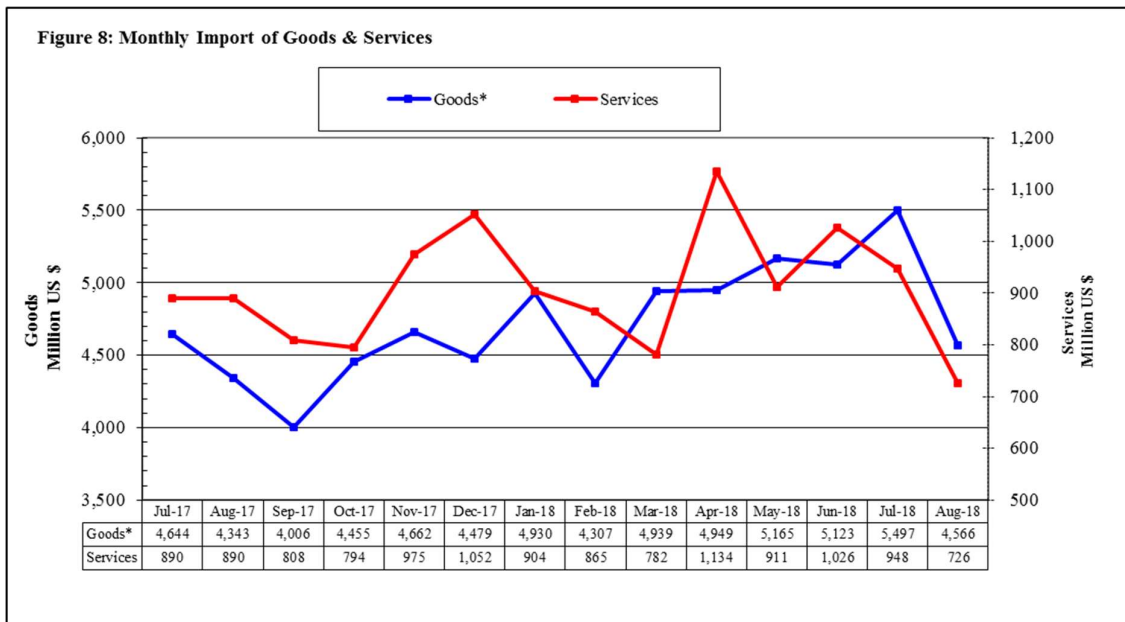
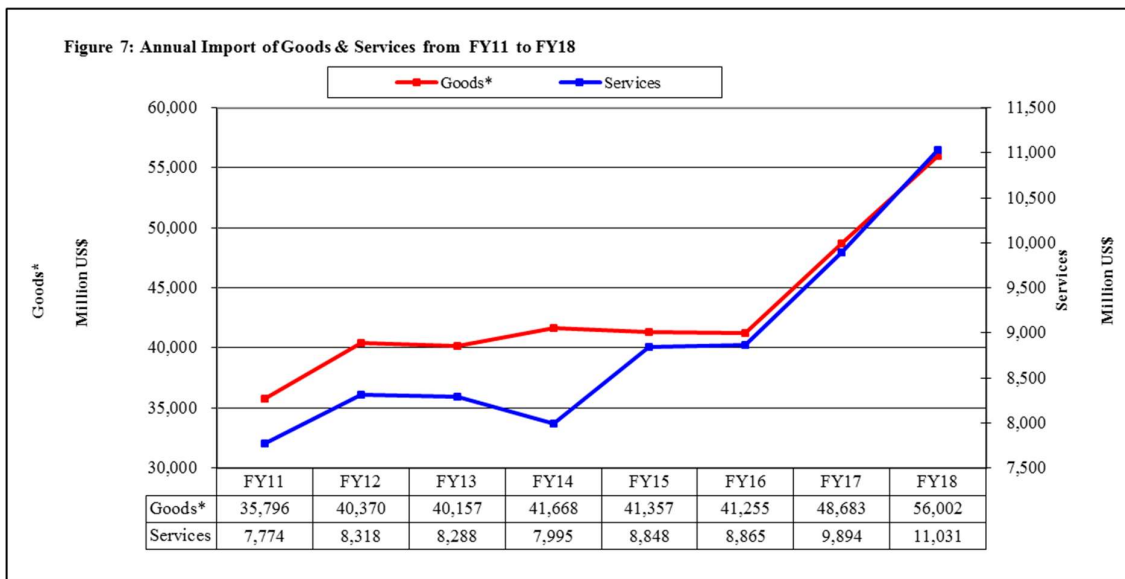


Figure 6: % Share of Major Countries in Import of Services During July-January, FY19
