Figure 1. Import of Goods and Services During July-December FY19

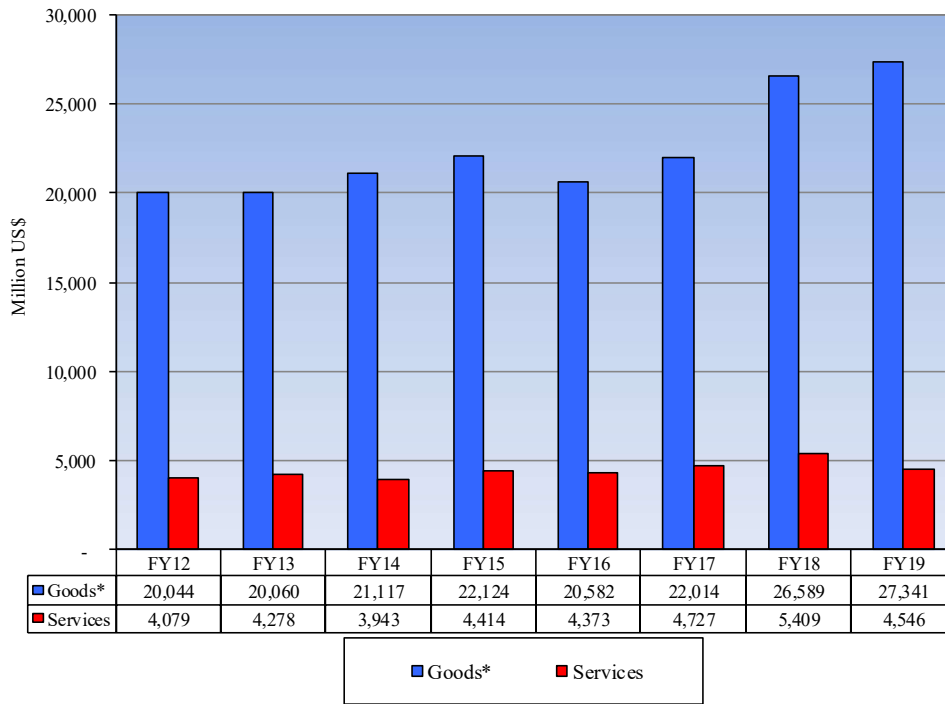
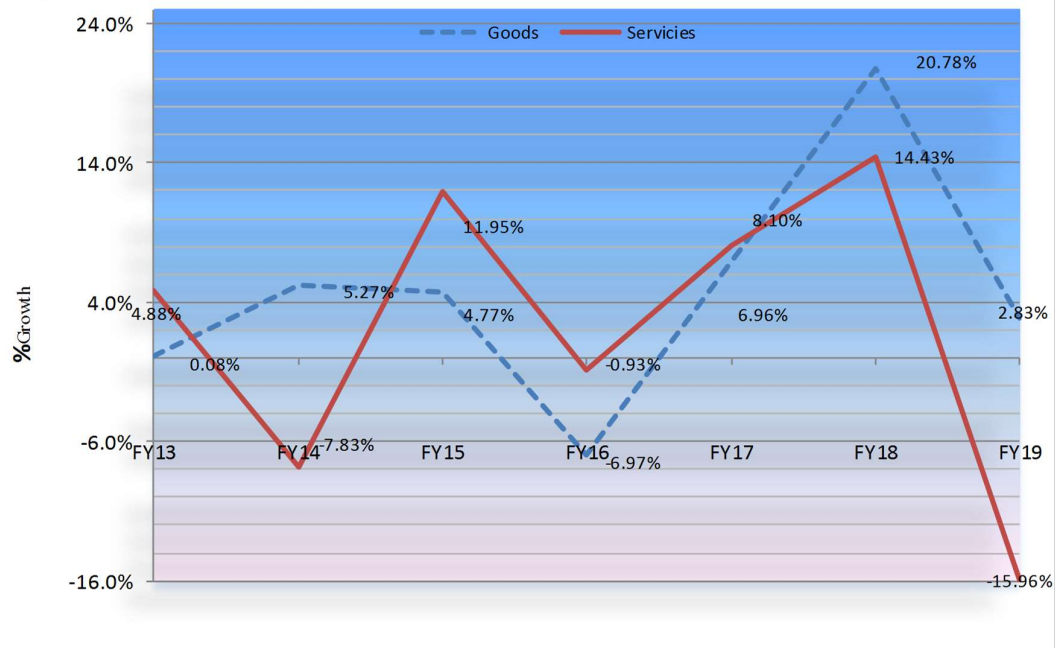


Figure 2: YOY Growth in Import of Goods & Services July-December FY19

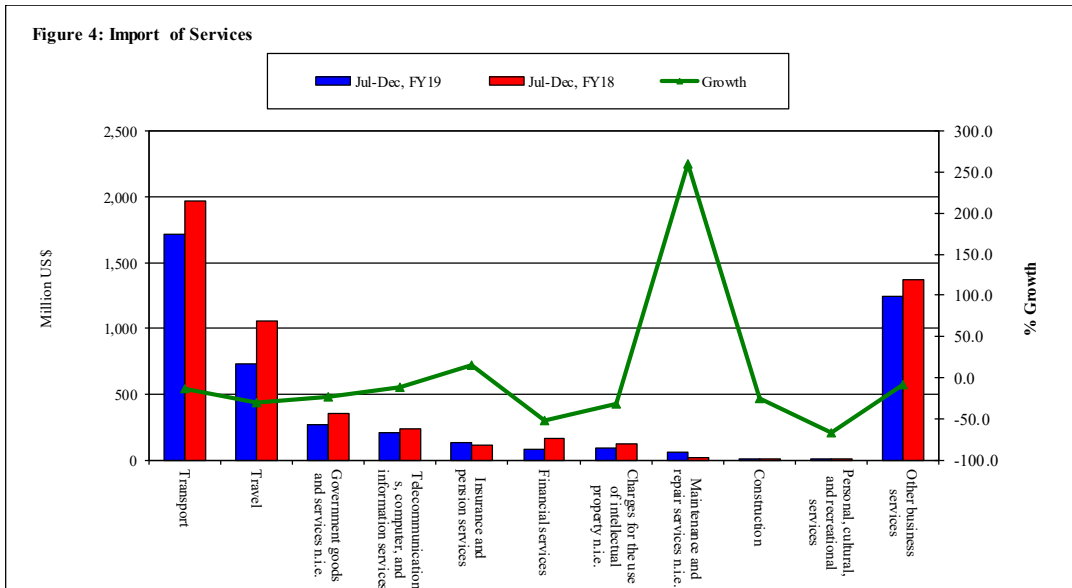
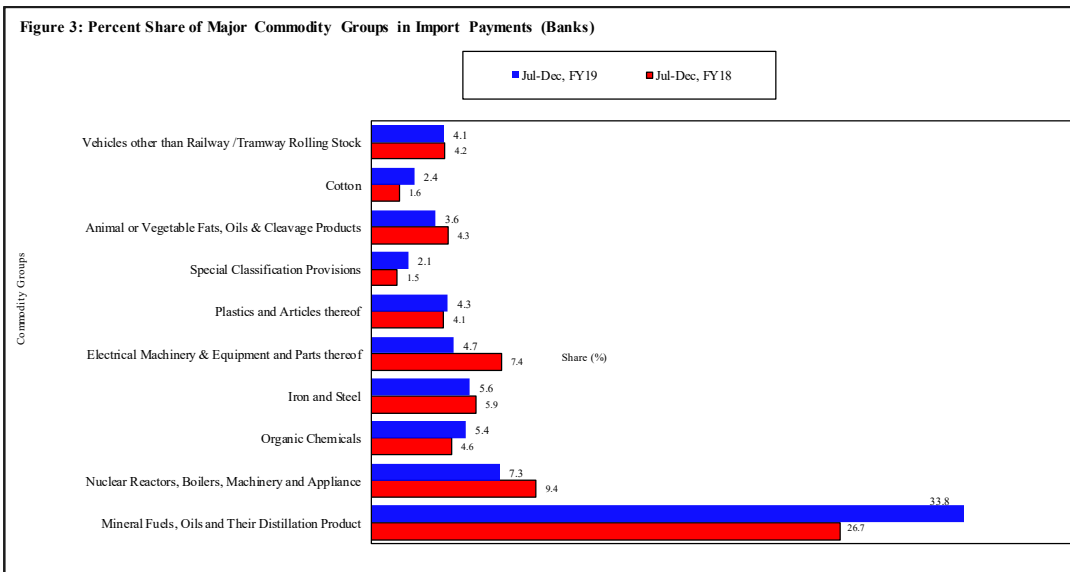

Figure 5: % Share of Major Countries in Import Payments of Goods During July-December, FY19

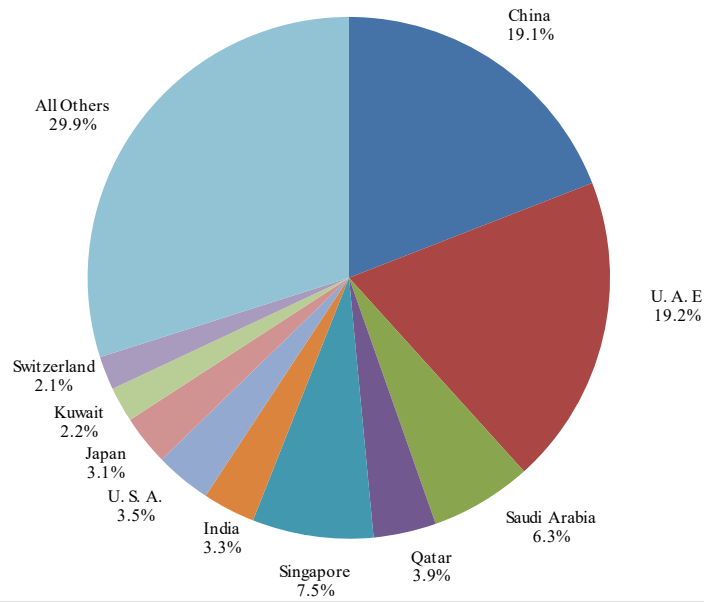
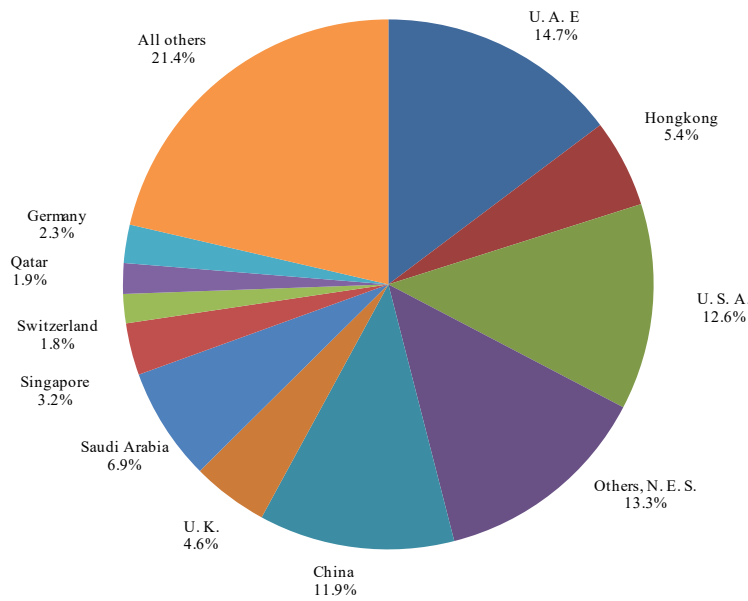
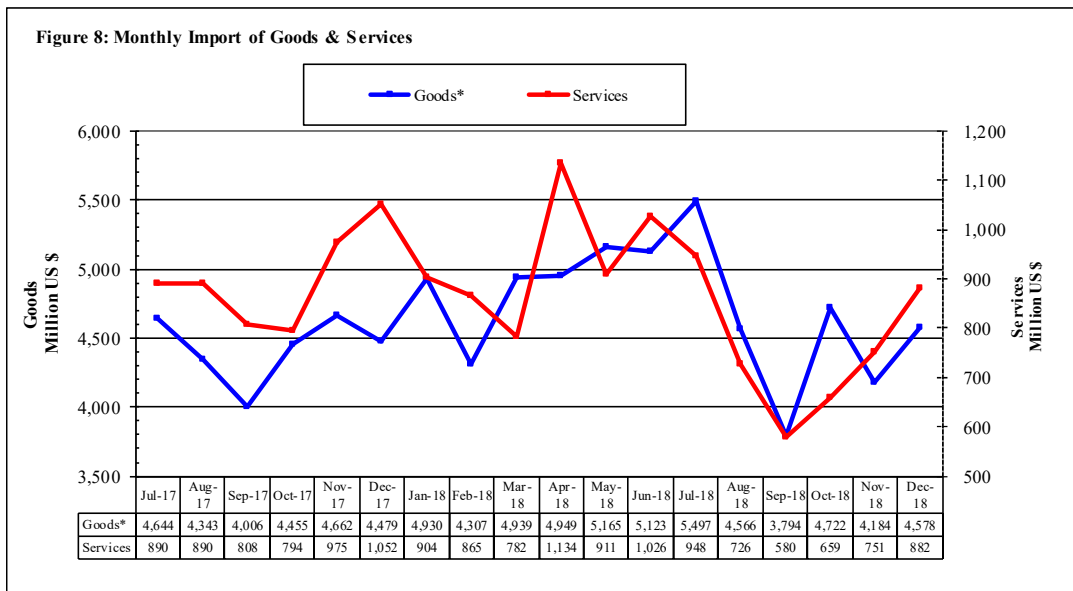
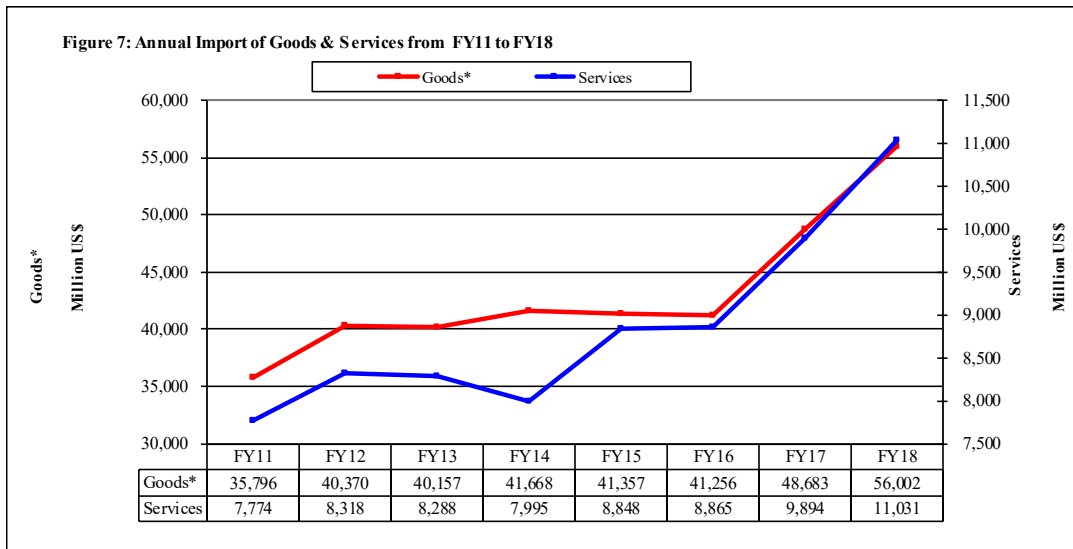


Figure 6: % Share of Major Countries in Import of Services During July-December, FY19
