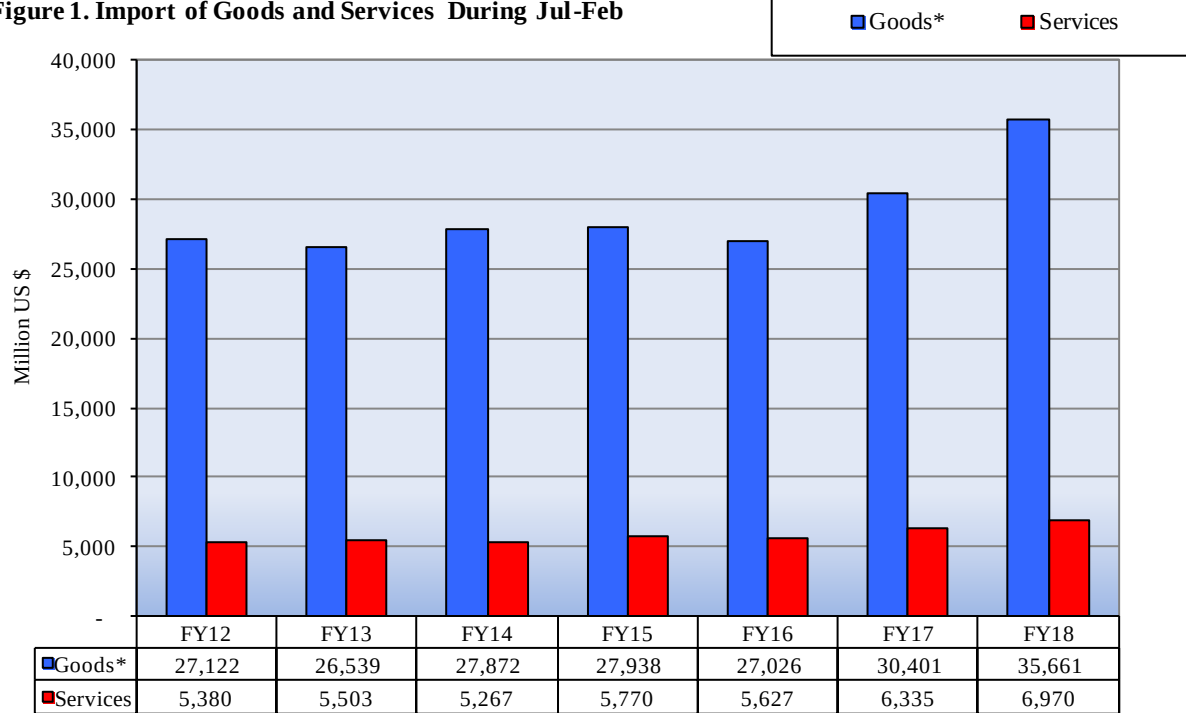
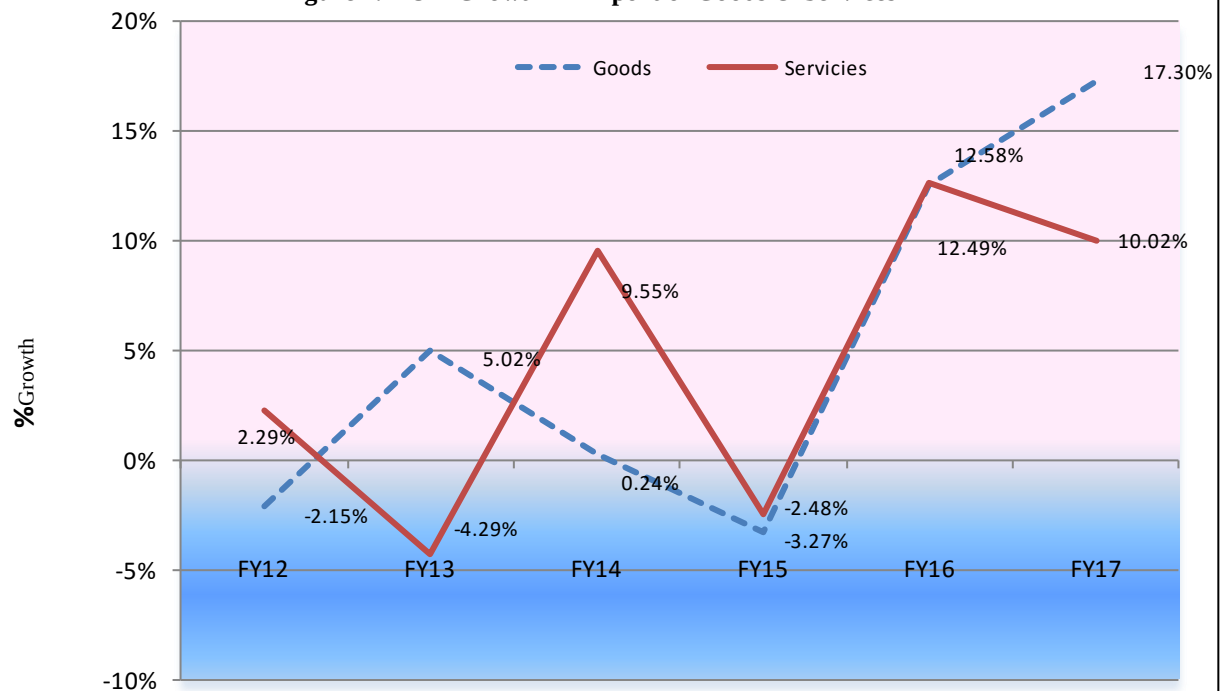

Figure 3: Percent Share of Major Commodity Groups in Import Payments (Banks)

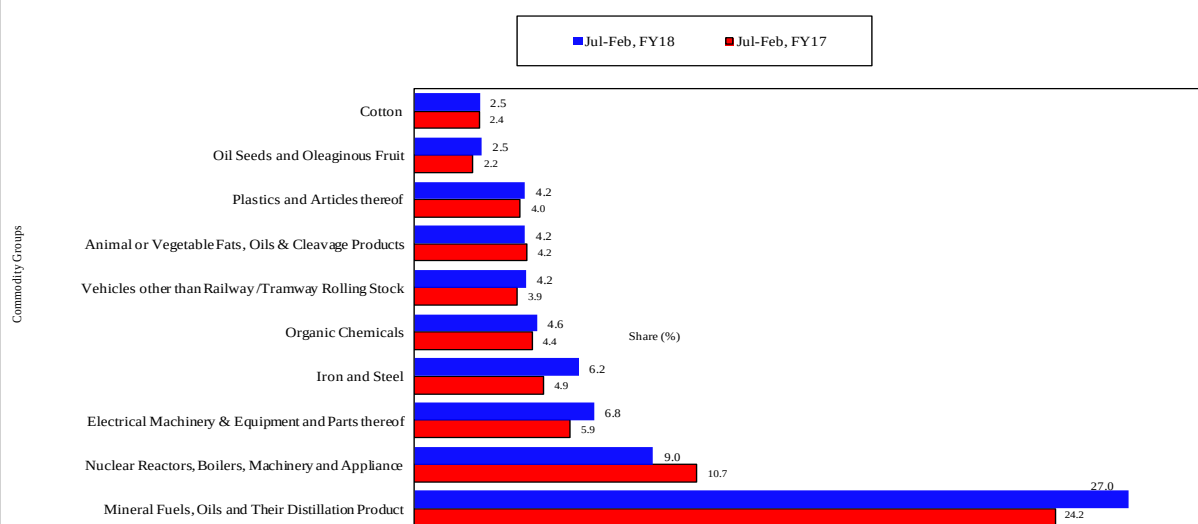
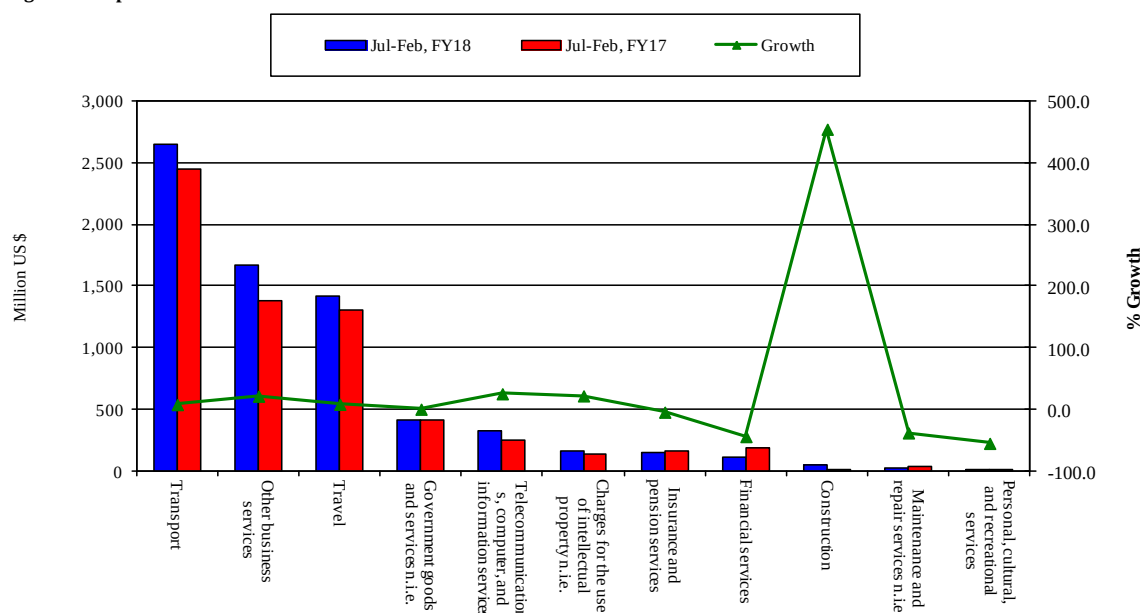


Figure 4: Import of Services

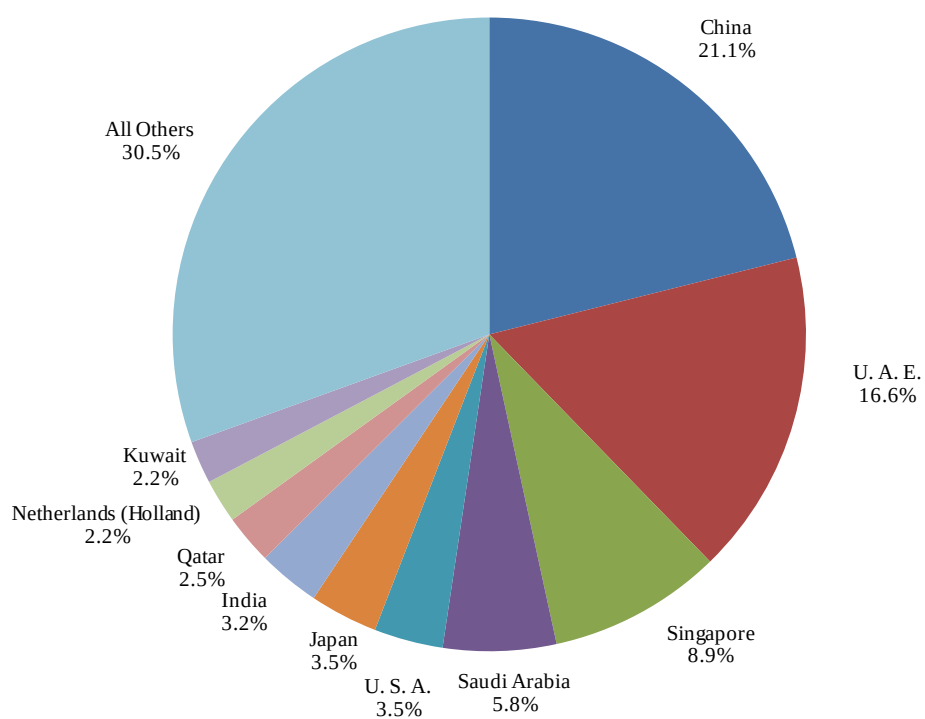
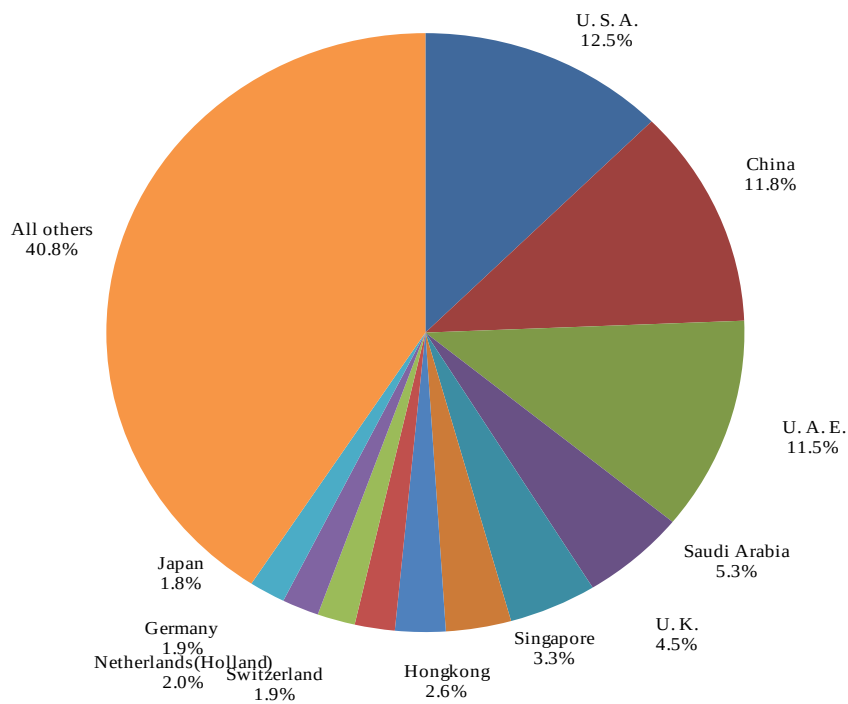
