Figure 1. Import of Goods and Services during July

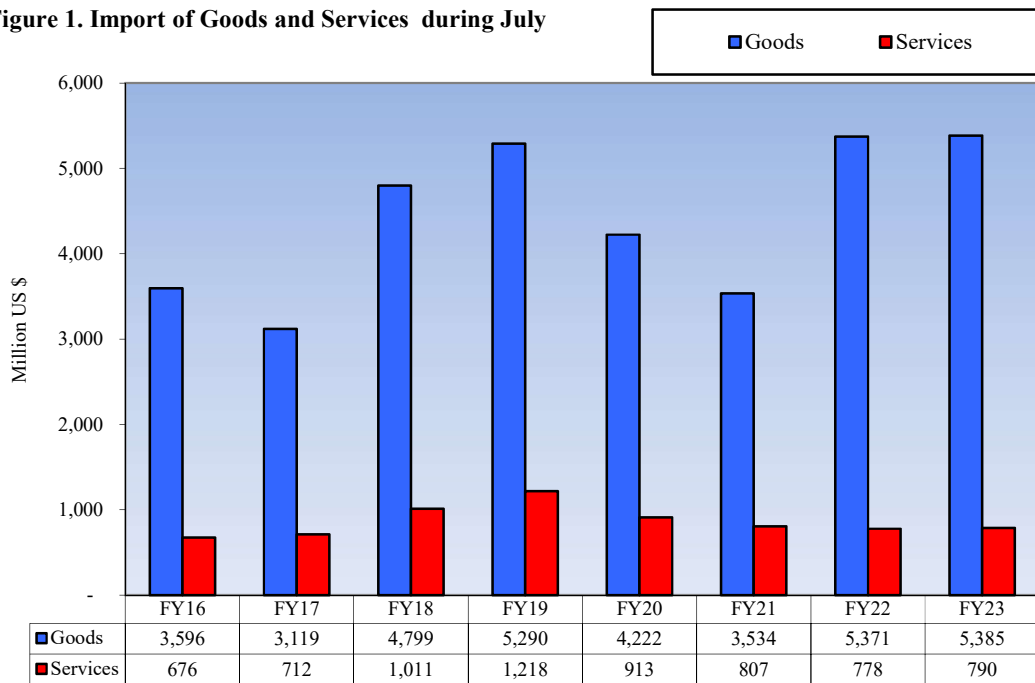


Figure 2: YOY Growth in Import of Goods & Services during Jul

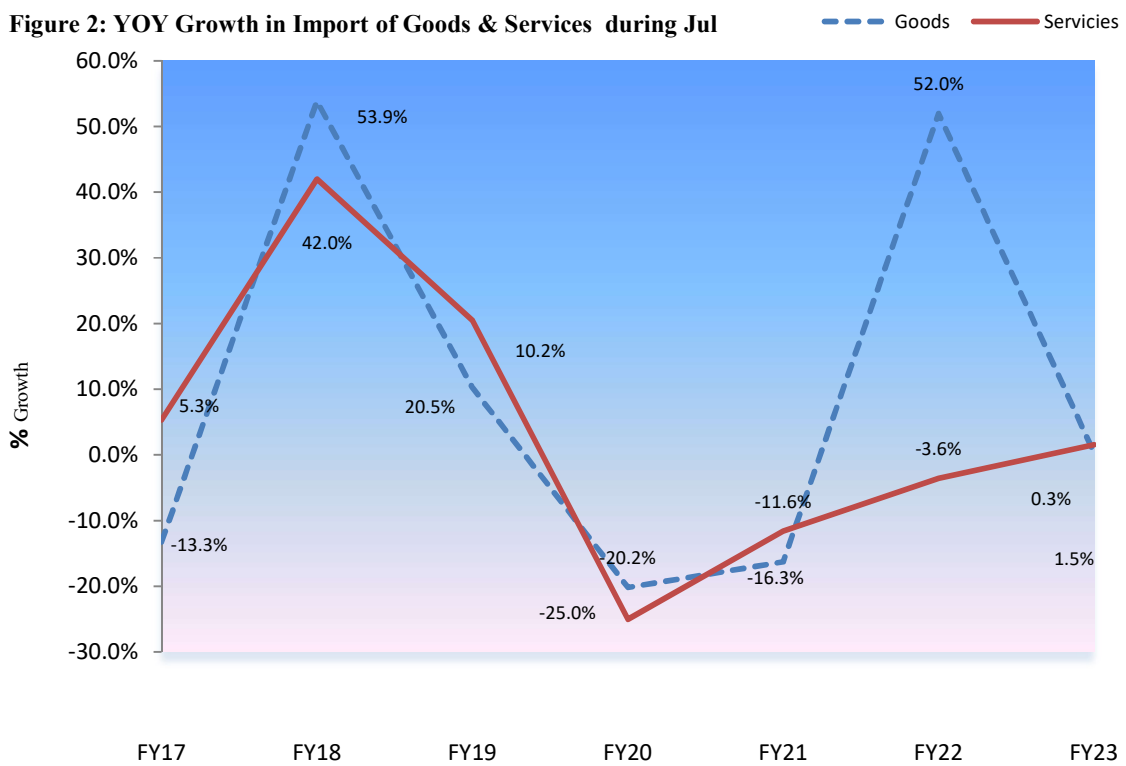

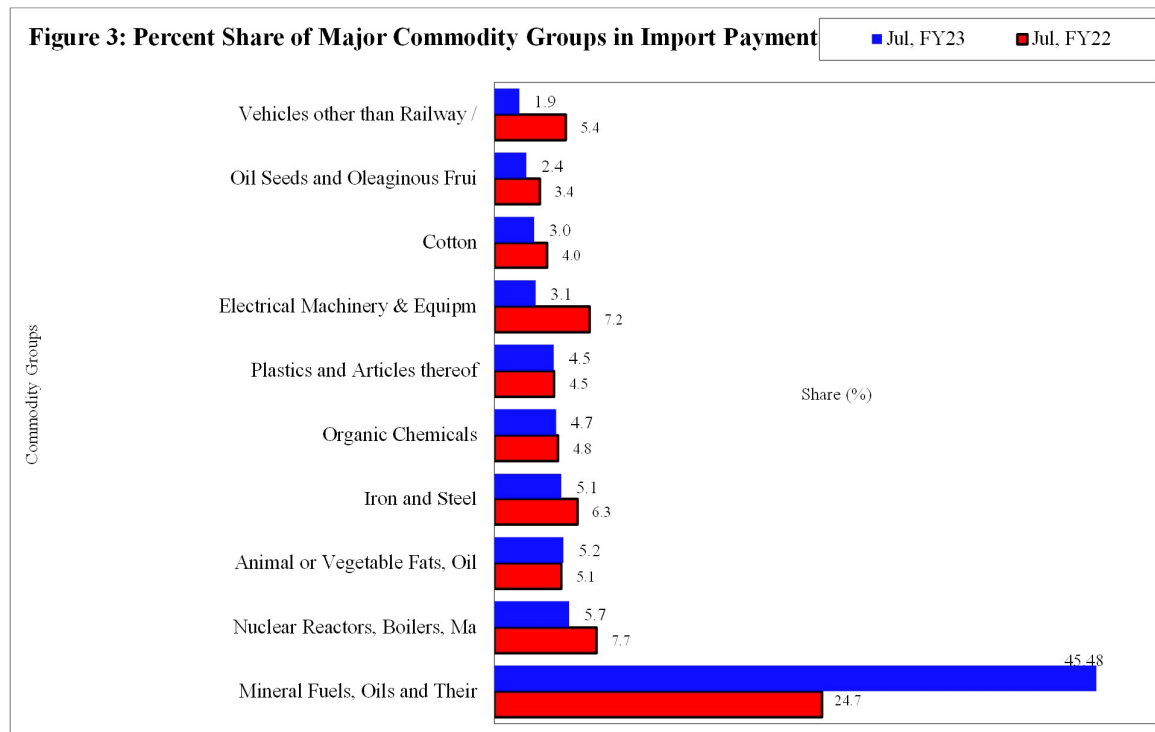

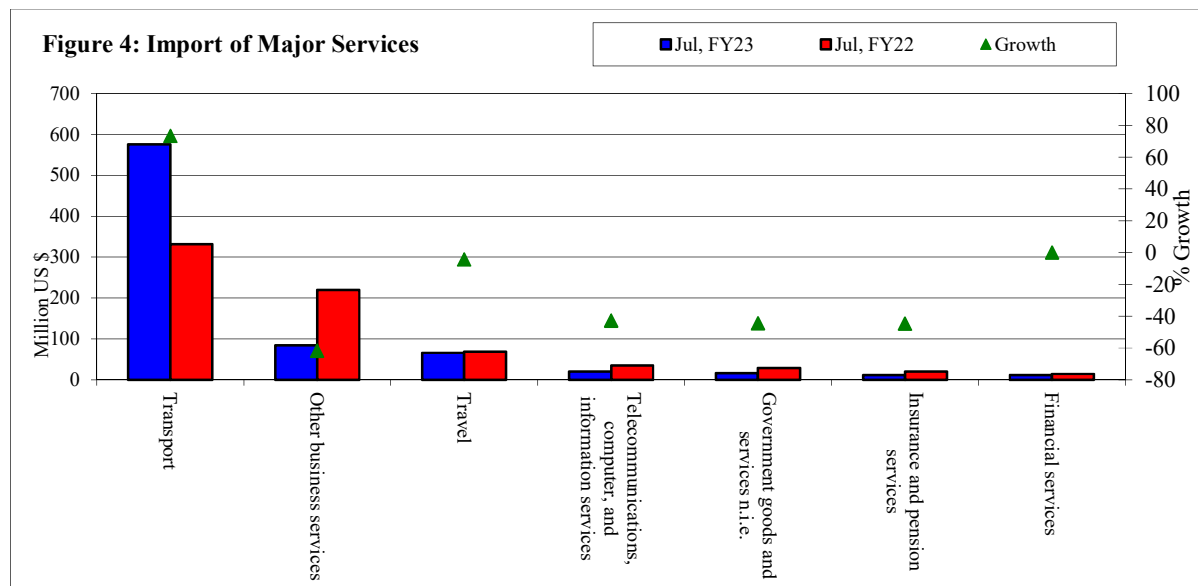
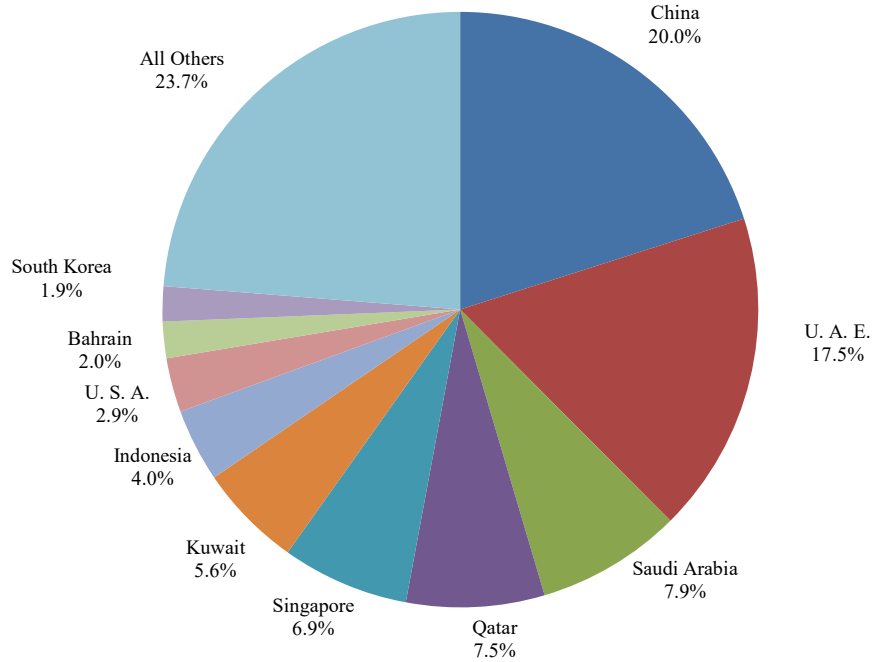
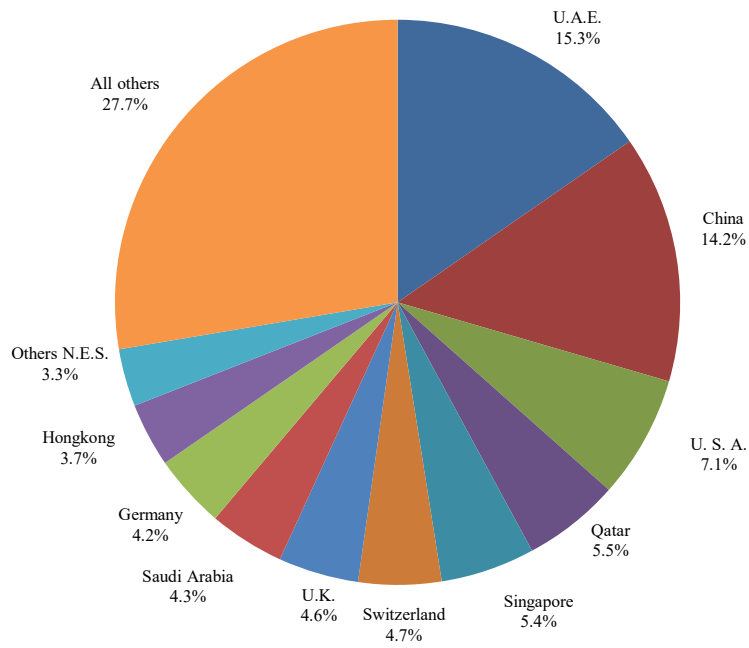


Figure 5: % Share of Major Countries in Import Payments of Goods During Jul FY23

Figure 6: % Share of Major Countries in Import of Services During Jul, FY23



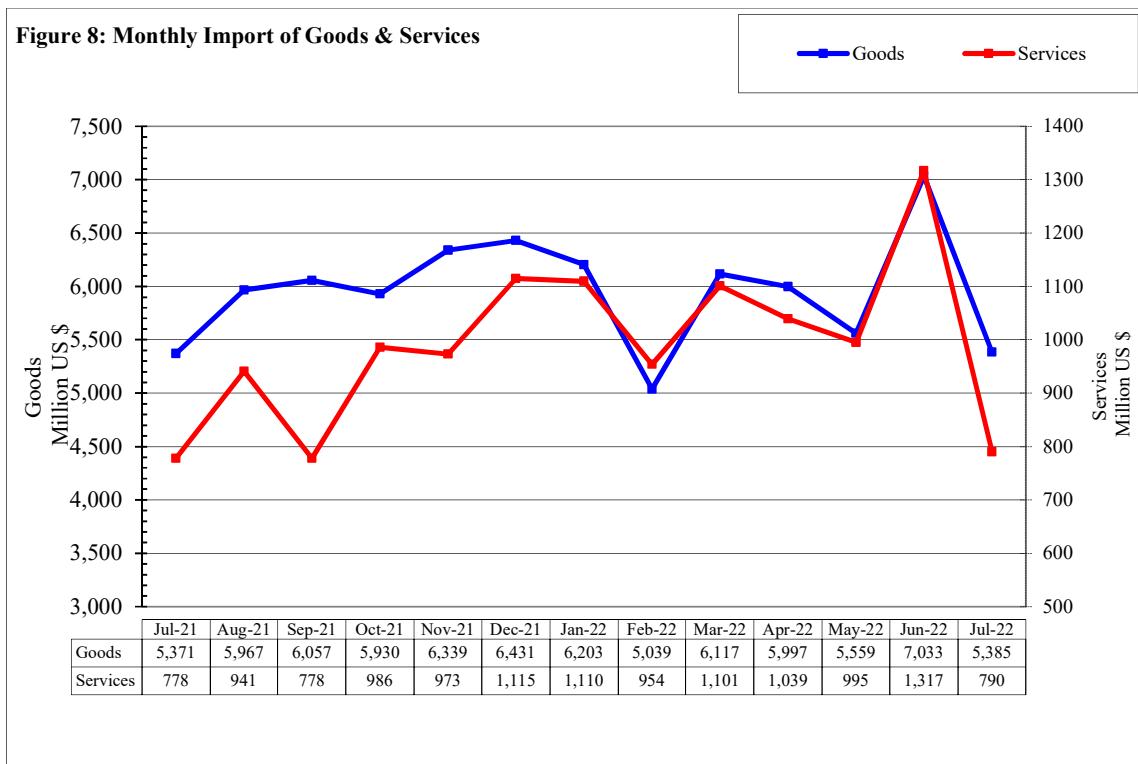
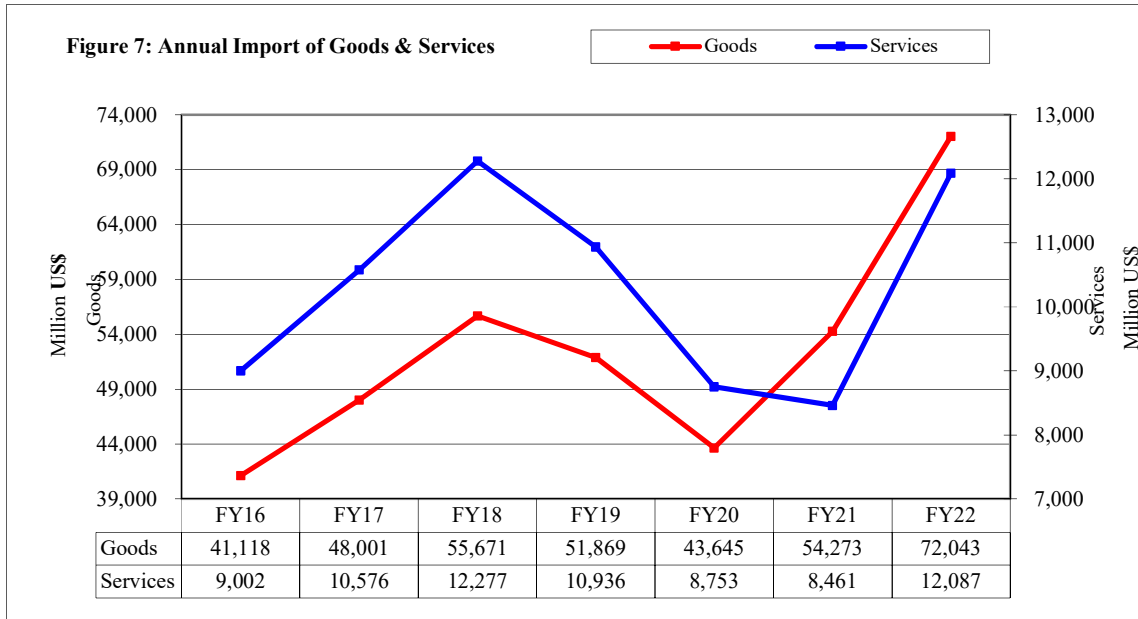
