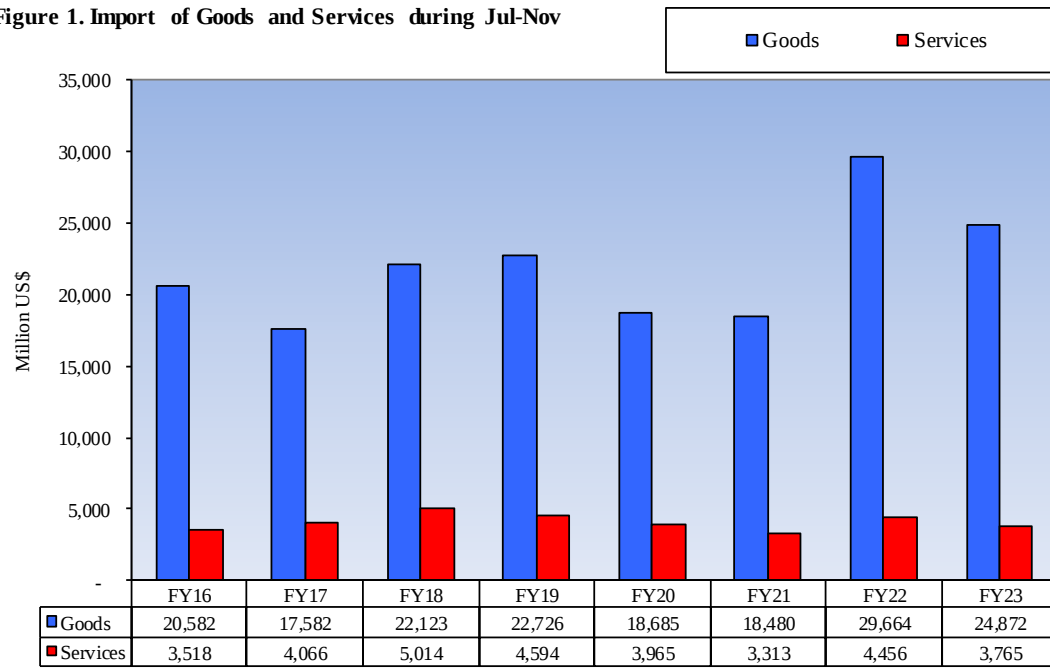
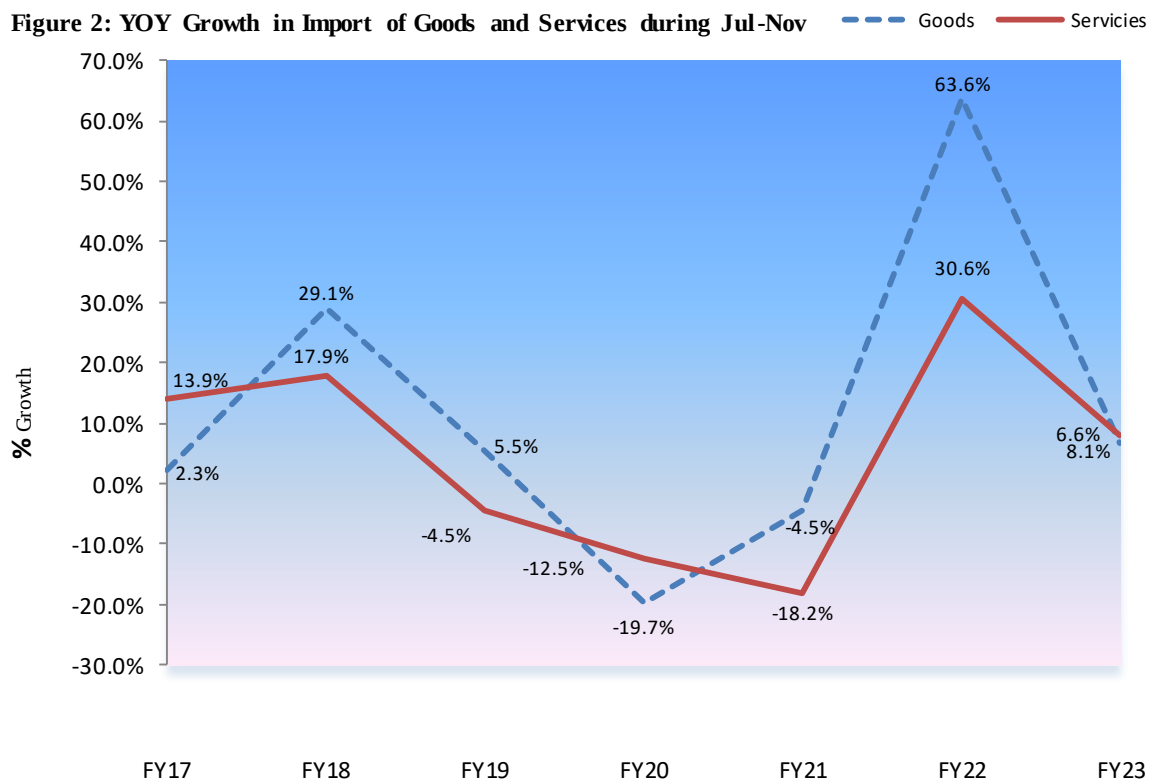
Figure 1. Import of Goods and Services during Jul-Nov**Figure 2: YOY Growth in Import of Goods and Services during Jul-Nov**

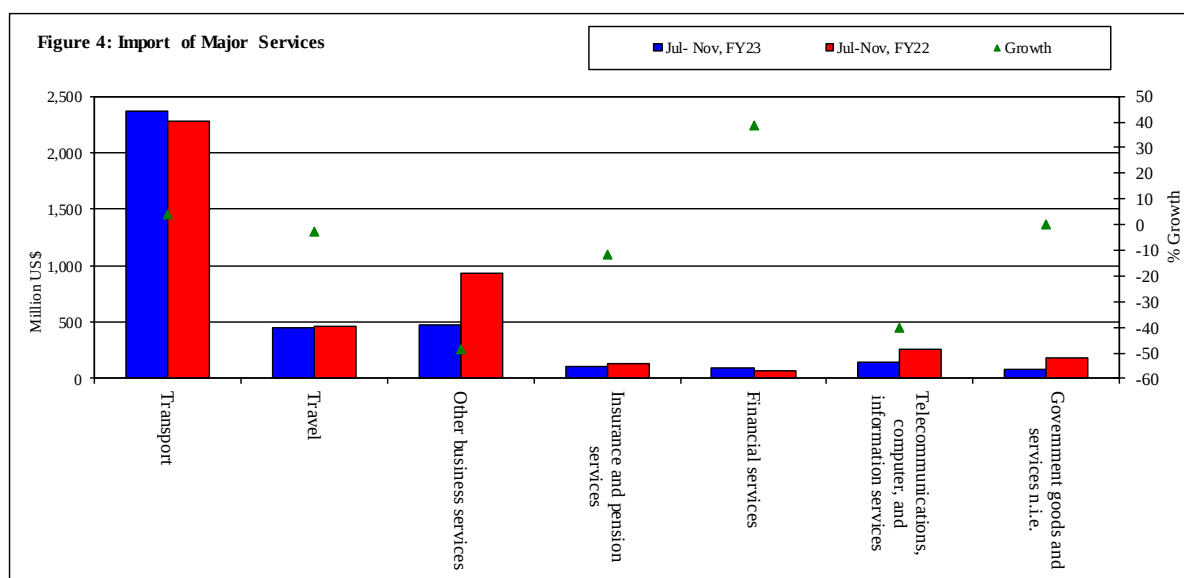
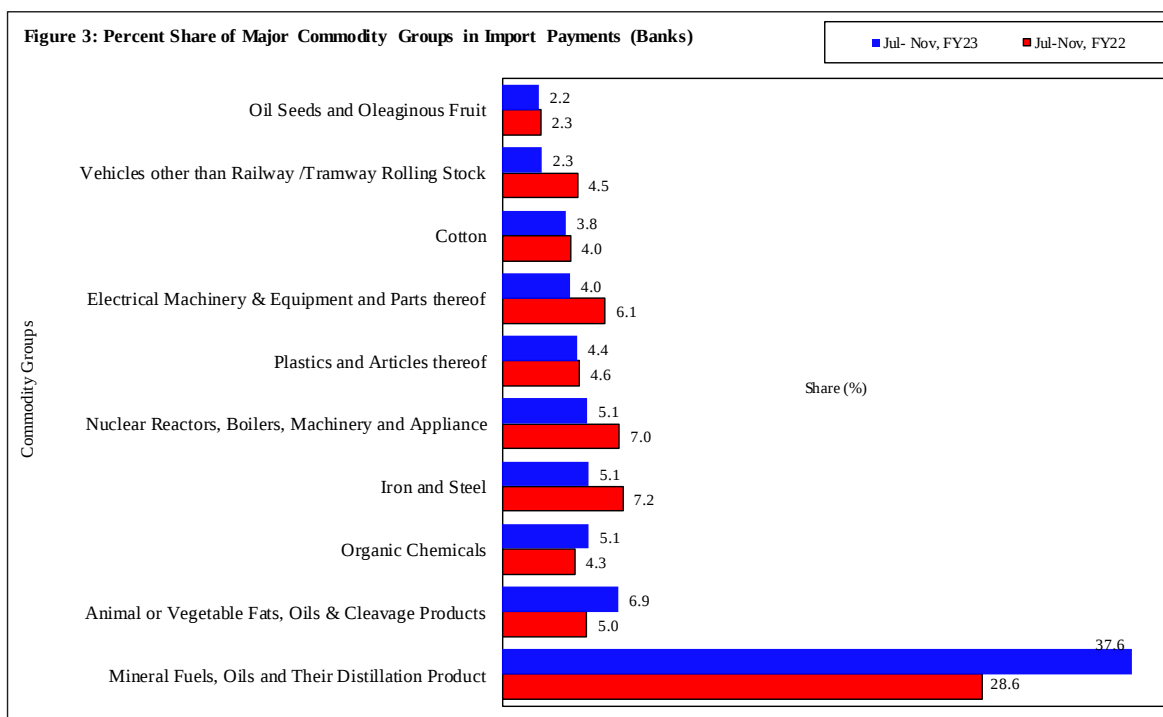
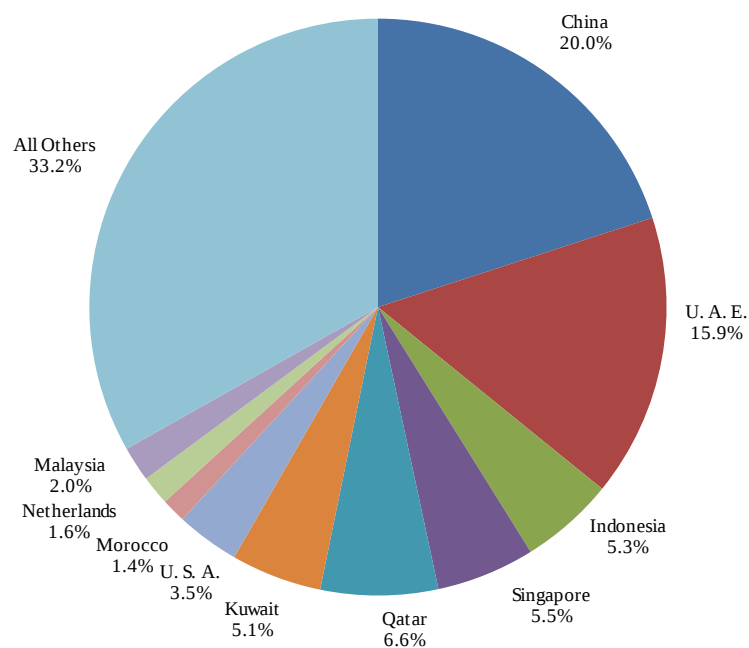
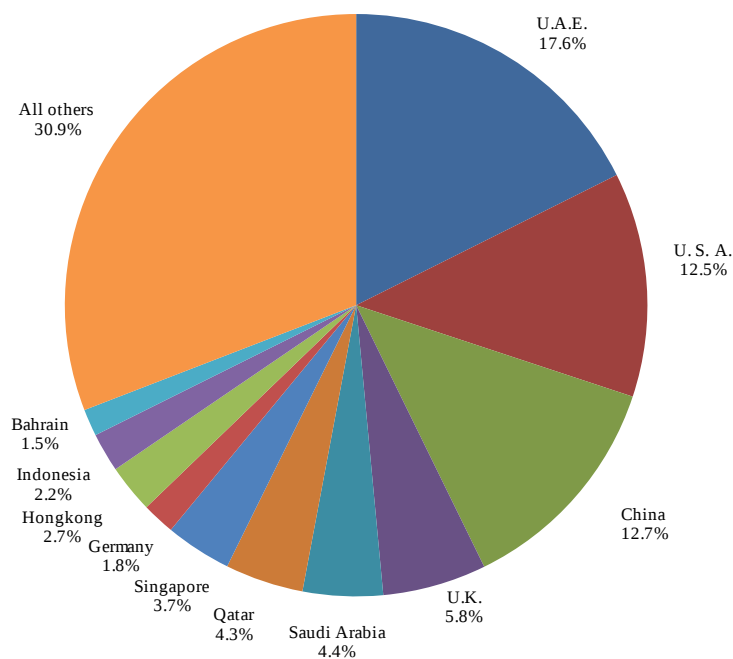


Figure 5: % Share of Major Countries in Import Payments of Goods During Jul-Nov, FY23

Figure 6: % Share of Major Countries in Import of Services During Jul-Nov, FY23



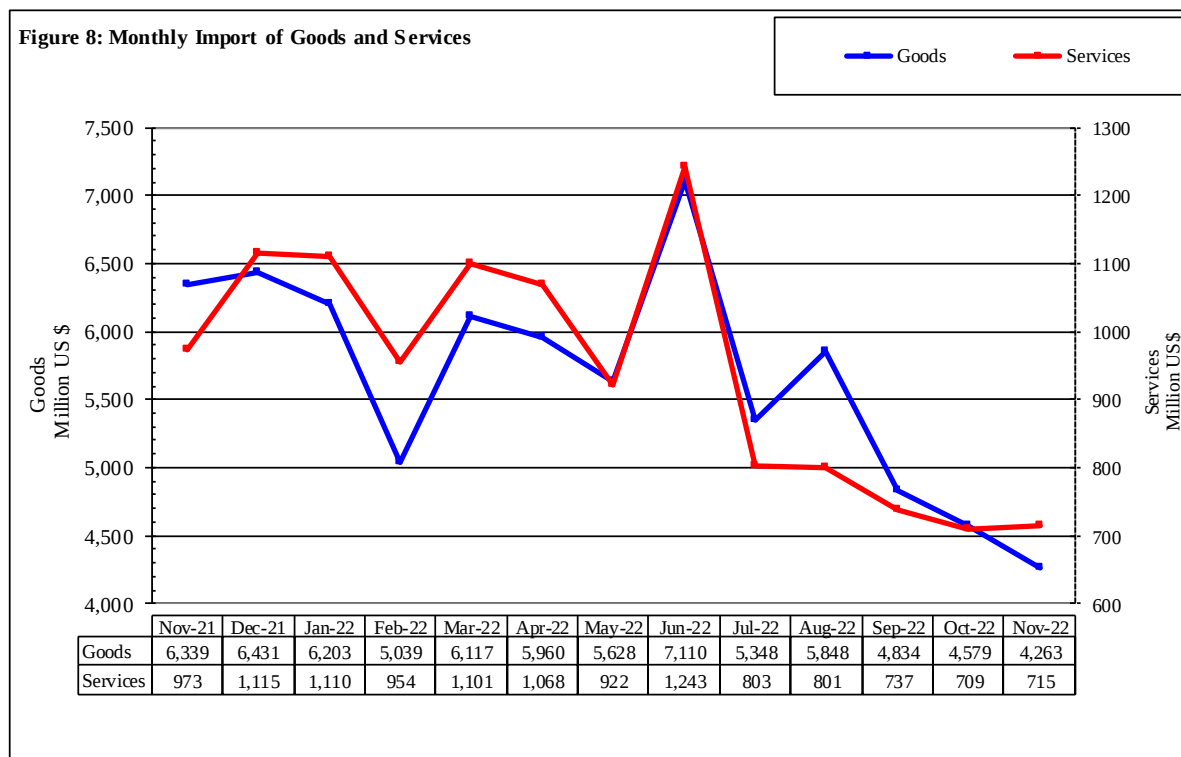
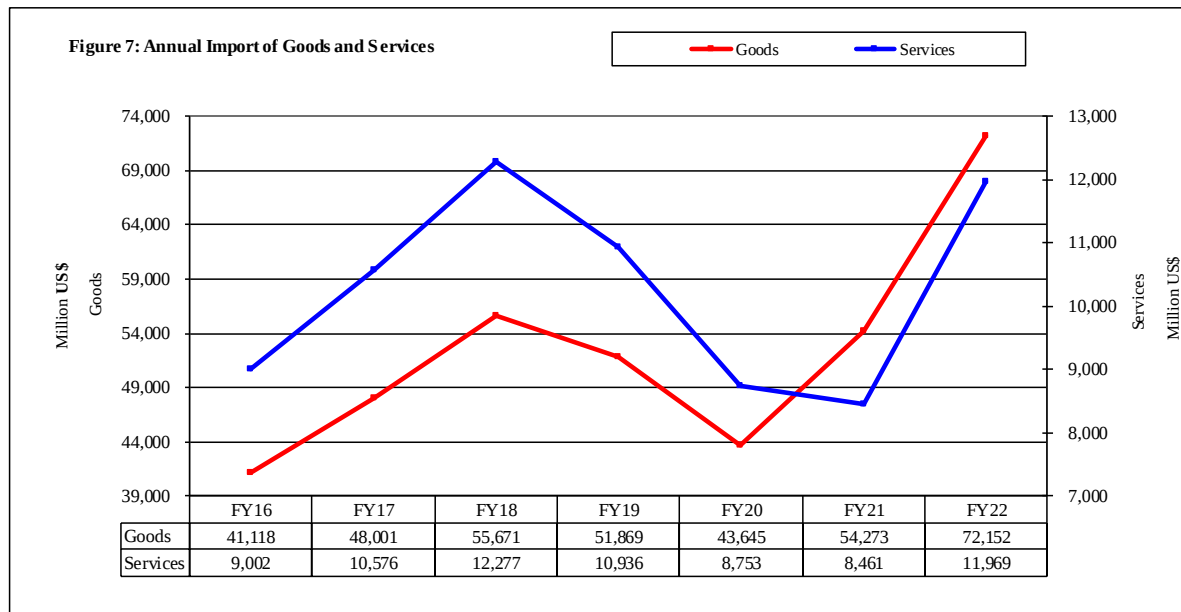
